**2006-07:** One of three players to start every game ... Led Penn and the Ivy League in scoring (18.2 ppg) ... Penn's leader, second in the Ivy in rebounds per game (7.5) ... Also second in the conference in field-goal percentage (.558) ... Hit team-high 41 three-pointers and 112 free shots ... Among Ivy League leaders in assists per game, steals per game, free-throw percentage, and 3-point FG made per game ... Led Penn in scoring 15 times ... Compiled eight double-doubles and nine games with 10 or more rebounds ... Had one 33-point game and 11 others more than 20 points ... Penn's top scorer (19 points) and rebounder (7) in NCAA Tournament loss to Texas A&M (3/15) ... Led all scorers with 23 points, added seven rebounds at Princeton (3/6) ...
