NOW TRENDING

The Pacers have won seven of their last 10 games and stand at 45-34 this season, which is currently sixth place in the Eastern Conference. Indiana has secured at least a top-8 seed in the East.

The Pacers' 51 games with 120 or more points is the most in the NBA since the Denver Nuggets posted 51 such games in 1983-84.

The Pacers won their three of their five games during their recent road trip and stand at 20-19 on the road this season. Indiana is looking to post a winning road record for the first time since the 2020-21 season and for the eighth time in NBA franchise history.

Tyrese Haliburton finished with 11 assists in Friday's win over Oklahoma City, and eclipsed Mark Jackson's single-season franchise record for assists 713 in 1997-98) with his final dime of the night.

Pascal Siakam finished with 25 points and a season-high 16 rebounds - the most by any Pacer this season - in the win at Golden State, 3/22. Siakam posted his highest scoring out-pout as a Pacer with 36 points on 16-for-29 shooting against the Lakers last Sunday. Siakam has scored 20 or more points in 13 of his last 22 games, and 20 of his 36 games overall in a Pacers uniform.

Myles Turner set the Pacers franchise record for career blocks - breaking Jermaine O'Neal's previous record (1,245) - during a five-block effort in the road win at Golden State, 3/22. Turner ranks ninth overall in the NBA this season with 1.9 blocks per game. Turner climbed into the top 60 in NBA history in career blocks with five during Monday's win over Brooklyn.

T.J. McConnell has scored in double figures in 15 of his last 19 games and 20 of his last 28 overall. McConnell now leads all bench players in the NBA in assists with 5.5 per game.

Andrew Nembhard scored a season-high 22 points to go with eight assists while filling in the starting lineup against Phoenix Jan. 26. Nembhard has battled through injuries to score in double figures in 23 of his last 38 games while averaging 10.1 points (.502 FG) and 4.1 assists per game over that span. The Pacers are 28-16 with Nembhard in the starting lineup.

Pacers Head Coach Rick Carlisle moved into 12th place in NBA history in career wins ahead of Red Auerbach (938) with last Monday's home win over the Nets. .

PACING THE FIELD

The Pacers lead the NBA in scoring this season with an average of 122.7 points this season.

Indiana has led the NBA in several offensive categories throughout most of the early portion of the regular season.

Indiana topped 120 points in seven consecutive games from Nov. 3-14, which was the longest streak in franchise history. The previous streak of consecutive games with 120 or more points was set last season (five straight from Dec. 27, 2022 - Jan. 4, 2023).

The Pacers have reached 140 or more points nine times this season (8-1 record) - which is the most in franchise history - 130 or more points 23 times (20-3) and 120 or more 50 times (38-12) through 77 games. Their 50 games with 120 or more points is the most in the NBA since the Denver Nuggets posted 51 such games in 1983-84.

The Pacers have shot 60 percent or better from the field seven times this season, most in franchise history. They set a franchise record by shooting 67.1 percent from the field (53-79) in a 126-108 road win at Atlanta Jan. 12.

Indiana rallied back from a 10-point first half deficit to earn a 132-129 home win over the Rockets, 2/6. The Pacers have now won 10 games this season after trailing by 10 or more points.

The Pacers earned a 157-152 road victory at Atlanta, 11/21, to secure East Group A in the In-Season Tournament. Indiana's 157 points set a new NBA franchise record for the most points scored, and is the highest scoring total in the NBA this season. The 309 combined team points marked the Pacers' highest-scoring game, and it was the first game in franchise history in which both teams shot 60 percent or better.

HISTORY FOR HALIBURTON

Tyrese Haliburton has posted record offensive numbers to begin the 2023-24 season. His list of achievements so far include:

- Haliburton leads the NBA with an average of 11.0 assists this season. That mark would be the most in a season since John Stockton in 1991-92 (13.7). Haliburton has recorded double-doubles in 41 games.

- He has 11 games with at least 15 assists, the most in a season in franchise history and most by any player since Russell Westbrook in 2020-21 (14).

- Haliburton returned to the lineup at Portland Jan. 19 after missing the previous five games with a hamstring strain and finished with 21 points, 17 assists and zero turnovers in 35 minutes. He is now the only player in NBA history to record three career games with 20+ points, 17+ assists and zero turnovers. All three of those games have come this season.

- He became the first player in NBA history to record multiple career games with 25+ points, 15+ assists and zero turnovers, and did so during consecutive games at Philadelphia Nov. 12 and 14...Haliburton finished with team highs of 33 points, 15 assists and zero turnovers in the team's In-Season Tournament win at Philadelphia, 11/14. He finished with a team-high 25 points, a season-high 17 assists and zero turnovers in 37 minutes at Philadelphia, 11/12...His 32 assists without a turnover is the most over a two-game span in NBA history...He later added a third game to his total as he finished with 27 points, 15 assists and zero turnovers in 37 minutes in the In-Season Tournament semifinal win over Milwaukee in Las Vegas, 12/7.

- Haliburton finished with 31 points, 12 assists, three blocks and zero turnovers in last Wednesday's win over Milwaukee. He joined Kareem Abdul-Jabbar as the only players in NBA history to record 30+ points, 10+ assists, 3+ blocks and zero turnovers in a game.

- Haliburton recorded a double-double in 11 straight games, which was the longest streak of his NBA career and the longest streak of 10+ assist games in franchise history. His 11 straight games with 10+ assists was the NBA's longest streak since Russell Westbrook posted 11 straight double-figure assist games during the 2018-19 season.

- Haliburton scored 21 points and set a new career high with 20 assists while he did not commit a turnover in the road win at Chicago, 12/28. He became the second player in franchise history to post 20+ points and 20+ assists in a game, and the second player in NBA history to record 20+ points, 20+ assists and zero turnovers (Chris Paul, 20 points, 20 assists, Dec. 10, 2016). One game later, Haliburton scored 22 points and matched a Pacers franchise record with a career-high 23 assists in the win over the Knicks, 12/30. Haliburton became only the third player in NBA history to record consecutive games of 20+ points and 20+ assists (Magic Johnson, Dec. 18-19, 1984; John Stockton, March 1-3, 1990).

- He recorded 84 assists and only six turnovers in five games from Dec. 28-Jan. 5. He is the first player with 80+ assists and six or fewer turnovers in any five-game span since individual turnovers were first tracked in 1977-78.

- Now accomplished four times in his Pacers career, he is the only player in the NBA since the start of the 2018-19 season to record at least 17 assists without a turnover.

- Haliburton led Indiana with 37 points and 16 assists in the win at Atlanta, 11/21. He set franchise records for one quarter with 26 points and seven 3-pointers in the 3rd period...He followed that effort with 33 points and 16 assists Toronto, 11/22. He became just the ninth player in NBA history to record 35+ points and 15+ assists in consecutive outings, and the first since James Harden in Nov. 2016.

- He capped the month of November with a career-high 44-point outing to go with 10 assists at Miami, 11/30. He joined Michael Jordan (March 1989) and LeBron James (Feb. 2017) as the only players to average 25+ points, 10+ assists with 50 percent shooting and 40 percent from 3-point in a single month (27 ppg, 11.8 apg, .519 FG, .447 3FG).

- Haliburton recorded his first NBA triple-double as Indiana outscored Boston 74-57 in the second half to defeat the Celtics Monday during the quarterfinal win...In addition to his triple-double, Haliburton did not register a turnover in 40 minutes. He became only the third player in NBA history age 23 or younger to record 25+ points, 10+ rebounds, 10+ assists and zero turnovers in a game (Nikola Jokic, 10/20/2018; Grant Hill, 1/13/1996).

- Haliburton was selected to his second straight NBA All-Star Game and as a starter for the first time in his career. Haliburton becomes the fourth individual and will mark the seventh time overall a Pacers player will start an NBA All-Star Game, joining Paul George (twice), Reggie Miller (once) and Jermaine O'Neal (three times).

- Overall since he was acquired in February 2022, Haliburton has appeared in 145 games with the Pacers and recorded 86 double-doubles. He passed 1,000 assists in a Pacers uniform with 10 against Detroit, 11/24, and 2,000 points against Portland, 11/27. Haliburton joined Oscar Robertson (1960-62) as the only players in NBA history to record 2,000+ points and 1,000+ assists in their first 100 games with a new team.

BENCH AND BALANCE

The Pacers currently have seven players who are averaging 10 or more points per game and have received key contributions off the bench from several players all season. The Pacers are **37-14** this season when six or more players score in double figures.

**Obi Toppin** ranks second in field goal percentage off the bench as he is shooting 57.2 percent this season. Toppin has reached double figures in scoring 18 times off the bench in his first season with the Pacers.

**Jalen Smith** has scored in double figures in 17 appearances off the bench this season for an average of 1001 points per game. He posted a season-high 20 points off the bench at New York 2/1.

**T.J. McConnell** leads all bench players with 5.5 assists per game and **10th** overall in the NBA with an assists-per-turnover ratio of 3.81. He posted season highs and his first double-double of the year with 20 points and 11 assists off the bench in the win at Miami, 12/2.

**Isaiah Jackson** ranks second among all bench players and ranks 22nd overall in the NBA with 1.18 blocks per game.

Myles Turner became one of four players in Pacers NBA franchise history to make 500 3-pointers in his career earlier this season.

With the acquisition of Doug McDermott on Feb. 8, the Pacers now have three active players on the roster in the top 15 in NBA franchise history in 3-pointers made. Entering his second tenure with the Pacers, McDermott ranks fourth in NBA franchise history in career 3-point percentage as he shot 41.1 percent over three seasons in Indiana (323-786) from 2018-21.

TURNER'S BLOCK PARTY

Myles Turner currently ranks ninth in the NBA in blocks with 1.9 per game while the Pacers rank ninth as a team with 5.7 per game.

Turner passed Jermaine O'Neal (1,245) as the franchise's career leader for blocked shots as he finished with five blocks during the road win at Golden State, 3/22.

Turner finished fifth in the NBA last season in blocks with 2.3 per game. He has ranked in the NBA's top five in blocked shots six times over the past seven seasons, including the 2018-19 and 2020-21 seasons in which he led the league in blocks. The team finished second in the league with 5.8 blocks per game in 2022-23.

Turner is in his ninth season with the Pacers after being selected 11th overall in the 2015 NBA Draft. Only seven players in NBA franchise history have completed longer tenures with the Pacers than Turner (Reggie Miller, 18 seasons; Jeff Foster, 13; Rik Smits, 12; Vern Fleming, 11; Dale Davis, 10; Austin Croshere, 9; Danny Granger, 9).

HISTORY AGAINST THE HAWKS

Indiana's record-setting offense has broken several single-game franchise records this season, multiple of which have come in games against the Atlanta Hawks.

Despite missing point guard Tyrese Haliburton in the first game after he suffered a hamstring strain, Indiana set a new franchise record for field goal percentage in a game as they finished shooting 67.1 percent from the field (53-79) in a 126-108 road win at Atlanta Jan. 12.

The Pacers posted a 150-116 win over the Atlanta Hawks Jan. 5. The Pacers finished with a franchise-record 50 assists on 60 field goals. That total is tied for the seventh-most in NBA history and was only the second time a team has posted 50 assists since 1990 (50 assists by Washington against Indiana during the 2020-21 season). Indiana also matched its season high by placing eight players in double figures. Indiana posted 150+ points for the third time this season, which is one shy of tying the record for the most in a season in NBA history (1971-72 Lakers and 1978-79 Spurs). Indiana's eight games with 140+ points is now tied for the third-most in NBA history and the most since the Denver Nuggets posted eight games with 140 or more in 1983-84.

