The Lakers ended their 2021-22 campaign on a high note as they beat the Denver Nuggets, 146-141, on Sunday night. Los Angeles overcame a 17-point deficit to send the game to overtime and eventually pulled away with the victory. Austin Reaves had a performance for the ages, finishing with 31 points, 16 rebounds and 10 assists for his first career triple-double, becoming just the second undrafted rookie to ever secure a triple-double. Malik Monk also had a strong night, finishing with a career-best 41 points, four rebounds and one assist in 35 minutes. Wenyen Gabriel secured his first career double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds, while Wayne Ellington led the bench with a season-high 18 points. Markus Howard led the Nuggets with 25 points off the bench.

LAKERS LATEST

PUTTING ARKANSAS ON THE MAP: In the final game of the 2021-22 season, Malik Monk and Austin Reaves had their best games of their professional careers. Monk scored a career-best 41 points and Austin Reaves tallied a triple-double with 31 points, 16 rebounds and 10 assists. Reaves became the fifth player in Lakers history to tally a triple-double as a rookie and just the fourth rookie in NBA history to tally 30+ points, 15+ rebounds and 10+ assists. Reaves is the first Lakers player since Kobe Bryant in 2002 to tally such numbers in a game. He is the first undrafted rookie to tally a 30-point triple-double.

NUMBER TWO ALL-TIME: LeBron James surpassed Karl Malone for second place on the NBA's all-time scoring list with a layup in the second quarter against the Wizards. James ended the historic night with 38 points, 10 rebounds and six assists. He now only trails Kareem Abdul-Jabbar on the NBA's scoring list.

WHY N(OT): Russell Westbrook recorded his 10th triple-double of the season with 22 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists. Westbrook hit the game-tying three-pointer with 0.9 seconds remaining to send the game to overtime. The clutch jumper marked his ninth career three-pointer inside the final five seconds of the fourth quarter and overtime, matching Kobe Bryant for second-most over the last 25 seasons.

PLENTY OF TWENTY: LeBron James is approaching yet another milestone in his 19th season as he looks to become the NBA's all-time leader in games with 20+ points. James is just four games away from passing Karl Malone for the most such games in NBA history. He has climbed the charts thanks to a streak of 32 consecutive 20-point games that started on 12/19 and ended on 3/16. He passed Abdul-Jabbar with a 23-point outing on 3/9 at Houston.

TRIPLE-QUINTUPLE: LeBron James became the only player in NBA history to tally 10,000+ points, 10,000+ rebounds and 10,000+ assists as he recorded his 10,000th career assist against the Suns. James finished the night with 31 points, seven rebounds, six assists and one block in 30 minutes. The performance marked his 28th game of the season with 30+ points.

DOUBLE 50 BURGER: LeBron James finished with 50 points, seven rebounds, six assists and one block in 36 minutes. The performance marked his second 50-point game of the season and the 14th such game of his career, tying Rick Barry for sixth most in NBA history. In his last two home games, James has scored 106 points, the first Lakers player to score 100+ across two consecutive home games in a single season since Kobe Bryant did so in April of 2007. James is the sixth player in NBA history to score 50+ points in consecutive home games and the only player to do so after turning 30.

ULTIMATE WARRIOR: LeBron James finished with a season-high 56 points (19-31 FG, 6-11 3FG, 12-13 FT) to go with 10 rebounds, three assists and one block in 38 minutes on 3/5 vs. Golden State, good for the sixth 50-point double-double of his career. James became the first Lakers player to tally 55+ points and 10+ rebounds since Shaquille O'Neal on March 6, 2000. He is just the fourth player in NBA history to record a 50-point game at age 37 or older, joining Jamal Crawford, Kobe Bryant and Michael Jordan. James scored 30 points in the second half, his highest scoring half since scoring 35 points in the second half on April 6, 2018 at Philadelphia. He has now scored at least 30 points in 19 different halves throughout his career.

TWENTY FIVE A NIGHT: LeBron James put together a scoring streak unlike anything he has done since the 2007-08 season. James scored at least 25 points in 23 consecutive games, good for the longest streak of his career. The last time he had such a streak was from 1/25/08-3/8/08 when he scored 25+ points in 21 consecutive games. His streak is tied for the longest such streak in the NBA this season.

HALF A NIGHT, RUSS: Russell Westbrook had one of his strongest nights since joining the Lakers as he finished with 35 points (12-23 FG), four rebounds and five assists on 1/28 against the Hornets. Westbrook scored 30 of his points in the second half, becoming the first Lakers player to have a 30-point half since Kobe Bryant scored 38 points in the final half of his career on 4/13/16 vs. Utah. The performance marked the seventh time that Westbrook had scored 30+ in a single half and the first time since scoring 30 points in the second half on 3/7/17 vs. Portland. Westbrook is just the seventh player this season to tally a 30-point half.

