- 12/7** Phoenix defeated the New Jersey Nets 161-157 in double-overtime as the two teams combined for the fourth-most points scored in NBA history and the most since Nov. 2, 1990 when Golden State won at Denver, 162-158. Phoenix's NBA season-high 161 points scored at New Jersey was franchise's second-highest point total, trailing only a 173-point effort vs. Denver on Nov. 10, 1990. Suns guard **Steve Nash** scored a regular season career high with 42 points.
- 12/11** Suns guard **Steve Nash** was named the NBA Western Conference Player of the Week for December 4-10. It was Nash's sixth career NBA Player of the Week honor.
- 12/19** The Suns won a franchise-record 15th consecutive game with a 115-98 triumph vs. Toronto, surpassing the previous record of 14 straight set from December 1-30, 1992. It was the NBA's longest win streak since the 1999-2000 L.A. Lakers won 19 in a row.
- 12/20** The Suns and Nuggets game was postponed due to severe weather conditions in the Denver, Colorado area and was eventually rescheduled for Feb. 5 at the Pepsi Center.
- 12/22** Unable to depart Denver for over two days, the snowbound Suns finally departed Mile High City after taking an alternate flight out of Colorado Springs and arrived in the Valley of the Sun only hours before the tip-off of the Suns-Wizards game that evening. Behind Gilbert Arena's US Airways Center record 54 points, Washington snapped the Suns' franchise-record 15-game win streak with a 144-139 overtime victory.
- 1/2** **Mike D'Antoni** was named NBA Western Conference Coach of the Month after guiding the Suns to an NBA-best 13-2 record.
- 1/22** Suns guard **Steve Nash** was named the NBA Western Conference Player of the Week for January 15-21. It was Nash's seventh career NBA Player of the Week honor.
- 1/28** Phoenix posted a franchise-record 17th consecutive victory at Cleveland, 115-100.

- 1/29** For the second week in a row (and eighth time in his career), Suns guard **Steve Nash** was named the NBA Western Conference Player of the Week for January 22-28. Nash became the first player in franchise history to win the weekly honor in back-to-back weeks. The Suns' franchise-record 17-game win streak was snapped at Minnesota, 121-112, behind Kevin Garnett's season-high 44 points.
- 2/1** Suns guard **Steve Nash** (5th All-Star appearance), forward **Shawn Marion** (4th) and center **Amaré Stoudemire** (2nd) were named to the Western Conference All-Star team as reserves. The Suns were the only NBA team with three All-Stars. Nash and Head Coach **Mike D'Antoni** were named the NBA Western Conference Player and Coach of the Month, respectively, after guiding the Suns to a franchise-record 15-1 record in January. The Suns matched the best January record in NBA history, tying the 1962-63 Los Angeles Lakers and the 15 victories were the most in any calendar month in franchise history.
- 2/12** The Suns announced that **Steve Nash** would not play in the 2007 NBA All-Star Game in Las Vegas due to inflammation in his right shoulder.
- 2/18** **Shawn Marion** collected 18 points, eight rebounds, four assists and two steals in 22 minutes in his hometown of Las Vegas at the 2007 NBA All-Star Game and teammate **Amaré Stoudemire** scored a Suns All-Star record 29 points and added nine rebounds in 21 minutes.
- 2/26** Suns center **Amaré Stoudemire** was named the NBA Western Conference Player of the Week for February 19-25. It was Stoudemire's third career NBA Player of the Week honor, and first since December 13, 2004.
- 3/14** The Suns snapped the Dallas' franchise-record 23-game home winning streak with a 129-127 double-overtime victory at American Airlines Center.
- 3/20** Phoenix clinched its third consecutive Pacific Division title (sixth in franchise history) with a 108-90 victory vs. Minnesota to become the first NBA team to be crowned a division champion in 2006-07.
- 4/23** Suns guard **Leandro Barbosa** was named the winner of the 2006-07 NBA Sixth Man Award. Barbosa became just the fourth Suns player to win the NBA Sixth Man honor, joining Eddie Johnson (1988-89), Danny Manning (1997-98) and Rodney Rogers (1999-2000).
- 4/29** Suns guard **Steve Nash** distributed a career-high and club playoff record 23 assists, one shy of tying Magic Johnson and John Stockton's NBA playoff record, in a 113-100 win in Game 4 of the Suns-Lakers first-round series in Los Angeles. Nash dished 15 assists in the first half to tie an NBA playoff record for most assists in a half (other, Magic Johnson and Doc Rivers).
- 4/30** Suns guard **Raja Bell** was named to the 2006-07 NBA All-Defensive Team for the first time in his career. Bell became the first Suns player to be named to an NBA All-Defensive Team since Jason Kidd (2000-01) and only the fourth player in club history to achieve that honor (Kidd, Dennis Johnson, Don Buse).
- 5/15** The NBA suspended **Amaré Stoudemire** and **Boris Diaw** for Game 5 of the Western Conference Semifinals for leaving "the immediate vicinity of their bench" during an altercation. The incident occurred with :18 remaining in the fourth quarter of the Suns' 104-98 win over the Spurs in Game 4 one day earlier.
- 5/18** Phoenix was eliminated from the postseason despite a late rally that saw the Suns trim a 20-point Spurs fourth quarter lead to 106-101 with 34.0 seconds remaining. Phoenix lost Game 6 in Alamo City, 114-106.
- 6/6** **Steve Kerr**, a five-time NBA champion and 15-year NBA veteran, was named President of Basketball Operations and General Manager. The Suns also announced that **Mike D'Antoni** would remain the team's Executive Vice President of Basketball Operations and Head Coach and would report to Kerr. **David Griffin** was promoted to Sr. Vice President of Basketball Operations.
