Led Colorado State in scoring, and rebounding... Earned first team all-conference honors along with NABC all-district honors... Averaged 16.8 points and 10.1 rebounds per game during the season... Named to the preseason all-Mountain West team... Named to the Wooden Award All-American Team watch list... Named as a Playboy All-American in the preseason... Scored 19 and had a team-best seven rebounds versus CSU-Pueblo (11/10)... Posted a double-double with 25 points and 19 rebounds gainst Baylor hitting 11-of-16 free throws... Posted second-consecutive double-double with 19 points and 15 rebounds in loss to Rice in NIT Season Tip-Off... Led CSU with 14 points and seven rebounds against MSU Northern (11/18)... Had six points and four rebounds against Boise State (11/20)... Led CSU with 24 points and nine rebounds in win over Denver (11/29)... Had 15 points and five rebounds against Kansas State (12/2)... 2005-06 • SOPHOMORE SEASON:

Played in and started all 31 games for the Rams... Named to the all-Mountain West first team at the season's conclusion... Selected to the NABC all-district second team... Averaged 16.2 points on 51.7 percent shooting (178-of-344) with 7.3 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 2.1 blocked shots in 28.7 minutes per game... Scored in all 31 games, including 28 double-digit efforts... Ranked among team leaders in nearly every statistical category including first in rebounding average (7.3), blocks (66) and scoring average (16.2), second in minutes per game (28.7) and assists (70) and third in field goal percentage (.517)... Ranked among Mountain West Conference leaders in seven categories including second in blocked shots (2.14 pg), fourth in scoring (16.2 ppg), rebounding (7.3 rpg) and defensive rebounds (5.06 pg), seventh in offensive rebounds (2.26 pg) and eighth in field goal percentage (.517) and free throw percentage (.763)... Led CSU in scoring 14 times, in rebounding 16 times, in assists five times, in steals five times and in blocked shots 13 times... Hit for a career-best 28 points including a 12-for-12 performance from the free throw line at New Mexico (1/7)... Recorded four double-doubles on the season including games against North Dakota State (11/23), Denver (11/26), Auburn (11/28) and UNLV (2/18)... Blocked a career-most seven shots in the season-opener against Northern Colorado (2/19)... Scored 13 points to go along with six rebounds in a loss to San Diego State in the MWC quarterfinal (3/9)... Grabbed a team-high eight rebounds to lead CSU to a first round win in the MWC tournament vs. TCU (3/7)... Had a team-high 17 points and nine rebounds as well as dishing out five assists in 38 minutes of play at home vs. Air Force (3/4)... Finished with five rebounds and two steals at BYU (3/1)... Came down with four rebounds and nine points before fouling out after playing only 20 minutes at Wyoming (2/25)... Converted on all nine of his free throw attempts to end with 13 points and a team-high nine rebounds in a win against TCU (2/22)... Tallied 24 points on 8-of-15 shooting from the field and 8-of-8 from the charity stripe to combine with a team-best 12 boards vs. UNLV (2/18)... Played 37 minutes in a 15 point, eight rebound performance at Utah (2/15)... Snagged a team-high 10 rebounds including three offensive boards and recorded three blocks vs. New Mexico (2/8)... Shot 7-of-15 from the field to finish with 16 points in a losing effort to San Diego State (2/4)... Hit on nine of his 12 attempts from the field as well as shooting 9-of-12 from the free throw line to record his second highest scoring outing of his career at Air Force (2/1)... Led CSU with 23 points, nine rebounds, and four blocks in a home loss vs. BYU (1/28)... Made all eight of his free throw attempts before fouling out with a team-best 18 points vs. Wyoming (1/25)... Had his 17th double-digit point performance in a loss at TCU (1/21)... Scored 12 points on 3-of-9 shooting in limited minutes vs. UNLV (1/18)... Was successful on seven of his 12 attempts from the field in a 17 point outing at home against Utah (1/14)... Blocked two shots as well as assisting on three baskets at San Diego State (1/4)... Finished up non-conference play with a 14 point game at home vs. Arkansas State (12/30)... Made all seven of his shots from the floor to finish with 19 points vs. UCCS (12/28)... Tied a career high in three-pointers made in a game with two in the Rainbow Classic against Iowa State (12/23)... Recorded a double-double by checking in with 17 points and 11 boards in 36 minutes of play on the road at Hawaii (12/22)... Dished out a career-high six assists in a win against Western Michigan in the Rainbow Classic (12/20)... Had a game-high five blocks to go along with 16 points and eight rebounds in win against Pepperdine (12/10)... Was held to limited minutes by getting into foul trouble early, but still managed to come away with six points and six rebounds in a road loss to Kansas State (12/7)... Scored 14 points, grabbed eight boards, and blocked three shots vs. IUPUI (12/3)... Had his fourth career double-double when he had 11 rebounds and 21 points on 6-of-13 shooting in a home win vs. Auburn (11/28)... Made 10-of-18 shots from the floor in his 15th career start to end a road win with 22 points and 13 rebounds against Denver (11/26)... Recorded his first double-double of the season against North Dakota State (11/23)... Had 16 points and five assists to help lead the Rams to a one-point win over Colorado (11/21)... Opened his sophomore season with a 26 point, nine rebound, seven block performance against Northern Colorado (11/18).