LAKERS LATEST

I'M THE CAPTAIN AGAIN: For the sixth consecutive season and ninth time overall, LeBron James led all players in All-Star voting as he was named an All-Star for the 18th time in his career. James has been named a captain in every year since the NBA switched to the current format and improved to 5-0 as the team captain of the annual event. His 18th straight selection ties him with Kobe Bryant for most all-time and his 18th overall selection ties him with Bryant for second-most selections in NBA history. A three-time NBA All-Star Game MVP and the contest's all-time leading scorer (413 points), James made his NBA-record 18th All-Star start on February 20, 2022, finishing with 24 points, six rebounds, eight assists, three steals and one block in 36 minutes.



10 ACROSS THE BOARDS: Dwight Howard added to his Hall of Fame resume as he passed Nate Thurmond for 10th place on the NBA's all-time rebounds list on 1/21 against the Orlando Magic. With his first rebound of the night, Howard broke a tie with Thurmond to take sole possession of 10th place, recording his 14,465th career rebound.

PASSING THE ALL-TIME PASSERS: LeBron James continued his climb up the NBA's all-time lists as he moved passed Oscar Robertson on the all-time assists list on 1/9 vs. Memphis. With his seventh assist of the night, James passed Robertson for seventh all-time, passing out his 9,888th career assist. James will now look to become just one of seven players all-time to tally 10,000 career assists.

DOUBLE-TRIPLE-DOUBLE: In the Lakers' 132-123 win over the Houston Rockets, both LeBron James and Russell Westbrook recorded triple-doubles and James added to his list of career milestones.

- LeBron James became the third player in NBA history to score 36,000 points as he finished with 32 points, 10 rebounds, 11 assists, one steal and two blocks in 39 minutes. James became the first Lakers player since Kobe Bryant in 2013 to score 30+ points in five consecutive games.
- Russell Westbrook tallied his seventh triple-double of the season with 24 points, 13 rebounds, 10 assists and two steals. James and Westbrook became just the third pair of Lakers teammates to record a triple-double in the same game, and the first since James and Lonzo Ball on 12/15/18.

CHRISTMAS TREE TOPPER: LeBron James appeared in his 16th career Christmas Day game, tying Kobe Bryant for most such games all-time, and put on a show in front of the Crypto.com Arena crowd. James finished the night with 39 points, nine rebounds, seven assists, three steals and one block in 40 minutes. With his third free throw of the night, James surpassed Bryant to become the all-time leading scorer on Christmas Day, totaling 422 career points on the holiday. With his second field goal of the night, James passed Bryant for most career field goals on Christmas Day, now totaling 150 field goals on December 25th.

BEST IN THE WEST: LeBron James was awarded the NBA's Western Conference Player of the Week award on December 13th, winning the weekly honor for an NBA-record 65th time in his 19-year career. James averaged 28.3 points (.608 FG%, .417 3FG%), 8.0 assists, 7.5 rebounds, 1.8 steals and 1.8 blocks as the Lakers finished the week 3-1 with victories over Boston, Oklahoma City and Orlando.

THIRD'S THE (MAGIC) WORD: The Lakers had their strongest defensive performance of the season as they dominated the third quarter against the Orlando Magic on December 12, holding their opponent to just 10 points in the third frame.

- Los Angeles held the Magic to 37.5 percent (33-88 FG) from the field, the lowest shooting percentage by a Lakers opponent this season
- The Lakers held Orlando to just 8.7 percent shooting (2-23 FG) in the third quarter, the worst shooting percentage by a Lakers opponent in a single frame since December 14, 1999 vs. LA Clippers (.056, 1-18 FG, Second Quarter)
- Los Angeles scored 23 unanswered points in the third quarter, good for their longest scoring run of the season

KEEPING IT 100: LeBron James became just the fifth player in NBA history to record at least 100 career triple-doubles as he recorded his 100th such game on 12/9 at Memphis. James finished the night with 20 points, 10 rebounds, 11 assists, four steals and two blocks in 37 minutes. He joins teammate Russell Westbrook, Oscar Robertson, Magic Johnson and Jason Kidd as they only players to accomplish the feat.

SOUTH BAY LAKERS, NBA G LEAGUE AFFILIATE

HOT-N-READY COMEBACK: The Lakers picked up their largest come-from-behind victory as they overcame a 17-point deficit on 11/21/21 at Detroit to beat the Pistons by a final score of 121-116. It marks the team's largest comeback since they erased a 20-point Memphis lead on 2/12/21.

