KINGS 2021-22 SEASON NOTES

SHOOTERS SHOOT

CHAVANO HIELD: Buddy Hield shot 7-of-13 from three at LAL on Tuesday, Jan. 4, making it his second consecutive game making at least seven three-pointers in a game (Hield shot 7-14 vs. MIA on Jan. 2). It is Hield's third time in his career making at least seven three-pointers in two consecutive games, and remains the only Kings player in franchise history to reach this feat.

TY-LEAGUE HALIBURTON: Tyrese Haliburton ranks 11th amongst all players in assists per game (7.1), 7th in 3-pt FG% (.429) and 7th in steals per game (1.7).

HALIBURTON STRETCH: Tyrese Haliburton had four consecutive games of at least 20 points and 10 assists and also five games out of six.. Haliburton is the first player to have four or more games of 20+ points or 10+ assists in a game in the Sacramento Era. According to Elias Sports Bureau, Haliburton is first player in franchise history to reach this feat since Larry Drew who had five games in 1982. Other players include Oscar Robertson (many times, high of 9 straight in 1964), Nate Archibald (many times, high of 14 straight in 1972), Phil Ford (4 straight in 1981), and Larry Drew (5 straight in 1982).

TRIPLE OVERTIME THRILLER IN HOLLYWOOD: The Sacramento Kings defeated the Los Angeles Lakers, 141-137 in three overtime periods on Friday, November 26. The last triple overtime game that the Kings participated in was a 135-133 victory at Golden State on January 14, 2009. Brad Miller led the way for the Kings with 30 points and 22 rebounds.

Furthermore, the Kings have now only had three triple overtime games in the Sacramento Era and have been victorious in all three occasions: Sacramento at Toronto, 119-118 (2/23/01), Sacramento at Golden State, 135-133 (1/14/09).

The overtime victory at LAL was the first overtime game and overtime win of the season for the Kings.

NEW FRANCHISE RECORDS: On Friday, November 5, 2021 vs. Charlotte, Sacramento shot 22 of 44 from three. The 22 made three's are a new franchise record with the previous being 21 made threes on three different occasions. Most recently, vs. Lakers on August 13, 2020 in the NBA Bubble.

WE JUST TRYING TO PARTY HOLMES: Richaun Holmes earned his first career 20-point/20-rebound game as he scored 23 points on 9-of-12 shooting and a career-high 20 rebounds vs. Charlotte on 11/5/21. According to @StatMuse, Holmes is the first Kings player to have a 20/20 game on at least .750 percent shooting since 1994.

THE BLACK FALCON: Harrison Barnes erupted in the first game of the season on Wednesday, October 20, 2021 at Portland with a career-high 36 points on 10-of-19 shooting from the field and 8-of-11 from the three-point line, which is also a new career-high. According to @StatsbySTATS, Barnes is the first NBA player to score 35+ points with no turnovers and no personal fouls in a season opener since turnovers were first tracked beginning in 1977-78.

ALL TIME KINGS SHOOTER: Buddy Hield became the Kings franchise three-point leader as he connected from beyond the arc six times vs. Utah Friday night. Hield passes Peja Stojakovic for most threes made all-time in Franchise history, who previously held the mark of 1,070 in a Kings jersey.

On Nov. 12, 2021 at Oklahoma City, Hield played in his 400th career game. He has the most three-pointers made of any player in NBA History in their first 400 games with 1,209.

GAME WINNERS: Chimezie Metu scored a three-pointer at the buzzer to beat the Dallas Mavericks 95-94 on December 29, 2021. The Kings have the most game-winning buzzer beaters in the NBA since 2018-19 season with seven:

BUDDY HIELD: Buddy Hield currently ranks second in the NBA in 3-pt field goals made with 167. He is also first in the league among reserves.

RICHAUN HOLMES: Richaun Holmes ranks third in the NBA in field goal percentage with .692.

HEAD COACH LUKE WALTON RELIEVED OF COACHING DUTIES:

SACRAMENTO, Calif. ---- Today, Sacramento Kings General Manager Monte McNair announced that Luke Walton has been relieved of his duties as head coach of the team and Alvin Gentry has been named interim head coach.

"After a thorough evaluation of the season thus far, I decided to make a change to the head coach position," said Kings General Manager Monte McNair. "I want to thank Luke for his efforts and contributions to our team."

Gentry brings more than 35 years of experience to the Sacramento bench. Prior to the Kings, Gentry most recently served as head coach for the New Orleans Pelicans (2015-20). Gentry also has head coaching stops with the Miami Heat (1995), Detroit Pistons (1997-2000), Los Angeles Clippers (2000-2003) and Phoenix Suns (2008-2013). In 1,105 games, Gentry has garnered a career record of 510-595 (.462).

Walton was named head coach of the Kings in April 2019 after spending three years as head coach of the Los Angeles Lakers. During his time with the Kings, he coached the team to a record of 68-93 (.422).

- Guided Phoenix to the 2010 Western Conference Finals following a 54-28 regular season record – the fourth best in Phoenix franchise history – and led the NBA in scoring with 110.2 points per game, along with offensive rating (115.3), and finished fourth in pace of play (95.3), while being the only team in the league to connect on over 40-percent of their three-point field goal attempts (.412).
