The Raptors Foundation Student Scholarship is dedicated to supporting high school students who are in need of financial support for post secondary education at an accredited institution in Ontario (university, college and vocational).

The scholarship will be awarded directly to the accredited institution of the successful candidate.

Eligibility requirements and criteria

- 1) Applicant must maintain 60% or higher in his/hers last year of high school.
- 2) Applicant must be applying for post secondary education or vocational training within Ontario.
- 3) Applicant must be legally entitled to receive funds.
- 4) Applicant must be 15-24 years old at the time of application.
- 5) Applicant must submit nominations letters from a registered charity.
- 6) Bursary recipients must give back to the charity sponsor with a minimum of 40 hours of volunteer work within the year.

Value of Awards and Number Each Year

There will be four scholarships available per year for the amount of \$5,000 CDN each.

The scholarship will be paid in two installments within the year.

Frequency of Availability and Application Times

Applications are accepted once per year with the deadline on April 4, 2008.

Application Procedure

The application procedure includes:

- the completion of the Raptors Foundation Student Scholarship Application; application can be found on raptors.com
- documentation verifying currently in last year of high school and in passing standards;
- outline of plans for bursary/budget for school year;
- copies of college/university applications and/or confirmation letter of acceptance from school;
- a letter of support from your charity sponsor;
- a letter of support from teacher, coach and/or employer
