# KINGS 2020-21 SEASON NOTES

## NO FOX GIVEN

**DE'AARON FOX NAMED WESTERN CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** Sacramento Kings guard De'Aaron Fox has been named the Western Conference Player of the Week after leading the Kings to a 4-0 record for games played between February 1 and February 7, the NBA announced today. Fox amassed averages of 31.0 points (.547 FG%, .379 3pt%, .760 FT%), 2.8 rebounds, 8.8 assists, 0.8 steals and 37.6 minutes per game in the 4 games (all starts) during the first week of February. The four-year guard registered two of his four double-doubles this season during the week, highlighted by a 38-point and 12 assists outing in a win at New Orleans on Feb. 1 as well as scoring 26 points and 11 assists in a home victory vs. Boston on Feb. 3.

This recognition marks the first time Fox has earned the honor of Western Conference Player of the Week and he is the first Kings player to receive the award since DeMarcus Cousins on Jan. 30, 2017.

**4TH AND FOX:** Sunday, Feb. 7, 2021, De'Aaron Fox led the Kings to their fourth straight victory at LA Clippers. Fox Scored 36 points and scored 10 points in the fourth quarter. It is the fifth game this season in which Fox has scored 10 or more points in the fourth quarter.

Fox has now scored 10 or more points in the fourth quarter six times this season and is ranked 8th in the NBA in fourth quarter scoring:

On Saturday, Jan. 30, 2021, Fox scored a total of 30 points and scored 17 points in the 4th quarter at Miami. Fox's 17 points are the most points scored in a quarter this season and is the most points in a 4th quarter by a Kings player since Fox scored 18 points vs. TOR on March 8, 2021.

The following game at New Orleans on Monday, Feb. 1, 2021, Fox scored 38 points and also scored 17 points in the 4th quarter to propell the Kings to a 118-109 victory. According to Elias Sports Bureau, Fox became the first Kings player in at least 20 years since play-by-play were recorded to score at least 17 points in consecutive 4th quarters of games and is the first player to achieve this in the NBA this season.

Fox also scored 30 points or more in consecutive games for the first time in his career. It is the second 35+ points/10+ assists game of the season and he joins Mike Bibby as the only Kings with multiple 35/10 games in a season since the 3pt era (1980) via @StatMuse.

**FOX'N EM UP:** De'Aaron Fox set a new career-high with 43 points on a career-high tying 17 made baskets to go along with a season-high 13 assists vs. New Orleans on Sunday, Jan. 17, 2021. According to ESPN Stats & Info, Fox is the first player in the Sac-Era and first player in franchise history to score at least 40 points and have 10 assists in a game since Tiny Archibald did so on March 13, 1973 for the Kansas City Royals.

Also vs. New Orleans on Sunday, Jan. 17, Fox entered the fourth quarter with 33 points and 11 assists. Fox is the first Kings player to score at least 30 points and have at least 10 assists through three quarters in a game since Mike Bibby had 31 points and 10 assists at LA Clippers (12/27/05).

**GENERAL FOX:** De'Aaron Fox has now amassed 1,503 assists in his fourth season and 238 games played. Fox is the first player to make his NBA debut with the Sacramento Kings and record 1,500 assists with the Kings.

## TYRESE'S PIECES

### TYRESE HALIBURTON NAMED WESTERN CONFERENCE ROOKIE OF THE MONTH FOR FEBRUARY:

Sacramento Kings guard Tyrese Haliburton has been named the Western Conference Rookie of the Month for games played in February, the NBA announced today.

Haliburton averaged 16.2 points (.513 FG%, .450 3pt%, .833 FT%), 3.8 rebounds, 5.3 assists, 1.8 steals, 0.5 blocks and 32.0 minutes per game in 13 games (1 start) during the month of February.

Haliburton is the fourth Kings player to earn Rookie of the Month honors in multiple months during their rookie campaign and the first since Isaiah Thomas won in both February and March of 2012.

