Timberwolves C **Rudy Gobert** was drafted by the Denver Nuggets in the first round (27th overall) of the 2013 NBA Draft, then traded in a draft night trade for the 46th overall pick, **Erick Green**, and cash considerations ... Timberwolves C **Karl-Anthony Towns** and Nuggets G **Jamal Murray** played at Kentucky ... Timberwolves head coach **Chris Finch** was an assistant with the Nuggets during the 2016-17 season ... Timberwolves F **Kyle Anderson** (2012-14), **Jaylen Clark** (2020-23), and Nuggets F **Peyton Watson** (2021-22) attended and played at UCLA ... Timberwolves G **Monte Morris** was drafted by the Nuggets (second round, 21st pick, 51st overall) in the 2017 NBA Draft ... **Morris** played for the Nuggets from 2017-22, appearing in 280 games (105 starts) and averaging 10.5 points, 2.3 rebounds, and 3.7 assists in 25.2 minutes ... Nuggets G **Justin Holiday**, Timberwolves F **Kyle Anderson**, and Timberwolves G **Mike Conley** played together while in Memphis during the 2018-19 season ... **Holiday** also played with Timberwolves F **TJ Warren** while in Indiana during the 2019-22 seasons ... ### RAINING THREE'S

With playoff seeding implications in every game down the stretch, the Nuggets helped their cause taking down the Atlanta Hawks 142-110 at home on 4/6. The victory tied the Nuggets for the second-most wins in franchise history, moving them to 54-24 overall. The Nuggets came out of the gates red hot from downtown, as they knocked down a season-high 23 three-pointers and tied their season-high in points for the third time (142). The Nuggets are 11-0 this season when finishing with 130+ points (with nine of those games coming at home). As well, for the first time this season, Denver shot 50%+ from the field and scored 30+ points in all four quarters.

Kentavious Caldwell-Pope led the Nuggets with 24 points (9-12 FG, 6-9 3FG), two rebounds, one assist, and two steals in 27 minutes, marking a new season-high in points and tying his season-high in 3FG. Caldwell-Pope was +21, his 12th game this season with a +/- of 20 or higher, marking more than he's had in the last two seasons combined.

### PLAYOFFS CLINCHED

After losing two straight home games, the Nuggets faced the Cleveland Cavaliers on Sunday afternoon and delivered for the home fans. Denver took down Cleveland 130-101, winning their 52 game of the season. With the victory, it guaranteed the Nuggets make the playoffs, being the first team from the Western Conference to lock up a spot. The Nuggets have now qualified for the playoffs in six straight seasons, the longest streak amongst all franchises in the Western Conference.

### MARCH MADNESS

Denver is closing the season strong, and the month of March has been good for the Nuggets. With their win over the Memphis Grizzlies on 3/25, Denver moved their record to 15-2 since the all-star break. It also marked the Nuggets' third time finishing with 10+ wins in a month this season (finished 10-5 in December and 10-5 in January), last season, the Nuggets finished with 10+ wins in a month only twice. Denver hasn't finished with more than 12 wins in a month over the last three seasons but still have three games remaining in March.

For the first time this season, the Nuggets are leading the league in monthly assists per game with 30.8. Denver is also shooting a season-best 51.9% FG and 40.1% 3FG (minimum five games played) in the month of March.

### ANOTHER 50-WIN SEASON

The Nuggets continue to be one of the most successful franchises in the league and with their win over the Portland Trail Blazers on 3/23, Denver moved their record to 50-21 on the season, the first team in the west to win 50 games. Missing two starters, Christian Braun rose to the occasion recording 17 points on 7-15 shooting, eight rebounds, six rebounds, three steals and one block in 36 minutes. He became the first Nuggets bench player to have 17+ points, 8+ rebounds, 6+ assists, 3+ steals and 1+ block in a game.

With the win, it is the third 50-win season in the Michael Malone era and their second straight. It also marks the fastest ever that the Nuggets reached 50 wins in an NBA season. In 2012-13 (when winning franchise-most 57 games) and again last year Denver won its 50th game in game 74.

### SEASON TO REMEMBER FOR MPJ

Michael Porter Jr. has officially etched himself into Nuggets history, this time atop the single season three-point record. MPJ was great all around against the New York Knicks on 3/21, posting 31 points on 13-16 shooting (3-6 3FG's) and eight rebounds in 37 minutes helping the Nuggets to the victory. He now has 193 threes on the season, marking the most in a single season in Nuggets franchise history (Dale Ellis, 192), and now finds himself on that list twice, sitting in fourth as well (170 in 20-21).

