GOBERT'S HISTORICAL SEASON

Rudy Gobert is currently averaging 15.6 points on 71.3 percent from the field, while grabbing 15.2 rebounds. He's on pace to become the only player in NBA history to average 15 point and 15 boards while also shooting better than 70 percent from the field.

DECEMBER DON

Utah Jazz guard Donovan Mitchell was named the Western Conference Player of the Month for games played during December. It marked Mitchell's first career player of the month honor and he became the first Jazz player to earn the accolade since Deron Williams in November 2010.

Mitchell posted averages of 30.2 points on 50.2 percent from the field, adding 5.0 assists, 3.2 rebounds and 1.2 steals per contest during the month, with Utah posting an NBA-best 12-2 (.857) record in December. He was one of only four NBA players to average at least 30 points, five assists and three rebounds during the month and one of only two players to average 30-or-more points on better than 50 percent shooting.

FLAME ON

2020-21 Sixth Man of the Year, Jordan Clarkson, continues his bench productivity this season, averaging 15.3 points per contest as a reserve. Clarkson has hit 107 threes, the second-most in the NBA this season.

GOING STREAKING

The Jazz won season-best eight-straight games from 11/27 – 12/15 and during that stretch they owned averages of 125.4 points per game on 52.1 percent from the field and 44.0 percent from beyond the arc, holding opponents to 106.4 points per contest, while hitting 19.3 threes per game. The team posted an offensive rating of 127.4 (18.9 net rating) and a defensive rebound percentage of 73.6 percent during the stretch.

THREES IN THREE

The Utah Jazz knocked down 20+ threes in three straight games, becoming the first team in NBA history to accomplish this feat. Utah posted a season-high 27 threes vs. BOS on 12/3, followed up by 20 @ CLE on 12/5 and 25 @ MIN on 12/8.

30-POINT DON

Utah Jazz guard Donovan Mitchell tallied 30+ points in four consecutive games (11/29 – 12/8), which tied for the second longest streak this season (Trae Young 5) and tied the longest streak in his career.

DON POTW

Donovan Mitchell was named the Western Conference Player of the Week for games played from Monday, Nov. 29, through Sunday, Dec. 5. It marked Mitchell's third Player of the Week accolade, having also earned the honor twice in 2018-19. Mitchell averaged 33.0 points on 57.1 percent shooting, 43.3 percent from downtown, along with 5.7 assists and 1.7 steals during the week, helping the Jazz to a 3-0 record.

A DELIGHTFUL DEBUT

In his Jazz debut and in his 16th NBA season debut Rudy Gay posted 20 points (7-of-8 FG & 5-of-6 3FG), five rebounds and two assists after missing 14 games to start the year with right heel injury recovery. It marked only the 20th time in NBA history that a player in their 16th season or later has posted 20-plus points in their first game of the season. It also tied a career-high for Gay for single-game three-point field goals. Additionally, Gay currently ranks 13th among active players in points scored with 17,141.

GOBERT NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Utah Jazz center Rudy Gobert was named the Western Conference Player of the Week for games played from 10/25-31. It marked Gobert's second Player of the Week accolade, last earning the honor in 2018-19 for games played from 3/11-17. He owned averages of 16.3 points on 77.8 percent from the field, 15.5 rebounds, 2.3 blocks and 1.0 assists in 31.1 minutes per game during the week, helping Utah to a 3-1 record. The two-time NBA All-Star totaled 98 points, 103 rebounds and 10 blocks in the first six games of the 2021-22 season which is only the third time a player has owned totals of at least 90 points, 100 rebounds and 10 blocks since 2001-02 through their first six games of a season (Andre Drummond, 2015-16 and 2019-20).

REBOUNding RUDY

Jazz C Rudy Gobert recorded at least 13 rebounds in his first eight games played this season. The last player to open a season with eight such games in a row was Shaquille O'Neal in 1992-93 and prior to that was Moses Malone in 1983-84.

In his first five games of the season, he scored at least 14 points and grabbed at least 14 rebounds, the only player over the last 40 years to do that was Charles Barkley in 1998-99.

On opening night, Gobert grabbed 21 rebounds vs. OKC, setting a franchise record for most rebounds in the team's first game of the season, then following up with 20 boards at Sacramento on 10/22 and 11/2. He now has 21 career games with 20-or-more rebounds, which passed Truck Robinson for the most in Utah Jazz history. His six games with 20-plus rebounds is first in the NBA this season.

2021-22 COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHTS:

The Utah Jazz are extending the Utah Jazz Scholars Program for an additional season to provide college scholarships to students from underrepresented groups. The program provides one scholarship for every Jazz win in the preseason, regular season, and playoffs during the 2021-22 campaign. The program is specially designated for students from underrepresented groups who have demonstrated financial need, with preference given to first-generation college students. In addition to the financial investment, each student will be offered guidance and assistance in the form of mentorships, job shadowing, and internship and job placement support – a collaborative effort between the Utah Jazz and the broader Utah business community. The Utah Jazz have partnered with 10,000 Degrees, a leading non-profit which focuses on college access and success programs, scholarships and support, to select scholarship recipients and administer the scholarships.