### TYRESE HALIBURTON NAMED WESTERN CONFERENCE ROOKIE OF THE MONTH FOR DECEMBER AND JANUARY:

Sacramento Kings guard Tyrese Haliburton has been named the Western Conference Rookie of the Month for games played in December and January, the NBA announced today.

Haliburton averaged 11.0 points (.473 FG%, .417 3pt%, .833 FT%), 3.4 rebounds, 5.4 assists, 1.1 steals, 0.7 blocks and 28.6 minutes per game in 17 games (1 start) to begin his rookie campaign. Haliburton has scored in double figures in 13 games including a career-high of 17 points twice - vs. Chicago on Jan. 6 and vs. Portland on Jan. 13.

Haliburton is the seventh Kings player to earn Rookie of the Month honors and the first since teammate Buddy Hield won the award in March of 2017.

**TYRESE HALIBURTON NAMED TO 2021 NBA RISING STARS ROSTER:** Today, the NBA announced that Sacramento Kings guard Tyrese Haliburton has been named to the 2021 NBA Rising Stars U.S. Team roster.

NBA Rising Stars, the league's annual showcase of premier young talent during NBA All-Star, will not be played this year due to the limitation of having All-Star events all on one night. This year, the NBA has acknowledged deserving first- and second-year NBA players by naming 10 individuals to one of two rosters representing the U.S. and World (NBA players from outside the United States). The 20 players were selected by NBA assistant coaches, with each of the league's 30 teams submitting one ballot per coaching staff.

Joining Haliburton on the U.S Team are Zion Williamson (New Orleans), Ja Morant (Memphis), LaMelo Ball (Charlotte), Anthony Edwards (Minnesota), Tyler Herro (Miami), De'Andre Hunter (Atlanta), Keldon Johnson (San Antonio), Michael Porter Jr. (Denver) and James Wiseman (Golden State).

Sacramento has featured 15 players in the Rookie or Rising Stars Challenge dating back to 1994, with the most recent being current teammates Marvin Bagley III and De'Aaron Fox in 2019. Bogdan Bogdanovic (2018) and Tyreke Evans (2010) hold the distinction as the two rookies in franchise history to have earned MVP honors of the game.

**SEASON OPENER THRILLER:** Sacramento defeated the Denver Nuggets 124-122 in Overtime in the season opener:

The Sacramento Kings 124-122 OT win over the Denver Nuggets was the first win in the Mile High City since Jan. 3, 2017 (116-110 win) and snaps a 6-game losing streak in Denver.

Per @EliasSports, Wednesday night's overtime victory for the Kings is the first season opening game to go into overtime in the Sac-era and the second time in franchise history (Nov. 5, 1955, a 100-98 loss to the New York Knicks in Rochester).

Since tracking began in 96-97, Buddy Hield's game-winner is the second game-winner on opening night in Kings franchise history. Jason Thompson had a go ahead put back dunk with :42 seconds left, also against the Nuggets on Oct. 30, 2013.

**KINGS SIGN NORVEL PELLE TO 10-DAY CONTRACT:** The Sacramento Kings have signed center Norvel Pelle to 10-day contract, according to Kings General Manager Monte McNair. Per team policy, terms of deal were not disclosed. Pelle appeared in three games for the Canton Charge in the NBA G League single site in Orlando, FL., and averaged 10.0 points (.700 FG%, .250 FT%), 10.7 rebounds, 3.0 blocks and 24.3 minutes per game. In two seasons, the 6-10, 231-pound center has accrued averages of 2.3 points (.509 FG%, .500 FT%), 2.9 rebounds, 1.3 blocks and 9.6 minutes per game in 27 games for two teams; Brooklyn (2020-21) and Philadelphia (2019-20).

