College Highlights: Earned Second Team All-Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference honors as a senior. Finished collegiate career at Concordia University in Minnesota after playing first three seasons at North Texas.

Senior (2005-06): Averaged 16.8 points (ranked third in the NSIC) and a team-high 6.0 rebounds (seventh). Also ranked seventh in the league in free throw percentage (.789) and fifth in blocks (1.07 bpg). Started 27 of 28 games. Led the team in scoring 17 times and paced the team in rebounding 12 times. Scored 20 or more points eight times. Posted career highs of 31 points and 13 rebounds vs. Minnesota-Duluth. Registered a double-double of 20 points and ten rebounds vs. Minnesota State-Moorhead. Recorded 24 points at Bemidji State. Scored 18 points and set a career-high with four blocks at Southwest Minnesota.

Junior (2004-05): Averaged 4.9 points and 2.2 rebounds in 14.0 minutes a contest. Started twice. Scored in double figures five times, with a season-high 14 points vs. Lamar. Scored 13 points at New Orleans. Tallied 11 points and six rebounds in the season opener vs. Angelo State. Recorded ten points, five rebounds, and a season-high five assists vs. Texas-Permian Basin. Grabbed a season-high seven rebounds at Louisiana-Lafayette.

Sophomore (2003-04): Averaged 4.3 points and 1.7 rebounds in 12.8 minutes a contest. Started seven times. Scored in double figures three times. Registered season highs of 12 points and seven rebounds vs. Hardin-Simmons. Scored 11 points at St. Bonaventure. Recorded 11 points at Louisiana-Lafayette. Tallied nine points and five rebounds at Arkansas.

Freshman (2002-03): Averaged 2.9 points and 1.9 rebounds. Posted season-high eight points on 4-for-5 shooting vs. Denver. Matched season high with eight points vs. Arkansas-Little Rock in the Sun Belt Tournament.
