**Senior (2006-07):** Played and started all 30 games...Ranked third on the team and seventh in the Atlantic 10 Conference in scoring (16.4 ppg.)...Also ranked third on team in rebounding (5.0 rpg.) and assists (78, 2.4 apg.)...Led team and placed third in A-10 in steals (48, 1.60 spg.)...Finished second on team in three-point field goals (56)...Scored in double figures 27 times, tying for team lead... Became 42nd Temple player to score 1000 points at Xavier (1/06) and ranks 27<sup>th</sup> on all-time Temple list with 1,276 points... Led team in scoring seven times...Career-high 34 points (11-19 FG), 7 rebounds versus W. Michigan (12/05)... Tallied 25 points (7-14 FG, 3-6 3pt, 8-8 FT) versus Massachusetts (2/11)...Scored 19 of 21 points in second half vs. St. Bonaventure (2/07) despite strained neck...Team-high 25 points and 10 rebounds, 3rd career double-double, vs. Saint Louis (1/17)...Scored game-high 26 points (9-15, 3-6 3pt, 5-5 FT), 8 rebounds. versus Lafayette (12/28)... Big 5 Player of the Week (12/10)...Team co-captain

**Junior (2004-05):** Played in all 30 games, starting 29...Averaged 8.2 points and 4.5 rebounds per game, placing fourth on team in both categories...Led team in three-point field goal percentage, hitting 44-of-126 from behind the arc for .349 clip...His 44 made three-pointers ranked second on squad...Dished 30 assists against just 15 turnover for team-best 2:1 ratio...Made 29-of-39 free throws for team high 74.4 percentage...His 18 blocked shots ranked second on squad...Tallied double figures 14 times with season highs of 15 points in wins over Dayton and Duquesne...Hit career-high seven free throws (7 attempts) in Dayton game...Posted second double-double of season in Duquesne win, grabbing 10 rebounds in contest...Other double-double came in home win over Fordham (12 pts., 12 rebs.)...Only non-start came on Senior Day as senior teammate Wilbur Allen started in his place...Scored double figures in final four games of season...Scored 13 points and hit three-pointer with 38 seconds to play to put team ahead for good in win at Richmond...Tallied 11 points, grabbed seven rebounds and blocked a career-high four shots at Maryland.

**Sophomore (2003-04):** Played in 28 games, making 13 starts...Third-leading scorer on team, averaging 10.4 points per game...Also ranked third on the team in assists (44), steals (30), three-pointers (42), minutes per game (28.6 mpg.)...Scored career-high 27 points, hitting nine-of-11 field goals, including four-of-six three-pointers, in win over Dayton (2/9)...Scored 21 points over career-high 40 minutes in an 82-74 loss at #5 Duke (1/8)...Tallied double figures in 12 games, leading team in scoring six times...Had some of his best games against tough competition on the road, scoring 16 points at Alabama and Maryland, and 13 points at Xavier...Scored 14 consecutive Temple points, including all 10 in decisive 10-0 run in win at UMass in conference opener...Hit game-winning three-pointer with 1:09 to play in 53-52 win over Villanova at The Palestra...Grabbed season-high eight rebounds at Maryland and versus Dayton in A-10 Quarterfinal win...Dished career-high four assists versus Fordham and Xavier...Missed home games against Rhode Island (flu) and La Salle (ankle injury)...Injured ankle in road loss to SJU (2/12)...Played with ankle injury which affected his shooting (16-73 FGs) in that contest and the remainder of the season.

**Freshman (2002-03):** Played in all 29 games, starting 12 times...Placed third on the team in scoring with a 7.0 average...Also ranked third on squad with 33 three-pointers made...Scored double figures in 11 games... Debuted with a 13-point effort in season-opener against Villanova (11/21) in a starting role...Best game of season came in a losing effort at Arizona State(12/9) where he tallied 18 points and season-high 13 rebounds while playing a season-high 35 minutes...Next game he recorded a season-high four steals against Penn State (12/13) despite suffering from back spasms...Scored season-high 19 points at George Washington (1/7)...GW was the first of three straight double-figure scoring outings that included 13 points at Dayton (1/10) and 10 against Rhode Island (1/14)...

Rebounded from a seven-game slump (5-32 FGs) to tally double-figures in three of four outings...Scored 10 points in win over Duquesne (2/18) and back-to-back double-figure outings, 11 points at La Salle (2/25) in just 14 minutes, and 15 versus Fordham (2/29) over 19 minutes...Ended season scoring a total of 13 points over final four contests, while playing a total of 39 minutes.
