Los Angeles dropped the second end of a back-to-back as they fell to the Washington Wizards, 127-119, on Saturday night. The Lakers led by as many as 16 points in the contest, but the Wizards outscored Los Angeles by 14 points in the final frame to secure the victory. Despite the loss, LeBron James made history once again as he passed Karl Malone for second place on the NBA's all-time scoring list. James ended the night with 38 points, 10 rebounds and six assists in 36 minutes. Russell Westbrook also tallied a double-double with 22 points, 10 rebounds, eight assists, one steal and one block. Malik Monk scored 17 points and Stanley Johnson added 12 points. Carmelo Anthony scored in double figures off the bench with 13 points. Kristaps Porzingis led the Wizards with 27 points, three rebounds, five assists and one steal in 26 minutes.

The Lakers picked up their third consecutive road victory as they beat the Milwaukee Bucks, 133-129, on Friday night. The Lakers committed a season-low four turnovers and tallied a season-best 32 assists as they shot 53.6 percent from the field. Anthony Davis had a dominant performance once again as he tallied a season-high 44 points, 10 rebounds, four assists and three blocks, while LeBron James finished with 28 points, eight rebounds, 11 assists and two steals. James passed Magic Johnson for sixth place on the NBA's all-time assists list in the victory. Russell Westbrook tallied a 15-point, 11-assist double-double off the bench and Lonnie Walker IV scored 14 points to round out the double-digit scorers. Giannis Antetokounmpo paced the Bucks with a team-high 40 points, seven rebounds, five assists and one block.

On the road, the Lakers are 15-11 all-time against the Raptors ... In the two teams' 20th meeting on Jan. 22, 2006, Kobe Bryant had a career night, scoring a team-record 81 points - including 55 points in the second half - to bring the Lakers back from an 18-point deficit to defeat the Raptors, 122-104, at STAPLES Center ... LAST TIME OUT:

- Anthony Davis finished with a season-high 44 points, 10 rebounds, four assists and three blocks in the win over Milwaukee. His 44 points mark his highest scoring game since scoring 46 points on Jan. 3, 2020 vs. New Orleans.
- LeBron James tallied 28 points, eight rebounds, a season-high 11 assists and two steals against Milwaukee. With his ninth assist of the night, James passed Magic Johnson for sixth on the NBA's all-time assists list. The victory marked his 900th career win, just the seventh player to reach the mark.

30/20 VISION: Anthony Davis finished with 37 points (15-16 FT), a season-high 21 rebounds, two assists, five steals and five blocks on Nov. 22 against the Phoenix Suns. Davis is the first player in NBA history to have a game with 35+ points, 20+ rebounds, 5+ steals and 5+ blocks.

- Davis became just the second player in NBA history to have 30+ points, 20+ rebounds, 5+ steals and 5+ blocks in a game, joining Bob McAdoo who accomplished the feat on Jan. 8, 1974.
- The performance marked the seventh 30-20 game of Davis' career and his first such game since tallying 40 points and 20 rebounds on Oct. 29, 2019 vs. Memphis. His 21 rebounds mark his most since joining the Lakers.
- Davis joined Wilt Chamberlain (1963) and Bob McAdoo (1975) as the only players in NBA history to have four consecutive games with 30+ points, 15+ rebounds while shooting above 60 percent from the field.

TAKE A BROW: Anthony Davis averaged 34.0 points (.629 FG%, .889 FT%), 17.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists, 2.0 steals and 2.5 blocks in a two-game span as the Lakers beat the Pistons and the Spurs from Nov. 18-20.

- Davis recorded 30 points (12-19 FG, 6-6 FT), a season-high-tying 18 rebounds, two assists, three steals and one block in a 31-point win over San Antonio on November 20. Davis became the first Lakers player to tally 30+ points and 15+ rebounds in less than 30 minutes since Wilt Chamberlain on Nov. 7, 1969. He joined Elgin Baylor (17 streaks) and O'Neal (2 streaks) as the only players in Lakers history to record 30+ points and 15+ rebounds in three consecutive games.
- Davis finished with a season-high 38 points (10-16 FG, 18-21 FT), 16 rebounds, two assists, one steal and four blocks on November 18 to lead the Lakers to a win over the Pistons. The performance marked his second consecutive game with 35+ points and 15+ rebounds, becoming the first Lakers player to accomplish the feat since Shaquille O'Neal did so in January of 2000.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE: Anthony Davis recorded a season-high 37 points (15-25 FG, 7-7 FT), a season-best 18 rebounds, including a career-high 10 offensive rebounds, and two assists in 34 minutes on 11/13 vs. Brooklyn. Davis' 10 offensive rebound were his most in a game since Oct. 28, 2014 when he collected nine such-rebounds vs. Orlando.

