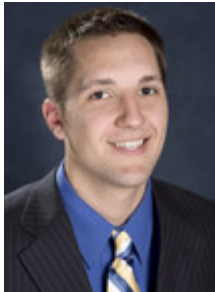




Pre-draft Workouts - June 15, 2008

Highlights: Named Second Team All-America by The Sporting News as a sophomore. Also earned First Team All-Pac-10 honors and was a finalist for the Wooden Award. Named Honorable Mention All-Conference as a freshman. Currently ranks as the 16th all-time leading scorer in Cal history with 1,236 points, and is the first sophomore in school history to top the 1,000 point mark. Also ranks ninth all-time in three-point field goals made (122) and third in career free throw percentage (.841).

2007-08 (Sophomore): Led the Pac-10 in scoring (21.1 ppg, ranked 18th nationally) and ranked third in rebounding (9.9 rpg). Season total of 697 points ranks as the second-highest in school history. Became the first player in Cal history to register at least 600 points and 300 rebounds in a season. Scored in double figures in every game, registered 20 or more points 18 times, and topped the 30-point mark four times. Posted 16 double-doubles. Exploded for a career-high 36 points, while pulling down 13 rebounds at Nevada. Tallied 33 points and a career-high 17 rebounds at Washington. Recorded 27 points and nine rebounds at Washington State. Notched 32 points and 15 rebounds vs. Arizona State and 30 points vs. Arizona in consecutive home games. Registered 22 points and 16 rebounds vs. Washington in the first round of the Pac-10 Tournament. Led team with 26 points vs. New Mexico in the first round of the postseason NIT.

2006-07 (Freshman): Led team in scoring (16.3 ppg) and rebounding (8.2 rpg). Ranked fifth in the Pac-10 in both categories, the only player in the league to finish in the top five in each area. Set a school freshman record with 269 total rebounds. Paced team in scoring 18 times and was the top rebounder in 22 contests. Posted eight double-doubles. Named MVP of the Great Alaska Shootout after averaging 17.3 points and 9.3 rebounds in three games. Notched 24 points and a season-high 16 rebounds at DePaul. Registered 18 points and 14 rebounds vs. Washington. Scored 21 points at UCLA. Set season high with 27 points and pulled down 15 rebounds vs. Oregon State in the opening round of the Pac-10 Tournament. Recorded 18 points vs. UCLA in the quarterfinals. Tallied 17 points and 12 rebounds vs. Oregon in the semifinals.
