Recorded 19 points, six rebounds, eight assists, and two steals in 37 minutes vs. BOS on 3/7 ... In the game prior, he posted 28 points, seven rebounds, nine assists, and one steal in 42 minutes vs. PHX, marking his 180th career game with 20+ points.

Raptors President, **Masai Ujiri**, served as the Nuggets Executive Vice President of Basketball Operations for three seasons (2010-13) ... Raptors Assistant General Manager **Dan Tolzman** worked for the Nuggets under Ujiri as the scouting coordinator and worked prior as the Nuggets media relations manager ... Raptors Assistant Coach, **Jim Sann**, attended the University of Colorado ... **Jamal Murray** and Raptors F **Kelly Olynyk** are both from Canada ... **Olynyk** and Nuggets F **Julian Strawther** both played for Gonzaga ... **Murray** and Raptors G **Immanuel Quickley** both played at Kentucky ... Raptors G/F **Bruce Brown** played one season for the Nuggets, in 80 games (31 starts), he averaged 11.5 points, 4.1 rebounds, 3.4 assists, and 1.1 steals while helping the Nuggets secure their first-ever NBA Championship.





RED HOT SINCE THE BREAK

It is officially the point in the season where the Nuggets find themselves in a battle for position and every win or loss is crucial. Denver has opened the post All-Star break looking every bit of their championship selves with an NBA best 7-1 record. It continued in a playoff atmosphere against the Boston Celtics on 3/7 where the Nuggets took down the Celtics 115-109. **The Nuggets shot 50% (45-90) from the field, while Boston shot 45.1% (41-91 FG), marking the 29th game this season Denver shot 50% or better, the Nuggets are now 27-2 overall and 17-1 at home when shooting 50% FG or better. All around the Nuggets are clicking at the right time and their numbers in key categories are trending in the right direction.**

MPJ'S PERFECT NIGHT

Michael Porter Jr. has looked like a new man after the All-Star break, and he is playing his best basketball of the season. Porter Jr. was locked in for the Nuggets road matchup against the Lakers on 3/2, posting one of the best stat lines of his career. He recorded 25 points on a perfect shooting night, going 10-10 from the field and 5-5 from three-point range to help the Nuggets win their eighth straight game over the Lakers 124-114. **It was his third time scoring 30+ this season, all coming with a double-double (32-8 all-time when he records a double-double) and the 14th time in Porter Jr's career scoring 30+ points in a game (12-2 in those games)**

Porter Jr. is the first player in NBA history to have 10+ FGA's and 5+ 3PA's without missing a shot in a game and is the first Nuggets player to record 25+ points, 5+ three-point attempts and 100% shooting in a game.

FIVE STRAIGHT W's

With a finals rematch looming against the Miami Heat on the second night of a back-to-back, the Nuggets kept their win streak alive taking down the Heat 103-97 at Ball Arena. It was their fifth straight victory out of the all-star break and their fast start helped get the victory. They led by 16 after the first quarter and still have only lost two home games in team history when leading by 16+ after the first quarter (in 1992 and 1999).

Jamal Murray left the game early with an ankle injury and Michael Porter Jr. stepped up. MPJ posted a game-high 30 points (12-23 FG, 4-10 3FG, 2-2 FT), 11 rebounds, three assists, two steals, and two blocks in 38 minutes. It marks the first time in his career posting those numbers and it is his 12th double-double of the season (had 15 last season).

BACK-TO-BACK SUCCESS

Denver has had their share of success this season in back-to-backs, and it continued 2/23 at Portland. After taking down the Wizards the night prior, the Nuggets beat the Trail Blazers 127-112, moving to 7-4 on the season in the second game of a back-to-back. It marked the fifth time this season the Nuggets shot 50% from the field in all four quarters and since the All-Star break they have shot 50% in all eight quarters.

Michael Porter Jr. led the way for Denver posting a season-high 34 points on 13-21 shooting, 12 rebounds and one assist in 35 minutes. It was his second straight game with a double-double and the 11th of the season. Jokic and Porter Jr. each scored 29 points and grabbed 12 rebounds, making it just the fourth time in franchise history teammates had 29+ points and 12+ rebounds in the same game. Collin Gillespie shined off the bench as well, playing the best game of his young career, recording 18 points (7-9 FG's, 4-4 3FG's), four assists and two rebounds off the bench in 24 minutes.

TOTAL TEAM EFFORT

Following the All-Star break, Denver Nuggets basketball was back on full display as the team hosted Washington on 2/22. The Nuggets used an all-around team performance to secure the 130-110 win, snapping their three-game losing streak. **The goal was to attack the rim early and Denver took full advantage, recording a season-high 28 points in the paint in the first quarter and finished the game outscoring the Wizards 88-42 in the paint. Some more highlights from the victory:**

- The win marked the Nuggets' third time this season with 10+ blocks and 10+ steals ... The team had just three such games in the previous nine years.
- Michael Porter Jr. recorded 22 points, 11 rebounds, and two assists in 30 minutes, marking his 10th double-double of the season ... Last season, he had three double-doubles.
- Christian Braun registered 12 points, 10 rebounds, one assist, and two steals in 23 minutes, marking his first career double-double ... Braun also set a new career-high in rebounds.

WIRE-TO-WIRE IN LA

The Nuggets had a much deserved three days off between games before heading to LA to take on the Lakers for their first game of a back-to-back on 2/8. The fresh legs were noticeable as the Nuggets controlled the game throughout, they closed the final two minutes with a 10-2 run to win 114-106. **It marked the Nuggets fourth wire-to-wire win of the season and their third ever against the Lakers. A few other notes from the win:**

- Denver's big three of Jokic, Murray and Porter Jr. combined for 80 points, 28 rebounds and 22 assists.
- The Nuggets attempted 15 less free throws than the Lakers. It was the sixth time this year that the opponent has had 15 or more free throw attempts than Denver with this being their first win in those games.
- Since 1996-97, it was just the third time that Denver had more dunks (8) than free throw attempts (7).

WATSON'S WINNING WAYS

In just his second season, Peyton Watson has shown incredible improvement on both ends of the floor, solidifying himself in the Nuggets rotation and a key part to their repeat goals. Watson's energy was contagious in the Nuggets 112-103 win over the Portland Trail Blazers on 2/4, as he played another great two-way game. He led the Nuggets bench with 12 points (5-6 FG, 2-3 3FG), six rebounds, one assist, two steals, and one block in 29 minutes, making it his second straight game scoring 10+ points off the bench.

It was also the second time this season Watson has finished consecutive games shooting 75% FG or better (finished 6-8 FG, 2-2 3FG vs. POR on 2/2). Last season, Watson had one streak of two or more games shooting 75% FG or better.





JAMAL STAYING HOT

Jamal Murray has been red hot over the last month and is looking more and more like a Western Conference All-Star. Murray impressed in the Nuggets 113-107 home win over the Milwaukee Bucks on 1/29, as he finished with a game-high 35 points (13-22 FG, 9-10 FT), two rebounds, five assists, and two steals in 35 minutes. His free throw makes and attempts marked new season-highs and he finished the first half with 21 points, marking the fourth time this season he's had 20+ points in the first half (each of those games came this month and Denver is 4-0 in that span).

In 14 games in January, Murray is averaging 24.1 points, 6.9 assists and 3.7 rebounds while shooting 49.0% from the field and 36.5% from three in 34.0 minutes. He's also scored 25+ points in six games and had 20+ points in all but three games.

ROLLING ALONG AT BALL ARENA

After nearly two weeks on the road the Nuggets returned home to take on the Philadelphia 76ers in front of another sold out crowd. Denver showed up and despite tired legs, took down the Sixers 111-105, moving their record to 18-4 at Ball Arena, the third best home record in the NBA. The big three of Murray, Porter Jr. and Jokic proved to be tough as they combined for 69 points, each scoring 20+ points for the fifth time this season (4-1). **As a team, the Nuggets finished shooting 45.1% from the field, continuing to hold the top spot in the NBA for the best field gold percentage at home and overall, they rank fourth in the league in FG%.**

DYNAMIC DUO SHINES

In a game that felt like a playoff matchup in many ways, the Nuggets entered a hostile environment at TD Garden on 1/20 to take on a Boston team that was 20-0 at home. As they have on many occasions before, Jamal Murray and Nikola Jokic put Denver on their back and willed the team to a 102-100 victory. Murray led all scorers, posting 35 points on 15-21 shooting, eight rebounds and five assists in 37 minutes while Jokic added 34 points, 12 rebounds and nine assists in 38 minutes.

They combined to shoot 29-43 from the field (67%) becoming just the second duo in Nuggets franchise history to 30+ points each at Boston. As well, since the merger Jokic and Murray become the eighth set of teammates (second since 1996), to both score 34+ points at TD Garden.

STARTING FIVE FIRING ON ALL CYLINDERS

Denver hosted a Sunday matinee against the Indiana Pacers on 1/14, before setting out on their longest road trip of the season (five games). The starting group for the Nuggets put on a show for the fans, taking down the Pacers 117-109 winning their seventh straight game against Indiana. That unit was red hot as they scored a season-high 106 points on 70% FG led by Jokic (25 points), Porter Jr. (25 points) and Gordon (20 points).

It marked just the ninth time since 1991 three Nuggets starters scored 25+ points in game and the first time since 2/8/22 four Denver players scored 20+ points. As well, it is the first time in franchise history that four starters each had 20+ points on 60%+ shooting.

MPJ HITTING THE BOARDS

Michael Porter Jr. has been hitting the boards all season and it has been a key factor to another fast start from the Nuggets. Porter Jr. posted 20 points, 10 rebounds, one assist, one steal, and one block in 33 minutes to help the Nuggets take down the Pelicans 124-113 on 1/12. **It's his ninth double-double of the season and 40th career game with 10+ rebounds. His nine double-doubles are already tied for the second most in a season in his career (15 in 2020-21).**

When MPJ rebounds, it usually means good things for the Nuggets as they are now 10-2 in games where he grabs 10+ rebounds. Compared to last season he already has eight more games with 10+ boards.

MURRAY BOUNCES BACK

After a rough shooting night in a home loss to Orlando on 1/5, Jamal Murray bounced back as he always does with a huge performance against the Detroit Pistons on 1/7. Murray finished with 37 points, five rebounds, four assists, one steal, and one block in 30 minutes, leading the Nuggets to a 131-114 win. It marked the 12th time in his career finishing with 35+ points as Denver moved to 10-2 in those games.

Murray was red hot from the jump as he scored 24 of his 37 in the first half. It was the sixth time Murray scored 24+ points in a first half and just the second time in his career doing so with 10+ FGM.

FOURTH QUARTER COMEBACK

On the first night of a road/home back-to-back the Nuggets won in dramatic fashion, knocking out the Warriors 130-127 behind Nikola Jokic's game winner. **The Nuggets trailed the Warriors 123-105 with 6:51 to play but closed on a 25-4 run to steal the victory.**

Aaron Gordon led the way in the fourth quarter, scoring 15 points to finish with a season-high 30 to go along with nine rebounds and two assists. Peyton Watson shined once again off the bench, posting 19 points on 6-10 shooting and five rebounds in 19 minutes. A few other highlights from the win:

- **The 18-point deficit tied the 17th biggest comeback win in team history.**
- **It was just the fifth time since 1996 that Denver trailed by 18+ in the fourth quarter and won.**
- **The 10th time in Nuggets history winning a game when trailing by 13+ after three quarters.**





SECOND STRAIGHT WITH 20

The Joker joined a list of NBA greats after another masterful performance in front of a sold-out crowd at Ball Arena on 3/7. Jokic finished with a team-high 32 points (11-19 FG, 10-10 FT), 12 rebounds, 11 assists, and two steals in 38 minutes helping the Nuggets take down the Boston Celtics 115-109. **It marked his 20th triple double of the season, making him the fourth player in NBA history to record 20+ triple-doubles in multiple seasons after recording 29 last season.**

ASSISTING SEASON AFTER SEASON

Despite the 117-107 loss to the Phoenix Suns at home on 3/5, Nikola Jokic once again sees his name at the top of the Nuggets record books. The Joker finished with 25 points (8-18 FG, 4-7 3FG, 5-7 FT), 16 rebounds, and five assists in 44 minutes setting a new season-high in 3FG. **The 16 rebounds moved him to 7,011 in his career, becoming the first player in franchise history to record 7,000 rebounds.**

As well, Jokic now has 560 assists on the season, joining Fat Lever as the only players in Nuggets franchise history to have five straight seasons recording 550+ assists. Outside of Jokic and Lever, the Nuggets have only had six other players finish with 550+ assists in a season,

FOUR IN A ROW

Nikola Jokic is currently on one of the most impressive streaks of his career, and it kept rolling Wednesday night vs. Sacramento on 2/28. The Joker recorded another triple double, posting 14 points (5-9 FG's), 14 rebounds and 11 assists in 32 minutes, finishing with a +37, the second-best mark of his career.

It was his fourth straight triple-double (all coming in wins), making it the fourth time in his career he has had four straight. Even more impressive is all of them have come before the start of the fourth quarter, Jokic joins Russell Westbrook as the only players since 1997-98 to post a triple-double before the fourth quarter in at least four consecutive games.

THREE STRAIGHT MASTERPIECES

The big man from Sombor Serbia, continues to do things few others have done before him. For the third straight game after the All-star break, Jokic was incredible, this time helping the Nuggets to a 119-103 win over the Golden State Warriors on 2/25. It moved Denver to 3-0 after the break with each win coming by 15+ points, the last time a Nuggets team did that was in December 2017. Jokic finished with 32 points (13-24 FG's), 16 rebounds, 16 assists, four steals and one block in 37 minutes for his 123rd career triple double and the 18th of the season. It is the seventh time in his career recording a triple double in three straight games and has only done so in four games in row three times. A few more notes from his huge three game stretch:

- **First player in NBA history with three straight games with 14+ rebounds and 14+ assists.**
- **Third game of his career posting 30+ PTS, 15+ AST, and 15+ REB, passing Wilt Chamberlain (2) and trailing Oscar Robertson (11) for second-most such games all-time.**
- **In his last three games, has had 82 points, 50 rebounds and 45 assists, while shooting 70.4% from the field and has a combined +/- of +67. No NBA player since at least 1975-76 has had a three-game span with 82/50/45.**
- **Second player ever with 30 points, 15 rebounds, 15 assists and four steals in a game since steals became official in 1973-74.**

BACK-TO-BACK WORKS OF ART

Nikola Jokic has maintained his dominate self and fresh out of the break, Jokic has done exactly that. The big man finished with another triple double on the second night of a back-to-back at Portland on 2/23. He posted 29 points, 15 rebounds and 14 assists in 35 minutes helping the Nuggets secure a 127-112 victory. The big fella had it going early recording 13 points, 11 rebounds and seven assists in the first half. Since 1996-97, there has been 11 times in the NBA a player has had 13+ points, 11+ rebounds and 7+ assists in a first half, Nikola Jokic has done it three of those times.

It is the 25th time in his career having a triple double in consecutive games (including four straight three times and three straight three times) but just the eighth time he has done it in back-to-back games. Over the last two games, Jokic posted 50 points, 34 rebounds, 29 assists on 22-27 shooting with fewer field goals missed than free throw attempts (7).

TRIPLE DOUBLE AROUND THE ASSOCIATION

The Joker and the Nuggets returned to action in front of the 27th consecutive sold out crowd at Ball Arena on 2/22. After a lengthy All-Star break and with every game mattering for the fight at the top of the Western Conference for playoff seeding, the Nuggets snapped their three-game losing streak taking down Washington 130-110. **Jokić once again led the way for Denver, posting 21 points (10-10 FG), 19 rebounds, 15 assists, and one steal in 31 minutes. The triple double marks the 121st of his career and he joins LeBron James and Russell Westbrook as the only players in NBA history to record a triple double against every franchise they have faced. The perfect night also had a few other highlights:**

- It is the fourth time in Jokic's career collecting a triple-double with perfect shooting from the field, setting an NBA record ... Wilt Chamberlain has three career triple-doubles with perfect shooting, followed by Draymond Green who has two.
- Now has three career games shooting 100% FG with 10 or more attempts, including two from this season (Howard – 3 games, Chamberlain – 8 games).





20/20/10 EXCLUSIVE

After sitting out in the Nuggets road loss to the Oklahoma City Thunder due to low back pain, the Joker returned and dominated in historic fashion against the Trail Blazers on 2/2. The big man posted 27 points (11-16 FG, 1-1 3FG, 4-4 FT), 22 rebounds, 12 assists, one steal, and two blocks in 38 minutes becoming the first player in NBA history to record that stat line in a game helping the Nuggets win 120-108. It also marked his 15th triple double of the season and his second straight doing so before the fourth quarter.

Jokić now has 15 career games grabbing 20+ rebounds, only two other players in franchise history have more such games (Dikembe Mutombo, 19 and Marcus Camby, 24). Finally, this marks the sixth time in his career posting 20/20/10, joining some all-time greats doing so six or more times.