Porter Jr. has 4,020 career points in 256 games with the Nuggets. The only other Nuggets players to amass that many points or more in 256 games or fewer is David Thompson (6,721 points in 256 games), Carmelo Anthony (5,988 points in 256 games), Larry Jones (5,746 points in 225 games), and Kiki Vandeweghe (5,723 points in 256 games).

### MURRAY DISHING THE ROCK

The Blue Arrow this season has been getting everyone involved and his assist numbers show it. Murray helped the Nuggets end their five-game road stand with a big win over the Minnesota Timberwolves on 3/19. He posted 16 points, along with 11 assists and eight rebounds in 32 minutes, helping the Nuggets regain the #2 seed in the Western Conference. With 13 games remaining, Murray has 356 assists just 44 shy of his career-high for a season (400).

As well, Murray now has nine games this season posting at least 10+ points and 10+ assists, while only having 12 other such games since joining the NBA in 2017.

### 20 ROAD WINS AND COUNTING

Denver has been rolling on the road as of late and it's a big reason why they find themselves in the number one spot in the West. Their winning ways continued in Austin, Texas on 3/15 as they took down the San Antonio Spurs 117-106 to move their record to 47-20 on the season. It is their fifth straight road victory, making them the first team in the NBA this season to have two separate five game road win streaks. As well, all five victories have come by 10+ points, marking the first time in team history they Nuggets have done that.

Finally, after the win, it moved the Nuggets road record on the season to 20-14, the seventh time in team history winning 20+ games on the road. Denver joins the Celtics and Clippers as the only NBA teams to win 20+ road games five times in the last six years.

## RED HOT SINCE THE BREAK

It is officially the point in the season where the Nuggets find themselves in a battle for position and every win or loss is crucial. Denver has opened the post All-Star break looking every bit of their championship selves with an NBA best 11-1 record. It continued in a playoff atmosphere against the Miami Heat on 3/13 where the Nuggets took down the Heat 100-88. **The Nuggets have won eight consecutive regular season games against the Heat, tying for the longest active win streak against any NBA team (Pacers). As well, the Nuggets have shot 50%+ FG in 29 of the 40 quarters (60%+ 12 times) since the break. All around the Nuggets are clicking at the right time and their numbers in key categories are trending in the right direction. As well,**

## COMEBACK FOR THE WIN

The Nuggets finished out their five game homestand with a contest against the Toronto Raptors on 3/11. Denver fell behind early, trailing by as many as 22 points in the third quarter but flipped a switch, outscoring the Raptors 74-51 in the second half to win 125-119. **Jamal Murray and Nikola Jokić led the way, as Murray finished with 26 points, five rebounds, 12 assists, and two blocks in 39 minutes, tying his season-high in blocks for the 10th time this season. Jokić added a triple-double posting 35 points (14-26 FG, 1-3 3FG, 6-6 FT), 17 rebounds, 12 assists, six steals, and two blocks in 38 minutes. A few more notes from the victory:**

- It was third time since 97-98 in which Denver trailed by 21+ points in the third quarter and won (1/18/2019 at Memphis, down 25; and 2/10/2020 vs. San Antonio, down 23).
- The Nuggets have won 13 of their last 15 home games.
- Nikola Jokić and Jamal Murray each recorded 25+ points and 10+ assists for the fourth time as teammates during the regular season and postseason ... It marks the most by a duo in NBA history ... It's also just the second time in NBA history that two teammates had 25+ points and 12+ assists in the same game.

## 1<sup>ST</sup> HALF FOR THE AGES

After two big matchups at home against the Suns and Celtics the Nuggets finished off the week with a Saturday night game against the Utah Jazz. Denver used a huge first half to get out to a big lead, scoring a season-high 142 points and took down Utah by 21 for their seventh wire-to-wire win of the season. The start of the game was dominated by the Nuggets, scoring a season-high tying 78 points on 66% shooting while making a season-high for half 14 three pointers in the first half. It was just the fourth time since 1996-97 the Nuggets had 14+ 3FG in a half.

