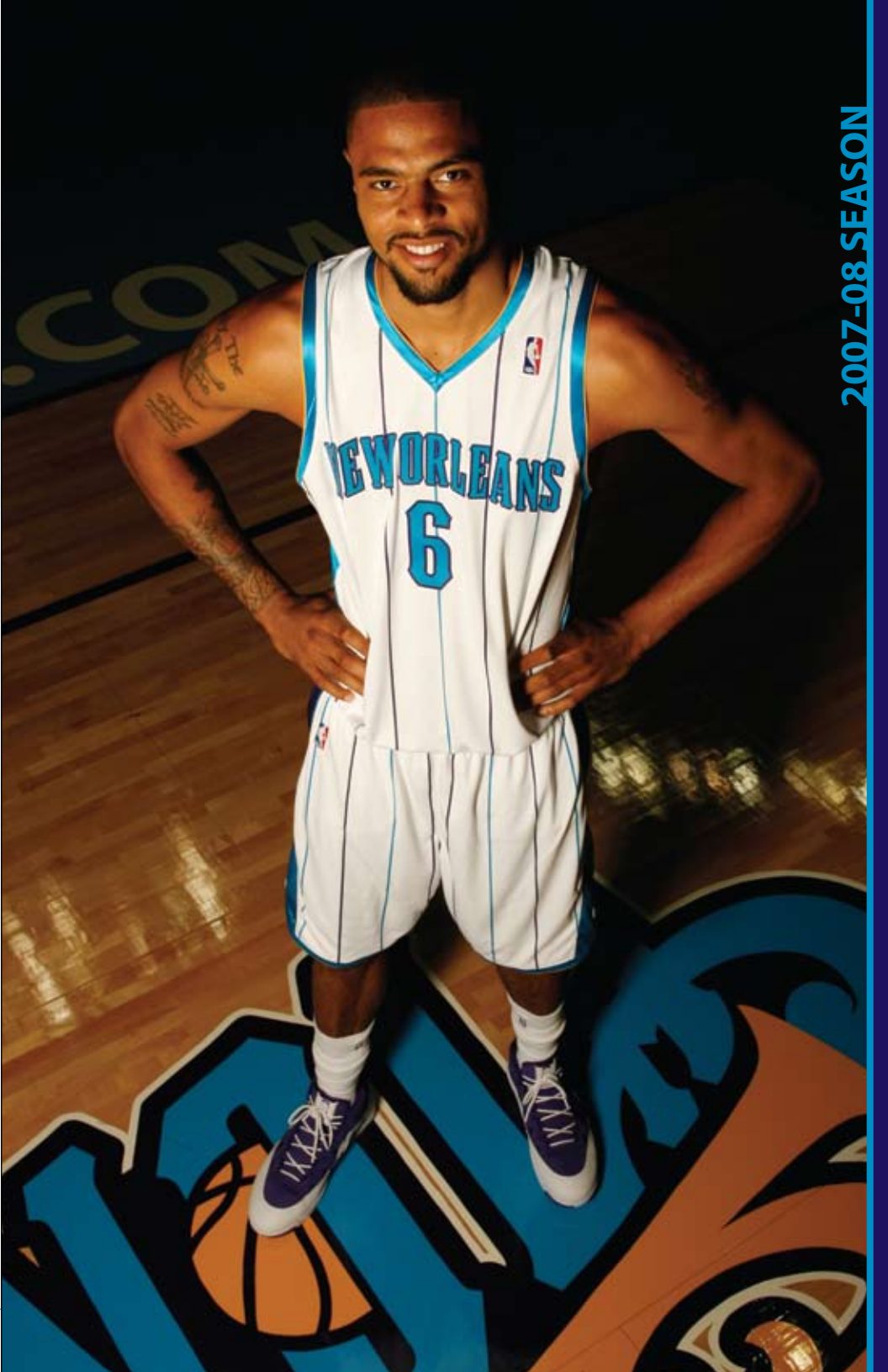

- The Hornets won 37 games by at least 10 points.
- The Hornets owned the second-most wins of any team against the Western Conference (34) and had the second-best road record (26-14) in the Western Conference.
- The Hornets were one of two NBA teams (Utah-Boozer, Williams) to have two players average a double-double (Paul, Chandler).
- Chris Paul became the first player in 15 years to average at least 20 points and 10 assists (Tim Hardaway, GSW, 21.5 ppg, 10.6 apg, 1992-93 season).
