**Warriors 125, Grizzlies 117**

**MEMPHIS, TN** – The Grizzlies allowed a season-high 125 points to the Golden State Warriors and lost their fourth consecutive home game, 125-117... One game after setting a new career high with 32 points at Orlando, **Rudy Gay** tied the mark with 32 points (11-of-18 FG) and four rebounds against the Warriors... Gay is now averaging 23.9 points through eight games in December... The Warriors improved to 13-5 with **Stephen Jackson** in the lineup and have won 11 of their last 15 after losing their first six games of the season... Jackson led the way for Golden State with 28 points (11-of-22 FG) and a season-high 12 rebounds, marking his first double-double of the season... Memphis nailed eight three-pointers in the fourth quarter on 13 attempts, both franchise records for makes and attempts in a single quarter... The Warriors improved to 7-6 on the road this season... Last season, the club did not earn its seventh win away from the Bay Area until its 32<sup>nd</sup> road game (March 5, 2007 at Detroit).

**ORLANDO, FL** – The Memphis Grizzlies ended a season-worst six-game losing streak Saturday on the road against the Orlando Magic... **Rudy Gay** set a new career high with a game-high 32 points (13-of-21 FG) while **Juan Carlos Navarro** added 27 points (7-of-13 FG)... Orlando's **Dwight Howard** racked up 31 points (10-of-11 FG) and 20 rebounds, marking the third 30/20 game of his career... It was Howard's sixth-straight double-double and the most rebounds any player has hauled in vs. Memphis this season... The Grizzlies' streak-snapping win could be attributed to their breaking out of a recent three-point shooting funk... The Grizzlies connected on 12 three-pointers after hitting just 12 in the previous three games combined... **Andre Brown** achieved a season-high in points (7) and set a career-high in rebounds (7) off the bench... It was Memphis' first win this season when trailing at the end of the third quarter (1-11)... In Memphis' last three six-game slides, the club has won the seventh game each time.

**SERIES HISTORY:** The Spurs emerged victorious in their Oct. 31 contest with the Grizzlies on Memphis' opening night and in San Antonio on Nov. 23... San Antonio holds a 38-11 advantage in the regular season series, standing at 19-6 vs. the Grizzlies in Memphis... The Spurs have won nine of the last 10 contests between the two clubs... The Grizzlies' lone win (101-91) over that span came on April 16, 2007... The Grizzlies franchise made its postseason debut against San Antonio on April 17, 2004, with the Spurs prevailing 98-74.

**NOTABLES:** Grizzlies Head Coach **Marc Iavaroni** averaged 5.8 points and 4.1 rebounds in 99 career games with the San Antonio Spurs from 1984-86... Memphis shot .459 (28-of-61) from three-point range against the Spurs in 2006-07, the team's highest percentage against any NBA opponent last season... Grizzlies Senior Vice President of Arena Operations **Steve Zito** previously worked for the San Antonio Spurs, where he oversaw the design, construction and operations of the SBC Center (now the AT&T Center) which opened in 2002... Spurs rookie **Darius Washington** led the University of Memphis to an Elite Eight appearance in 2006... Grizzlies Radio Play-by-Play announcer **Eric Hasseltine** and Spurs guard **Brent Barry** were high school classmates at De La Salle High School, in Concord, CA.

**SAN ANTONIO, TX** – The San Antonio Spurs built up a 21-point lead in the first half and never let up, handing the Grizzlies their fifth-straight road loss, 101-88, at the AT&T Center... Spurs forward **Tim Duncan** dominated with 28 points (14-of-17 FG) and nine rebounds, taking advantage of the Memphis' smaller starting lineup and the absence of **Darko Milicic**, who missed his fourth consecutive game with a sprained left thumb... San Antonio outscored Memphis 64-38 in the paint... **Juan Carlos Navarro** made his second start of the season and paced the Grizzlies with 16 points... Spurs guard **Tony Parker** contributed 21 points and eight assists... Netting 12 points on 6-of-14 shooting, **Pau Gasol** scored in double figures for his 70<sup>th</sup> game in a row, tying him with injured Los Angeles Clippers forward **Elton Brand** for the league's fifth-longest active streak.