## MPJ'S PERFECT NIGHT

Michael Porter Jr. has looked like a new man after the All-Star break, and he is playing his best basketball of the season. Porter Jr. was locked in for the Nuggets road matchup against the Lakers on 3/2, posting one of the best stat lines of his career. He recorded 25 points on a perfect shooting night, going 10-10 from the field and 5-5 from three-point range to help the Nuggets win their eighth straight game over the Lakers 124-114. **It was his third time scoring 30+ this season, all coming with a double-double (32-8 all-time when he records a double-double) and the 14<sup>th</sup> time in Porter Jr's career scoring 30+ points in a game (12-2 in those games)**

**Porter Jr. is the first player in NBA history to have 10+ FGA's and 5+ 3PA's without missing a shot in a game and is the first Nuggets player to record 25+ points, 5+ three-point attempts and 100% shooting in a game.**

## FIVE STRAIGHT W's

With a finals rematch looming against the Miami Heat on the second night of a back-to-back, the Nuggets kept their win streak alive taking down the Heat 103-97 at Ball Arena. It was their fifth straight victory out of the all-star break and their fast start helped get the victory. They led by 16 after the first quarter and still have only lost two home games in team history when leading by 16+ after the first quarter (in 1992 and 1999).

**Jamal Murray left the game early with an ankle injury and Michael Porter Jr. stepped up. MPJ posted a game-high 30 points (12-23 FG, 4-10 3FG, 2-2 FT), 11 rebounds, three assists, two steals, and two blocks in 38 minutes. It marks the first time in his career posting those numbers and it is his 12<sup>th</sup> double-double of the season (had 15 last season).**

## BACK-TO-BACK SUCCESS

Denver has had their share of success this season in back-to-backs, and it continued 2/23 at Portland. After taking down the Wizards the night prior, the Nuggets beat the Trail Blazers 127-112, moving to 7-4 on the season in the second game of a back-to-back. It marked the fifth time this season the Nuggets shot 50% from the field in all four quarters and since the All-Star break they have shot 50% in all eight quarters.

**Michael Porter Jr. led the way for Denver posting a season-high 34 points on 13-21 shooting, 12 rebounds and one assist in 35 minutes. It was his second straight game with a double-double and the 11<sup>th</sup> of the season. Jokić and Porter Jr. each scored 29 points and grabbed 12 rebounds, making it just the fourth time in franchise history teammates had 29+ points and 12+ rebounds in the same game. Collin Gillespie shined off the bench as well, playing the best game of his young career, recording 18 points (7-9 FG's, 4-4 3FG's), four assists and two rebounds off the bench in 24 minutes.**

## TOTAL TEAM EFFORT

Following the All-Star break, Denver Nuggets basketball was back on full display as the team hosted Washington on 2/22. The Nuggets used an all-around team performance to secure the 130-110 win, snapping their three-game losing streak. **The goal was to attack the rim early and Denver took full advantage, recording a season-high 28 points in the paint in the first quarter and finished the game outscoring the Wizards 88-42 in the paint. Some more highlights from the victory:**

- The win marked the Nuggets' third time this season with 10+ blocks and 10+ steals ... The team had just three such games in the previous nine years.
- Michael Porter Jr. recorded 22 points, 11 rebounds, and two assists in 30 minutes, marking his 10th double-double of the season ... Last season, he had three double-doubles.





## MOVING UP THE RANKS

Nikola Jokić is moving up the all-time scoring list in franchise history and just passed a Nuggets great. Joker posted 42 points, 16 rebounds, six assists, one steal, and two blocks in 37 minutes vs. SAS on 4/2, tying his season-high in points. **Jokić now holds the third-most points in franchise history (13,978) moving ahead of Carmelo Anthony (13,970).**

**As well, Joker tied Anthony for the second most 40-point games in Nuggets history with 19, trailing Alex English who had 40 total games.**

## ATOP THE ALL-TIME GREATS

After a two-game losing streak, the Nuggets bounced back at home against the Cleveland Cavaliers on 4/1. Denver used another all-time performance from Nikola Jokić, who posted 26 points (11-18 FG, 1-2 3FG, 3-5 FT), 18 rebounds, 16 assists, and one steal in 34 minutes. It marked Joker's 23<sup>rd</sup> triple double of the season and 128<sup>th</sup> of his career, just 11 short of passing Magic Johnson for third on the all-time list.

