# 2007 WARRIORS DRAFT NOTES

**2007 NBA DRAFT PROCESS:** The 2007 NBA Draft will be held at The WaMu Theatre at Madison Square Garden in New York, NY, on Thursday, June 28, with television coverage beginning on ESPN at 4:00 p.m. PT...For the 19th consecutive year, the draft will consist of two rounds (60 total selections)...There will be a five-minute time limit for selections in the first round and a two-minute limit in the second round.

**WARRIORS OWN 18th SELECTION IN FIRST ROUND:** Entering the 2007 NBA Draft, the Golden State Warriors own the 18th overall pick in the first round...The Warriors have owned the 18th pick in the draft just once previously, having selected Wesley Cox out of Louisville with the 18th overall selection in 1977...Golden State has not owned a lower slot in the first round, based on the previous season's record, since the 1992 NBA Draft when the team selected Latrell Sprewell with the 24th overall pick...In 1999, Golden State picked lower in the first round than the 18th selection when the team tabbed Jeff Foster at #21...However, Golden State originally owned the 10th overall pick in that 1999 draft before swapping picks with Atlanta as part of a multi-player trade on the day prior to the draft...Additionally, Golden State did not have a first round pick in the 2000 NBA Draft.

**LOOKING TO CONTINUE SECOND ROUND SUCCESS WITH 36th & 46th SELECTIONS:** In addition to their first round pick, the Warriors also own the 36th and 46th overall picks in the second round of this year's draft...In recent years, Golden State has come away from the draft process with several second round success stories, including Monta Ellis (#40 in 2005), Gilbert Arenas (#31 in 2001) and Marc Jackson (#38 in 1997).

**WARRIORS SUMMER LEAGUE INFORMATION:** The Warriors are scheduled to participate in the 2007 NBA Summer League in Las Vegas from July 7-14...Golden State's 2007 summer league entry will play five games against other NBA summer league clubs at either Cox Pavilion or Thomas & Mack Center on the campus of UNLV...The 2007 NBA Summer League, which features squads representing 21 NBA teams, is scheduled to take place from July 6-15 and offers special hotel rates for fans on its website – [www.vegassummerleague.com](http://www.vegassummerleague.com)...The Warriors' 2007 summer league roster, which will be coached by Warriors assistant Keith Smart, will be announced shortly after the 2007 NBA Draft takes place on June 28.
