BUCK SHOTS

- Coming off a 124-117 win over the Clippers on Sunday, the Milwaukee Bucks conclude their four-game road trip on Tuesday against the Sacramento Kings. The Bucks improved to 42-23 this season with Sunday's win and enter the final game of the trip in second place in the Eastern Conference standings. After tonight's game, Milwaukee returns home to host Philadelphia on Thursday.
- The Bucks have won their last 15 games against the Kings – a streak that began on Nov. 5, 2016. The streak extended to 15 wins earlier this season at Fiserv Forum on Jan. 14 thanks to a Damian Lillard game-winning three at the buzzer in overtime that gave Milwaukee a 143-142 win. The win streak is the longest active streak for any team against an opponent in the NBA and is now tied for the Bucks' second-longest win streak against an opponent in franchise history (trailing only their 19 consecutive wins against CLE between Jan. 2, 1979 and Jan. 13, 1983).
- The duo of Damian Lillard (35 pts, 11 asts, 7 rebs) and Giannis Antetokounmpo (34 pts, 10 asts, 7 rebs) led the Bucks in their win over the Clippers on Sunday. Their performance came on the heels of another strong effort the previous game against the Lakers when Lillard scored 28 points with 12 assists and Antetokounmpo had a triple-double with 34 points, 14 rebounds and 12 assists. It's the first time in NBA history that a pair of teammates have scored 20+ points and dished out 10+ assists in consecutive games, with Antetokounmpo and Lillard becoming just the second teammates to have 30+ points and 10+ assists in the same game. In their two games in Los Angeles, Antetokounmpo and Lillard combined to average 65.5 points, 22.5 assists and 16.5 rebounds on 52.8% shooting.
- Malik Beasley knocked down eight threes over his last two games and now has 183 made threes this season, which are the fifth-most in a season in Bucks history. Lillard, with a season-high-tying seven threes on Sunday and 16 total on the road trip so far, now sits right above Beasley in fourth with 184 3FGM. Only Ray Allen in 2001-02 (229) and 2000-01 (202) and Brook Lopez in 2018-19 (187), have made more threes in a season than Beasley and Lillard have this season.

MILWAUKEE BUCKS LAST THREE GAME RECAPS

Bucks at Clippers – Sunday, March 10 – Crypto.com Arena – Los Angeles, CA

W, 124-117 – Damian Lillard and Giannis Antetokounmpo combined for 69 points as the Bucks took down the Clippers 124-117 at Crypto.com Arena in a Sunday matinee. Facing a 59-62 deficit to start the third quarter, Milwaukee scored the first seven points of the frame to take a 66-62 lead. The Clippers scored four straight points to tie it at 66, but Brook Lopez made a three that broke the tie and tipped off a four-minute series that saw eight lead changes and two ties. Antetokounmpo ended the series and put the Bucks on top 81-80 with 4:46 left in the third, and they entered the final frame on top 91-85. Los Angeles opened the frame on a 2-8 run to tie the game at 93 until Malik Beasley made a three to send the Bucks by three points. The Clippers retook a 96-98 lead until Antetokounmpo made back-to-back shots to help the Bucks take a 100-98 lead, their final lead of the game. Lillard scored 16 of his game-high 35 points in the fourth quarter to help secure the victory. Lillard also dished out a team-high 11 assists, while Antetokounmpo finished with 34 points and 10 assists. Beasley made four threes and scored 17 points, and Bobby Poris Jr. scored 11 points and led the Bucks with eight rebounds. The Clippers were led by Norman Powell with 26 points.

Bucks at Lakers – Friday, March 8 – Crypto.com Arena – Los Angeles, CA

L, 122-123 – The Bucks fell 122-123 to the Lakers at Crypto.com Arena on Friday after time expired on their fourth quarter battle. Trailing 90-96 through three quarters, Milwaukee opened the final frame on a 13-7 run to tie the game at 103 with 7:16 remaining. The Lakers pulled back out ahead 105-110, but a Brook Lopez three and Pat Connaughton free throw brought the Bucks within one point. Giannis Antetokounmpo made a pullup shot to put Milwaukee on top 111-110, its first lead since the second quarter, with 2:53 to go in the frame. Los Angeles retook a 111-112 lead with a floater, but Connaughton answered with a three that put the Bucks on top 114-112. Damian Lillard followed with a three and a free throw that gave Milwaukee a 118-112 lead with 1:54 left. Los Angeles went on a 4-9 run that made it a 122-121 game with just 39.4 seconds left and took a 122-123 lead with .59 seconds to go. The Bucks tried to answer, but Lillard's buzzer-beater attempt was blocked as time ran out. Antetokounmpo recorded his eighth triple-double of the season with 34 points, 14 rebounds and 12 assists, while Lillard finished with 28 points and 12 assists. Connaughton, who scored a season-high 17 points, Lillard and Malik Beasley all made four threes in the contest, while Lopez had 3 3FGM and scored 11 points. The Lakers were led by D'Angelo Russell with 44 points.