**Jokić now has four career games with 25+ points, 15+ rebounds, and 15+ assists while shooting 60% or better from the field. No other player in NBA history has more than three games.**

## DOMINATE DIVISION PERFORMANCE

Nikola Jokić knew it was a meaningful game from the jump and his performance showed it. The big man recording another great line, posting 35 points (14-22 FG's), 16 rebounds, two assists and two steals in 37 minutes at Minnesota on 3/19, helping the Nuggets win their 48<sup>th</sup> game of the season and regain the #2 seed in the Western Conference. **It marks the Joker's fourth game this season with 35+ points and 15+ rebounds, only trailing Giannis Antetokounmpo by one.**

## A STAT LINE NEVER SEEN BEFORE

Nikola Jokić is on pace for his third MVP and the case was added to after his huge game against the Raptors on 3/11. Jokić had one of the best stat lines the NBA has ever seen after putting up a game-high 35 points (14-26 FG, 1-3 3FG, 6-6 FT), 17 rebounds, 12 assists, six steals, and two blocks in 38 minutes helping the Nuggets to a 125-119 win. **Jokić the second player to record a triple double with 35+ points, 15+ rebounds and 6+ steals since James Harden in 2017. A few other notes from his big night:**

- Recorded his 21<sup>st</sup> triple-double of the season and 126<sup>th</sup> of his career.
- Only seven other players have recorded a 35-point triple-double with 5+ steals (all took place from 1973-1989).

## SECOND STRAIGHT WITH 20

The Joker joined a list of NBA greats after another masterful performance in front of a sold-out crowd at Ball Arena on 3/7. Jokić finished with a team-high 32 points (11-19 FG, 10-10 FT), 12 rebounds, 11 assists, and two steals in 38 minutes helping the Nuggets take down the Boston Celtics 115-109. **It marked his 20<sup>th</sup> triple double of the season, making him the fourth player in NBA history to record 20+ triple-doubles in multiple seasons after recording 29 last season.**

## ASSISTING SEASON AFTER SEASON

Despite the 117-107 loss to the Phoenix Suns at home on 3/5, Nikola Jokić once again sees his name at the top of the Nuggets record books. The Joker finished with 25 points (8-18 FG, 4-7 3FG, 5-7 FT), 16 rebounds, and five assists in 44 minutes setting a new season-high in 3FG. **The 16 rebounds moved him to 7,011 in his career, becoming the first player in franchise history to record 7,000 rebounds.**

**As well, Jokić now has 560 assists on the season, joining Fat Lever as the only players in Nuggets franchise history to have five straight seasons recording 550+ assists. Outside of Jokić and Lever, the Nuggets have only had six other players finish with 550+ assists in a season,**

## FOUR IN A ROW

Nikola Jokić is currently on one of the most impressive streaks of his career, and it kept rolling Wednesday night vs. Sacramento on 2/28. The Joker recorded another triple double, posting 14 points (5-9 FG's), 14 rebounds and 11 assists in 32 minutes, finishing with a +37, the second-best mark of his career.

**It was his fourth straight triple-double (all coming in wins), making it the fourth time in his career he has had four straight. Even more impressive is all of them have come before the start of the fourth quarter, Jokić joins Russell Westbrook as the only players since 1997-98 to post a triple-double before the fourth quarter in at least four consecutive games.**





### THREE STRAIGHT MASTERPIECES

The big man from Sombor Serbia, continues to do things few others have done before him. For the third straight game after the All-star break, Jokić was incredible, this time helping the Nuggets to a 119-103 win over the Golden State Warriors on 2/25. It moved Denver to 3-0 after the break with each win coming by 15+ points, the last time a Nuggets team did that was in December 2017. Jokić finished with 32 points (13-24 FG's), 16 rebounds, 16 assists, four steals and one block in 37 minutes for his 123rd career triple double and the 18<sup>th</sup> of the season. It is the seventh time in his career recording a triple double in three straight games and has only done so in four games in row three times. A few more notes from his huge three game stretch:

- **First player in NBA history with three straight games with 14+ rebounds and 14+ assists.**
- **Third game of his career posting 30+ PTS, 15+ AST, and 15+ REB, passing Wilt Chamberlain (2) and trailing Oscar Robertson (11) for second-most such games all-time.**
- **In his last three games, has had 82 points, 50 rebounds and 45 assists, while shooting 70.4% from the field and has a combined +/- of +67. No NBA player since at least 1975-76 has had a three-game span with 82/50/45.**
- **Second player ever with 30 points, 15 rebounds, 15 assists and four steals in a game since steals became official in 1973-74.**

### BACK-TO-BACK WORKS OF ART

Nikola Jokić has maintained his dominate self and fresh out of the break, Jokić has done exactly that. The big man finished with another triple double on the second night of a back-to-back at Portland on 2/23. He posted 29 points, 15 rebounds and 14 assists in 35 minutes helping the Nuggets secure a 127-112 victory. The big fella had it going early recording 13 points, 11 rebounds and seven assists in the first half. Since 1996-97, there has been 11 times in the NBA a player has had 13+ points, 11+ rebounds and 7+ assists in a first half, Nikola Jokić has done it three of those times.