**KINGS WAIVE GLENN ROBINSON III:** The Sacramento Kings have waived forward Glenn Robinson III, according to General Manager Monte McNair. Robinson III appeared in 23 games (two starts) with the Kings, averaging 5.3 points (.424 FG%, .364 3pt%, .913 FT%), 2.0 rebounds, 0.9 assists and 16.1 minutes per game. A seven-year veteran from the University of Michigan, Robinson III has accrued career averages of 5.9 points (.457 FG%, .373 3pt%, .779 FT%), 2.6 rebounds and 17.4 minutes per game in 304 games (105 starts) for six teams: Sacramento (2020-21), Philadelphia (2019-20, 2014-15), Golden State (2019-20), Detroit Pistons (2018-19), Indiana Pacers (2015-18), and the Minnesota Timberwolves (2014-15).

**MEMPHIS GRIZZLIES GAMES POSTPONED:** On Thursday, January 21, 2021, the NBA announced that the Sacramento Kings games at Memphis on Jan. 24 and Jan. 25 have been postponed in accordance with the NBA's Health and Safety Protocols.

The games are being postponed due to unavailable players for the Grizzlies and contact tracing for other players on their roster, and in order to ensure the health and safety of players on both teams. A date for the rescheduled games will be announced at a later time.

**2020-21 PRESEASON TRANSACTIONS:** On Sunday, December 20, the Sacramento Kings waived forward-center Frank Kaminsky. Kaminsky appeared in four preseason games with the Kings, averaging 5.3 points (.400 FG%, .250 3pt%) and 7.6 minutes per game. Prior to Sacramento, the former ninth overall pick in the 2015 NBA Draft by the Charlotte Hornets accrued averages of 9.8 points (.422 FG%, .347 3pt%, .750 FT%), 4.0 rebounds, 1.6 assists and 21.9 minutes per game in 321 career games (36 starts) with Charlotte (2015-19) and the Phoenix Suns (2019-20).

The Sacramento Kings waived center Chimezie Metu, on Tuesday, December 22, 2020. Metu appeared in four preseason games with the Kings, averaging 6.0 points (.563 FG%, .333 3pt%, .625 FT%), 2.3 rebounds and 7.4 minutes per game. An early entrant out of the University of Southern California, the 49th overall selection in the 2018 NBA Draft by the San Antonio Spurs has career averages of 2.3 points (.430 FG%, .767 FT%), 1.5 rebounds and 5.3 minutes per game in 47 games in two seasons with San Antonio (2018-20).

On Thursday, December 24, 2020, the Kings announced that they have signed free agent center Chimezie Metu to a two-way contract.

**TIME IN THE 2019-20 BUBBLE :** The Sacramento Kings finished their time in the bubble going 3-5 overall as Sacramento went on to average 119.0 points per game during their eight seeding games, the seventh highest scoring average among the 22 bubble teams. The Kings also went on to average 27.0 assists and 8.5 steals per game, ranking fourth and fifth respectively among the teams who participated in the 2020 NBA Restart. Sacramento averaged 13.3 3s per game, the 11th best among the 22 teams as the Kings set the franchise record for 3-point field goals made in a single quarter with nine in the first quarter vs. Dallas on Aug. 4 and nine in the third quarter at Los Angeles on Aug. 13. In their win over the Lakers on Aug. 13, the Kings tied their franchise record with 21 3-pointers, marking the third time the team reached that mark this season with the other two times coming on Mar. 7 at Portland at Jan. 30 at the Clippers.

Sacramento received strong play from guard De'Aaron Fox who appeared in six seeding games and posted 26.2 points, 7.3 assists and 1.7 steals per contest. Fox finished with the ninth best scoring output, eighth highest assist average and was tied for 14th in steals per game among bubble league leaders. Only Fox and Rockets guard James Harden averaged at least 26.0 points, 7.0 assists and 1.5 steals per game during the restart. Guard Bogdan Bogdanovic was a big factor in the success Sacramento found, posting 19.8 points, 4.5 rebounds and 4.8 assists per game in eight seeding games as he ended the bubble with the 29th highest scoring average.