Utah Jazz C **Rudy Gobert**, Rudy’s Kids Foundation and Smith’s Food teamed up with Salt Lake Education Foundation to open a food pantry at Northwest Middle School where approximately 86% of the student body are living below the poverty line. The pantry will provide students and their families with access to emergency food and the ability to learn about other community resources.

Udo and the Utah Jazz have a new program to honor local healthcare professionals with home game recognitions and away game trips with the Utah Jazz this season. A total of seven healthcare workers will be selected from public nominations this season. Each individual will be honored at a Utah Jazz home game and also receive a trip for two people to an away Jazz game with airfare, hotel, tickets, and a gift card. Recipients are honored for overcoming the unprecedented impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and other health challenges through resiliency and strength to provide support and care for their patients and colleagues.



The Utah Jazz celebrate the fifth anniversary of its transformative 5 For The Fight jersey patch donated by Qualtrics in support of cancer research this season as the first-ever cause-related sponsorship in the history of North American professional sports and is the only cause-related jersey patch in the NBA. To date, 5 For The Fight has raised nearly \$30 million to help eradicate cancer and helped to hire 25 cancer research fellows in the United States and Europe. All funds raised are used to accelerate the pace of innovative cancer research by supporting revolutionary cancer researchers and cutting-edge medical centers around the world, including the Huntsman Cancer Institute in Salt Lake City.

Instructure, the Salt Lake City-based makers of the Canvas Learning Management System, and the Utah Jazz are recognizing local educators at Jazz games throughout the season. Through the Most Valuable Educators program, Instructure will recognize 21 educators during 21 home games throughout the 2021-22 Jazz regular season. Each honored educator will be guests of Instructure at the game and receive a personalized Jazz jersey. In addition, they will receive a \$1,000 classroom grant courtesy of Instructure and a surprise classroom visit or organized assembly involving the Jazz Bear mascot, and personnel from the Utah Jazz and Instructure.

JAZZ BUSINESS HIGHLIGHTS

✔ Salt Lake City has been selected to host NBA All-Star 2023... The 72nd NBA All-Star Game will take place at Vivint Arena, home of the Jazz, on Sunday, Feb. 19, 2023... It will mark the 30th anniversary of the 1993 NBA All-Star Game played in Salt Lake, where Jazz players Karl Malone and John Stockton became the first teammates to share the All-Star MVP award.

✔ The Jazz celebrated their 160th consecutive sellout (including playoffs) on Dec. 3, 2021 vs. Boston. The team sold out every game in a single season in 2018-19 for the fifth time ever and first time since 1992-93, and has capped season ticket sales at 13,000 for two consecutive years. It marks the second-longest sellout streak in franchise history.

QUIN SNYDER



Quin Snyder is currently in his eighth season as head coach of the Utah Jazz, guiding Utah to a **352-245 (.590)** record. He has helped the team to five-straight playoff appearances, advancing to the Western Conference Semifinals in three of those showings. In 2017-18, Snyder was named the runner-up in NBA Coach of the Year voting. He possesses a diverse coaching background that spans more than two decades in the NBA, Europe, the NBA G League and college, including 10 years of experience as a head coach.

From 2007-10, Snyder served as the first head coach of the San Antonio Spurs-owned/operated Austin Toros of the G League. During this time, he recorded a 94-56 (.627) mark, while leading the club to playoff appearances in all three seasons. As coach of the Toros, Snyder worked closely with the Spurs coaching staff and front office. During his three-year tenure in Austin, he compiled more wins and guided more players to the NBA than any other coach in the G League during this time frame. Snyder was also named the 2008-09 NBA G League Coach of the Year.

His first head coaching position came at the University of Missouri where he was named Rookie Coach of the Year by the Basketball Times after his inaugural season. He led the Tigers to four NCAA Tournaments, including an Elite Eight appearance in 2002.

Snyder has worked with some of the best minds in basketball, beginning at Duke University where he was the associate head coach under Mike Krzyzewski. Following his time in Austin he also made stops as an NBA assistant with the Philadelphia 76ers, Los Angeles Lakers and CSKA Moscow, helping the team to a 2012-13 Russian League Championship. He then returned to the NBA as an assistant coach in Atlanta before joining the Jazz.

Born in Mercer Island, Wash., Snyder was a two-time Washington player of the year and a McDonald's All-American. He played collegiately at Duke (1985-89), reaching three Final Fours. He was elected as a team captain and honored as an Academic All-American. Snyder earned undergraduate degrees in both philosophy and political science from Duke, later earning a Juris Doctor and M.B.A. from Duke as well. Snyder resides in Salt Lake City with his wife Amy and their children Anika, Madeleine, Wyatt and Tristan.

Snyder competed collegiately at Duke University (1985-89), averaging 6.2 points, 4.2 assists, 1.9 rebounds and 1.4 steals per game in 136 games. Snyder led the Blue Devils to three Final Fours (1986, 1988, and 1989) and won two ACC Championships (1986, 1988). Academically, Snyder was named to the ACC Honor Roll three times. Snyder attended training camp with the Indiana Pacers after finishing his career at Duke but went on to pursue other coaching endeavors.

A native of Mercer Island, Wash., Snyder earned undergraduate degrees in both philosophy and political science at Duke and later earned a Juris Doctor and M.B.A from there as well.