**It is the 25<sup>th</sup> time in his career having a triple double in consecutive games (including four straight three times and three straight three times) but just the eighth time he has done it in back-to-back games. Over the last two games, Jokić posted 50 points, 34 rebounds, 29 assists on 22-27 shooting with fewer field goals missed than free throw attempts (7).**

### TRIPLE DOUBLE AROUND THE ASSOCIATION

The Joker and the Nuggets returned to action in front of the 27<sup>th</sup> consecutive sold out crowd at Ball Arena on 2/22. After a lengthy All-Star break and with every game mattering for the fight at the top of the Western Conference for playoff seeding, the Nuggets snapped their three-game losing streak taking down Washington 130-110. **Jokić once again led the way for Denver, posting 21 points (10-10 FG), 19 rebounds, 15 assists, and one steal in 31 minutes. The triple double marks the 121<sup>st</sup> of his career and he joins LeBron James and Russell Westbrook as the only players in NBA history to record a triple double against every franchise they have faced. The perfect night also had a few other highlights:**

- It is the fourth time in Jokić's career collecting a triple-double with perfect shooting from the field, setting an NBA record ... Wilt Chamberlain has three career triple-doubles with perfect shooting, followed by Draymond Green who has two.
- Now has three career games shooting 100% FG with 10 or more attempts, including two from this season (Howard – 3 games, Chamberlain – 8 games).

### 20/20/10 EXCLUSIVE

After sitting out in the Nuggets road loss to the Oklahoma City Thunder due to low back pain, the Joker returned and dominated in historic fashion against the Trail Blazers on 2/2. The big man posted 27 points (11-16 FG, 1-1 3FG, 4-4 FT), 22 rebounds, 12 assists, one steal, and two blocks in 38 minutes becoming the first player in NBA history to record that stat line in a game helping the Nuggets win 120-108. It also marked his 15<sup>th</sup> triple double of the season and his second straight doing so before the fourth quarter.

**Jokić now has 15 career games grabbing 20+ rebounds, only two other players in franchise history have more such games (Dikembe Mutombo, 19 and Marcus Camby, 24). Finally, this marks the sixth time in his career posting 20/20/10, joining some all-time greats doing so six or more times.**

### A TRIPLE-DOUBLE MASTER CLASS

Nikola Jokić and the Nuggets came to Indiana riding a two-game winning streak and needing a win to guarantee a winning five game road trip. Jokić and Jamal Murray delivered, as the duo each scored 30+ points, carrying Denver to a 114-109 win. It marked the ninth time ever that Jokić and Murray both scored 30+ points in the same game with Denver moving to 9-2 in those games. Jokić was his normal dominant self, finishing with 31 points (13-9 FG's, 3-4 3FG's, 2-2 FT's), 13 rebounds and 10 assists in 37 minutes for his league leading 13<sup>th</sup> triple double of the season.

**The Joker now has 10 career 30+ point triple doubles with one or fewer turnovers (including four this season). Nobody else in NBA history has more than two in their career.**

### ANOTHER LIST WITH ALL-TIME GREATS

The Nuggets continued along on their five-game road trip taking on the Washington Wizards on 1/21. Nikola Jokić was aggressive from the jump, making sure to set the tone and the Nuggets followed, winning 113-104. In the first half, the Joker posted 26 points on 10-13 shooting, six rebounds, five assists, two blocks and one steal in 19 minutes, becoming the first NBA player since at least 1996-97 to have those numbers in any half. **For the game, Jokić finished with a season-high 42 points on 15-20 shooting, 12 rebounds and eight assists in 36 minutes, once again landing him on an elite list of some of the NBA greats.**

