Pro Career Highlights: Spent the 2007-08 season in the NBA Developmental League with the Dakota Wizards, averaging 12.9 points, 2.8 rebounds, and 4.2 assists in 21 games. Selected by the Wizards in the tenth round (139th pick overall) of the 2007 NBA D-League Draft. Played with the Dallas Defenders in the PBL in the summer of 2008 (statistics unavailable). Played with Petrochimi Imam Harbour in Iran in 2006-07 (statistics unavailable). Selected by the Tulsa 66ers in the tenth round (113rd pick overall) of the 2006 NBA D-League Draft. Participated in NBA summer league with the Atlanta Hawks in the summer of 2006. Played with Demon Astronauts Amsterdam in the Dutch League in 2004-05, averaging 10.0 points and 3.1 rebounds in 22 games. Recorded a season-high 30 points vs. DenHelder. Played in 14 games in FIBA Europe League competition, averaging 18.0 points, 3.9 rebounds, and 2.4 assists.

College Highlights: Finished collegiate career at LSU after playing freshman season at Panola Junior College in Carthage, Texas. Sat out the 2000-01 season at Panola as a redshirt. Left LSU at the start of his junior season and turned professional.

Junior (2003-04): Appeared in two games before leaving the team. Played a total of ten minutes. Scored only two points of the season against Southern in the season opener.

Sophomore (2002-03): Averaged 4.5 points and 0.9 rebounds in 9.4 minutes a contest. Appeared in 11 games before missing the rest of the season due to academic ineligibility. Posted season highs of 14 points and three rebounds in final appearance of the season vs. Centenary. Scored nine points vs. Nicholls State in the season opener. Registered eight points vs. Texas A&M-Corpus Christi.

Redshirt Freshman (2001-02): At Panola JC, averaged 18.4 points, 5.1 rebounds, and 2.2 steals. Ranked second on the team in scoring, eighth in Region XIV.

Personal: Majored in general studies. Favorite NBA team is the Phoenix Suns and favorite athlete is Tiger Woods.
