Highlights: Transferred to Utah in the middle of the 2004-05 season and sat out the remainder of the year as a redshirt... Scored a career high 28 points vs. Rice 11/25/06... Registered a season high of 26 points vs. UNLV on 2/6/08... Scored 20 or more points 15 times during his career at Utah.

(2007-08) Senior: Nov. 8: Named a team captain; Nov. 9: 10 points, 4 assists off the bench vs. USC Upstate; Nov. 13: Scored 10 points in a span of 2:07 in the second half vs. High Point; Nov. 14: Scored 14 of his 18 points in the second half; Nov. 19: Scored a then-season-high 19 points vs. Santa Clara on 8-of-11 shooting; Nov. 28: Scored 12 points, tied a career-high with 3 steals, dished out a game-high 4 assists vs. Weber State; Dec. 1: Scored 11 points vs. UC Irvine; Dec. 22: Scored team high 14 points (including 4-of-8 3-pointers) in front of more than 30 friends and family members at California; Dec. 27: Scored game-high 17 points (including 4-of-8 3-pointers) vs. Idaho State; Dec. 31: Scored 11 points vs. Gonzaga; Jan. 5: Scored a then-season-high 22 points (including 6-of-14 from 3-point range) vs. Air Force; Five 3-pointers in the first half vs. AFA accounted for all of Utah's first-half FGs; Jan. 9: Tied for game-high honors with 19 points on 7-of-11 shooting (including 5-of-8 from 3-point range); Jan. 16: Tied for game-high scoring honors with 12 points; Jan. 22: Scored a game-high and then-season-high 25 points at New Mexico on 8-of-11 shooting (including 5-of-7 from 3-point range), also grabbed a season-high 5 rebounds, made a season-high 4 free throws and played a season-high 41 minutes vs. the Lobos; Jan. 26: Set a new Utah school record with 8 3-pointers and scored a game-high 24 points vs. TCU; Jan. 28: Named MWC Player of Week for first time in his career and first time for a Ute this season; Jan. 30: Season-high 6 rebounds vs. Wyoming; Feb. 2: Scored 13 points (including 3-of-4 from 3-point range) at Colorado State; Feb. 6: Scored a season-high 26 points on 8-of-13 field goals and season-high 7-of-7 free throws vs. UNLV; Feb. 9: Scored 17 points on 5-of-9 shooting from 3-point range (including four 3-pointers in the second half) in win over Air Force; Feb. 11: Named MWC Co-Player of the Week; Feb. 16: Scored 17 points (including 7-of-8 from the free-throw line) vs. San Diego State; Feb. 20: Team-high 15 points and 3 steals vs. BYU; Feb. 23: Scored a team-high 17 points vs. New Mexico (including 9-of-9 at the FT line); March 1: Scored 15 points (on 6-of-12 FG shooting) at Wyoming; March 4: Scored 14 points (including 4-of-6 from 3-point range) vs. Colorado State; March 8: Scored 12 points at UNLV; March 13: Scored 11 points vs. New Mexico; March 14: Scored 10 points vs. UNLV; March 19: Scored a team-high 17 points at UTEP.

(2006-07) Junior: Earned Honorable Mention All-Mountain West Conference honors ... on the Ute single-season charts, ranks second in both 3-pointers made (88) and attempted (208) ... scored in double figures seven consecutive games to start the Mountain West Conference schedule ... reached double figures in six of the 10 games to close out the season ... had at least five assists in six games, including four conference games ... made at least five 3-pointers four times during season ... perfect at the free throw line in 11 games ... in the last five games of the regular season, shot 58.2 percent from the field, 45.5 percent (15-for-33) from 3-point range and 10-for-10 at the free throw line to average 17.7 points per game ... ranked

(2005-06) Sophomore: Honorable mention all-Mountain West Conference ... appeared in all 29 games, starting all but two ... played at least 30 minutes 21 times ... four 20-point games and a team-best 20 double-figure scoring games ... led the Utes in scoring 12 times, including the last three regular-season games ... scored in double figures in 14 of the 16 Mountain West Conference games ... ranked 11th in scoring (13.1 ppg), 19th in field goal percentage (45.6), 18th in assists (2.38 apg), second in three-point field goal percentage (45.9) and third in three-pointers per game (2.34) in the MWC ... in conference games, ranked seventh in scoring (15.4 ppg), 10th in field goal percentage (50.3), 17th in steals (1.12 spg), first in three-point percentage (49.0) and second in three-pointers per game (2.94) ... on the Ute single-season charts, finished tied for second in three-point percentage (45.9), tied for fourth in three-pointers made (68) and ninth in three-point attempts (148) ... first career double-double against UNLV (Feb. 22) with 20 points and a career-best 10 rebounds in 34 minutes ... shot 7-for-13 from the field, 3-for-6 from three-point range and 3-for-4 from the free throw line ... career-high 23 points against BYU (Jan. 7), shooting 9-for-17 from.