- **Denver** beat the Atlanta Hawks at home **on 4/6**, winning their fourth consecutive game at home against Atlanta ... The Nuggets put up 27 bench points before the half and 58 overall for the game ... It marks the most bench points in a first half this season ... In the last two games combined, Denver's reserves scored a total of 26 points.
- **Denver** knocked down a season-high 23 three-pointers and tied their season-high in points for the third time (142) **vs. ATL on 4/6** ... The Nuggets are 11-0 this season when finishing with 130+ points (with nine of those games coming at home) ... Last season, Denver finished 7-0 when scoring 130+ points (nine games at home).
- **Kentavious Caldwell-Pope** led the Nuggets with 24 points (9-12 FG, 6-9 3FG), two rebounds, one assist, and two steals in 27 minutes, marking a new season-high in points and tying his season-high in 3FG **vs. ATL on 4/6** ... - **Nikola Jokic** posted 36 points on 14-24 shooting, 17 rebounds and 10 assists **at LAC on 4/4** ... He becomes the 26th player in the NBA to achieve 14,000 career points while playing with just one team ... He joins fellow Nuggets great Dan Issel in that achievement.
- **Denver** beat the San Antonio Spurs 110-105 at home **on 4/2**, clinching home court in the first round of the playoffs ... The Nuggets finished with 10 blocks and are averaging 5.5 blocks per game, marking their most BPG since the 2013-14 season ... The Spurs finished with 12 blocks, marking the second time in 10 years both the Nuggets and their opponent had 10+ blocks in a game (also happened on 12/23/23).

Porter Jr. has 14 double-doubles this season, one shy of his career-high 15 double-doubles in a single season which he set in 2020-21.
- **The Nuggets** beat the Cleveland Cavaliers 130-101 at home **on 3/31**, snapping their two-game losing streak ... For the 10th time this season, the Nuggets scored 130+ points (10-0) ... It marks the first time since the 2021-22 season Denver finished 10+ games with 130+ points (posted 11 games with 130+ points for a record of 8-3) ... Prior to doing this twice in the last three seasons, Denver hasn't done so once since the 1990-91 season.
- **Denver** concludes March 11-4 with a winning percentage of 73.3%, their best percentage of the season (minimum of five games played) ... Denver is also 23-6 against teams in the East (13-1 at home) with one final Eastern matchup remaining against the Hawks on Saturday.
- **Christian Braun** recorded 10 points, six rebounds, one assist, one steal, and one block in 28 minutes off the bench for a career-high +26 in his 75th game of the season **vs. CLE on 3/31** ... Braun, who played in 76 games last season, is averaging 3.6 rebounds (compared to 2.4 last season), 1.4 assists (compared to .8 last season), and 7.1 points (compared to 4.7 last season).
- **Denver** lost to the Minnesota Timberwolves 111-98 at home **on 3/29**, dropping their record to 51-23 on the season ... The Nuggets have failed to score 100 points in two consecutive games, prior to those games, Denver had 17 straight scoring 100+ points ... Denver is 0-8 when scoring fewer than 100 points this season and 51-15 when scoring 100+ points.
- **Nikola Jokić** posted 32 points (11-24 FG, 10-13 FT), 10 rebounds, five assists, two steals, and one block in 37 minutes **vs. MIN on 3/29**, marking his 60th double-double of the season ... - **The Nuggets** fell to the Phoenix Suns 104-97 at home **on 3/27** ... Even with the loss, the Nuggets have won nine of their last 11 games and have a record of 51-22 and 29-7 at home ... With one more home win, Denver will see it's 16th season with 30+ home wins and will be the third time in the last six years the team has done so.
- **Aaron Gordon** tallied 18 points, six rebounds, and two assists in 36 minutes **vs. PHX on 3/27**, marking the eighth time he's put up that stat line or better this season (6-2) ... The Nuggets are 24-9 this season when Gordon finishes with 15+ points ... He's three games shy of matching the number of games he had last season with 15+ points (36 games).







