MORE ABOUT TONIGHT'S GAME...

*Tonight's match-up is the third and final meeting between the Washington Wizards and Boston Celtics. The Celtics currently lead the season series, 2-0.

*Last gameō The Wizards were defeated by the Toronto Raptors, 97-96 on April 13th at Verizon Center...Chris Bosh hit a three-pointer with 9.9 seconds to go to give the Raptors a one point lead which would be the difference in the game...Caron Butler led all scorers with 28 points on 9-of-17 from the field to go along with nine rebounds...Antawn Jamison scored 23 points and grabbed seven rebounds...Brendan Haywood rejected four shotsō Javale McGee scored 10 points and grabbed seven rebounds for Washington.

*Last time versus Boston...The Wizards fell to the Boston Celtics, 108-83, on January 2nd at TD Banknorth Garden. Nick Young led the Wizards with 15 points off of the bench in just 17:10 minutes of actionō Antawn Jamison narrowly missed his 19th double-double of the season as he scored 14 points and grabbed nine rebounds. Caron Butler returned to action after missing three games due to a left ankle sprainō .Butler scored eight points and had four steals in 31:59 minutes of play.

*Washington has used a total of 20 starting line-up combinations this season.

*Antawn Jamison and Caron Butler have scored 20 or more points in the same game 27 times this season.

*The Wizards have blocked a total of 23 shots over their last two games.

*Brendan Haywood is averaging 3.6 blocks over his last three games.

*Javaris Crittenton is averaging 9.3 points, 3.9 rebounds and 3.2 assists in nine games as a starter this season.

*Washington-Boston connectionsō Wizards forward Darius Songaila was drafted by the Celtics with the 50th overall pick in the second round of the 2002 NBA Draft...Wizards swingman Caron Butler and Celtics guard Eddie House were teammates in Miami during Butler's rookie season in 2002-03... Mike James averaged 10.7 points per game in 55 games for Boston in 2003-04ō Interim Head Coach Ed Tapscott played his collegiate basketball for Tom Penders at Tufts University in the Boston suburbs, and later served as a graduate assistant coach at Tufts beginning in 1975.

WIZARDS NOTES

B-WOOD BACK ON THE HARDWOOD: After missing the first 75 games of the season, Brendan Haywood is back as a force in the middle for the Wizards. In six games, Haywood is averaging 9.7 points, 7.3 rebounds and 2.5 blocks. The seven-footer has posted two double-doubles and recorded a season-high of five blocks, in the Wizards 100-98 victory over the Raptors on April 10th.

CUP OF TOUGH JUICE: Caron Butler is averaging 24.7 points over his last seven games. The two-time All-Star has also posted 31 points two times in his last seven contests. Butler surpassed the 8,000 point career mark during the April 4th matchup against Miami at Verizon Center.

TEN AND UP: Antawn Jamison streak of 10 or more points ended at 73 games on April 8th in Cleveland. The streak began on 11/12/2008 and marked the longest streak of his career. He also had a streak of 62 games of 10 or more points last season from 11/16/2007--03/23/2008. Jamison tied his longest streak of 10 or more points of his career, which was 67 on March 23th against Chicago, which he originally accomplished during the 2000-01 season with the Golden State Warriors. Jamison's streak ranks as one of the best current streaks in the NBA.

LENDING A HELPING HAND: In his first two games this season, Gilbert Arenas has dished out 20 assists and committed only one turnover. Arenas is the first player since turnovers became an official stat in 1977-78 to record 20 assists and one of fewer turnover in their first two games of the season.

ENTERING THE 30's: Caron Butler has scored 30 or more points in ten games this season. Butler's ten 30-point games this season are the most he has posted in a season in his seven year career. The two-time all-star recorded four 30 or more point games during the 2007-08 with the Wizards and the 2004-05 season as a member of the Los Angeles Lakers his highest totals before this season.

AGENT ZERO RETURNS TO LIVE ACTION: Gilbert Arenas made his triumphant return on March 28th versus the Detroit Pistons. For Arenas, it was his first game action since playing in game four of last season's first round playoff series versus the Cleveland Cavaliers. Arenas posted a double-double with 15 points and 10 assists.

GETTING THE NOD: Called upon to start in 36 games this season, Andray Blatche has answered the call with numbers that equal career-highs. In his 36 starts this season, Blatche is averaging 11.8 points and 6.3 rebounds, while shooting 47.4 percent from the field.

MISTER FIFTY: A steady contributor as a starter and as a reserve this season, forward Darius Songaila comes in and makes shots. Songaila continues to lead the team in field goal percentage shooting a career high 53.0 percent, connecting on 238-of-449 from the field this season.

HUSTLE MAN: Dominic McGuire is averaging 5.5 points, 6.4 rebounds, 3.3 assists, 1.1 blocks in the 56 games he has started this season. In those 56 starts, the second-year forward has posted double-figures in rebounds in eleven games and dished out a career-high nine assists in two games. McGuire tied his career-high with 14 rebounds vs. PHI (2/25). He also posted his first career double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds vs. CLE (1/4).

MARCH MADNESS: Jamison turned it up a notch into high gear during the month of March. In 16 games played during the month, Jamison averaged 25.4 points and 8.2 rebounds. His 25.4 point scoring average during the month is his highest average during any month this season. Jamison had three 30 or more point games the month, including his season-high of 36 points against Orlando (3/13).
