Head Coach David Fizdale

David Fizdale was named the 29th head coach in New York Knickerbockers franchise history on May 7, 2018.

Fizdale, 44, led the Memphis Grizzlies to a 50-51 (.495) regular season record as head coach over the past two seasons (2016-17 and 2017-18), which included a trip to the NBA Playoffs in 2017.

Prior to joining the Grizzlies for his first NBA head coaching assignment, Fizdale spent the previous eight seasons (2008-09 thru 2015-16) with the Miami Heat as an assistant coach, including the final two years as assistant head coach under Erik Spoelstra. During his tenure in Miami, the Heat won back-to-back NBA Championships in 2012 and 2013, and more Playoff games (70) and series (15) than any other NBA team.

With a decade-and-a-half of NBA coaching experience, the Los Angeles native was an assistant coach for one season in Golden State (2003-04) and for four seasons in Atlanta (2004-05 thru 2007-08).

Fizdale began his coaching career in the college ranks, serving as an assistant coach at his alma mater, the University of San Diego (1998-99 thru 2001-02) and at Fresno State (2002-03). His first NBA job was as a member of the Heat's video department in 1997-98.

Fizdale was a three-year starter at the University of San Diego and was named to the All-West Coast Conference team as a senior in 1995-96 when he led the Conference in assists with 7.0 APG.

Born on June 16, 1974 in Los Angeles, David earned a bachelor's degree in communications with a minor in sociology from San Diego in 1996.

Knicks Knotations

KNICKS UPDATE:

The New York Knicks have acquired guard Dennis Smith Jr., center DeAndre Jordan and two future first round draft picks from Dallas in exchange for forward Kristaps Porzingis, and guards Tim Hardaway Jr., Trey Burke and Courtney Lee.

Dennis Smith Jr.-6-3, 195-pounds, averaged 12.9 points, 4.3 assists and 3.0 rebounds over 28.4 minutes in 32 games (all starts) for Dallas this season. The Fayetteville, NC-native earned All-Rookie second team honors after averaging 15.2 points, 5.2 assists and 3.8 rebounds over 29.7 minutes in 69 games (all starts) last season. He ranked third among rookies in assists, fifth among rookies in scoring, sixth in steals and seventh in minutes. His 106 three-pointers were the most by a Mavericks rookie in franchise history and he became the fourth youngest player in NBA history to record a triple double on Dec. 29, 2017. He was originally selected by Dallas with the ninth overall pick in the 2017 NBA Draft.

DeAndre Jordan- 6-11, 265-pounds, averaged 11.0 points, 13.7 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.1 blocks over 31.1 minutes in 50 games (all starts) for Dallas this season. He held career averages of 9.5 points on 67.1-percent shooting with 10.8 rebounds and 1.7 blocks over 28.2 minutes in 800 games (688 starts) over 11 seasons with LA Clippers and Dallas. The Bellaire, TX-native represented the Western Conference in the 2017 NBA All-Star game. He is a two-time All-NBA Defensive first team selection (2015, 2016), an All-NBA first team selection in 2015-16 and two-time All-NBA third team selection (2015 and 2017). He was originally selected by LA Clippers in the second round (35th overall) of the 2008 NBA Draft.

Knick Knotables:

Damyean Dotson is played in his 100th career NBA game at PHO on 3/6/19.

Kevin Knox (12.8 ppg) and **Allonzo Trier** (10.9 ppg) are the first set of Knick rookies to average at least 10.0 points in a season since Patrick Ewing (20.0) and Gerald Wilkins (12.5).

New York Knicks finished ninth in the NBA at 24.0 FTA per game. Last season the Knicks were 28th in the NBA at 19.0 FTA per game.

New York Knicks finished 14th in the NBA in turnovers at 14.1 per game. New York was 21st last season turning the ball over 14.7 times per game.



CONSECUTIVE BLOCK STREAK:

- **Mitchell Robinson's streak** of at least one block in 38 straight games ended. The streak is an all-time Knicks rookie record, breaking Patrick Ewing's 28 straight games. The streak of two blocks in 29 straight games was a Knicks rookie high.
- **Robinson** was the fourth rookie since 1973-74 (when blocks were first recorded) to block a shot in 38 or more consecutive games. Others are Alonzo Mourning, David Robinson and Manute Bol.
- **ROBINSON** was the only rookie younger than 20 years of age record 30 straight games on at least one block.
- Last NBA rookie before **Robinson** to have 38 straight games of at least one block was Allonzo Mourning of the 1992-93 Charlotte Hornets (57-game streak, 11/13/1992 to 03/14/1993).
- The 29 games with at least two blocks was a Knicks rookie record. He was just the second rookie in NBA history with a streak of 29-games w/ at least two blocks (since 1973-74).
- He joined Manute Bol (45 games).

