Pro Career Highlights: Started the 2006-07 season in China with the Yunnan Honghe Running Bulls (statistics unavailable) before moving on to Aix-Maurienne in the French ProB league, averaging 10.3 points and 6.0 rebounds in four games. Spent the 2005-06 season in the Netherlands with Matrixx Magix Nijmegen, averaging 14.4 points and 9.3 rebounds in 19 games. Played in the Dutch All-Star Game.

College Highlights: Started 31 of 77 career games. Finished collegiate career at Miami after playing freshman season at Fresno City College in California. Sat out the 2002-03 season as a medical redshirt while recovering from a broken bone in his right foot.

Senior (2004-05): Averaged 8.7 points and 6.4 rebounds (ranked 13th in the ACC) in 23.8 minutes a contest. Started the last 23 games of the season. Scored in double figures 11 times. Set a career-high with 18 points vs. South Carolina State. Matched career high with 18 points and grabbed six rebounds vs. Duke. Pulled down a career-high 13 rebounds at Georgia Tech. Grabbed 12 rebounds vs. Florida State. Scored 15 points vs. Maryland. Tallied 12 points and eight rebounds at Virginia Tech.

Junior (2003-04): Averaged 6.3 points and 3.5 rebounds in 17.2 minutes a contest. Started eight of 22 games, missing eight games due an unspecified NCAA violation. Scored in double figures four times. Posted season-high 16 points and grabbed seven rebounds vs. Syracuse. Registered 12 points and seven rebounds vs. Louisiana-Monroe. Tallied nine points, six rebounds, and a career-high three blocked shots vs. Georgetown.

Sophomore (2001-02): Averaged 1.5 points and 1.4 rebounds in 5.6 minutes a contest. Scored season-high six points vs. Georgetown in the first round of the Big East Tournament. Tied for the team lead with a season-high seven rebounds vs. Missouri in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Freshman (2000-01): At Fresno City College, averaged 23.2 points, 14.3 rebounds, and 3.0 blocked shots. Shot 57.8 percent from the field and 79.4 percent from the free throw line. Earned First Team All-District and All-Central Valley Conference honors.
