<b>Kai Jones</b>	Acquired in a trade with the New York Knicks in exchange for a 2022 protected first-round pick (8/3/21).
<b>Théo Maledon</b>	Signed as a free agent (10/15/22).
<b>Cody Martin</b>	Selected in the second round (36th overall) of the 2019 NBA Draft.

Charlotte - The wheels fell off Charlotte's offense in the fourth quarter as the Clippers pulled away for a 115-90 victory over the Hornets at Spectrum Center. LaMelo Ball posted game highs with 23 points and 10 assists, but the Hornets mustered just a 32.7 field goal percentage and a 23.5 percent clip from downtown. Reggie Jackson and Brandon Boston Jr. each tallied 19 points to lead the charge for the Clippers, and Marcus Morris added 16 points. The Clippers gained a plus-16 advantage on the glass and shot 52.4 percent from the field, including a 39.3 percent rate from beyond the arc.

Charlotte - Kevin Durant poured in a game-best 27 points on 10-of-20 shooting, including 6-of-6 from the free-throw line, to guide the Nets to a 98-94 victory over the Hornets at Spectrum Center. Durant added eight rebounds and three blocks, and Cam Thomas contributed 21 points off the bench, including 10-of-11 shooting from the free-throw line. Nic Claxton posted 11 points, nine rebounds, three steals and four blocks. Terry Rozier led the charge for the Hornets, notching 25 points and connecting on six 3-pointers. Kelly Oubre Jr. and P.J. Washington Jr. each tallied 18 points. Charlotte struggled from the field, hitting at a 37.2 percent clip (32-of-86).

## THE BUZZ: HORNETS PLAYER NOTES

### LaMelo Ball

- Last season became the third player in NBA history to average 20.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 7.0 assists in his age-20 season, joining LeBron James and Luka Doncic.
- Last year became the fourth-youngest All-Star in NBA history (20 years, 182 days). He recorded 18 points on 7-of-11 shooting, including 4-of-8 from 3-point range, in addition to three rebounds, three assists and three steals in 22 minutes in his All-Star debut. Ball also notched eight points, two rebounds, one assist and two steals in the 2022 Clorox Rising Stars event.
- Ball and Magic Johnson are the only two players in NBA history to average 17.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, 6.0 assists and 1.5 steals over the first 100 games of their career.
- Has recorded six triple-doubles in his young career, the third-most by any player in NBA history prior to his 21st birthday. He notched five triple-doubles in 2021-22, the most in any season by a Hornets player. Ball is the second-youngest player in NBA history to record five career triple-doubles.
- Was one of three players to accumulate 1,500 points, 500 rebounds and 500 assists in the 2021-22 season, joining Luka Doncic and Nikola Jokic. He is the only Hornet ever to reach those thresholds in a season.
- Last year became the youngest player in NBA history to make 200 3-pointers in a season. He is the second-youngest player to reach 300 career 3-pointers made, behind only Anthony Edwards. Among qualified players to attempt at least 7.0 3-pointers per game last season, Ball tied for fifth in accuracy (38.9 percent). He logged 56 games with multiple 3-pointers, tied for eighth-most in the league.
- Ranked in the top 10 last season in assists per game (7.6) and steals per game (1.6), and was one of four players (Tyrese Haliburton, Dejounte Murray, Chris Paul) to finish in the top ten in both categories. Ball recorded 34 multi-steal games last season, tied for sixth-most in the NBA.
- With his 25-point, 16-rebound and 11-assist outing at Los Angeles Lakers (Nov. 8), Ball became the youngest player in NBA history (20 years, 78 days) to post a 25-15-10 game. Was one of five players to notch a 25-15-10 line last season, joining Giannis Antetokounmpo, Kevin Durant, Joel Embiid and Nikola Jokic.
- Led the league with four games in which he made at least four 3-pointers and swiped at least four steals.

### James Bouknight

- Tied career highs with five defensive rebounds, six total rebounds and two steals at Boston (Nov. 28).
- Equaled his personal best with a pair of steals vs. Portland (Nov. 9).
- Matched his career best with six rebounds vs. Washington (Nov. 7).
- Set a career high with five assists at Memphis (Nov. 4), then matched it next game with five assists vs. Brooklyn (Nov. 5); also blocked a career-high two shots and tied a personal best with 29 minutes played vs. Brooklyn.