MITCH QUICK HITS:

- **Mitchell Robinson** is one of 11 players in the NBA with at least four games of at least 10 points, 10 rebounds and four blocks.
- **Robinson** is the only rookie this season to have five games of five or more blocks. He is one of five players in the NBA the season with at least five games of five or more blocks.
- **Robinson** recorded a career high 17 points, 14 rebounds, six blocks and three steals over 33 minutes on 2/26 vs. ORL. It was his sixth time leading the team in rebounds and his fourth game over his career with at least five blocks.
- **Robinson** became the first Knicks rookie to post consecutive games of five or more blocks since the 1973-74 season, when blocks were first tracked officially (Elias).
- **Robinson** became the first rookie since 2002 to record at least 15 points, 10 rebounds, and five blocks in consecutive games since Yao Ming (Dec. 16 & Dec. 18, 2002).
- **Robinson** became the seventh rookie in the last 30 years to record a double-double and five or more blocks in back-to-back games (Joining David Robinson, Dikembe Mutombo, Shaquille O'Neal, Alonzo Mourning, Tim Duncan and Yao Ming).
- **Robinson** posted 17 points, 14 rebounds, six blocks and three steals. He joins David Robinson (89) and Ralph Sampson (84) as the only rookies to post such numbers in a game since blocks became a stat in 73-74.
- **Robinson** finished first in BPG in the NBA among rookies at 2.44 per game and second in the NBA.
- **Mitchell Robinson's** per 36 stat line is 12.8 points, 11.2 rebounds, 4.3 blocks, and 1.4 steals. (Per 36 minutes ratings are calculated by

taking the player's total in any category (points, rebounds, assists, etc.) divided by 36 minutes played.)

MITCH IN FEBRUARY:

- **Mitchell Robinson** led all rookies in the month of February in blocks at 3.18 (next highest is 1.10), FIRST in FG% at 71.6% (min. five games), fourth in rebounds at 8.7 and ninth in points at 11.0.
- **Mitchell Robinson** was first in the NBA in blocks at 3.18 per game during the month of Feb.

MITCH ROB: Mitchell Robinson is averaging 2.48 blocks on the season, which would mark the highest for any rookie in Knicks franchise history. The only other Knick to average at least 2.00 blocks during his rookie season was Patrick Ewing (2.06 bpg).

- **Robinson** is the first rookie in NBA history to average 2.40+ blocks and shoot 60% from the field for his rookie season.
- **No rookie ever shot 68% in a season of at least 200 FGA's**
- **Robinson** led the NBA with 24 blocked three-pointers this season (second is Ben Simmons with 18)
- **Robinson** set a new Knicks rookie record for most blocks in a season (161) breaking Kristaps Porzingis' 134 blocks accomplished in 2015-16.

With a min. of 35 games played, **Robinson** is the first rookie to average at least 2.40 blocks since Tim Duncan (1997-98).

New York Knicks forward Kevin Knox has been named KIA NBA Eastern Conference Rookie of the Month for December. Knox becomes the eighth rookie in franchise history to be awarded Rookie of the Month honors.

Among Eastern Conference rookies, Knox led in scoring (17.1 ppg), three-pointers (33), was second in rebounding (6.0 rpg), and led all rookies in minutes (34.9 mpg) in the month of December. He appeared in all 14 games (nine starts) for the Knicks during the month, scored in double figures in 12 games and recorded six games with 20 or more points. On December 9, Knox joined LeBron James as just the second teenager in NBA history to record at least 25 points and 15 rebounds in a game (vs. Charlotte). He is the first Knicks rookie since Patrick Ewing to post at least 25 points and 15 rebounds in a game. In December, the Tampa, FL-native became just the sixth Knicks rookie ever to post three consecutive games of at least 20 points and five rebounds and is the first since Patrick Ewing (1985-86).
