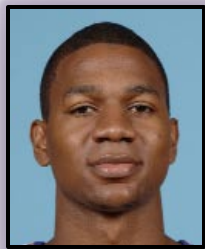
Professional: Selected by the Suns with the 15th overall pick in the first round of the 2008 NBA Draft... Became the fifth Stanford Cardinal selected by the Suns in franchise history, joining Casey Jacobsen (2002), Kimberly Belton (1980), Mike Bratz (1977) and Claude Terry (1972)... 16th early entry candidate selected by Phoenix in draft history.

College: Two-year collegiate standout at Stanford where he averaged 8.9 points, 5.6 rebounds and 2.33 blocked shots in 67 career games (61 starts)... As a sophomore, received Honorable Mention All-Pac-10 honors and was named to the Pac-10's All-Defensive Team ... Finished his college career with the second-most career blocks in Stanford history (156) despite playing just two seasons... Recorded two of the three most prolific single-season block totals in school history with 83 blocks in 2007-08 (2nd-most all-time) and a freshman-record 73 blocks in 2006-07 (3rd-most)... In his second and final season with the Cardinal, averaged 10.2 points, 5.7 rebounds and 2.31 blocks, including 12.7 points, 6.0 rebounds and 2.67 blocks in three NCAA Tournament games... Registered 14 points and five blocked shots vs. Cornell in the first round of the NCAA Tournament and followed that up with an 18-point, nine-rebound, three-block performance vs. Marquette in the second round... As a freshman, averaged 7.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and a Pac-10-best 2.35 blocks.

Personal: A native of Fresno, Calif., is a film enthusiast who also enjoys comic books, drawing, writing, playing volleyball and swimming... From a family rich with sports tradition... Mother, Deborah Ledford, was a collegiate swimmer at Stanford ranked second in the world in the 400 individual medley who tried out for the 1968 U.S. Olympic team... Has three brothers, Alexander, Christopher and Brook, and one sister, Ursula Richardson... Oldest brother, Alexander, who is 6-foot-10, played college basketball at Santa Clara and Washington while older brother Christopher, who is 6-foot-7, passed on college basketball scholarships to pursue a career as a movie producer... Twin brother, Brook, who was a teammate at Stanford, was taken 10th overall in the 2008 NBA Draft by the New Jersey Nets... After the NBA, would like to work as a designer for film or television.

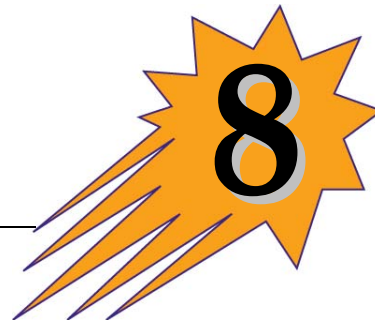

Professional: In his rookie season, averaged 2.2 points, 0.8 rebounds and 0.9 assists in 8.1 minutes... Appeared in 33 games, the most games played by a Suns rookie since Zarko Cabarkapa played 49 games in 2003-04... Scored a career-high nine points on Feb. 6 vs. New Orleans on a career-high four made field goals... Played one stint with the Suns' NBA Development League affiliate, the Albuquerque Thunderbirds, after being assigned on Dec. 17 and recalled on Jan. 10... Averaged 31.6 points, 3.8 rebounds and 3.2 assists in 41.4 minutes in five games with the Thunderbirds... Named D-League.com Performer of the Week on Jan. 7... Made NBA debut in the Suns home opener on Nov. 2 vs. L.A. Lakers, scoring five points, grabbing two rebounds and dishing one assist... Selected by Phoenix with the 59th overall pick in the second round of the 2007 NBA Draft... Is the first Maryland player to be taken by the Suns since selecting Mark Fothergill and Herman Veal in 1984... Is the first Terrapin drafted in the NBA since Steve Blake was taken in the second round by the Washington Wizards in 2003.

College: Played four seasons at Maryland averaging 10.1 points, 3.3 rebounds, 2.9 assists and 1.82 steals in 111 collegiate games (from 2003-07... Finished his career ranked among Maryland's all-time leaders in points, assists and steals... Scored 1,126 points and ranks 35th all-time in scoring at Maryland.. His 316 career assists rank 15th all-time, while his 202 steals places him fifth in the school annals... Named the Terrapins' Most Valuable Player following his senior season after averaging a team-high 14.9 points... Named second-team All-ACC and earned a spot on the Atlantic Coast Conference All-Defensive Team... Started all 34 games as a senior as the Terps finished the year 25-9 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament... Poured in a career-high 27 points in win vs. No. 5 North Carolina, earning back-to-back ACC Player of the Week honors... Earned ACC All-Defensive Team Honorable Mention honors as a junior in 2005-06.... Led Maryland and ranked seven in ACC in assists (4.0) and sixth in ACC in steals (1.8)... Suffered a season-ending torn right ACL injury in practice on Jan. 17, 2005 and played in only 14 games in 2004-05... Garnered ACC All-Freshman Team Honorable Mention pick as a freshman.

