Hyattsville, Md./Northwestern

A three-time All-BIG EAST honoree during his career at Georgetown ... Named a third-team Associated Press All-American as a junior ... Green ranks 17th all-time in scoring at Georgetown with 1,339 points ... His 664 rebound rebounds rank 16th all-time while his 6.5 per game average stands 20th ... Green also ranks 17th all-time with 294 assists ... He was named the BIG EAST Player of the Year as a junior in 2006-07 when he led the Hoyas to a 30-7 record, the Final Four, the BIG EAST Tournament Championship and the BIG EAST Regular Season Championship ... Selected to the All-BIG EAST first team in 2005-06 and was named the league's Co-Rookie of the Year in 2004-05.

2006-07 (Junior)

The BIG EAST Player of the Year ... Also named the BIG EAST Tournament's Most Outstanding Player and the MOP for the NCAA East Regional ... A unanimous All-BIG EAST first team selection ... Earned third-team Associated Press All-American honors and was a National Association of Basketball Coaches District 4 first team honoree ... Led the team in scoring, averaging 14.3 points per game, and was second on the team in rebounding (6.4 rpg) and assists (3.19 apg) ... Shot 51.3 percent from the floor (196-of-382), 37.5 percent from three-point land (36-of-96) and 77.5 percent from the free throw line (100-of-129) ... Scored a game-high 17 points, grabbed seven rebounds and had four assists in the season opener against Hartford ... Led the team with 19 points, eight rebounds and six assists in only 23 minutes against Vanderbilt ... Eight points, six rebounds and five assists in 26 minutes at Fairfield ... Scored 14 points, had six rebounds and four assists against Ball State ... Scored five points and had eight rebounds against Oregon ... Scored eight points, had a season-high 10 rebounds and handed out five assists at Duke ... Scored a game-high 17 points, connecting on 6-of-8 shots from the field ... Scored 17 points, dished out five assists and grabbed four rebounds against James Madison ... Scored 15 points and had six rebounds against Oral Roberts ... Scored five points and had six rebounds against WSSU ... Scored 12 points, grabbed six rebounds and had five assists against Towson ... Then-season-high 20 points and nine rebounds in win over Navy ... Tallied 10 points while recording four rebounds and four assists at Michigan ... Scored 15 points, had six rebounds and three assists against Notre Dame ... Became the 37th player in Georgetown history to reach 1,000 points for his career with a team-high 15 points at Pittsburgh, tying his career-high with seven assists in the process ... Scored only four points, but had a game-high six assists to go with five rebounds and three blocks at Rutgers ... Scored eight points and grabbed nine rebounds while also recording four assists and a season-high three steals in a win over Seton Hall ... Finished with a team-high 19 points on 7-of-13 shooting and also collected three rebounds in a win against DePaul ... Finished with 17 points and a game-high tying four assists to go with three rebounds while playing a season-high 39 minutes in a home win against Cincinnati ... Scored a career-high 24 points on 9-of-13 shooting at St. John's, adding eight points and four assists ... Tallied 16 points, seven boards and four assists in win at Louisville ... Matched his career-high with 24 points in a win against No. 11 Marquette, collecting five rebounds and handing out four assists ... Strong outing in win over No. 22 West Virginia, hitting 7-of-13 shots from the field for 15 points, grabbing six rebounds and handing out five assists in the process ... Hit the game-winning shot with 19.9 seconds left and added two more free throws in a 58-55 win at Villanova, scoring a game-high 19 points, grabbing eight rebounds, handing out four assists and blocking a career-high eight shots ... Named BIG EAST Player of the Week on February 19 ... Scored a game-high 21 points, connecting on 6-of-10 shots from the field and 7-of-8 from the free throw line, in a win at Cincinnati ... Eleven of his 14 points came in the second half in win over No. 10 Pittsburgh, grabbing four rebounds, handing out three assists and recording two steals in the process ... Broke a string of nine-straight games in double-figures with nine points in the loss at Syracuse, also added a season-best 10 rebounds ... Scored 14 points, grabbed two rebounds, blocked two shots and had two steals in win over Connecticut ... Scored 12 points and grabbed a team-high nine rebounds in the BIG EAST Quarterfinals against Villanova ... Scored a career-high 30 points, tied a career-high with 12 rebounds - his first double-double of the season - and hit the game-winning jumper with 13 seconds left to lift the Hoyas past Notre Dame in the BIG EAST Tournament Semifinals ... Scored 21 points and grabbed five rebounds to lead GU to the BIG EAST Tournament Championship win over Pittsburgh ... Named Most Outstanding Player, averaging 21.0 points and 8.7 rebounds in three games ... Scored 15 points - hitting 6-of-9 from the field and all three free throw attempts - and grabbed three rebounds against Belmont in the NCAA Tournament first round ... Posted a double-double with 11 points and 12 rebounds, tying a career-high, also adding five blocks, in the NCAA Tournament second round win over Boston College ... Hit the game-winning jumper with 2.5 seconds left to give Georgetown a 66-65 win over Vanderbilt in the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament; finished the game with a team-high 15 points, four rebounds and three assists ... Team-high 22 points, on a career-high 10 field goals (10-for-17 shooting), also adding nine rebounds, three assists and two steals in 42 minutes in the Hoyas 96-84 overtime win over North Carolina to advance to the Final Four.

