WIZARDS TIDBITS

-Tonight's game is the first of two meetings between the Washington Wizards and Portland Trail Blazers. The two teams split last season's series at one game apiece. The Wizards and Trail Blazers will meet again on March 10th in Washington.

-Last game versus Detroit...The Wizards defeated the Detroit Pistons, 98-77, on February 12th at The Palace of Auburn Hills...JaVale McGee scored 22 points and grabbed 11 rebounds...Nick Young scored 22 points on 8-of-13 from the field...John Wall scored nine points and dished out a career-high tying 15 assists...Jan Vesely tallied 10 points, eight rebounds, three blocks, two assists and two blocks...Rashard Lewis added 10 points.

-Rashard Lewis reached the 15,000 career point plateau in Washington's last game at Detroit (2/12). Lewis joins Paul Pierce and Jason Kidd as the only players in NBA history who have scored at least 15,000 points, grabbed 5,000 rebounds and hit 1,500 three-pointers in their careers.

-John Wall is averaging 18.8 points and 8.2 assists in his last six games. Wall is shooting .512 percent (41-of-81) from the field in his last six games.

-Wall averaged 25.0 points, 9.5 assists and 5.5 rebounds in two games versus Detroit last season.

-Trevor Booker is averaging 12.5 points, 7.3 rebounds, 1.5 steals and 1.5 blocks in his last six games. Booker is shooting .559 percent from the field during this stretch.

-JaVale McGee is 25 points shy of 2,000 career points.

-The Wizards held the Pistons to opponent lows in field goal percentage (.328), points in the fourth quarter (14), points in the second half (32) and three-pointers made (1).

-Washington's 21 points road victory over Detroit (2/12) represents their largest road victory since December 2, 2008. The Wizards defeated the Nets in New Jersey, 108-88.

-Wizards-Trail Blazers connections...Trail Blazers assistant coach Bernie Bickerstaff was the Washington Bullets/Wizards Head Coach for the final 35 games of the 1996-97 season through the first 32 games of the 1998-99 season...Wizards center JaVale McGee and Trail Blazers guard Armon Johnson played together at Nevada in 2007-2008...Wizards guard Roger Mason and Trail Blazers forward Kurt Thomas were teammates on the San Antonio Spurs in 2008-2009...Trail Blazers guard Jamal Crawford was teammates with Wizards forward Ronny Turiaf on the Golden State Warriors (2008-2009) as well as with Wizards guard Maurice Evans on the Hawks (2009-2011).

WIZARDS NOTES

COOK BOOK: Wizards forward Trevor Booker is averaging 12.3 points, 7.2 rebounds and 1.4 steals per game in his last nine games. Booker is shooting .620 percent from the field during this stretch. The second-year forward scored a season-high 19 points on 7-of-10 from the field against the Raptors (2/6).

WALL ON FIRE: In his last 17 games, John Wall is averaging 18.8 points, 7.8 assists and 5.5 rebounds per game. Wall has eclipsed the 20-point mark six times and the 30-point mark twice during this stretch, including a career-high 38 points versus Houston (1/16).

FOREVER YOUNG: Nick Young is averaging 19.4 points per game in his last 17 games to boost his scoring averaging to 17.3 points per game. Young has scored 20 or more points nine times during the 17-game stretch.

BLOCK PARTY CONTINUES: After finishing second in the NBA in total blocked shots (193) and blocks per game (2.4) in 2010-11, Wizards center JaVale McGee is once again among the league leaders in blocks this season. McGee is tied for first along with Oklahoma City's Serge Ibaka in the NBA in total blocks with 79 and ranks second blocks per game at 2.8.

BENCH SCORING: Second-year guard Jordan Crawford is averaging 11.9 points and 3.3 assists off of the bench in his last 17 games. For the season, Crawford is averaging 11.1 points in 28 games off of the bench.

ONE FOR THE ROAD: In the Wizards' first road victory of the season over the Bobcats (1/28, 102-99), the team shot over .526 percent from the field which marked the first time they have shot over .500 from the field this season. As a team, the Wizards tallied 26 assists, 10 steals and 10 blocks. The last time the Wizards had at least 26 assists, 10 steals and 10 blocks in the same game was on January 5, 2007, in a 116-105 home victory over the Los Angeles Clippers. The Wizards and Nuggets are the only two teams to record these numbers in the same game this season.

HELPING HAND: The Wizards had 13 assists in the first quarter versus Denver (1/20), which marked the first time they had at least 13 assists in a quarter since April 15, 2000 against Milwaukee. The Wizards had 13 assists versus the Bucks in the first quarter of that game. Washington's 19 first half assists versus Denver marked their most assists in a half since recording 19 assists in the first half against the Bucks on April 1, 2007

BIG WIN: In Washington's, 105-102, win over the Oklahoma City Thunder (1/18), the team set season-highs in a number of categories. Season-highs were set in fourth quarter points (33), second-half points (59), free-throws made (31), three-pointers made (8) and offensive rebounds (19).

CAREER DAY: In the Wizards' MLK matinee versus Houston (1/16), John Wall turned in a career best performance. Wall scored a career-high 38 points on a career-high 13 field goals made (13-of-22). The second-year guard added eight assists, six rebounds and four steals in addition to his career-high in points. Wall scored 24 second half points including 18 in the fourth quarter. He became the first NBA player this season to have at least 38 points, eight assists, six rebounds and four steals in the same game.

MCGEE FILLS THE STAT SHEET: In the Wizards' contest versus Philadelphia (1/14), JaVale McGee became the first player this season to have at least 23 points, 18 rebounds and five blocks in the same game. McGee is also the last NBA player to record these numbers in the same game. McGee had 28 points, 18 rebounds and five blocks versus at Golden State on March 27, 2011.