### Gordon Hayward

- Tied a season high with seven assists and zero turnovers at Cleveland (Nov. 18), his first action since missing eight games with a left shoulder contusion.
- Notched the 4,000th field goal of his career vs. Golden State (Oct. 29).
- Totaled 41 points, the most by a Hornet all 2021-22 season, on 15-of-19 shooting at San Antonio (Dec. 15, 2021), and his 78.9 field goal percentage was the best among all 40-point performances in the league last season. His accuracy set a new franchise record for field goal percentage in a 40-point game.
- Was one of four players last season to score at least 40 points in fewer than 30 minutes, joining Joel Embiid, LeBron James and Trae Young. He played 29 minutes against San Antonio.
- Led the Hornets with a 39.1 percent clip from behind the arc last season.

### Kai Jones

- Matched the career high he set the previous game with nine points at Boston (Nov. 28), in addition to setting new personal bests with four field goals made, 11 field goals attempted, three 3-pointers attempted and four offensive rebounds.
- Recorded career highs with nine points, three field goals made, five field goals attempted, three free throws made, three offensive rebounds, nine defensive rebounds, 12 total rebounds and 28 minutes played in a win vs. Minnesota (Nov. 25).
- Matched a career best with four points in a win vs. Philadelphia (Nov. 23).
- Rejected a career-high three shots at Memphis (Nov. 4).

### Théo Maledon

- Dished four assists in the second quarter in a win vs. Washington (Dec. 2), equaling his personal best for any quarter.
- Recorded 11 points, four rebounds, in addition to setting season highs with eight assists and three steals in his first start of the season at Boston (Nov. 28)... dished five assists in the first half, a season high for any half and the eighth time in his career with at least five dimes in a half.
- Set season highs with five free throws made, six free throws attempted, two offensive rebounds and seven total rebounds in a season-best 26 minutes in a win vs. Minnesota (Nov. 25).
- Tied a season high with a pair of timely steals in the fourth quarter of a win vs. Philadelphia (Nov. 23).
- Delivered 14 points on 4-of-7 shooting, including a pair of 3-pointers, in a win at Orlando (Nov. 14), in addition to three rebounds, three assists and two steals.
- Notched 15 points on 6-of-7 shooting at New York (Oct. 26); his 85.7 FG% was the second-highest of his career (min. 3 FGA).

### Cody Martin

- Led Charlotte and tied for sixth in the league last season with 19 charges drawn, while finishing sixth in charges drawn per game (0.27).
- Martin set career highs last season in points (7.7), rebounds (4.0), assists (2.5), steals (1.2), blocks (0.5), field goal percentage (48.2), 3-point percentage (38.4) and free-throw percentage (70.1).

### Jalen McDaniels

- As of Dec. 5, he is averaging 2.1 assists per game, nearly doubling his previous career best (1.1).
- Scored the 1,000th point of his career with a driving layup in the third quarter vs. Milwaukee (Dec. 3). He finished the game with 21 points, tying the second-most in any game of his career, behind only the career-high 24 points he poured in at Boston (Nov. 28).
- Poured in a career-high 24 points at Boston (Nov. 28), while tying personal bests in field goals made (nine) and 3-pointers made (four).
- Tallied 10 points in the fourth quarter at Miami (Nov. 10), the seventh double-digit scoring quarter of his career. He tied season highs with six made field goals and four assists in the game.
- Tied his personal best for steals in a half with three thefts in the first half vs. Washington (Nov. 7) and also tied a career high with two blocks; nailed the 100th 3-pointer of his career.
- Recorded multiple assists in 13 straight games from Apr. 7 - Nov. 5, by far a career high. His previous best streak was four, which he did twice.
- Set career highs with 18 field goal attempts and five steals at Chicago (Nov. 2); also tied personal bests with three offensive rebounds and two blocks.
- Recorded 12 points and 10 rebounds in a win vs. Golden State (Oct. 29) to notch the fourth double-double of his career.
- Matched his career high with four 3-pointers vs. New Orleans (Oct. 21), doing so without a miss.

### Bryce McGowens

- Dished a career-best six assists at Boston (Nov. 28), in addition to notching his second double-digit scoring performance with 10 points, all of which came in the first half, a career high for any half. Made two 3-pointers, collected two rebounds and played 24 minutes, all of which represent personal bests.
- Poured in 32 points (8-17 FG, 3-8 3P, 8-9 FT), in addition to five rebounds, five assists and two steals in his G League debut against the College Park Skyhawks (Nov. 11).
- Logged a career-high 12 points at Memphis (Nov. 4).
- Scored his first career points with a driving layup in the fourth quarter of a win at Atlanta (Oct. 23).
- The Hornets acquired Bryce McGowens via trade with the Minnesota Timberwolves after Minnesota selected McGowens with the 40th overall pick. McGowens appeared in 31 games (31 starts) at Nebraska in his lone college season, averaging a team-high 16.8 points (40.3 FG%, 27.4 3P%, 83.1 FT%), 5.2 rebounds and 1.4 assists in 33.3 minutes per game.

## THE BUZZ: HORNETS PLAYER NOTES

### Kelly Oubre Jr.

- As of Dec. 5, he is one of seven players to average 19.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 1.5 steals this season, joining O.G. Anunoby, Jimmy Butler, Luka Doncic, Anthony Edwards, Paul George and Dejounte Murray. Oubre is averaging 19.8 points, 5.2 rebounds and 1.7 steals per game.
- Recorded 11 free throws made, a season high, on 12 attempts, also a season best, vs. Milwaukee (Dec. 3).
- Poured in a season-high 34 points, the most by a Hornet this season, on 12-of-21 shooting, including 5-of-9 from beyond the arc and 5-of-5 from the free-throw line, at Cleveland (Nov. 18).
- Collected a career-high seven offensive rebounds vs. Indiana (Nov. 16), and his 13 total rebounds represented a season best.
- Swiped a career-best six steals in a win at Orlando (Nov. 14), leading Charlotte to a season-high 15 steals as a team.
- Delivered 15 points on 6-of-7 shooting in the first half at Miami (Nov. 12), the sixth time in his career he's scored at least 15 points on 85.0 percent shooting or better in a half.
- Tallied the 500th assist of his career at Miami (Nov. 10).
- Splashed five 3-pointers in the first half at Miami (Nov. 10), becoming the first Hornet to make five 3s in a half since LaMelo Ball (4/8/22 at Chicago). It was the seventh time Oubre accomplished the feat in his career, six of which have come as a Hornet. For the game, Oubre connected on seven 3s, equaling the most by a Hornet since Oubre nailed 10 at Indiana (1/26/22). He finished with 29 points, a season high.
- Recorded 10 points and four rebounds in the opening frame at Miami (Nov. 10), both of which tied his season highs for any quarter.
- Snared a season-high four offensive rebounds vs. Portland (Nov. 9).
- Notched 24 points and 10 rebounds in a win at Atlanta (Oct. 23), the 12th 20-10 game of his career.
- In the opening frame of the season at San Antonio (Oct. 19), Oubre swiped three steals to tie his career-high for steals in a quarter, which he has done seven times.
- Tied the Hornets record with 10 3-pointers made at Indiana (Jan. 26, 2022) en route to 39 points, which set a new franchise high for points scored off the bench. It was Oubre's second game scoring 35-plus points off the bench, the most in the NBA last season. He also became the fourth player in NBA history to record double-digit 3-pointers in a game as a reserve.
- Shattered the Hornets franchise record and became the fifth player in NBA history to make eight 3-pointers in a quarter with his eruption in the final period vs. Detroit (Jan. 5, 2022). Oubre's 24 points in the fourth quarter tied a franchise record.
- Tallied three 30-point games off the bench last season, establishing a new Hornets record. In 63 games off the bench last year, Oubre averaged 14.7 points per game, good for third among reserves leaguewide. He nailed a Hornets-record 156 3-pointers off the bench last season, besting Dell Curry's previous franchise mark.

### Mason Plumlee

- As of Dec. 5, he is one of five players in the NBA to average at least 9.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 4.0 assists, joining Giannis Antetokounmpo, Joel Embiid, Nikola Jokic and Domantas Sabonis. Plumlee is averaging 9.4 points, 9.0 rebounds and 4.1 assists.
- Collected 13 points and 11 rebounds vs. Milwaukee to record his ninth double-double of the season, a team high.
- Tallied 14 points in the first half of a win vs. Washington (Dec. 2), tied for the fourth-most in any half of his career...posted 17 points, one off his season high, and 10 boards for his eighth double-double of the year.
- Became the 13th player this season to record five offensive rebounds, five defensive rebounds and five assists in a game with his six offensive rebounds, six defensive rebounds and five assists in a win vs. Minnesota (Nov. 25).
- Notched 11 points and 13 rebounds, in addition to six assists, for his seventh double-double of the season in a win vs. Philadelphia (Nov. 23).
- Recorded 12 points and 10 rebounds vs. Indiana (Nov. 16) to notch his fourth double-double in his last five games.
- Set season highs with 18 points and three steals in a win at Orlando (Nov. 14), in addition to collecting 11 rebounds to notch his third double-double of the season.
- Notched 13 points on 4-of-4 shooting, 15 rebounds and five assists at Miami (Nov. 10) to become the third player in NBA history with multiple games of 10-15-5 on 100 percent shooting in their career, joining Wilt Chamberlain and Wes Unseld. Plumlee previously recorded 13 points on 4-of-4 shooting, 16 rebounds and seven assists at Dallas (4/21/21). Only six players in NBA history (Plumlee, Chamberlain, Unseld, Tom Boerwinkle, Happy Hairston and Swen Nater) have accomplished the feat in a single game. It also marked Plumlee's fourth double-double of the season, all of which have come in the last seven games, and his sixth double-digit rebounding outing in his last seven appearances.
- Recorded season bests with 16 points, seven field goals made and 10 field goals attempted vs. Portland (Nov. 9); also grabbed 12 rebounds, notching his third double-double of the season.
- Snared a season-high seven offensive rebounds vs. Washington (Nov. 7); grabbed 10 rebounds in the game for his fourth double-digit effort on the glass in a five-game span.
- Recorded five assists in the opening frame vs. Golden State (Oct. 29), the fourth time in his career he's dished at least five dimes in a quarter.
- Was the only player in the league last season to shoot 60.0 percent or better from the field while averaging at least 3.0 assists per game.
- Shot 100 percent from the field in 15 games last season, third-most in the NBA (min. two FGA).
- Led the Hornets in rebounds (7.7), offensive rebounds (2.4) and field goal percentage (64.1) last season.

### Nick Richards

- Became the third Hornets player ever with three consecutive double-doubles off the bench with his 13-point, 13-rebound performance in a win vs. Philadelphia (Nov. 23)... he also tied his career high with eight defensive rebounds in the game.
- Delivered the fourth double-double of his career, all of which have come this season, with 11 points and 10 rebounds at Washington (Nov. 20).
- Collected career highs with eight defensive rebounds and 14 total rebounds at Cleveland (Nov. 18), and tallied 13 points for his third career double-double, all of which have come this year.
- For the second time in three games, Richards set new career highs with 20 points, 11 rebounds and nine made field goals (on 100 percent shooting) in a win at Atlanta (Oct. 23). It marked the second double-double of his career, both coming in the first three games this season. His nine made field goals without a miss tie for the third-most in franchise history. Richards also set career highs in a quarter with 11 points, four made field goals and a 100 percent shooting clip (min. 4 FGA) in the third period at Atlanta.
- In the Hornets' 129-102 victory over San Antonio (Oct. 19), Richards set career highs in points (19), total rebounds (10), offensive rebounds (eight), field goals made (seven) and free throws made (five). The third-year big man also set personal bests for points in a half (12), total rebounds in a half (six) and offensive rebounds in a half (five) in the opening 24 minutes against the Spurs. His eight offensive rebounds are the most ever by a Hornet in a season opener, and he is one of six Hornets ever to snare eight offensive rebounds off the bench.

