• **PLAYOFFS:** On 4/9 at Phoenix, the Clippers defeated the Suns to clinch the fifth seed in the Western Conference postseason. LAC has made the post-season in 10 of their last 12 seasons.

• **CONTINUING TO BUILD:** LA at 585-363 (.617) have the NBA's second-best regular season record since the start of the 2011-12 season. On 4/5 vs. Lakers, the Clippers extended a franchise record of securing a record above .500 to 12 consecutive seasons which is the longest active streak in the NBA and tied for the seventh-longest streak in NBA history.

• **DIME MACHINE:** On 3/28 vs. Chicago, the Clippers had 41 assists in a 124-112 victory. It is tied for the fifth-most assists in a single game in franchise history and is just the 11th time that the Clippers had at least 40 assists in a single game. The last time the Clippers achieved the feat was when they also had 41 assists on 1/22/15 vs. Brooklyn.

• **MOVING UP THE LEADERBOARD:** On 11/7 vs. Cleveland, with his 448th career three-pointer as a Clippers, Paul George surpassed Lou Williams for sole possession of fifth place on the Clippers' all-time three-point field goal list. On 2/28 vs. Minnesota, George made his 1,989th career three-pointer to surpass Jason Kidd for sole possession of 14th place on the NBA's all-time three-point field goal list.

• **OFFENSE EXPLOSION:** On 2/24 vs. Sacramento, the Clippers were involved in the second-highest scoring NBA history in a 175-176 double overtime loss to the Kings. In the contest, LAC set franchise records in points and in three-pointers made (26).

• **ALL-STAR:** Paul George was selected as a Western Conference All-Star for the 2023 NBA All-Star Game in Salt Lake City. This is George's eighth career All-Star selection and second as a member of the Clippers, as the Palmdale, Calif., native is just one of three players in the NBA this season to be averaging at least 23 points, 6.0 rebounds, 5.0 assists and 1.5 steals.

• **IMPROVED OFFENSE:** The Clippers have scored over 100 points in 39 of their last 42 contests. Since January 6, the Clippers are fifth in the NBA in offensive rating (118.2) and tied for second in 3P% (39.2).

• **IMPROBABLE COMEBACK:** On 12/26 at Detroit, the Clippers overcame a 14-point deficit with three minutes remaining to defeat the Pistons. Entering the game, teams were 2-12,873 when trailing by 14+ points with three minutes remaining in the play-by-play era.

• **TRIPLE DOUBLE:** On 12/14 vs. Minnesota, Paul George had 17 points, 11 rebounds and 11 assists. Including the postseason, it was his fifth career triple-double (first since: 2/11/19 vs. Portland). George's triple-double was the 47th triple-double in franchise history and the first since Kawhi Leonard on 1/24/20 at Miami.

• **STORMIN' NORMAN:** On 11/29 at Portland, Norman Powell scored a Clippers' career-high 32 points off the bench in a 118-112 victory. Powell scored 22 of his 32 points in the fourth quarter. Since 1996-97, it was the most points scored in a fourth quarter by a Clipper. This season, Powell ranks first in points per game off the bench (17.6).

• **HISTORIC AFTERNOON:** On 11/27 at Indiana, Ivica Zubac put up 31 points, three blocked shots and a career-high 29 rebounds. Since 1973-74, Zubac joined Kareem Abdul-Jabbar (2/3/78 at New Jersey) and Elvin Hayes (12/2/73 vs. Seattle) as the only players in NBA history to have at least 31 points, 29 rebounds and three blocked shots in a single game. Zubac's 29 rebounds are tied for the fourth-most in franchise history, and are the most since Michael Cage collected 30 rebounds on 4/24/88 vs. Seattle.

• **PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** Paul George was named Player of the Week (10/31-11/6), his 11th career Player of the Week honor. During the week, George averaged 32.3 points, 5.8 rebounds, 5.8 assists and 2.3 steals while shooting 56% from the floor and 44.7% from three. George ranked second in scoring, and was one of two players to shoot at least 44% from three (min. 9.0 3PA) and 56% from the floor.

• **PG-13:** On 10/31 vs. Houston, George became just the eighth player in NBA history to have at least 35 points, nine rebounds, eight assists and six steals in a single game. George joined Ron Harper as the only two players in franchise history to achieve such a stat line.

• **BIG ZU:** Ivica Zubac currently ranks seventh in the NBA in total rebounds (756). Zubac joins DeAndre Jordan as the only two players in franchise history to start the first seven games of a season with at least 80 rebounds and 20 blocked shots.

• **OPENING NIGHT:** On 10/20 at Lakers, the Clippers opened their 2022-23 season with a 103-97 win over the Los Angeles Lakers. It was the Clippers eighth-straight win over the Lakers. Since 2012-13, the Clippers are 33-7 against the Lakers. LAC collected 58 rebounds in the contest, which was tied for the third-most rebounds in franchise history in the opening game of a season.

• **KAWHI:** Kawhi Leonard is the winningest player in NBA regular-season history with a 462-166 (.736) record.

The Clippers returned to Los Angeles for their home opener with a disappointing 95-112 loss to the Phoenix Suns. The game went downhill quickly for the Clippers as the Suns went on an 11-0 run and LAC was never able to recover. LAC never led in this contest, and trailed by as many as 22. The Clippers struggled from beyond the arc as they were 36-for-82 (43.9%) from the floor and 9-for-32 (28.1%) from beyond the arc. LAC only had 16 assists on the night, but did collect 10 steals. Marcus Morris Sr. did his best to keep the Clippers in the game as he scored 22 points on 10-of-14 shooting. Paul George added 16 points, seven rebounds, four assists and two steals. John Wall was effective off the bench with 17 points on 7-of-12 shooting with four assists. Terance Mann was the only other Clipper in double digits, as he contributed 11 points. The Suns were led by Devin Booker who had 35 points on 13-of-21 shooting with four assists. The Clippers will look to flush this game as they head to Oklahoma City to take on the Thunder this Tuesday night.

The Clippers three-game winning streak was snapped with a 95-111 loss to the Phoenix Suns in Los Angeles. LAC was very shorthanded as they were missing Kawhi Leonard, Paul George, Norman Powell, Luke Kennard, Ivica Zubac and Reggie Jackson in this contest. The Clippers struggled to shoot the ball in this game, as they were just 34-for-90 (37.8%) from the floor and 12-for-33 (36.4%) from beyond the arc. LAC also turned the ball over 18 times leading to 21 points for Phoenix. Terance Mann stepped up in this game as he had a season-high 22 points on 8-of-14 shooting with 11 rebounds and four assists. Brandon Boston Jr. had 16 points off the bench with three assists. Marcus Morris Sr. had 14 points and seven rebounds.