Bucks at Warriors – Wednesday, March 6 – Chase Center – San Francisco, CA

L, 90-125 – Playing in the first game of their four-game West Coast road trip, the Bucks fell 90-125 to the Warriors at Chase Center on Wednesday. Giannis Antetokounmpo scored the first five points of the game, but Golden State went on a 9-18 run to take a 14-18 lead. The Bucks struggled to extinguish the Warriors' hot shooting and trailed 58-78 through two quarters after the Warriors went 12-19 (.632) from three in the first half. Milwaukee opened the third quarter with a statement 19-5 run that cut it to a 77-83 game with just 5:33 remaining in the frame. The Warriors withstood the threat of the Bucks' comeback and pulled back ahead 81-93 to end the third quarter. Milwaukee's third-quarter momentum faltered in the final frame as it was outscored 9-32 by Golden State. Antetokounmpo led the Bucks with 23 points and seven rebounds, and he and Damian Lillard each dished out a team-high six assists. Lillard, who finished with 20 points, also made five threes to tie Reggie Miller (2,560) for fourth place on the NBA's all-time 3FGM list. Bobby Portis Jr. chipped in 20 points, with 18 of them coming in the first half, and hauled in six boards. The Warriors were led by Stephen Curry with 29 points.

De'Aaron Fox then made one of two free throws on the other end to put the Kings up two, setting up Lillard's game winner on the final possession. Lillard finished the game with a team-high 29 points and was one of four Bucks to score 20 points, along with Giannis Antetokounmpo (27), Malik Beasley (23) and Bobby Portis Jr. (22). DAME TIME IN INDY: It was Dame Time in Indianapolis during NBA All-Star Weekend as Bucks guard Damian Lillard stole the show by winning the 3-point contest on Saturday before being named the MVP of the 73rd NBA All-Star Game on Sunday. In doing so, he joined Michael Jordan as the only players in NBA history to win a Saturday night event and be named MVP of the All-Star Game in the same year. Lillard won his second consecutive 3-point contest by defeating Karl-Anthony Towns and Trae Young in the final round before scoring a team-high 39 points, while knocking down a game-high 11 threes, in the All-Star Game on Sunday to win MVP.



BUCKS REPRESENT AT ALL-STAR WEEKEND: In addition to Lillard, the Bucks were well represented during NBA All-Star Weekend. Giannis Antetokounmpo, who was the league's leading vote getter and team captain for the Eastern Conference All-Stars, made his eighth consecutive All-Star Game start, while the Bucks coaching staff earned the right to coach the East All-Stars. Led by head coach Doc Rivers, it was the fourth time that Milwaukee has had its coaching staff coach the All-Star Game. Bucks guard Malik Beasley also made his NBA All-Star Weekend debut, participating in the 3-point contest alongside Lillard.

As head coach of the Orlando Magic (1999-03), Boston Celtics (2004-13), Los Angeles Clippers (2013-20) and Philadelphia 76ers (2020-23), Rivers racked up 1,097 wins, good for ninth-most in NBA history, and owned an overall record of 1,097-763 (.590). He's led his teams to the playoffs in 19 of his 24 seasons as a head coach, with two trips to the NBA Finals and an NBA Championship with the Celtics in 2008. His 111 playoff wins are the fourth-most in league history.

The 1999-00 NBA Coach of the Year, Rivers was named one of the 15 Greatest Coaches in NBA history in 2022 by a panel of 43 current and former NBA head coaches in collaboration with the National Basketball Coaches Association. Overall, his combined 1,208 regular season and playoff wins as a head coach are the eighth-most in NBA history.

Most recently, Rivers served as head coach of the 76ers for three seasons from 2020-23 where he amassed a 154-82 (.653) regular season record and made the postseason all three years. Including his three trips to the playoffs with the 76ers, Rivers has advanced to the playoffs in 15 of his last 16 seasons as a head coach going back to 2008.

A native of Chicago and product of Proviso East High School in Maywood, Illinois, Rivers played and graduated from Marquette University, and his number 31 jersey hangs in the rafters of Fiserv Forum. After being selected in the Second Round of the 1983 NBA Draft, Rivers went on to play 13 seasons in the NBA between 1983-96 with the Hawks, Clippers, Knicks and Spurs. He appeared in 864 games in his career, including in 81 playoff games, and was an NBA All-Star in 1988.