### Terry Rozier

- Notched a game-high 26 points vs. Milwaukee (Dec. 3), marking his fourth straight game with at least 20 points.
- Delivered 12 points on 4-of-5 shooting and 4-of-4 from the free-throw line in the first quarter of a win vs. Washington (Dec. 2), equaling the most points scored by a Hornet in any quarter this season. He finished the game with 25 points, five rebounds and eight assists, his second 25-5-5 game of the season. He notched five dimes in the second quarter, a season high.
- Connected on a 3-pointer in 45 straight games from Jan. 25, 2022 to Nov. 18, 2022, the second-longest streak in franchise history (Baron Davis, 46 games, April 2001-Jan. 2002) and a career best for Rozier.
- Tallied a season-best 28 points at Cleveland (Nov. 18), including a game-tying 3-pointer with 1.1 seconds remaining to force overtime... it marked Rozier's third career field goal to tie or take the lead with less than five seconds remaining in the fourth quarter... set career highs with 32 field goal attempts and 49 minutes played in the game.
- Scored a season-high 25 points vs. Brooklyn (Nov. 5), and his six 3-pointers made were the most by any Hornet this season. It marked his 100th 20-point performance as a Hornet.
- Matched his career highs with 11 assists and four offensive rebounds vs. New Orleans (Oct. 21).
- Entered the 2022-23 season ranked fourth on the Hornets' all-time 3-pointers list with 616.
- Led the league with 92 3-pointers made from the corner last season, connecting at a 41.3 percent clip. Rozier was especially lethal from the left corner, where he poured in a league-best 64 triples.
- Is one of four players to record 200-plus 3-pointers made in each of the last two seasons, alongside Stephen Curry, Buddy Hield and Duncan Robinson.
- Ranked seventh league-wide with 155 catch-and-shoot 3-pointers made last season, draining 38.9 percent of his spot-up tries. He ranked fifth in 2020-21 with 162 catch-and-shoot triples.
- Totaled 30 games with at least four 3-pointers last season, tied for eighth-most in the league.
- In addition to his shooting prowess, Rozier was one of four players to record more than 300 assists and fewer than 100 turnovers last season, joining Tyus Jones, Tyrese Maxey and Monte Morris.

### **Dennis Smith Jr.**

- Notched the 1,000th assist of his career at Washington (Nov. 20).
- Tallied nine points in the opening frame vs. Portland (Nov. 9) to match his season high for points in a quarter and did so on 4-of-4 shooting; swiped four steals in the contest, his second-most in a game this season.
- Notched 10 assists vs. Washington (Nov. 7) for his second double-digit assist outing of the season; also matched a career high with three blocks in the game.
- Became the third player this season (Jimmy Butler, Dejounte Murray) to record a 15-point, 5-rebound, 5-assist and 5-steal performance with his 15-7-8-6 line vs. Sacramento (Oct. 31). Smith Jr.'s six steals tied for the second-most in his career and were one shy of equaling his personal best (seven at Houston, Feb. 24, 2020).
- Recorded 14 points and 11 assists at New York (Oct. 26), the 10th double-double of his career and first this season. It marked the 11th time in Smith's career he has dished double-digit assists in a game.

### **JT Thor**

- Dropped 30 points against the Westchester Knicks (Nov. 28) in his first G League action of this season.
- Poured in a career-high 11 points at Memphis (Nov. 4).
- Set personal bests with five defensive rebounds and six total rebounds in a win at Atlanta (Oct. 23).

### **P.J. Washington Jr.**

- Recorded two steals and two blocks in the first quarter vs. Milwaukee (Dec. 3), the third time in his career with multiple steals and multiple blocks in a quarter. He swatted three shots in the first half, marking the seventh time in his career with three rejections in a half. Washington finished with three steals and three blocks, the second time in his career reaching those thresholds. He also dished five assists in the game, matching the season high he set the previous game vs. Washington (Dec. 2).
- Set a season high with five 3-pointers made in a win vs. Washington (Dec. 2) and tied a career-high with 11 3-point attempts, in addition to dishing a season-best five assists.
- Scored 28 points and hauled in a season-best 10 rebounds for his first double-double of the season, in addition to swiping a career-high-tying four steals at Cleveland (Nov. 18).
- Tied a season high with four 3-pointers on a season-best nine attempts vs. Indiana (Nov. 16); also made a season-high six free throws on a season-high-tying seven attempts.
- Tied his season highs with four assists, four offensive rebounds and seven total rebounds vs. Portland (Nov. 9).
- Tallied a game-high 25 points vs. Washington (Nov. 7), his third 25-point outing of the season. He scored 12 points in the fourth quarter, tying the most by a Hornet in any quarter this season. He recorded 21 points in the second half, the most by a Hornet in any half this season and tied for the second-most in any half of his career. He also set a season high with three steals in the game.
- Poured in 31 points in an overtime win vs. Golden State (Oct. 29), the second-most he's scored in a game in his career. Washington Jr.'s 13 made field goals represent the second-most he's made in a game. It was the fourth time in Washington Jr.'s career he's made double-digit field goals in a game. In his next outing vs. Sacramento (Oct. 31), Washington Jr. delivered 28 points on 12-of-21 shooting. It marked the first time in his career he logged back-to-back 25-point games, and the 59 points were the most in any two-game span of his career.