- Davis joined Patrick Ewing as the only players in NBA history to record at least 35 points and 10 offensive rebounds in a game in 35 minutes or less.
- Davis became the third active player to record 35+ points and 10+ offensive rebounds in a game, joining John Collins and Rudy Gobert.

PLENTY OF TWENTY: LeBron James achieved yet another milestone in his 20th season as became the NBA's all-time leader in games with 20+ points. James recorded the 1,135th 20-point performance of his career on 10/28 at Minnesota, passing Karl Malone for the most such games in NBA history. He climbed the charts thanks to a streak of 32 consecutive 20-point games that started on 12/19/21 and ended on 3/16/22. He passed Abdul-Jabbar with a 23-point outing on 3/9/21 at Houston.

James kicked off his 20th campaign with his 510th career 30-point performance and now sits just two such games away from passing Wilt Chamberlain for second all-time.

WELCOME BACK: During the 2022 offseason, the Lakers welcomed back three players who had formerly suited up for the purple-and-gold: Dennis Schröder, who averaged 15.4 points, 3.5 rebounds, 5.8 assists and 1.1 steals in 61 games during the 2020-21 season, Thomas Bryant, who appeared in 15 games for the Lakers as a rookie during the 2017-18 campaign, and Damian Jones, who appeared in eight games for Los Angeles in the 2020-21 season.

THE KING STAYS PUT: On August 18, the Lakers and 18-time NBA All-Star LeBron James agreed to a contract extension. The Akron, Ohio native originally signed with Los Angeles on July 9, 2018 and led the Lakers to their 17th NBA Championship in 2020, recording 27.6 points, 10.8 rebounds, 8.8 assists and 1.2 steals en route to his fourth NBA Finals MVP award.

A NEW LEADER: The Lakers found themselves a new leader this summer, hiring former player and recent Milwaukee Bucks assistant coach Darvin Ham to be the 28th head coach in franchise history and the 24th of the Los Angeles era. Ham enjoyed an eight-year NBA playing career (1996-98, 1999-2005), suiting up for Detroit (2004 NBA Champion), Atlanta, Milwaukee, Washington, Indiana and Denver before transitioning over to coaching in 2008 as an assistant coach with the New Mexico Thunderbirds of the NBA Developmental League. In 2011, Ham joined the Lakers as an assistant coach, spending two seasons with Los Angeles. He would then spend five seasons as an assistant with the Atlanta Hawks (2013-18) and joined the Milwaukee Bucks as an assistant coach in 2018, helping the Bucks to the 2021 NBA Championship.

CHAMPIONSHIP EXPERIENCE: With the signings of two-time NBA Champion Damian Jones and 2022 NBA Champion Juan Toscano-Anderson, the Lakers added some championship experience to their roster in free agency this past summer. These two join four-time NBA champion LeBron James and 2020 NBA Champion Anthony Davis as Lakers with NBA titles on their resumes.

NUMBER TWO ALL-TIME: LeBron James surpassed Karl Malone for second place on the NBA's all-time scoring list with a layup in the second quarter against the Wizards on March 19, 2022. James ended the historic night with 38 points, 10 rebounds and six assists. He now only trails Kareem Abdul-Jabbar on the NBA's scoring list.

DAILY DOUBLE DIGITS: LeBron James opened his 20th season in the NBA with a 31-point performance, ensuring that his double-digit scoring streak would continue.

- With a 26-point performance on his 36th birthday on Dec. 30, 2020, James extended his double-digit scoring streak to 1,000 consecutive games, becoming the first player in league history to reach that mark.
- James's double-digit scoring streak – which began on Jan. 6, 2007 – has far eclipsed Michael Jordan's previous NBA record of 866 consecutive 10-point performances from 1986-2001.
- James has finished with 10+ points in all but eight regular season contests in his career.
- In league history, there have only been seven streaks in which a player has finished in double figures in 500+ consecutive contests (see chart).