- **Denver** beat the Memphis Grizzlies 128-103 at home **on 3/25**, moving their record to 51-21 on the season ... For the first time in Nuggets' history, 13 different players posted at least one assist ... The NBA record is 14 which was done by the Grizzlies in November 2021 ... Denver had 37+ assists for the 11th time this season, the most of any team this year.
- **The Nuggets** shot at least 60% FG in the first half for the third time in the last four games **vs. MEM on 3/25** ... Denver finished with 53% FG, marking the 37th time this season shooting 50% or better from the field ... The Nuggets are 33-2 in those games.
- **Nikola Jokić** posted 29 points, 11 rebounds, eight assists, three steals, and one block in 30 minutes **vs. MEM on 3/25** ... Jokić has 13 games this season with three or more steals and finished last season with eight ... No other center has more than seven games with three or more steals ... Jokić career-high for games with 3+ steals in a season is 16 (2018-19).
- **The Nuggets** beat the Portland Trail Blazers 114-111 on the road **on 3/23**, moving their record to 14-2 after the all-star break ... For the fifth time this year seven Nuggets scored 10+ points (Denver 4-1) and all 5 starters scored 10+ for the 16th time (13-3).
- **Aaron Gordon** posted 22 points on 8-21 shooting, 12 rebounds and five assists in 37 minutes **at POR on 3/23** ... It marked the seventh time in his career recording 20+ points, 10+ rebounds and 5+ assists, doing so for the first time since 2020.
- **Denver** took down the New York Knicks 113-100 at home **on 3/21** ... It marked the third time this season two Nuggets have finished with 30+ points and zero or one turnover ... While it's the 13th time this season two teammates have done so, no other NBA team has done it more than twice.
- **The Nuggets** had 30 points in the paint in the second half compared to the Knicks' 10 **vs. NYK in 3/21** ... Denver finished with 66 while New York finished with 46, marking the 40th time this season the Nuggets have finished with more points in the paint than their opponent (32-8).
- **Michael Porter Jr.** finished with a game-high 31 points (13-16 FG, 3-6 3FG, 2-2 FT) and eight rebounds in 37 minutes **vs. NYK on 3/21** ... Porter Jr. has 193 three-point field goals made this season, marking the most by a player in one season in franchise history.
- **Nikola Jokić** posted 30 points, 14 rebounds, 11 assists, one steal, and zero turnovers in 39 minutes **vs. NYK on 3/21** ... Jokić has six 30-point triple-doubles with zero or one turnover this season ... The only other player this season to have done so was Domantas Sabonis (has one 30-point triple-double with zero or one turnover).
- **The Nuggets** took down the Minnesota Timberwolves 115-112 on the road **on 3/19**, finishing their road trip with a 3-1 record ... It marked the third game this season three players all had double-doubles.
- **Jamal Murray** finished with 18 points on 6-14 shooting, 11 assists and four rebounds in 32 minutes **at MIN on 3/19** ... It's his second straight game with 8+ assists and his seventh this season, more than his last three seasons combined (6).
- **Denver** fell to the Dallas Mavericks 107-105 on a last second shot **on 3/17**, just their second loss since the all-star break ... Dallas had 21 offensive rebounds compared to the Nuggets six ... The difference of 15 is the biggest in Denver history in nearly 11 years (Brooklyn +16 on 3/29/13) ... The 17-point edge by the Mavs in 2nd chance points, as well as +24 paint points, were season worsts by Denver.
- **The Nuggets** took down the Spurs 117-106 in Austin, Texas **on 3/15**, winning their fifth straight road game ... After the win, Denver improves to 19-3 when having 60+ paint points and 12-2 with 40+ bench points.
- **Jamal Murray** posted 15 points, 10 rebounds and eight assists in 34 minutes **at SAS on 3/15** ... The Nuggets are now 19-6 all-time when Murray records a triple double.
- **Denver** beat the Miami Heat 100-88 on the road **on 3/13** ... The Nuggets have won eight consecutive regular season games against the Heat, tying for the longest active win streak against any NBA team (Pacers) ... They are 21-6 against the East this season.
- **The Nuggets** have played 10 games since the all-star break, going 10-1 in those games ... Denver has outscored the opponent by 10+ points in a quarter 12 times while scoring 30+ 24 times.
- **The Nuggets** defeated the Toronto Raptors at home 125-119 **on 3/11**, ending their five game homestand with a 4-1 record ... It marked the third time since 1997-98 in which Denver trailed by 21+ points in the third quarter and won (1/18/2019 at Memphis, down 25; and 2/10/2020 vs. San Antonio, down 23).
- **Denver** finished the first half with eight turnovers **vs. TOR on 3/11** ... It marks the 26th time this season Denver has finished with fewer than 10 turnovers (20-6) ... Last season, Denver finished 15 games with fewer than 10 turnovers.

Michael Malone enters his ninth season as head coach of the Denver Nuggets. He was named the 16th head coach in Denver's NBA franchise history on June 15, 2015. He is now the fourth longest tenured coach in the NBA and currently ranks third all-time amongst Nuggets head coaches with 367 wins.