### **Mark Williams**

- Poured in 37 points on 16-of-23 shooting and 11 rebounds against the Westchester Knicks on Nov. 29.
- Made a game-winning putback layup against the College Park Skyhawks on Nov. 11, and drilled a game-tying 3-pointer at the buzzer to force overtime the next night vs. College Park.
- In his first G League assignment with the Greensboro Swarm, Williams appeared in two games, notching two double-doubles and averaging 21.0 points, 15.5 rebounds and 2.0 blocks.
- Scored the first points of his career with a pair of free throws in a win at San Antonio on opening night (Oct. 19).
- The Hornets selected Mark Williams with the 15th overall pick in the 2022 NBA Draft. Williams appeared in 62 games (54 starts) in two seasons at Duke, averaging 9.7 points (70.4 FG%, 66.1 FT%), 6.3 rebounds and 2.3 blocks in 20.5 minutes per game for his career.

### **Multiple Players**

- Terry Rozier (3.0 3PM/G), LaMelo Ball (2.9) and Kelly Oubre Jr. (2.5) became the first trio in Hornets history to average at least 2.5 3-pointers made per game in a season.
- Ball and Oubre were two of 11 players leaguewide to record multiple games with at least four 3-pointers made and four steals. Oubre achieved the feat twice while Ball led the league with four instances.
- Rozier (222 3PM) and Ball (220) became the first pair of teammates in Hornets history to each make at least 200 3-pointers in the same season, and they were the only duo in the league to do so last season. Rozier's output in 2021-22 matched his 2020-21 3-point total to tie for fifth-most in team history, while Ball's season ranks seventh-best in Hornets lore. Rozier and Ball ranked 12th and 13th, respectively, in the league in 3-pointers made last season.



# THE BUZZ: HORNETS TEAM NOTES

## Fundamentals

- The Hornets knocked in 88.5 percent (23-of-26) of their free throws vs. Milwaukee (Dec. 3), their best clip of the season. Charlotte also forced the Bucks to commit 22 turnovers, tied for the most by a Hornets foe this season.

## Offensive Clinic

- The Hornets poured in 74 points in the first half in a win vs. Washington (Dec. 2), their most in any half this season. Charlotte's 27 field goals made equaled a season best. The Hornets tallied 107 points through three quarters, their most this year. Three Hornets (Terry Rozier, 25; Kelly Oubre Jr., 22; P.J. Washington Jr., 21) scored 20-plus points, the second such occasion this year.
- The Hornets set a season best in the first half by committing just three turnovers, and then they topped that with just one turnover in the second half. The Hornets committed four turnovers and allowed seven points off turnovers for the game, both of which are season bests. Charlotte dished 12 assists in the second quarter, matching its most in any quarter this season.
- The Hornets tied season highs with 10 made free throws and 13 free throws attempted in the second quarter, and they tied a season best with 25 free throws made in the game.

## Owning the Boards

- The Hornets snared nine offensive rebounds in the first quarter of a win vs. Washington (Dec. 2) and grabbed 13 offensive boards in the first half, both of which represent season highs for a quarter and half. Charlotte limited Washington to five rebounds in the first quarter, the fewest by a Hornets opponent in any quarter this season.

## Turning the Tide

- The Hornets outscored the Timberwolves, 39-21, in the third quarter on Nov. 25, turning a 10-point halftime deficit into an eight-point advantage heading into the fourth quarter. The Hornets won the game, and the 18-point differential in the third quarter marked Charlotte's best in any quarter this season. The Hornets also set season highs in free throw attempts (32) and rebounds (55) in the game.

## Paint Beasts

- The Hornets delivered a season-high 72 points in the paint in their win vs. Philadelphia (Nov. 23), including season highs with 40 points in the paint in the first half and 24 in the fourth quarter. It was enough to offset the Hornets' struggles from long range, as Charlotte's six 3-pointers made were the team's fewest in a win since 2019. It marked the Hornet's first win this season when trailing at halftime, having lost their previous 10 instances.

## Causing Havoc

- The Hornets forced 20 turnovers at Cleveland (Nov. 18) and converted those into 35 points, a season high. The Hornets also tied a season high with 14 3-pointers made, the fourth time they've connected on 14 triples in a game.

