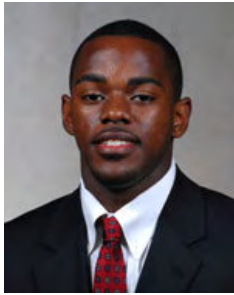

2007-08 (Senior): Second-team all-Sun Belt Conference selection...Named to the SBC all-tournament team after averaging 15 points and 3.7 rebounds per game in the Hilltoppers' three Victories...Paced WKU with 129 assists, and is second on the team with 63 three-pointers...One of two players on the squad averaging in double figures scoring with 13.9 points per outing...Recorded 15 points, five assists and three steals in 3/23 victory over San Diego in second round of NCAA Tournament...Posted a career-best 33 points including seven of WKU's 10 in overtime to lead all players in win over Drake on 3/21 in opening round of the NCAA Tournament, adding five rebounds, five assists and two steals...Collected 17 points in 20 minutes in 3/9 win over North Texas in quarterfinals of Sun Belt Conference Tournament, adding a game-high three steals...Scored 22 points — making 4-of-6 from three-point range to go along with three rebounds and two assists in regular-season finale at Florida Atlantic on 3/1...Posted team-high totals of 20 points, four assists and three steals in win at Middle Tennessee on 2/16...Paced the Hilltoppers with 15 points and six assists in 2/13 victory over Troy, turning the ball over just once in 23 minutes...Had 21 points and eight assists against just one turnover in win at North Texas on 2/7...Collected 20 points and a team-best four assists in win over Arkansas State on 1/27...Handed out season-best nine assists in 1/23 victory at New Orleans, adding eight points and three rebounds...Led all players with a career-best eight rebounds, five assists and two steals in win at Louisiana-Lafayette on 1/19, adding nine points...Posted 17 points and six assists with only one turnover in 1/16 victory over Florida Atlantic...Shared game-high scoring honors after posting 20 points at South Alabama on 1/5 (including 15 after halftime), adding four rebounds and four assists.

2006-07 (Junior): In his first year on the Hill, was the only player to start all 33 contests ... Led the team with 131 assists — the ninth-highest total in school history — and 170 free-throw attempts ... Averaged 12.8 points per game, which was 19th in the Sun Belt Conference, and 3.97 assists per outing, the fourth-best average in the league ... Also ranked eighth in the SBC with a 1.24 assist-to-turnover ratio and was 10th with a 39.8 three-point field-goal percentage ... Connected on 43.9 percent overall from the field and 69.4 percent at the foul line ... Finished fourth on the team with 31 steals ... Raised averages to 13.8 points and 4.39 assists per contest in league play, improving his assist-to-turnover ratio against Sun Belt foes to 1.39 ... Shot 42.6 percent from beyond the arc in SBC games ... Scored in double figures 25 times, the second-highest total on the team ... Paced WKU in assists on 20 occasions, leading all players 15 times ... Topped the squad in steals 10 times and in scoring on seven occasions ... Paced team with career-high 23 points — making 6-of-10 from the floor and 8-of-9 foul shots — while adding four rebounds and two assists in 3/4 victory over Florida Atlantic in quarterfinals of the Sun Belt Tournament ... Posted 17 points — going 7-of-7 at the free-throw line — nine assists, four rebounds and three steals in regular-season finale against Florida International on 2/24 ... One of two Hilltoppers in double figures in 2/20 win over Kentucky Wesleyan, finishing with 14 points on 5-of-6 shooting, two rebounds, two assists and a pair of steals ... Had 15 points, a career-high-tying six rebounds and game-best six assists at South Alabama on 2/8 ... Turned in first career double-double with 22 points and 10 assists in 1/31 victory over Louisiana-Monroe, as he was 8-of-13 from

the field and 4-of-5 at the foul line ... Led the Toppers with 17 points and seven assists without committing a turnover in 1/21 win over New Orleans ... Collected a game-high 22 points on 7-of-11 shooting in victory over Louisiana-Lafayette on 1/13 ... Was 4-of-4 from three-point range en route to scoring a game-high 21 points in win at Florida International on 1/11, adding game-best six assists while committing only one turnover ... Paced WKU with 14 points — 12 came in the second half — and five assists on 1/6 at Nebraska ... Posted seven points and six assists without a turnover in win over Troy on 1/3 ... Matched a career high with seven assists and set another with six rebounds in 12/30 victory at Florida Atlantic, adding eight points ... Recorded 14 of his career-high 18 points against North Texas on 12/19 in the second half, twice giving WKU a one-point lead in the final minute by hitting two free throws — he also finished with a career-best five rebounds and five assists with just one turnover ... Scored nine of his 11 points in 12/6 victory at Montana in second half, hitting all four free-throw attempts in the final two minutes to help seal the win ... Collected 12 points — making 6-of-6 at the free-throw line — while handing out four assists and posting a game-high four steals in win over UAB on 11/28 ... Posted 16 points in 11/25 victory over Ball State, hitting 5-of-9 from the field and 5-of-6 at the free-throw line ... Led the Toppers in scoring for the first time with 15 points in victory over Tennessee State on 11/19, adding five assists in 18 minutes.

Junior College/High School: Was a National Junior College Athletic Association first-team All-America selection and the NJCAA Region 16 Player of the Year in 2005-06 after leading Missouri State-West Plains with 18.3 points per game and 158 assists his sophomore season ... Also averaged 4.2 rebounds per contest and recorded a team-best 66 steals while hitting 76 three-point field goals ... A first-team all-region honoree, Brazelton shot 73.7 percent from the free-throw line — he visited the charity stripe 190 times last winter — and also posted a 1.58 assist-to-turnover ratio ... His 604 points as a sophomore were the fifth-highest season total in the school's record books, as he finished his two-year career fourth in Grizzly history with 973 points ... Also ranks third all-time with 288 assists and 223 free throws made, while his 120 three-pointers are fifth in MSUWP's record books ... Brazelton helped lead the Grizzlies to a 20-13 record last season and a berth in the Region 16 championship series ... Was also voted first-team all-region following his freshman campaign, as he is one of just two players in school history to accomplish the feat in both of his seasons ... As a senior at Rich Central High School, he averaged 14 points and six assists per game to help the Olympians to a 22-8 record and a berth in the regional championship contest.