Last season saw Coach Malone lead the Nuggets to their first NBA Championship in franchise history, ending a 47-year long drought. They finished the regular season with a 53-29 record as they clinched the number one overall seed in the Western Conference and playoff berth for the fifth straight year. Denver finished the postseason with a 16-4 record, losing only one home game during the postseason and never having a series go over six games.

Malone has helped lead the Nuggets to at least one playoff series victory in four of the last five seasons. Since 2018-19, Denver has eight playoff series victories, which doubles the franchise total for the previous 32 years. Malone has totaled 37 postseason wins, ranking him first all-time in franchise history for most playoff victories passing Doug Moe with 24.

Since Malone took over prior to the 2015-16 season, the Nuggets have seen the postseason on five occasions including an NBA Championship and two Western Conference Finals appearances in 2020 and 2023. The Nuggets are also second in the NBA, trailing only the Milwaukee Bucks for the most combined regular season and postseason wins in a five-year span with 285. Additionally, based on winning percentage, Malone has overseen four of the top ten seasons in NBA franchise history.

Malone has 406 victories as an NBA head coach and possesses over 26 years of coaching experience, 22 coming in the NBA with six different teams – New York, Cleveland, New Orleans, Golden State, Sacramento and Denver. The teams that Malone has been a member of the coaching staff have amassed 14 playoff appearances, including two NBA Finals showing and four conference finals appearances. Malone and his staff have also been selected to coach two All-Star games, most recently in 2023 where he coached Team LeBron at the in Salt Lake City, UT, falling to Team Giannis 184-175.

Before joining the Nuggets, Malone served as the head coach of the Sacramento Kings for two seasons. Before his time with the Kings, Malone was the lead assistant for the Golden State Warriors under Mark Jackson from 2011-13 where they clinched a postseason berth in 2013, their first since 2007.

Prior to Golden State, Malone worked as the lead assistant to Monty Williams in New Orleans and helped the Hornets achieve a 46-36 record and a trip to the 2011 NBA Playoffs. The Hornets were the most improved defensive team in the NBA in 2011, allowing a league-best 8.7 fewer points per game than in the previous campaign (94.0 ppg, after giving up 102.7 ppg in 2009-10).

Malone also served as an assistant coach under Mike Brown for the Cleveland Cavaliers for five seasons, during which the Cavs posted a 272-138 (.663) record, the third-best mark in the NBA over that span. The Cavaliers made five consecutive playoff appearances during Malone's time on the bench, reaching the NBA Finals in 2007 and the Eastern Conference Finals in 2009. In 2008-09, the Cavs notched a franchise record and NBA-best 66 wins, with Malone and the rest of the team's staff earning the right to coach the Eastern Conference All-Star squad. In 2009-10, the Cavaliers again captured the league's best regular season record with 61 wins.

Malone's NBA coaching career began with a four-season stint with the New York Knicks, where he originally joined Jeff Van Gundy's staff as a coaching associate in the summer of 2001, and was promoted to assistant coach in May 2003.

Before joining the NBA, Malone coached seven years in the college ranks, with his last stop coming at Manhattan College where he was the lead assistant. During the 1998-99 season Malone worked at the University of Virginia as its director of men's basketball administration. Malone also spent three seasons (1995-96 – 1997-98) at Providence College under New York Basketball Hall of Fame coach Pete Gillen after beginning his coaching career working for Greg Kampe at Oakland University in Michigan.

Malone is a three-time participant in the NBA's "Basketball Without Borders" program, having coached at the league's global outreach camps in Africa (2017), Puerto Rico (2006) and Argentina (2005). In 2017 Malone traveled to Johannesburg, South Africa where he spent a week coaching at the BWW camps and then served as an assistant coach for Team Africa, for the NBA Africa Game 2017.

Malone also served as an assistant coach for the Canadian Men's Senior National Team for three years. He helped guide the Canadian team to a top-four finish in the 2009 FIBA Americas Championship in Puerto Rico, qualifying Canada for the 2010 World Championships.

A native of Queens, New York, Malone played college basketball at Loyola College in Maryland, where he graduated with a BA degree in 1994. He is a graduate of New Jersey's Seton Hall Prep where he played two years under Bob Farrell. Malone also played a season under Tom Blackburn at Worcester Academy (Mass.).

Michael is the son of longtime NBA coach Brendan Malone, who coached for over 28 years in the league. He and his wife, Jocelyn, have two daughters, Caitlin and Bridget.