## I'll Take That

- The Hornets swiped a season-high 15 steals in a win at Orlando (Nov. 14), led by Kelly Oubre Jr.'s career-high six thefts.

## Continuing to Crash the Glass

- For the second-straight game, the Hornets set a new season high for offensive rebounds in a game, grabbing 20 vs. Portland (Nov. 9) after snaring 17 vs. Washington (Nov. 7). The Hornets hauled in 11 offensive rebounds in the first half against the Blazers, equaling their most in any half, and seven in the second quarter, their most in any quarter this season.

## Patrolling the Paint

- The Hornets set season highs for points in the paint in a quarter, half and game vs. Washington (Nov. 7). Charlotte notched 22 points in the paint in the first quarter, 36 points in the first half and 70 points for the game. The Hornets also grabbed 17 offensive rebounds in the game, a season best, including six offensive boards in the third quarter, matching the most they've collected in any quarter this season.

## Locking Down

- The Hornets turned in their best defensive performance of the season vs. Brooklyn (Nov. 5), limiting the Nets to 98 points, 33 field goals made, 84 field goals attempted, 39.3 percent shooting and 30 points in the paint, all of which marked season bests for Charlotte. The Hornets limited the Nets to 17 points in the third quarter, their best defensive quarter of the season. Charlotte also held the Nets to 41 total rebounds in the game, the fewest by a Hornets opponent this season.

## Strong Start

- The Hornets notched season highs in field goal percentage (60.5), 3-point percentage (53.3) and assists (22) in the first half vs. Sacramento. For the game, Charlotte recorded season bests with 11 steals, 14 3-pointers made and a 48.3 percent clip from downtown.

## Move the Rock

- The Hornets recorded a season-high 12 assists on 13 made field goals in the opening stanza vs. Golden State (Oct. 29). Mason Plumlee led all players with five assists.

## Pouring It On

- The Hornets kept up their strong offensive start to the season by scoring 45 points in the third quarter at Atlanta (Oct. 23), tied for the sixth-most in any quarter in franchise history. The eruption brought Charlotte's total to 104, the 13th-most points scored through three quarters in franchise history.

## Historic Opener

- The Hornets set franchise records in their 129-102 win at San Antonio (Oct. 19) for most points in the first quarter of a season opener (38), most points in the first half of a season opener (68) and the largest margin of victory in a season opener (27). Charlotte's 129 points were one shy of equaling the franchise record for points in a season opener (130 in 1990).
- Six Hornets shot 50 percent or better from the field against San Antonio (Oct. 19), tying for the second-most in a game in franchise history (min. nine field goal attempts). This has been done five times, and the record is seven, set in 1992.

## G-League Roundup

- The Greensboro Swarm (4-8) defeated the Maine Celtics, 123-120, on Dec. 2 behind 31 points (11-20 FG, 5-10 3P) and eight assists from Jalen Crutcher. Kobi Simmons delivered 28 points on 10-of-18 shooting, including 4-of-11 from 3-point range, and Ashton Hagans notched a double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds. The Swarm return to action on Dec. 5 at Raptors 905.
- Three current Hornets (James Bouknight, Kai Jones and JT Thor) gained experience playing for the Swarm last season. The Swarm finished 9-24 (.273) in the regular season and 3-9 (.250) in the Showcase Cup.
- Bouknight appeared in 12 games (12 starts) with the Swarm, averaging 23.0 points (45.4 FG%, 30.0 3P%, 84.1 FT%), 6.3 rebounds, 4.6 assists and 1.8 steals in 34.0 minutes per game.
- Jones suited up for 32 games (31 starts) with Greensboro, averaging 16.5 points (62.2 FG%, 32.9 3P%, 59.5 FT%), 9.7 rebounds, 1.1 assists, 1.3 steals and 2.0 blocks in 30.3 minutes per game.
- Thor appeared in 16 games (15 starts) for the Swarm, averaging 12.5 points (48.8 FG%, 31.3 3P%, 71.4 FT%), 5.8 rebounds and 1.3 assists in 27.2 minutes per game.

## Nine Blocks for Nuggets

- All fans in attendance at home games in which the Hornets record at least nine blocked shots are eligible to receive free nuggets via the Chick-fil-A app.

