

## **Marquis Webb**

**G/F | Sr. | 6-5 | 205 | Paterson Catholic HS/Paterson, NJ**

**At Rutgers:** Started all but three games in his career ... Reached the 1,000 point milestone against Connecticut (2/21), becoming just the 35th player in RU's 100 year history to reach the mark, and concluded his career with 1,026 points, No. 33 all-time ... Finished career listed on seven of Rutgers' all-time record charts, including No. 9 in assists (305) and three-point field goals made (140), and No. 12 in free throw percentage (.785) ... Two-time captain for the Scarlet Knights ... Regarded as one the BIG EAST's top defensive players throughout career ... A versatile athlete who could play a number of positions.

**2006-07:** Scored in double-figures in 16 of 29 games in senior year ... Scored a career-high 28 points in RU's win over South Carolina State (12/31) and pulled down a season-high six rebounds ... Led RU with 16 points against Bradley (11/24) ... Scored 13 points against Nebraska (12/2), including shooting 4-of-6 from the floor ... Scored nine points, including a 3-of-4 performance from beyond the arc, in RU's win over Princeton (12/9) ... Scored 14 points against Lehigh (12/22), including a 4-of-4 performance from the free throw line ... Scored 12 points and had a season-high four steals at Seton Hall (1/3) ... Had 13 points on a 4-of-4 performance from beyond the three-point arc at Cincinnati (1/7) ... Scored 12 points and grabbed four rebounds against eventual Final Four participant Georgetown (1/17) ... Scored 17 points, including a 6-of-9 performance from the field at Providence (1/20) ... Scored 11 points in Scarlet Knights' double-overtime win against Seton Hall (1/27), including a 7-of-8 performance from the free throw line ... Finished with 11 points, three rebounds, and two assists against eventual NIT-champion West Virginia (1/31) ... Led Rutgers in scoring at then-No. 11 Marquette (2/7) with 12 points, and added four rebounds against the Golden Eagles ... Scored 11 points against Cincinnati (2/10), including a 5-of-5 performance from the free throw line ... Scored 13 points, pulled down three rebounds and dished out three assists in season finale against Notre Dame (3/3).

**2005-06:** Was second on the team in scoring (9.5) and third on the team in assists (2.7) ... Scored 17 points on 6-of-11 shooting in the NIT opening round victory over Penn State (3/14) ... Increased his offensive production during BIG EAST action, posting double-figures in scoring in 12 of RU's 16 league games ... Averaged 10.2 points per game during league play ... Scored in double figures in 20 games this season, including 16 of the last 22 contests ... Enters the 2006-07 season tied for 14th in Rutgers history with 271 career assists ... A standout defender, he limited Temple's Mardy Collins (15.1 ppg) to 11 points, DePaul's Sammy Mejia (15.6 ppg.) to 11 points, and Pittsburgh's Carl Krauser (17.0 ppg) to six points on 2-of-7 shooting from the field ... Registered 11 points, seven assists and seven rebounds in 43 minutes of action against No. 3 Villanova (1/11) ... Was 11th in the BIG EAST in assist/turnover ratio (1.77) during league action.

**2004-05:** Tallied a season-high 16-points at Connecticut (1/15), and scored 15 points in second game against the Huskies (2/19) ... Dished out a career-high 11 assists against No. 4 Syracuse (1/24), marking the fourth time on the season he had registered at least five assists in a game ... Outstanding game against Providence (1/19) when he harassed 6-7 All-American Ryan Gomes into a 6-of-18 shooting night, limiting the forward to 14 points (six below his season average), despite giving up two inches to Gomes ... Also scored eight points and dished out six assists against the Friars ... Played at least 30 minutes in 22 of RU's 29 games, including a season-high 38 minutes against No. 25 Wisconsin (12/4) ... Tallied a career-high 10 rebounds, also contributed eight points and three assists vs. the Badgers ... Scored 12 points vs. Rhode Island (12/11), aided by a 5-of-6 effort from the foul line ... Enjoyed a solid all-around game against Penn State (12/1), scoring 11 points, while recording six assists, seven rebounds and a career-high four steals.

**2003-04:** Played some of his best basketball under the bright lights of Madison Square Garden at the end of the year... Scored nine points and recorded four rebounds and a pair of assists in a 36-minute stint against Iowa State in the NIT semifinal win over the Cyclones ... Earlier in March 2004, he tallied a career-high 19 points vs. Virginia Tech (3/14) in first round of BIG EAST Tournament ... Registered a season-best eight rebounds against Syracuse (2/10), and scored 11 points against the Orange ... Scored 13 points against Notre Dame (1/31) on 3-of-6 shooting from the floor and 5-of-6 from the free throw line ... Dished out seven assists and was 10-of-10 from the free throw line in a victory over St. John's (1/24) ... Scored eight of his 11 points in the final 1:06 of overtime as Rutgers defeated Monmouth, 78-75 (1/13) ... Solid floor game vs. Georgetown (1/3) with 10 points, three steals, two assists and four rebounds in 39 minutes ... Made first career start against Buffalo (11/25), logging 29 minutes and dishing out six assists ... Dished out six assists and added eight points, including 6-of-6 from the foul line against Northwestern (12/27).

**Scholastic/Personal:** A four-year starter at Paterson Catholic High School, one of the top scholastic basketball programs in New Jersey, Webb was a consensus All-State player (First-Team Star-Ledger, Second-Team AP, Second-Team Gannett) and a First-Team All-Passaic County selection by the Bergen Record ... Webb led his teams to a combined 84-21 record over his four-year career ... He led Paterson Catholic to the NJSIAA Playoffs four times and to the North Jersey Parochial B final in his junior and senior seasons ... As a senior, Webb paced Paterson Catholic to a 22-5 record and the No. 7 ranking in the Star-Ledger Final Top 20 Poll Averaged 18.8 points, 5.1 rebounds, 6.2 assists and 2.3 steals per game ... Scored a school-record 60 points in a victory over Glen Rock and finished his prolific career with 1,764 career points ... As a junior, Webb averaged 16.9 points, 7.3 rebounds, 5.9 assists and 3.2 steals per game while earning All-State (second-team) and All-Passaic County (first-team) honors in 2001-02 ... Led Paterson Catholic to a 23-3 record, a berth in the NJSIAA North Jersey, Parochial A final and to the Passaic County Tournament championship ... As a freshman, scored 18 points in a state tournament game to help Paterson Catholic defeat St. Anthony of Jersey City for the first time in school history ... Ranked as one of the Top 20 guards in the nation by Rivalshoops.com ... Born Jan. 29, 1984.