2004-05 • FRESHMAN SEASON:

Played in 26 games and started in 11, all versus Mountain West opponents... Named Mountain West Freshman of the Year and all-MWC honorable mention in his rookie season... Averaged 10.5 points on 55.4 percent shooting (103-of-186) with 5.8 rebounds, 1.7 assists and 1.4 blocked shots in 24.4 minutes per game... Scored in all 26 games while hitting for double-digits 13 times... had his first career double-double versus UNLV (2/21) hitting for 24 points and 11 rebounds... Ranked 16th in the MWC in scoring, ninth in rebounding and fifth in field goal percentage... Was among team leaders in several statistic categories including first in blocks (36), second in field goal percentage (.554), rebounding (5.8 rpg) and points (274) and third in assists (45)... Sat out games against New Mexico and Utah due to a knee injury... Posted a career-best 14 rebounds at Air Force (1/8) in his first career start... Blocked a season-high four shots and finished with 12 points on 5-of-8 shooting from the floor in a losing effort to Utah in the Mountain West tournament (3/10)... Came down with eight rebounds in 35 minutes of play on the road vs. New Mexico (3/5)... Converted on all three of his free throw attempts in limited action against Wyoming (2/26)... Grabbed four offensive rebounds to end with nine total boards in a home loss to UNLV (2/21)... Recorded second career double-double to end with a season-high 24 points and 39 minutes to go along with a team-high 11 rebounds at home against San Diego State (2/19)... Recorded two blocks to combine with 5 rebounds in a losing effort on the road vs. BYU (2/14)... Was good on all three of his shot attempts to end with six points vs. Air Force (2/7) in his first action after a knee injury that held him out the previous game... Grabbed a team-high six rebounds in a loss to Wyoming (1/29)... Dished out three assists and converted on eight of 12 free throw attempts to finish with 18 points in his fifth career start at San Diego State (1/24)... Had a season-high four assists to go along with a team-high eight rebounds at UNLV (1/22)... Finished a 3-of-4 shooting night with eight points and a season-high three steals in a home loss to Utah (1/17)... Scored a team-high 19 points on 8-of-12 shooting including making his only three-point attempt in a win against BYU (1/15)... Led CSU with three assists in a road loss to Pepperdine (1/3)... At Denver (12/30), tallied nine points, six rebounds, three assists, and two blocks in the win... Made four of five field goal attempts to finish with eight points and four assists in a blow-out win vs. Stetson (12/28)... Converted on six of nine attempts from the floor to end 14 point, five rebound performance vs. Texas State (12/21)... Ended with nine points, five rebounds, and three assists in a loss to in-state rival Colorado (12/18)... Was good on his only shot attempt from behind the arc to conclude an 8-point, seven-rebound performance against Purdue (12/11)... Recorded one block and an assist in limited action vs. Montana State (12/7)... Converted on 4-of-5 shooting from the field and from the free throw line to cap off a 12 point performance against Drake (12/4)... Led the team with three blocks and ended a 6-of-10 shooting night with 14 points in an overtime loss to Auburn (11/30)... Had a team-high two blocked shots vs. IUPUI (11/27)... Hit on 2-of-3 shot attempts to end a 5-point night in a win against Nebraska-Omaha (11/24)... Finished with 12 points on 4-of-6 shooting to go along with three assists and a team-high two blocks at home vs. Northern Colorado (11/22)... Had a season-best two steals to finish a 13 point, two block performance in his first action on the collegiate level against Regis (11/20).

HIGH SCHOOL:

Jason was regarded as the state's premier prep player during his senior season at Platte Valley High School... Named the most outstanding player in the Colorado High School All-State game, was a two-time state player of the year, was named to the "All-Colorado" team as a junior and senior and was a three-year letterwinner and starter for the Broncos... Was named to all-conference and all-state teams three times and was selected as most outstanding player in state Class 3A tournament as a senior... Currently holds school records for most career blocked shots, career scoring, consecutive free throws made, and most blocked shots in one game and led his team in scoring, rebounding and blocked shots three seasons in a row... While being recruited, he chose Colorado State above Gonzaga, Utah, and Wyoming.
