2008 WARRIORS DRAFT NOTES

2008 NBA DRAFT PROCESS: The 2008 NBA Draft will be held at The WaMu Theatre at Madison Square Garden in New York, NY, on Thursday, June 26, with television coverage beginning on ESPN at 4:00 p.m. PDT...For the 20th consecutive year, the draft will consist of two rounds (60 total selections)... There will be a five-minute time limit for selections in the first round and a two-minute limit in the second round.

WARRIORS OWN 14th SELECTION IN FIRST ROUND: Entering the 2008 NBA Draft, the Golden State Warriors own the 14th overall pick in the first round...The Warriors have owned the 14th pick in the draft six times previously, having selected Jack Sullivan from Mount Saint Mary's (1957), Hubie White from Villanova (1962), Lester Conner from Oregon State (1982), Tellis Frank from Western Kentucky (1987), Tim Hardaway from Texas El-Paso (1989) and most recently Troy Murphy from Notre Dame (2001).

LOOKING TO CONTINUE SECOND ROUND SUCCESS WITH 49th SELECTION: In addition to their first round pick, the Warriors also own the 49th overall picks in the second round of this year's draft...In recent years, Golden State has come away from the draft process with several second round success stories, including Monta Ellis (#40 in 2005), Gilbert Arenas (#31 in 2001) and Marc Jackson (#38 in 1997).

WARRIORS SUMMER LEAGUE INFORMATION: The Warriors are scheduled to participate in both the 2008 NBA Summer League presented by EA Sports in Las Vegas as well as the Rocky Mountain Revue in Salt Lake City...The Warriors' 2008 NBA summer league roster will be announced shortly after the 2008 NBA Draft takes place on June 26...Warriors assistant coach Keith Smart with coach the Las Vegas entry while shooting coach Sidney Moncrief with guide the Revue entry.
