



## FACT SHEET

- The ExxonMobil Green Team is a summer youth program that provides summer internships and a study program for high school students. Programs vary from city to city, but all students involved in this program work on a project to improve the community in which they live as well as participating in an educational component.
- The goals of the ExxonMobil Green Team program are:
  - Provide a meaningful work experience for youth from low- to moderate-income households
  - Introduce students to new concepts through academic and development courses
  - Enhance the students' awareness of the important relationship between education and work
  - Motivate students to complete school and pursue a higher education
- Since its launch in 1981, ExxonMobil has invested \$6.1 million in the Dallas program reaching approximately 3,350 students. Students earn a paycheck for all of their time, whether working or participating in educational activities.
- In Dallas, ExxonMobil Green Team students will be placed with selected area nonprofits, where they will work in teams of four to six. While with the agencies, Green Teams will focus on environmental and conservation projects, including research, education and public awareness campaigns.
- Each Wednesday, students will receive instruction from the Maguire Energy Institute at Southern Methodist University (SMU) and will also attend classes in career exploration, leadership development and environmental engineering.
- On Fridays, students will take part in educational field trips and activities with an environmental focus.
- The 2008 ExxonMobil Green Team will also work together on a large-scale service project. Students will select the project as a group and will be responsible for coordinating the day's activities.
- The ExxonMobil Green Team is currently in place in eight cities including: Torrance, California; Chalmette, Louisiana; Clinton, New Jersey; Paulsboro, New Jersey; Beaumont, Texas; Dallas, Texas; Houston, Texas; and, Arlington, Virginia.
- The ExxonMobil Green Team is one of the signature community programs funded by the ExxonMobil Foundation. ExxonMobil Foundation is the primary philanthropic arm of the Exxon Mobil Corporation in the United States. The Foundation and the Corporation engage in a range of philanthropic activities that advance education, health and science in the communities where ExxonMobil has significant operations. In the United States, ExxonMobil supports initiatives to improve math and science education at the K-12 and higher education levels.