- Anthony Davis finished with 30 points, 10 rebounds, six assists, four steals and five blocks in 40 minutes. The performance marked the first time that Davis has tallied 30+ points, 10+ rebounds, 5+ steals, 4+ steals and 5+ blocks in a game. He became just the fourth player in NBA history to tally such statistics, joining Hakeem Olajuwon, Kareem Abdul-Jabbar and Michael Jordan.
- Carmelo Anthony led the second unit with 18 points (5-8 3FG), two rebounds and two blocks in 30 minutes. It was the sixth time this season that he has made at least five three-pointers in a game. The only other seasons that Anthony had more games with 5+ triples was 2013-14 (8) and 2017-18 (7).

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: In his 19th season in the NBA, Carmelo Anthony is finding himself right at home with the Los Angeles Lakers. Through 35 regular season home games at Crypto.com Arena, Anthony is shooting 42.7 percent (88-206 3FG) from three-point range on the Lakers home court. His shooting percentage at home would rank fifth in the league among three-point shooters. Including road contests, he is currently shooting at a 37.5 percent clip on the year.

ALAMO-T: The Lakers picked up their first overtime victory of the season on 10/26 at San Antonio, securing a 125-121 victory. Anthony Davis and Russell Westbrook each grabbed a 30-point double-double in the win. The Lakers overcame a 12-point deficit in the win, marking their second consecutive win where they had to overcome a double-digit deficit. The win also marked the 400th career victory for Head Coach Frank Vogel.

AGING LIKE FINE NINE: Carmelo Anthony continued to climb up the NBA's all-time scoring list as he passed Moses Malone for ninth all-time on 10/24 vs. Memphis

- Anthony finished with a team-high 28 points, three rebounds, one assist, one steal and two blocks on the historic night.
- He shot 10-15 from the field and 6-8 from three-point range, marking his 20th career game with at least six three-pointers made

NBA'S 75TH ANNIVERSARY TEAM: To celebrate the NBA's 75th anniversary, a group of 76 players were named to the 75th Anniversary Team to as the Greatest Players in NBA History. Four Lakers players were honored on the team, including Carmelo Anthony, Anthony Davis, LeBron James and Russell Westbrook. The quartet were just four of 11 active players to receive the honor.



DAILY DOUBLE DIGITS: LeBron James opened his 19th season in the NBA with a 34-point performance, ensuring that his double-digit scoring streak would continue.

- With a 26-point performance on his 36th birthday on Dec. 30, 2020, James extended his double-digit scoring streak to 1,000 consecutive games, becoming the first player in league history to reach that mark.
- James's double-digit scoring streak – which began on Jan. 6, 2007 – has far eclipsed Michael Jordan's previous NBA record of 866 consecutive 10-point performances from 1986-2001.
- James has finished with 10+ points in all but eight regular season contests in his career.
- In league history, there have only been seven streaks in which a player has finished in double figures in 500+ consecutive contests (see chart).

LEBRON IN THE NBA'S TOP-10 REGULAR SEASON WINS LIST: Lakers forward LeBron James owns 894 career regular season wins, ranking seventh on the NBA's all-time victories list, after passing Tony Parker on March 18, 2022. The Akron, OH, native sits 23 wins away from moving past NBA legend Dirk Nowitzki for sixth all-time. The active leader in wins, James is one of 18 current or former NBA players to achieve the 800 career wins milestone

WELCOME BACK: During the 2021 off-season, the Lakers welcomed back five players who had formerly suited up for the purple-and-gold. Trevor Ariza, a member of the 2009 Championship Team, returned after spending last season with the Miami Heat. Kent Bazemore (2013-14) and Wayne Ellington (2014-15) each spent one season with the Lakers and will look to bring their sharp-shooting back to Los Angeles. Also returning to the team are two members of the 2020 Championship Team, Avery Bradley and Dwight Howard.

RUSS IS HOME: On August 6, the Lakers completed a five-team trade to bring Russell Westbrook back to Los Angeles. Westbrook, the NBA's all-time leader in triple-doubles, went to high school in Lawndale and played two seasons at UCLA, averaging 8.3 points, 2.4 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.0 steal.

LAKERS x BIBIGO: The Lakers announced a multi-year global marketing partnership with Bibigo, a brand by the No. 1 food company in Korea. The global marketing partnership establishes Bibigo as the first international partner ever for the Lakers and will include a large-scale integrated marketing program, including courtside branding (baseline courtside apron and rotational LED signage), social and digital fan focused campaigns. In addition, the two companies will collaborate on various community initiatives within the greater Los Angeles area including the Lakers "In the Paint" fine art program, which will showcase original works of BIPOC artists and the Lakers Global Mural series campaign which will feature Lakers mural artwork around the world.