**Spurs 104, Grizzlies 101**

**MEMPHIS, TN** – The Memphis Grizzlies nearly captured their first opening night victory since moving to Memphis in 2001, but the defending NBA champion San Antonio Spurs came through in the clutch to spoil **Marc Iavaroni**'s head coaching debut with the Grizzlies... After the Grizzlies took a 95-93 lead with 2:05 remaining in the game, the San Antonio Spurs closed the game on an 11-6 run to seal the victory... Spurs guard **Manu Ginobili** scored a game-high 30 points, including San Antonio's final nine of the game... The Grizzlies dropped to 3-10 in season openers and have not won since 2000 when the club was in Vancouver... The game featured 16 lead changes and neither team led by more than seven points... **Pau Gasol** led the Grizzlies with 22 points, while **Mike Miller** chipped in with 11 points, a team-high 10 rebounds and five assists in the loss... San Antonio won for the eighth time in the last nine decisions against the Grizzlies.

**SERIES HISTORY:** The Pistons have won 11 of the last 13 meetings between the franchises, including the last five, and hold a 18-5 advantage in the all-time series... The Pistons handled the Grizzlies 113-103 on Dec. 11 in the teams' only other meeting this season... The Grizzlies' 2004-05 season series sweep over Detroit (101-79 at Detroit on Jan. 6, 2005 and 72-68 at Memphis on Dec. 11, 2004) represent the club's only wins over the Pistons since moving to Memphis.

**NOTABLES:** Grizzlies forward/center **Darko Milicic** was originally selected by the Pistons with the second overall pick in the first round of the 2003 NBA Draft and was a member of the Detroit's 2004 NBA Championship team... Pistons guard **Chauncey Billups** and Memphis guard/forward **Mike Miller** played together on the USA National Team which went undefeated (10-0) and won the gold medal at the FIBA Americas Championship last summer... Grizzlies guard **Damon Stoudamire** and Pistons forward **Rasheed Wallace** were teammates on the Portland Trail Blazers from 1997-2004... Grizzlies forward **Brian Cardinal** was originally selected by the Pistons in the second round with the 44<sup>th</sup> overall pick of the 2000 NBA Draft... Pistons forward **Antonio McDyess** (Quitman) and Pistons guard **Lindsey Hunter** (Utica) are Mississippi natives.

**MEMPHIS, TN** – Memphis extended its season-high five-game losing streak with a 113-103 loss to the Detroit Pistons... The Grizzlies have now lost 11 of the past 13 contests with Detroit, including the last five... The Pistons' starting backcourt outscored its Memphis counterparts 55-8... Memphis' starting backcourt of **Mike Miller** and **Damon Stoudamire** has combined for just 11 points on 3-of-19 (15.8 percent) shooting in the past two games (5.5 points)... **Rudy Gay** led the Grizzlies in scoring with 20 points (8-of-17 FG), and **Pau Gasol** added 18 points (6-of-12 FG) and eight rebounds, ending his double-double streak at four games... **Darko Milicic** finished with 12 points (6-of-12 FG), all coming in the first quarter... The ex-Piston scored in double-figures for the first time since netting 10 points on Nov. 14 at Milwaukee, his last game before suffering a sprained left thumb vs. New Orleans on Nov. 16... The surging Pistons have won seven of their last eight games with an average margin of victory of 19.6 points... All seven wins have come by 10 points or more... Detroit is now 10-0 this season when scoring over 100 points.

**2007-08 TEAM NOTES**

**JUST THE QUICK FACTS**

- Tonight's matchup pits the best team in the Southwest Division (San Antonio, 18-6) against the worst (Memphis, 7-17)... The Southwest Division boasts the best overall winning percentage of all the NBA divisions (69-49, .585; Pacific Division – 66-56, .541)... and is the only division with four teams at or above .500 (Dallas – 17-9, New Orleans – 15-10, Houston – 12-12).
- The Grizzlies are looking to avoid a five-game home losing streak for the first time since dropping five-straight from March 20-April 10, 2007.
- San Antonio has won nine of the last 10 meetings, including both games this season.
- The Grizzlies are averaging 114.4 points in seven wins this season and just 99.8 points in 17 losses.
- With 8.46 three-pointers per game (4<sup>th</sup> in the NBA), converting at 40.0 percent (2<sup>nd</sup>), the Spurs are one of the few teams in the league who have had better success with the long ball than the Grizzlies, who enter tonight's game hitting 8.21 treys (6<sup>th</sup>) at 37.9 percent (4<sup>th</sup>).
- The Grizzlies are 0-6 in games decided by three points or less... San Antonio is 2-0 in tight games and gave Memphis one of those losses, 104-101, on Oct. 31.
- Memphis is 0-9 when scoring under 100 points.