Personal: Full name is Darryl Eugene Strawberry but goes by D.J.... Born on June 15, 1985 in New York, N.Y... Son of Lisa Watkins and former Major League Baseball player Darryl Strawberry... Has two brothers, Jordan Strawberry and Jesse Watkins... Also has four sisters, Diamond, Jade and Jewell Strawberry and Faith Watkins... Lists Michael Jordan as his favorite professional basketball player... Joined teammates Steve Nash, Leandro Barbosa and Alando Tucker at the Yao/Nash Charity Gala event, a charity basketball game on Sept. 14, 2007 in Beijing, China.

Professional: In his rookie season, averaged 3.7 points and 1.3 rebounds in 8.0 minutes in six games... Made NBA debut on Nov. 6 at Charlotte, scoring two points and grabbing one rebound... Spent three separate stints with the Albuquerque Thunderbirds, the Suns' NBA Development League affiliate from Nov. 28-Dec. 17, Jan. 10-Jan. 21 and March 13-April 7... In 21 games (19 starts) with Albuquerque, averaged 27.7 points, 6.0 rebounds and 1.6 assists... Named D-League.com Performer of the Week on Dec. 17... Selected by Phoenix with the 29th overall pick in the first round of the 2007 NBA Draft... Is the second Wisconsin player chosen by the Suns in the first round (Michael Finley, 21st overall in the 1995 NBA Draft).

College: Played five seasons at Wisconsin after receiving a medical redshirt in 2003-04, and averaged 16.5 points, 5.7 rebounds and 1.6 assists in 134 collegiate games from 2002-07... Finished as the Badgers all-time leading scorer (2,217), surpassing former Suns draft pick Michael Finley and ranks ninth in Big Ten history... Also holds seven other school records, including offensive rebounds (314), field goals (798), free throws (520), free throw attempts (817), minutes played (4,297), games played (134) and games started (126)... Played in 99 victories at Wisconsin, most in school history, and was part of the Badgers four winningest teams... Named Big Ten Player of the Year and was a consensus All-American as a senior after averaging 19.9 points (2nd in Big Ten), 5.4 rebounds and 2.0 assists in 36 games... One of four finalists for the Naismith Trophy given to the national player of the year, along with eventual winner Texas forward Kevin Durant (2nd overall in 2007 NBA Draft to Seattle), Texas A&M guard Acie Law IV (11th overall in 2007 NBA Draft to Atlanta) and North Carolina forward Tyler Hansbrough... Led Wisconsin to heights unparalleled in school history as a senior... The Badgers won 17 consecutive games, the longest single-season streak in school history, earned a No. 1 ranking in *The Associated Press* poll for the first time, and garnered their highest seed ever in the 2007 NCAA Tournament (No. 2)... Scored a career-high and Paradise Jam Tournament-record 38 points (fourth-most in school history) in win over Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 19, 2005... As a sophomore, led Badgers in scoring (15.2) and averaged a career-best 6.1 rebounds in 2004-05... Missed all but four games due to a right foot injury in 2003-04 and received a medical redshirt... As a freshman, started at power forward and finished third on the team (and third among Big Ten freshmen) averaging 12.0 points... Led the Big Ten and set a school record for offensive rebounds (2.69 per game, 86 total).

Personal: Born on February 11, 1984 in Lockport, Ill... Parents are Lisa Tucker and Forrest Harris... Owns a 38-inch vertical jump... Majored in life sciences communications at Wisconsin... Nickname is Doe... Averaged 22.2 points, 7.7 rebounds and 5.7 assists to earn first-team all-state honors as a senior at Township High School in Lockport, Ill.

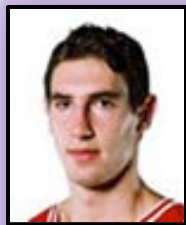

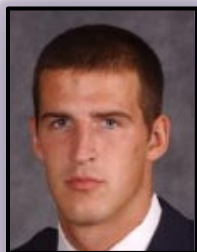

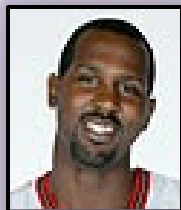
