- 1/9** **Steve Nash** earned Western Conference Player of the Week honors for games played Jan. 2-8. Nash led the Suns to a 3-1 mark and averaged a league-high 14.3 assists along with his 21.3 points; Suns signed forward **Josh Davis** to a 10-day contract.
- 1/26** Phoenix acquired forward **Nikoloz Tskitishvili** from Minnesota for a 2006 second-round pick.
- 2/2** **Steve Nash** was named an NBA All-Star starter for the first time in his 10-year career. Nash was an All-Star reserve in 2002, 2003 and 2005.



- 2/9** **Shawn Marion** was named to the Western Conference All-Star team as a reserve for the third time in his career (2003, 2005, 2006).
- 2/25** **Shawn Marion** became the first Suns player to score 30 points and grab 20 rebounds since Charles Barkley (March 26, 1995 vs. Houston) with 31 points and a career-high and NBA 2005-06 season-high 24 rebounds vs. Charlotte.
- 2/27** President and General Manager **Bryan Colangelo** resigned after 11 seasons as general manager of the club.
- 3/1** For the first time in his seven-year career, Suns forward **Shawn Marion** was named NBA Western Conference Player of the Month for February. The Matrix averaged a team-leading 24.2 points and 13.9 rebounds, including nine double-doubles in 10 games; Suns waived swingman **Jim Jackson** and signed guard **Andre Barrett** to a 10-day contract; **Mike D'Antoni** was named NBA Western Conference Coach of the Month after guiding the Suns to a 9-1 record in February.
- 3/3** Phoenix signed free-agent forward **Tim Thomas** to a one-year contract.
- 3/5** Suns forwards **Shawn Marion** and **Amaré Stoudemire** were two of 23 players named to the USA Basketball Men's Senior National Team Program.
- 3/9** Suns signed President and Chief Operating Officer **Rick Welts** to a contract extension through the 2008-09 season.
- 3/10** Suns Head Coach **Mike D'Antoni** named Executive Vice President of Basketball Operations and General Manager; **David Griffin** promoted to Vice President of Basketball Operations and **Mark West** promoted to Vice President of Player of Programs.
- 3/11** Suns signed **Andre Barrett** to a second 10-day contract.
- 3/15** Suns released **Andre Barrett**.
- 3/23** **Amaré Stoudemire** made his season debut vs. Portland with a team-high tying 20 points and nine rebounds after missing the club's first 66 games due to left knee surgery.
- 4/9** Phoenix clinched its second consecutive division title for the first time in franchise history and its fifth overall (1980-81, 1992-93, 1994-95, 2004-05, 2005-06).
- 4/16** **Boris Diaw** logged his second consecutive triple-double at L.A. Lakers (other at Golden State on April 14) on his 24th birthday, to become only the fourth player in franchise history to achieve that feat (Alvan Adams, Charles Barkley, Jason Kidd-twice).
- 4/17** The Suns, who already broke their own NBA record for most three-pointers made in a single season earlier in the season, made a club-record 20 treys, one shy of the league record, vs. the New Orleans/Oklahoma City Hornets in a 115-78 blowout win.
- 5/1** **Boris Diaw** was named the winner of the 2005-06 NBA Most Improved Player Award after posting career highs of 13.3 points, 6.9 rebounds and 6.2 assists in 81 games in his first season with Phoenix. In his first two NBA seasons with Atlanta, Diaw averaged 4.6 points, 3.6 rebounds and 2.4 assists.
- 5/6** The Suns became just the eighth team in NBA history to overcome a 3-1 deficit by winning the final three games of the best-of-seven first-round playoffs series vs. the L.A. Lakers, including a 121-90 victory in Game 7. The 31-point margin of victory ranked second in club playoff history.
- 5/7** **Steve Nash** won his second consecutive NBA Most Valuable Player Award and joined Hall of Famer Magic Johnson as the only point guards in league history to capture multiple MVP trophies. Nash averaged career highs in points (18.8), rebounds (4.3), minutes (35.5), field goal percentage (.512) and free-throw percentage (franchise record .921).
- 5/17** **Steve Nash** was named to the All-NBA First Team for the second year in a row, while teammate **Shawn Marion** was on the All-NBA Third Team for the second-straight year.
- 5/22** The Suns advanced to the Western Conference Finals for the second year in a row (8th time overall) by capturing their second Game 7 victory in the 2006 NBA Playoffs with a 127-107 win over the L.A. Clippers.
- 5/24** Phoenix took a 1-0 lead in the 2006 Western Conference Finals with a come-from-behind 121-118 road win in Dallas. **Boris Diaw** nailed the game-winner on a 7-foot turnaround jump shot with 0.5 seconds left to seal the victory and added a career-high 34 points.
- 6/3** Phoenix was eliminated from the postseason after relinquishing an 18-point lead to the Dallas Mavericks to lose Game 6, 102-93 in the 2006 Western Conference Finals.