**OFF TO THE RACES**

Grizzlies Head Coach **Marc Iavaroni** promised to bring a high-scoring, fast-paced offensive system to Memphis, much like he did in his five previous seasons with the Phoenix Suns (including the last three-and-a-half as **Mike D'Antoni's** lead assistant) and so far has done little to disappoint... The Grizzlies are averaging a franchise-best **104.0** points per game, which would top last season's club record 101.6 scoring average... In the franchise's 12-year history, the Grizzlies have ranked as one of the NBA's 10 best scoring teams just four times and have never cracked the top five. ... Here is a look at the Grizzlies' best-scoring seasons.

**CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR**

The Grizzlies have caught a few bad breaks at the end of games this season... **Memphis is the only NBA team to lose six games by three points or less (0-6)**... The Miami Heat (1-5) are the only other NBA team to have lost more than three... The Grizzlies suffered their **sixth** loss by three points or less this season following a 118-116 overtime defeat at New Orleans on Dec. 7... Memphis also dropped its season opener vs. San Antonio (104-101) on Oct. 31, at Milwaukee (102-99) on Nov. 14, an overtime loss vs. New Orleans (120-118) on Nov. 16, at Dallas (108-105) on Nov. 17 and vs. Portland (106-105) on Dec. 3.

## BEHIND THE ARC

The Memphis Grizzlies have relied heavily on the three-point shot this season, and it has proven to be one of the club's most reliable weapons... The Grizzlies rank in the top 10 in three-point field goal percentage (franchise-best **.379**, **4<sup>th</sup>**) and three-point field goals made (franchise-best **8.21**, **5<sup>th</sup>** Memphis is **5-4** when it has made 10 or more 3-pointers and **2-13** when it doesn't).

### SHOOTING STAR

Grizzlies guard/forward **Mike Miller** has consistently been regarded as one of the NBA's top shooters, but this season he's close to achieving a career first – shooting at least at least 50 percent from the field (**.504**), 40 percent from three-point range (**.426**) and 80 percent from the free throw line (**.789**)... Only **Steve Nash**, **Jason Terry**, **Caron Butler** and **John Salmons** are shooting 50 FG%, 40 3FG% and 80 FT% AND met all the statistical minimums to qualify among the league leaders in 2007-08.

### "LA BOMBA"

Nicknamed "La Bomba" for his high-arching floaters, Grizzlies rookie **Juan Carlos Navarro** is dazzling NBA fans and opponents with his crafty passes, gritty play and deadly shooting ability... Navarro currently ranks in the top 5 among all rookies in scoring average (**10.9**, **2<sup>nd</sup>**), three-point field goals made (**49**, **1<sup>st</sup>**) and three-point field goal percentage (**.405**, **2<sup>nd</sup>**), assists (**2.0**, **2<sup>nd</sup>**), free throw percentage (**.909**, **2<sup>nd</sup>**) and minutes per game (**23.3**, **5<sup>th</sup>**)... He tied an NBA rookie record with eight three-point field goals (on nine attempts) vs. New Orleans on Nov. 16... The only other first-year players to make eight treys in a single game are current New Jersey Nets guard **Jason Kidd** and Chicago Bulls guard **Chris Duhon**... The Spanish guard's breakout game included 28 points in 34 minutes vs. the Hornets after totaling 30 points in his first 91 minutes played in the club's first seven games... His eight three-pointers were also one shy of **Mike Miller's** club record (nine, twice).

### GAY SHINES AMONG 2006 DRAFT CLASS

Averaging a team-high **19.5** points per contest, Grizzlies sophomore forward **Rudy Gay** **leads** all 2006 draftees in scoring, significantly upping his scoring output from his rookie season (10.8 in 2006-07)... Gay scored a career-high 32 points (13-of-21 FG) vs. the Orlando Magic on Dec. 15 and matched it the next game vs. Golden State on Dec. 17... He has recorded double-figures in **21** games this season, 20-plus points **11** times and has surpassed 30 points **five** times... He finished with 20-plus in eight games total in 78 appearances during his rookie year, with one game of 30 or more.
