**Career Highlights:** Ranks fifth in Cal history with 95 career blocks ... blocked 48 shots as a sophomore, which is fifth on Cal's season list ... voted honorable mention All-Pac-10 his sophomore year ... raised his free throw shooting rate from 38.6 percent as a freshman to 80.0 percent as a junior.

**Junior (2006-07):** Started Cal's first 11 games of the year before suffering a stress fracture to his left mid-foot vs. Furman Dec. 19 and did not return to the lineup following surgery ... was cleared for practice after the season ... got off to a strong start, averaging 10.7 ppg and 8.4 rpg with 21 blocks before being hurt ... despite missing the year's final 22 games, still led the team in blocks ... named to the all-tournament team at the Great Alaska Shootout after finishing with 16 points, 9 rebounds and 4 blocks vs. Loyola Marymount in the championship game ... swatted away a career-high 5 blocks vs. Santa Clara ... recorded double doubles against Santa Clara (12 points, 10 rebounds), Kansas State (12-12) and Nevada (14-10) ... attended the Pete Newell Big Man Camp prior to the start of the season.

**Sophomore (2005-06):** Ranked among the top five in the Pac-10 in both rebounding (5th, 6.6 rpg) and blocks (4th, 1.55 bpg) ... had five double-doubles on the year and led Cal in rebounding 11 times (includes ties) despite playing alongside Pac-10 rebound champ Leon Powe ... broke his career scoring high in consecutive games vs. Long Beach State (14), Northern Colorado (21) and Northeastern (26) ... also had a personal-best 14 points vs. Northeastern and was named both MVP of the Golden Bear Classic and Pac-10 Player of the Week for his effort ... had 10 points and 8 boards in a win at UCLA ... finished with 10 points and 11 rebounds vs. USC at home.

**Freshman (2004-05):** Ranked third on the team in rebounding with 4.5 per game ... was second on the team and ninth in the Pac-10 with 0.90 bpg ... in his first career start, had 12 points, 12 rebounds and 3 blocks at BYU ... finished with 11 points and five boards at San Diego State to earn MVP honors of the San Diego SLAM.

**High School:** Averaged 12.9 ppg, 11.4 rpg and 4.4 bpg as a senior at Newark Memorial HS, earning first-team All-Metro honors from the *San Francisco Chronicle* ... ranked as the No. 3 power forward on the West Coast by TheInsiders.com and the 64 overall recruit in the country by *Hoop Scoop* ... recorded the first triple-double in his school's history with 25 points, 17 rebounds and 14 blocks in one game.
