The Lakers were shorthanded once again as they fell to the LA Clippers, 118-94, on Thursday night as the Clippers swept the season series. The Lakers scored 30 points off 22 Clippers turnovers, but shot a season-low 37.9 percent from the field in the loss. Kyle Kuzma handled the scoring load for the purple-and-gold, finishing with 25 points, five rebounds, four assists, two steals and one block in 31 minutes. Montrezl Harrell also scored in double figures for the Lakers with 14 points, six rebound and four assists. Alex Caruso made his third consecutive start, finishing with eight points, a season-high seven assists and two steals. Paul George paced the Clippers with 24 points, seven rebounds and five assists as Kawhi Leonard pitched in 15 points, eight rebounds, six assists and one block.

Los Angeles fell behind by as many as 14 points, but used a strong second half performance to grab their biggest win of the season as they beat the Sacramento Kings, 117-92, on Tuesday night. The Lakers held the Kings to just 33 points in the second half and rode a 40-8 run to grab control of the game en route to the 25-point win. Dwight Howard had his best game of the season as he came off the bench and finished with 12 points, 13 rebounds, two steals and two blocks in 35 minutes. Anthony Davis had 25 points, seven rebounds, three assists, two steals and two blocks, while Russell Westbrook tallied 23 points, five rebounds, six assists and one steal. Malik Monk led the second unit with 22 points, four rebounds and four assists and Carmelo Anthony scored 14 points in 19 minutes off the bench. Richaun Holmes led the Kings with 27 points (12-12 FG), eight rebounds, two assists and two blocks.

LAST TIME OUT:

- Los Angeles picked up their biggest win of the season as they beat the Sacramento Kings by 25 points, overcoming a 14-point deficit to grab the win
- Dwight Howard tallied his first double-double of the season as he recorded 12 points, 13 rebounds, two steals and two blocks. Howard was a +27 in 35 minutes off the bench
- Malik Monk scored 22 points (6-10 3FG) and was a season-best +33 in his 33 minutes off the bench

HOT-N-READY COMEBACK: The Lakers picked up their largest come-from-behind victory as they overcame a 17-point deficit on 11/21/21 at Detroit to beat the Pistons by a final score of 121-116. It marks the team's largest comeback since they erased a 20-point Memphis lead on 2/12/21.

- Anthony Davis finished with 30 points, 10 rebounds, six assists, four steals and five blocks in 40 minutes. The performance marked the first time that Davis has tallied 30+ points, 10+ rebounds, 5+ steals, 4+ steals and 5+ blocks in a game. He became just the fourth player in NBA history to tally such statistics, joining Hakeem Olajuwon, Kareem Abdul-Jabbar and Michael Jordan.
- Carmelo Anthony led the second unit with 18 points (5-8 3FG), two rebounds and two blocks in 30 minutes. It was the sixth time this season that he has made at least five three-pointers in a game. The only other seasons that Anthony had more games with 5+ triples was 2013-14 (8) and 2017-18 (7).

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: In his 19th season in the NBA, Carmelo Anthony is finding himself right at home with the Los Angeles Lakers. Through 14 regular season games at STAPLES Center, Anthony is shooting 50 percent (46-92 3FG) from three-point range in the Lakers home arena. His shooting percentage at STAPLES Center would rank first in the league among three-point shooters. Including road contests, Anthony is currently shooting at a career-high 42.1 percent clip on the year.

ALAMO-T: The Lakers picked up their first overtime victory of the season on 10/26 at San Antonio, securing a 125-121 victory. Anthony Davis and Russell Westbrook each grabbed a 30-point double-double in the win. The Lakers overcame a 12-point deficit in the win, marking their second consecutive win where they had to overcome a double-digit deficit. The win also marked the 400th career victory for Head Coach Frank Vogel.

AGING LIKE FINE NINE: Carmelo Anthony continued to climb up the NBA's all-time scoring list as he passed Moses Malone for ninth all-time on 10/24 vs. Memphis

- Anthony finished with a team-high 28 points, three rebounds, one assist, one steal and two blocks on the historic night.
- He shot 10-15 from the field and 6-8 from three-point range, marking his 20th career game with at least six three-pointers made

NBA'S 75TH ANNIVERSARY TEAM: To celebrate the NBA's 75th anniversary, a group of 76 players were named to the 75th Anniversary Team to as the Greatest Players in NBA History. Four Lakers players were honored on the team, including Carmelo Anthony, Anthony Davis, LeBron James and Russell Westbrook. The quartet were just four of 11 active players to receive the honor.



DAILY DOUBLE DIGITS: LeBron James opened his 19th season in the NBA with a 34-point performance, ensuring that his double-digit scoring streak would continue.

- With a 26-point performance on his 36th birthday on Dec. 30, 2020, James extended his double-digit scoring streak to 1,000 consecutive games, becoming the first player in league history to reach that mark.
- James's double-digit scoring streak – which began on Jan. 6, 2007 – has far eclipsed Michael Jordan's previous NBA record of 866 consecutive 10-point performances from 1986-2001.
- James has finished with 10+ points in all but eight regular season contests in his career.
- In league history, there have only been seven streaks in which a player has finished in double figures in 500+ consecutive contests (see chart).

The active leader in wins, James is one of 18 current or former NBA players to achieve the 800 career wins milestone

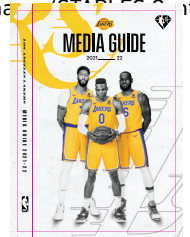
WELCOME BACK: During the 2021 off-season, the Lakers welcomed back six players who had formerly suited up for the purple-and-gold. Trevor Ariza, a member of the 2009 Championship Team, returned after spending last season with the Miami Heat. Kent Bazemore (2013-14) and Wayne Ellington (2014-15) each spent one season with the Lakers and will look to bring their sharp-shooting back to Los Angeles. Also returning to the team are three members of the 2020 Championship Team, Avery Bradley, Dwight Howard and Rajon Rondo.

RUSS IS HOME: On August 6, the Lakers completed a five-team trade to bring Russell Westbrook back to Los Angeles. Westbrook, the NBA's all-time leader in triple-doubles, went to high school in Lawndale and played two seasons at UCLA, averaging 8.3 points, 2.4 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.0 steal.

LAKERS x BIBIGO: The Lakers announced a multi-year global marketing partnership with Bibigo, a brand by the No. 1 food company in Korea. The global marketing partnership establishes Bibigo as the first international partner ever for the Lakers and will include a large-scale integrated marketing program, including courtside branding (baseline courtside apron and rotational LED signage), social and digital fan focused campaigns. In addition, the two companies will collaborate on various community initiatives within the greater Los Angeles area including the Lakers "In the Paint" fine art program, which will showcase original works of BIPOC artists and the Lakers Global Mural series campaign which will feature Lakers mural artwork around the world.
