RECAP: The South Bay Lakers remained winless on the road as they fell to the Santa Cruz Warriors, 97-91, on Friday night. Johnathan Williams paced the Lakers (1-5) with 18 points and 11 rebounds for his second consecutive double-double. Kendrick Nunn scored 22 points off the bench as the Warriors (6-0) remained undefeated. Santa Cruz took a slight 24-23 lead after the first quarter as Darius Morris scored eight points in the frame. Scott Machado and Williams combined for 12 points in the period to keep the Lakers close. The Warriors took a 52-41 halftime lead behind nine points in the second from Nunn. South Bay stormed back in the third quarter to take a 67-65 lead heading into the final quarter. Williams tallied 10 points and eight rebounds as the Lakers held the Warriors to 25.0 percent from the field in the frame. However, the Warriors took control in the fourth as their reserves scored 20 points to put the game away. A second straight double-double from Williams wasn't enough for the Lakers, who shot only 2-of-16 from beyond the arc in the loss. Allen scored 12 points in his first career start and Machado posted a near double-double himself with 10 points and nine assists. Isaac Bonga also scored in double digits with 15 points.

RECAP: The South Bay Lakers dropped the final game of their three-game road trip, as they fell to the Westchester Knicks, 103-89, on Wednesday night. Johnathan Williams scored a career-high 25 points for South Bay (6-8) to go along with 10 rebounds. Trevon Bluiett led the Knicks (12-3) with 29 points off the bench. The Knicks took a slight lead after the first quarter, 21-20, despite eight points in the period by Williams. Westchester maintained a small lead after two, 43-39, as Bluiett scored a team-high nine points in the first half. Westchester extended their lead through three, 74-64, behind 12 points in the frame from Bluiett. The Knicks were able to finish off the victory in the fourth quarter as Bluiett and Isaiah Hicks combined for 16 points in the final frame. Williams tallied his seventh double-double of the season and his third straight game with 20+ points. Travis Wear scored 14 points and Isaac Bonga finished with 11 points and eight rebounds. Andre Ingram tallied double figures off the bench with 11 points while Scott Machado finished with nine points and 10 assists.

Johnathan Williams secured his seventh career double-double with 25 points and 10 rebounds on 12/5 at Westchester. The two-way forward is averaging 19.2 points and 8.8 rebounds in 12 games with South Bay this season.

Caruso the Closer

Alex Caruso scored 19 of his 28 points in the fourth quarter in South Bay's 107-101 win over Windy City on 12/3. Caruso shot 5-9 from the field, 3-6 from three-point range and 6-7 from the free throw line in the final period.

They Call Me JJ

Jemerrio Jones continued his great start to his rookie season with a near triple-double on 11/28 vs. Texas, finishing with 10 points, 14 rebounds, nine assists, two steals and three blocks. Jones leads the team in rebounds per game (10.2), steals per game (1.9) and blocks per game (1.3).

The Rooks Rock

Svi Mykhailiuk and Moe Wagner joined South Bay on assignment on 11/28 and helped lead the team to a 123-113 win. Mykhailuk finished with 29 points and connected on 7-9 from beyond the arc. The sharp-shooter finished the first half with 20 points on a perfect 6-6 from three. Wagner tallied 21 points, including a dominant third quarter where he scored 17 points and shot 7-8 from the field.

Come On Scottie!

Scott Machado scored 33 points, including 16 points in the fourth, to give the Lakers their first road win on 11/24 at Sioux Falls. Machado will join the Brazilian National Team for FIBA Qualifiers. The point guard tallied three points and three assists vs. Dominican Republic on 11/30 and eight points and six assist on 12/3

Red, White and Blue Berry

Joel Berry II was selected to play for Team USA as part of the second-round FIBA Basketball World Cup 2019 Americas Qualifiers. Berry II posted four points, two rebounds and one assist on 11/29 vs. Argentina and helped Team USA secure a berth in the FIBA World Cup

Izzy Fo Shizzy

Isaac Bonga did a bit of everything in South Bay's 107-92 win over the Salt Lake City Stars on 11/18. The rookie guard posted 25 points, six rebounds, three assists, three steals and a block in the win. Bonga shot 5-9 from beyond the arc in the game and is shooting at a 44.4 percent clip from three-point range this season.

All five starters scored in double figures for the first time this season on 11/18 vs. Salt Lake City. The starting five combined for 81 points in the win. It was the first time that all five starters reached double figures since 3/11/18 at Northern Arizona

Holy Caruso!

Alex Caruso had his best game of the young season in a 119-118 win over the Iowa Wolves on 11/12. Caruso tallied 26 points, seven rebounds and 11 assists, but it was his four triples in the fourth quarter that helped the Lakers grab the win. The two-way guard scored the game-winning shot from distance with 3.3 seconds remaining to give South Bay their first victory of the year.

Großartig

South Bay dropped their first game of the season, but got good production from their two rookies on assignment from LA. Isaac Bonga tallied 27 points, 9 rebounds, 3 assists and 2 blocks, while Moe Wagner pitched in 17 points and 4 rebounds.

DRE'S BACK

Andre Ingram returns to the South Bay for his 11th season in the G League. The veteran sharp-shooter became a household name last season when he was called up to the Los Angeles Lakers for the final two games of the season.

- His 19 points were the most by a Laker in their debut since Nick Van Exel (23) in 1993, while his four three-pointers were the most ever in a Lakers debut
- Ingram received his first NBA Call-Up on 4/9, after shooting a G League-leading 47.5 percent from three-point range for the South Bay Lakers
- Andre played in 384 G League games over 10 seasons, with career averages of 10.2 points (.464 FG%, .461 3P%), 3.1 rebounds and 1.6 assists
- The G League's all-time leader in made three's (716) has shot 45 percent or better from three in eight of his 10 G League seasons

HIT THE JACKPOT

Several members of the South Bay Lakers helped contribute to the Lakers successful run at the 2018 Las Vegas Summer League, where they advanced to the championship round for the second straight year.

- Alex Caruso led the way with 5.2 assists per game along with 6.5 points in 23.5 minutes
- Johnathan Williams averaged 4.4 points and 4.6 rebounds as the starting power forward
- Isaac Bonga made his Lakers debut over the summer and averaged 2.1 points and 1.0 rebounds in 9.0 minutes of action
- Jeffrey Carroll appeared in six games for Los Angeles, averaging 4.2 points and 2.0 rebounds per game
