# 2006 WARRIORS DRAFT NOTES

**2006 NBA DRAFT PROCESS:** The 2006 NBA Draft will be held at The Theatre at Madison Square Garden in New York, NY, on Wednesday, June 28, with television coverage beginning on ESPN at 4:30 p.m. PST...For the 18th consecutive year, the draft will consist of two rounds (60 total selections)... There will be a five-minute time limit for selections in the first round and a two-minute limit in the second round.

**WARRIORS OWN 9th & 38th SELECTIONS:** Entering the 2006 NBA Draft, the Golden State Warriors own the 9th overall pick and the 38th overall selection (8th in the second round)...The Warriors have owned the 9th overall pick in the draft three times previously and have selected in the draft's top-nine 32 times.

**WARRIORS HISTORY OF PICKS AT #9:** This year's draft marks just the fourth time that the Warriors have held the #9 selection in the NBA Draft -- but also marks the second straight year that the team has owned the #9 pick...Here is a look at the players whom the Warriors have selected at #9:
