MORE ABOUT TONIGHT'S GAME...

-Tonight's game is the first of two meetings between the Washington Wizards and San Antonio Spurs. The Spurs took both meetings last season. The two teams will meet again on January 2nd at Verizon Center.

-Last contest...The Washington Wizards were defeated by the Oklahoma City Thunder last night at Ford Center, 127-108...Caron Butler led the Wizards with 24 points on 8-of-16 from the field...Antawn Jamison posted his second straight double-double with 22 points and 12 rebounds...Brendan Haywood posted his fourth double-double of the season with 14 points and 16 rebounds...Gilbert Arenas scored 23 points and had eight assists...Earl Boykins added 11 points off of the bench in 17:18 minutes of action.

-Last night, Gilbert Arenas (23), Caron Butler (24) and Antawn Jamison (22) scored 20 or more points in the same game for the first time since November 8, 2007 at New Jersey.

-Wizards center Brendan Haywood is averaging 13.0 rebounds per game in his last six games. Haywood is also averaging 6.2 offensive rebounds per game during this stretch, and is currently tied for second in the NBA in offensive rebounds per game with an average of 4.6.

-The Wizards last win in San Antonio came on December 11, 1999. Mitch Richmond led the Wizards to a 99-89 victory, with 31 points on 12-of-19 from the field.

- Washington currently ranks in the top ten in the NBA in three-point field goal percentage (.357, 9th), offensive rebounding (12.1, 8th) and total rebounds per game (43.0, 10th).

-Tonight's contest will complete the Wizards third back-to-back set of the season. The Wizards are currently 1-1 in the second game of back-to-backs.

-Washington-San Antonio connectionsō Wizards forward Antawn Jamison and Spurs guard Michael Finley were teammates in Dallas in 2003-04ō Spurs guard Roger Mason Jr. appeared in 142 games for Washington from 2006-08, and averaged 9.1 points per game as a Wizard in 2007-08ō Washington's Gilbert Arenas and San Antonio's Richard Jefferson were teammates at Arizonaō Wizards center Fabricio Oberto played with the Spurs from 2005-09 averaging 4.2 points and 3.9 rebounds per gameō Fabricio Oberto and Spurs guard Manu Ginobili were teammates on the 2004 Olympic Gold Medal winning Argentina National Team in Athens, Greece. Spurs forward Antonio McDyess played three seasons under Wizards Head Coach Flip Saunders in Detroit.

WIZARDS NOTES

CAPTAIN CONSISTENT IS BACK: After missing the first nine games of the season, Antawn Jamison returned to action the only way he knows how, with a double-double. Jamison scored 31 points and grabbed 10 rebounds in the Wizards' 108-91 victory over the Cleveland Cavaliers (11/18). The 11 year pro, followed that performance with another double-double in his second outing with 22 points and 12 rebounds at OKC (11/20).

HIS NAME IS EARL: On November 11th, the Wizards signed veteran guard Earl Boykins to add depth and leadership in the backcourt. In his first NBA game since April 16, 2008, Boykins did not disappoint as he scored 20 points on 7-of-12 from the field in 30:31 minutes of play versus Detroit (11/14). The nine-year pro, has posted career averages of 9.5 points and 3.4 assists in 523 career games. In three games with the Wizards, Boykins is averaging 13.3 points and 2.7 assists. He is also no stranger to the Wizards and has had a couple of his best games against Washington.

BACK IN FORM: After only appearing in six games during the 2008-09 season due to injury, Brendan Haywood looks like he is back to the form that saw him produce career-high numbers during the 2007-08 season. In the first eleven games, Haywood is averaging a career-high 11.2 points and 11.3 rebounds. The ninth-year pro posted a career-high 19 rebounds on November 6th in Indiana. Haywood has grabbed at least 10 rebounds in seven of 11 games played this season.

MILLER FROM THE FIELD: A career sharpshooter, Mike Miller is showing why he is known as one of the best shooters in the league. After missing three games with a shoulder injury, Miller returned to score a season-high 20 points on 7-of-11 from the field and 4-of-7 from three-point range. In eight games played this season, Miller is posting career-highs in field goal percentage (.592) and three-point field goal percentage (.591).

FLIP-ING THE SCRIPT: On April 22, 2009, Flip Saunders became the 22nd head coach in Wizards history. Saunders brings an impressive resume to Washington and is tasked with leading the Wizards back to the elite in the East. Now in his 14th year as a head coach in the NBA, Saunders has amassed a record of 590-404 (.593 winning percentage). Saunders has compiled seven 50-win seasons and has taken his teams to the playoffs in 11 out of 13 seasons, and has advanced to the Conference Finals four times.

10,000 POINT CLUB: On November 6th in Indiana, Gilbert Arenas became the 294th player in NBA history to reach 10,000 career points. Arenas who is in his ninth season as a pro is currently averaging 22.8 points in 443 career games played.
