## HOUSING/MEALS

All campers and staff will be housed at Tropicana Gardens. Each room will comfortably accommodate approx. 2-3 campers. The dorm will contain a camp store, recreation room, coin-operated laundry room and dining area for use by all. Three all-you-can-eat meals are provided per day (except 1st day: dinner only; last day: breakfast only).



## SECURITY

All camp staff reside at Tropicana Gardens to ensure evening supervision. Athletic training/medical staff are on duty at all times.

## TUITION

Overnight Camper cost is \$670.00 which includes the \$20 REFUND-ABLE key deposit (refunded the last day of camp). The cost for overnight campers enrolling for both sessions (\$1400.00) includes a room and board charge for the in-between stay over.

Day Camper cost is \$470.00.

Full tuition must accompany each application in order to reserve your spot in camp. If you cancel at least three weeks prior to the first day of that session, you may receive a refund less \$150.00 administration fee. There will be no refund if cancellation occurs less than three weeks before camp begins. Campers who have to leave due to illness or injury will receive a prorated refund based on the number of days room and board were required. No refunds will be given to campers who voluntarily leave camp (i.e. Homesickness).

## REGISTRATION/PICKUP

*\*We do not provide transportation*

Registration is Friday, July 3rd and Wednesday, July 8th from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM at Tropicana Gardens. At registration, campers are required to submit the Medical Health Form with physician's signature. Checkout is Tuesday, July 7th and Sunday, July 12th at 12:00 PM.

All campers have their rooms inspected and any damage will be the responsibility of camper parents/guardians.

## CONFIRMATION OF ACCEPTANCE

A confirmation package with a checklist of things to bring, Medical Health Form and a set of directions will be forwarded to each camper after his application and tuition have been received. Please allow 2-3 weeks for this notification due to the high volume of mail we receive. Because we sellout quickly, please do not make any travel arrangements until you receive notification that your child has been accepted into the program.