A TRIPLE-DOUBLE MASTER CLASS

Nikola Jokić and the Nuggets came to Indiana riding a two-game winning streak and needing a win to guarantee a winning five game road trip. Jokić and Jamal Murray delivered, as the duo each scored 30+ points, carrying Denver to a 114-109 win. It marked the ninth time ever that Jokić and Murray both scored 30+ points in the same game with Denver moving to 9-2 in those games. Jokić was his normal dominant self, finishing with 31 points (13-9 FG's, 3-4 3FG's, 2-2 FT's), 13 rebounds and 10 assists in 37 minutes for his league leading 13th triple double of the season.

The Joker now has 10 career 30+ point triple doubles with one or fewer turnovers (including four this season). Nobody else in NBA history has more than two in their career.

ANOTHER LIST WITH ALL-TIME GREATS

The Nuggets continued along on their five-game road trip taking on the Washington Wizards on 1/21. Nikola Jokić was aggressive from the jump, making sure to set the tone and the Nuggets followed, winning 113-104. In the first half, the Joker posted 26 points on 10-13 shooting, six rebounds, five assists, two blocks and one steal in 19 minutes, becoming the first NBA player since at least 1996-97 to have those numbers in any half. **For the game, Jokić finished with a season-high 42 points on 15-20 shooting, 12 rebounds and eight assists in 36 minutes, once again landing him on an elite list of some of the NBA greats.**

JUST CAN'T MISS

Once again, the big man in the middle for the Nuggets is shooting the basketball at a clip rarely seen before in NBA history. The Nuggets hosted a Sunday matinee against the Indiana Pacers on 1/14 and Jokić tallied 25 points (12-13 FG, 1-2 FT), 12 rebounds, nine assists, two steals, and one block in 33 minutes, leading Denver to their 28th win of the season.

It is the third time in a calendar year he has reached 25+ points, 12+ rebounds, and nine or more assists on 90+% shooting. Outside of Jokić, that stat line has only been achieved five times in NBA history with the last time being in 1998. As well, over his last nine games, Jokić is shooting 85-105 from the field. It is the first time in NBA history a player has shot 80% from the field or better in a nine-game span (min. 100 attempts).

DOING WHATEVER IT TAKES

Nikola Jokić will flat out do whatever it takes to win a basketball game. He proved exactly that on 1/7 vs. Detroit, as he posted four points (2-3 FG's), seven rebounds, 16 assists, and five blocks in 24 minutes, helping Denver win 131-116 for their 26th win of the season. The line from the Joker was one of the more unique in NBA history, a few notes from the win:

- **One of two NBA players since 1982-83 to have 16+ assists and five or more blocks in a game ... The other player was Nuggets' Jalen Rose (16 assists, six blocks vs. BOS on 2/18/96).**
- First player since Russell Westbrook on 12/8/15 to have 16+ assists in under 25 minutes.

SHOOTING LIGHTS OUT

The Joker has been almost automatic shooting the ball from all over the floor the last four games. It continued at Golden State on 1/4, as Jokić posted 34 points (13-16 FG's), 10 assists and nine rebounds while hitting a game winning three at the buzzer to cap the Nuggets 18-point comeback. The big man is on a stretch of near perfection, going 39-44 from the field during the four-game stretch. Jokić once again joins only Wilt Chamberlain on a list of NBA history. Since Wilt, he has the highest FG% over a four-game span in the shot clock era (since 1954-55) with a minimum of 40 attempts.

THE PERFECT TRIPLE DOUBLE

As if achieving a triple double isn't hard enough, Nikola Jokić made it look easy in front of the home crowd against the Memphis Grizzlies on 12/28. The Joker put on show, not missing a shot the entire night. He finished with 26 points on (11-11 FG's, 1-1 3FG's, 3-3 FT's), 14 assists and 10 rebounds for his league leading 11th triple double of the season and 116th of his career.

He became the first player to post a 20+ point triple-double on 100% shooting (FG's, 3FG's, and FT's). It also marks the third time in his career he has a perfect shooting triple double, joining Wilt Chamberlain as the only players to have three or more.





- **The Nuggets** defeated the Boston Celtics 115-109 at Ball Arena **on 3/7**, moving their record to 7-1 since the All-Star break ... Michael Malone enters his ninth season as head coach of the Denver Nuggets. He was named the 16th head coach in Denver's NBA franchise history on June 15, 2015. He is now the fourth longest tenured coach in the NBA and currently ranks third all-time amongst Nuggets head coaches with 367 wins.

