MORE ABOUT TONIGHT'S GAME...

-Tonight's game is the second of four meetings between the Washington Wizards and Miami Heat. The Heat took the first meeting, 93-89 on November 4th at Verizon Center. The two teams will meet again on November 27th in Miami, and for the final time on January 22nd in Washington.

- Last contest...The Washington Wizards were defeated by the Phoenix Suns, 102-90 at Verizon Center on November 8th...Gilbert Arenas and Andray Blatche scored 20 apiece for the Wizards...Caron Butler added 19 points and grabbed six rebounds...Randy Foye scored 16 points and grabbed four rebounds in his second start of the season...Brendan Haywood posted a double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds and also blocked a season-high five shots, this marked Haywood's third straight game with 10 or more rebounds.

-Last time versus Miami...The Wizards were defeated, 93-89, by the Miami Heat on November 4th at Verizon Center...Washington battled back from a 19-point first half deficit to tie the game at 66-66 at the end of three quarters...Dwyane Wade took control of the back and forth battle in the fourth quarter to lead Miami to the victory...Wade finished with 40 points, a season-high for a Wizards opponent this season...Gilbert Arenas led Washington with 32 points, his second game of 30 or more points this season...Brendan Haywood (16 points, 11 rebounds) and Caron Butler (13 points, 10 rebounds) each posted their first double-doubles of the season in the loss.

-Brendan Haywood is averaging 11.7 points, 13.3 rebounds and 3.7 blocks in his last three games. Haywood has grabbed 10 or more rebounds in his last three games, the last time he posted four games with 10 or more rebounds occurred during the 2007-08 season, when he posted four straight from 11/11/07--11/17/07.

-Haywood has grabbed eight offensive rebounds in each of his last two games. With this feat, Haywood became the first Washington player to post at least eight offensive rebounds in consecutive games since Moses Malone did so on January 10th and 12th of 1987.

-Gilbert Arenas is averaging 22.3 points and 5.2 assists in 18 career games played versus Miami.

-The Wizards are currently ranked in the top 10 in the NBA in total rebounds per game (43.3, 10th), defensive rebounding (32.0, 6th) and blocks (5.4, 9th)

-Washington-Miami connections...Wizards forward Caron Butler was drafted by Miami with the 10th overall pick in the 2002 NBA Draft. As a rookie in Miami, Butler averaged 15.4 points per game and was named to the 2002-03 NBA All-Rookie First Team, but was later dealt to the Lakers in the trade that brought Shaquille O'Neal to South Beach. Butler, 29, and Miami's Dwyane Wade, 27, have been friends and rivals since their AAU days in the Chicago-Milwaukee area. Washington's Andray Blatche and Miami's Dorell Wright attended the same Connecticut prep school, South Kent Prep. Wizards guard Mike James appeared in 93 games for the Heat in 2001-02 and 2002-03. Wizards swingman Mike Miller and Miami forward Udonis Haslem were teammates on the 1999-2000 Florida Gator team that made it to the National Championship game where they lost to Michigan State. 10,000 POINT CLUB: On November 6th in Indiana, Gilbert Arenas became the 294th player in NBA history to reach 10,000 career points. Arenas who is in his ninth season as a pro is currently averaging 22.8 points in 439 career games played.

BACK IN FORM: After only appearing in six games during the 2008-09 season due to injury, Brendan Haywood looks like he is back to the form that saw him produce career-high numbers during the 2007-08 season. In the first seven games, Haywood is averaging a career-high 11.3 points and 10.7 rebounds. The ninth-year pro posted a career-high 19 rebounds on November 6th in Indiana. Haywood has posted two straight double-doubles, and has grabbed at least seven rebounds in every game played so far this season.

GETTING DEFENSIVE: Coming into the 2009-10 season, the Wizards have taken more of a defensive approach and so far in the first seven contests it has showed. Washington has held their first seven opponents to .435 percent from the field, which currently ranks eight in the NBA.

ARENAS BACK ON THE CASE: After missing significant action during the last two seasons, Gilbert Arenas is averaging 24.4 points (currently ranked 11th in the NBA) and 5.6 assists in his first seven games. Arenas scored 32 points in Washington's 123-104 win over New Jersey (10/31), which marked his highest scoring output since November 14, 2007, when he scored 30 points against the Pacers.

FLIP-ING THE SCRIPT: On April 22, 2009, Flip Saunders became the 22nd head coach in Wizards history. Saunders brings an impressive resume to Washington and is tasked with leading the Wizards back to the elite in the East. Now in his 14th year as a head coach in the NBA, Saunders has amassed a record of 589-401, and his .595 winning percentage is currently seventh among active head coaches. Saunders has compiled seven 50-win seasons and has taken his teams to the playoffs in 11 out of 13 seasons, and has advanced to the Conference Finals four times.
