Milestones: Wisconsin's all-time leading scorer with 2,217 career points ... also set UW career records for field goals (798), free throws (520), free-throw attempts (817), offensive rebounds (314), games played (134), games started (126) and minutes played (4,297) ... ranks ninth in Big Ten history in both career points and free throws and fourth in conference history in free throw attempts ... owns single-season school records for points, field goals, field goal attempts and free throw attempts ... sixth in the country in career points among seniors ... became the first Badger to lead the Big Ten in scoring (20.0 ppg., 2006) since Don Rehfeldt in 1950

2006-07: Started all 36 games for UW ... led the team and ranked second in the Big Ten with 19.9 points per game ... second on the team with 5.4 rebounds per game ... scored 20 or more points in seven straight games (Jan. 28 - Feb. 17) ... 716 points are a UW single-season school record ... second on the team in assists (73) ... scored a season-high 32 points against Pitt ... averaged 22.2 points and 6.5 rebounds in road games

Summer of 2006: Averaged a team-high 21.2 points in five games during UW's tour through Italy ... added 5.2 rebounds and 2.6 assists ... shot 51.2 percent from the floor and tied for the team lead with nine 3-pointers ... scored a game-high 32 points in win over Mylena Treviglio ... added 20 in final game vs. Castelletto Ticino

2005-06: Started all 31 games and led the team in scoring (19.0 ppg.) ... ranked among the school's single-season top 10 in points (588, fifth), field goals (222, fourth) and field goal attempts (490, third) ... scored at least 20 points in 11 of 17 games against the Big Ten, including three with at least 27 points ... averaged 21.6 points against ranked teams ... scored a career-high and Paradise Jam Tournament-record 38 points (fourth-most in school history) in win over Eastern Kentucky ... set a Paradise Jam Tournament-record for field goals (26) and finished one point shy of the tourney mark of 69 total points ... suffered a nasal injury against Wake Forest and wore a custom-made protective mask in 13 games

2004-05: Played in 31 games, starting 30 ... led the Badgers in scoring (15.2 ppg.) and had nine 20-point efforts ... was also second on the team in rebounding (6.1 rpg.) ... ranked among the top 10 in the conference in both categories ... scored a season-high 27 points vs. Maryland ... averaged 18.5 points vs. ranked teams ... made a running 3-pointer as time expired to give UW a win over Iowa in the Big Ten tournament semifinals ... also hit the game-winner on a putback as the horn sounded vs. Indiana

2003-04: Missed all but four games due to a right foot injury ... applied for and received a medical redshirt

2002-03: Played in all 32 games, starting the final 27 ... finished third on the team (and third among Big Ten frosh) in scoring with 12.0 ppg. ... tops among Big Ten freshmen in rebounds (5.9 rpg.) ... led the Big Ten and set a school record for offensive rebounds (2.69 per game and 86 total) ... among the top five in UW freshmen history in games played, minutes played, points, field goals, field goal percentage and free throw attempts ... registered season highs in points (24) and rebounds (18) in first career start vs. UNLV ... set a school record with 11 offensive boards in that game and his 18 total rebounds were the most by a Big Ten player all season ... recorded 24 double-digit scoring performances

High School: Averaged 22.2 points, 7.7 rebounds and 5.7 assists to earn first-team all-state honors as a senior ... one of only two juniors to be named to the Herald News AA all-area team