2005-06 (Sophomore)

Led the team in scoring, averaging 11.9 points per game ... Second in rebounding, grabbing 6.5 boards per game, and led in assists, handing out 3.27 per game ... Shot 44.5 percent from the floor (143-of-321) ... Earned second team All-BIG EAST honors ... Named first team All-District by the National Association of Basketball Coaches ... Tallied 14 points, nine rebounds and a season-high four blocks in loss at Vanderbilt ... Scored a season-high 21 points - including 20 in the

second half – during a loss at Illinois ... Scored team-high 17 points and tied his season-best with nine rebounds in loss at West Virginia ... Chipped in 13 points to go with eight rebounds at UConn ... Scored 18 points, tied a career-high with seven assists, grabbed five boards and had three steals against Duke ... Dropped 12 points, seven boards and six assists in a career-high 46 minutes at Notre Dame ... Scored 20 points, grabbed seven rebounds and had five assists in win over Cincinnati ... Named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll on January 30 ... Registered 15 points and seven rebounds in win at DePaul ... Tied his career-high with 22 points, connecting on 9-of-14 shots from the field, and grabbed four rebounds in a 61-58 win over Pittsburgh ... Named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll on February 6 ... Scored nine points, had five rebounds, three blocks and two assists in win over St. John's ... First double-double of the season with 21 points and 10 rebounds against West Virginia ... Scored 15 points, grabbed six rebounds and had a game-high six assists in loss at Villanova ... Scored nine points, had six rebounds and five assists in win over Rutgers...Team-high 18 points in win over Syracuse, connecting on season-high 8-for-12 from the line, while grabbing seven boards and dishing out four assists ... Chipped in 10 points and four rebounds in loss at South Florida ... Scored 13 points and had nine rebounds against Notre Dame in BIG EAST Tournament first round ... Team-high 16 points, nine rebounds and five assists vs. Marquette in BIG EAST Tourney Quarterfinals ... Added 10 points and seven boards against Syracuse in BIG EAST Semifinals ... Scored 19 points, grabbed eight rebounds and had six assists in the NCAA Tournament win over Ohio State ... Closed out the season with 15 points, six rebounds and four assists against Florida.

BIG EAST Co-Rookie of the Year ... Unanimous Honorable Mention All-BIG EAST selection ... *Basketball Times* National Freshman of the Year ... Team's second-leading scorer, averaging 13.1 (13.4 in BIG EAST play) ... Led the team in rebounding (6.6), assists (2.9) and blocks (1.6) ... Five times named BIG EAST Rookie of the Week ... Named to the Rainbow Classic All-Tournament Team ... Had five double-doubles ... Shot 50.2 percent from the field ... Started every contest and averaged 33.8 minutes per game ... Set career high in scoring with 22 vs. Connecticut 1/8/05 ... Career high in rebounds with 12 at Villanova 1/15/05....Established career high in assists with seven at Boston College 1/29/05, in blocks with six vs. Penn State 12/6/04, and in steals with four vs. Long Beach State 12/22/04.

Averaged 17 points, 10 rebounds and four blocks as a senior ... Led Northwestern to a 17–9 record last season and the Maryland 4A State Championship ... Selected to First Team *Washington Post* All-Met ... One of 24 Washington area players selected to take part in 2004 Jordan Capital Classic Regional game.