Last season saw Coach Malone lead the Nuggets to their first NBA Championship in franchise history, ending a 47-year long drought. They finished the regular season with a 53-29 record as they clinched the number one overall seed in the Western Conference and playoff berth for the fifth straight year. Denver finished the postseason with a 16-4 record, losing only one home game during the postseason and never having a series go over six games.

Malone has helped lead the Nuggets to at least one playoff series victory in four of the last five seasons. Since 2018-19, Denver has eight playoff series victories, which doubles the franchise total for the previous 32 years. Malone has totaled 37 postseason wins, ranking him first all-time in franchise history for most playoff victories passing Doug Moe with 24.

Since Malone took over prior to the 2015-16 season, the Nuggets have seen the postseason on five occasions including an NBA Championship and two Western Conference Finals appearances in 2020 and 2023. The Nuggets are also second in the NBA, trailing only the Milwaukee Bucks for the most combined regular season and postseason wins in a five-year span with 285. Additionally, based on winning percentage, Malone has overseen four of the top ten seasons in NBA franchise history.

Malone has 406 victories as an NBA head coach and possesses over 26 years of coaching experience, 22 coming in the NBA with six different teams – New York, Cleveland, New Orleans, Golden State, Sacramento and Denver. The teams that Malone has been a member of the coaching staff have amassed 14 playoff appearances, including two NBA Finals showing and four conference finals appearances. Malone and his staff have also been selected to coach two All-Star games, most recently in 2023 where he coached Team LeBron at the in Salt Lake City, UT, falling to Team Giannis 184-175.

Before joining the Nuggets, Malone served as the head coach of the Sacramento Kings for two seasons. Before his time with the Kings, Malone was the lead assistant for the Golden State Warriors under Mark Jackson from 2011-13 where they clinched a postseason berth in 2013, their first since 2007.

Prior to Golden State, Malone worked as the lead assistant to Monty Williams in New Orleans and helped the Hornets achieve a 46-36 record and a trip to the 2011 NBA Playoffs. The Hornets were the most improved defensive team in the NBA in 2011, allowing a league-best 8.7 fewer points per game than in the previous campaign (94.0 ppg, after giving up 102.7 ppg in 2009-10).

Malone also served as an assistant coach under Mike Brown for the Cleveland Cavaliers for five seasons, during which the Cavs posted a 272-138 (.663) record, the third-best mark in the NBA over that span. The Cavaliers made five consecutive playoff appearances during Malone's time on the bench, reaching the NBA Finals in 2007 and the Eastern Conference Finals in 2009. In 2008-09, the Cavs notched a franchise record and NBA-best 66 wins, with Malone and the rest of the team's staff earning the right to coach the Eastern Conference All-Star squad. In 2009-10, the Cavaliers again captured the league's best regular season record with 61 wins.

Malone's NBA coaching career began with a four-season stint with the New York Knicks, where he originally joined Jeff Van Gundy's staff as a coaching associate in the summer of 2001, and was promoted to assistant coach in May 2003.

Before joining the NBA, Malone coached seven years in the college ranks, with his last stop coming at Manhattan College where he was the lead assistant. During the 1998-99 season Malone worked at the University of Virginia as its director of men's basketball administration. Malone also spent three seasons (1995-96 – 1997-98) at Providence College under New York Basketball Hall of Fame coach Pete Gillen after beginning his coaching career working for Greg Kampe at Oakland University in Michigan.

Malone is a three-time participant in the NBA's "Basketball Without Borders" program, having coached at the league's global outreach camps in Africa (2017), Puerto Rico (2006) and Argentina (2005). In 2017 Malone traveled to Johannesburg, South Africa where he spent a week coaching at the BWW camps and then served as an assistant coach for Team Africa, for the NBA Africa Game 2017.

Malone also served as an assistant coach for the Canadian Men's Senior National Team for three years. He helped guide the Canadian team to a top-four finish in the 2009 FIBA Americas Championship in Puerto Rico, qualifying Canada for the 2010 World Championships.

A native of Queens, New York, Malone played college basketball at Loyola College in Maryland, where he graduated with a BA degree in 1994. He is a graduate of New Jersey's Seton Hall Prep where he played two years under Bob Farrell. Malone also played a season under Tom Blackburn at Worcester Academy (Mass.).

Michael is the son of longtime NBA coach Brendan Malone, who coached for over 28 years in the league. He and his wife, Jocelyn, have two daughters, Caitlin and Bridget.

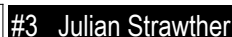