## THE BUZZ: HORNETS TEAM NOTES

### Raising the Standard

- The 2021-22 Hornets established new franchise records in points (9,457), 3-pointers made (1,143), 3-pointers attempted (3,130), 2-point percentage (.542) and points in a game (158 at Indiana, Jan. 26). Charlotte's 1,143 triples represent the ninth-most in a season in NBA history.
- With an 87-point outburst in the second half of a win at Indiana (Jan. 26), the Hornets set a franchise record for points in a half. It was the most points scored in a second half by any team since the Houston Rockets scored 94 in 1991. For the night, the Hornets scored 158 points, a new franchise high.
- The 21-22 Hornets notched the top four single-game scoring performances in franchise history (158 at Indiana, Jan. 26; 143 at Houston, Nov. 27; 142 at New Orleans, March 11; 141 at Detroit, Feb. 11).
- Charlotte tied for the league lead with 32 games scoring at least 120 points, and they led the NBA with five 140-point outbursts.
- Charlotte poured in 20-plus 3-pointers in nine games last season, most in the NBA.
- The Hornets were the only team last season with three qualified players to average at least 19.0 points per game.

### Share the Sugar

- The Hornets ranked first in the NBA last season with 28.1 assists per game and 2,302 total assists, and they tied for the most assists in a single game with 41 at New Orleans (March 11).
- Charlotte led the league with 73.0 assist points created per game.
- Charlotte tied for the second-highest assist-to-turnover ratio last season (2.12).

### Pushing in Transition

- Charlotte ranked second in the league last season with 24.5 points per game in transition, and its 100.52 pace tied for fourth-fastest.
- The Hornets tied for fifth in steals per game (8.6) and forced their opponents to commit 15.0 turnovers per game, tied for the fourth-most in the league, which allowed them to finish third with 18.6 points off turnovers per game.
- Charlotte was fourth in deflections per game (16.0) and tied for third in loose balls recovered (6.2).

### Inside-Out Attack

- Charlotte employed a balanced approach en route to recording 115.3 points per game, the fourth-most in the NBA. The Hornets poured in 13.9 3-pointers per game (fifth) and connected at a 36.5 percent clip (sixth), while also tallying the second-most drives per game (54.3) and converting the fourth-most drive points per game (28.6).

### Modern Offense

- The Hornets last season ranked third in paint points per game (51.4), fifth in 3-pointers made per game (13.9) and 26th in percentage of points scored in the midrange (5.4 percent).
- The Hornets posted 0.95 points per possession in isolation situations, fifth-best in the league, and 1.06 points per possession in spot-up situations, tied for fifth in the league.

### Swarm on the Road

- The Hornets finished 21-20 (.512) away from Spectrum Center last season, marking the first time since 2001-02 the team has been above .500 on the road in a season.

## COACHING HIGHLIGHTS

- Hired as head coach of the Charlotte Hornets on June 24, 2022. Clifford enters his second stint with the Hornets, having previously served as head coach from 2013-2018, leading the franchise to two playoff appearances and accruing a 196-214 (.478) record. He was named Eastern Conference Coach of the Month three times (April 2014, March 2016, March 2019).
- Clifford's 203 victories as Charlotte's head coach rank second in franchise history, behind Allan Bristow (207). He is the longest-tenured coach in franchise history.
- Clifford served as head coach of the Orlando Magic for three seasons (2018-21), guiding the team to two playoff berths and compiling a 96-131 (.423) record. In his five seasons as an assistant in Orlando, Clifford helped the Magic reach the playoffs in all five seasons, including an appearance in the 2009 NBA Finals.
- Prior to his head coaching stints, Clifford was an assistant coach for 13 seasons in the NBA with the New York Knicks (2000-03), Houston Rockets (2003-07), Orlando Magic (2007-12) and Los Angeles Lakers (2012-13).
- Clifford began his coaching career in the high school and college ranks, with his stops including Woodland High School (Maine), Saint Anselm College (D-II), Fairfield, Boston University, Siena, Adelphi (D-II) and East Carolina. In all, Clifford holds 39 years of coaching experience.
- Clifford guided the Charlotte Bobcats to the playoffs in his first season at the helm (2013-14), transforming the team into a top-five defense and securing the franchise's first winning season since 2009-10.
- In 2015-16, Clifford's Hornets finished 48-34, the team's highest win total since 1999-00 (49).