The Pacers earned a 157-152 road victory at Atlanta, 11/21, to secure East Group A in the In-Season Tournament. Indiana's 157 points set a new NBA franchise record for the most points scored. The 309 combined team points marked the Pacers' highest-scoring game, and it was the first game in franchise history in which both teams shot 60 percent or better.

HISTORIC SHOOTING WEEKEND

Indiana turned in a historic shooting effort against Charlotte Nov. 4, as the Pacers tied NBA records for 3-pointers made in a quarter (12 in the third period) and in a half (18 in the second half). The Pacers finished with 50 points in the third quarter, which was their second period with 50+ points in NBA franchise history, trailing only a 54-point effort in the third quarter against Denver on Nov. 10, 2010. Indiana finished with 22 3-pointers on the night, falling one shy of the franchise record.

Tyrese Haliburton tied his previous career high with 43 points against the Hornets and became the first player in franchise history to record 40+ points and 10+ assists as he added 12 assists. Haliburton tied previous franchise records for one quarter as he finished with 25 points and six 3-pointers in Indiana's third-quarter effort (he later passed that mark with 26 points and seven 3s in the third quarter at Atlanta, 11/21).

The Pacers followed that effort one game later by tying their previous NBA franchise record with 152 points in a 41-point victory over the San Antonio Spurs Nov. 6. Indiana tied its NBA franchise record for points in a half by scoring 86 in the first half. It was the team's ninth-largest margin of victory in NBA franchise history, and the largest win since earning a 152-95 road win (+57) at Oklahoma City on May 1, 2021, which was also the largest margin of victory on the road in NBA history.

THE OPENING ACT

The Pacers opened the 2023-24 regular season with a 143-120 win over the Washington Wizards at Gainbridge Fieldhouse Oct. 25. The Pacers' 143 points marked their most points scored in a season opener in franchise history and was the fifth-highest total by a team on Opening Night in NBA history. It was the NBA's highest scoring total on Opening Night since the 1990-91 season.

The Pacers made 20 3-pointers in their win over the Wizards, marking their most 3-pointers made on Opening Night in franchise history. It marked the third-highest total on Opening Night in NBA history, falling short of the Chicago Bulls' record of 23 triples made on Oct. 23, 2019, a team coached by Pacers assistant Jim Boylen.

Bruce Brown set a new career high with six 3-pointers on his way to a team-high 24 points in the win. He tied Chris Duarte's 2021 record for the most 3-pointers made in an opener in team history.

The Pacers had eight players score in double figures during their Opening Night win over the Wizards, matching their 2022-23 season high, which was accomplished twice.

THE CARLISLE FILE

After he was hired in June 2021, Rick Carlisle returns in 2023-24 to continue his third tenure with the Indiana Pacers, including his second as head coach. He guided the Pacers to a 181-147 (.552) record during four seasons from 2003-07. In his first season as Pacers head coach in 2003-04, Carlisle led Indiana to a franchise-record 61 wins, posted the best record in the NBA, won a Central Division title and reached the 2004 Eastern Conference Finals.

He also served as an assistant coach for the Pacers under head coach Larry Bird from 1997-2000. Carlisle helped lead the team to three straight Eastern Conference Finals appearances, including the franchise's first appearance in the NBA Finals in 2000.

Carlisle's 286 wins stands as the most by a head coach in Pacers NBA history. He passed Frank Vogel for most on the list with Indiana's win at Miami, 12/2. He is now one of four coaches to lead two different franchises in NBA coaching victories (Red Auerbach, Phil Jackson, Lenny Wilkens).

Carlisle ranks third among active NBA head coaches in career coaching victories behind San Antonio's Gregg Popovich and Milwaukee's Doc Rivers. He reached 900 wins for his NBA career with Indiana's 152-111 win over San Antonio Nov. 6.

## ALL-STAR INDY 2024

NBA All-Star to returned to the Circle City for the first time since 1985 when Indianapolis hosted the event at the Hoosier Dome downtown. Originally announced in December 2017, Indianapolis was scheduled to host All-Star festivities in 2021 before being rescheduled to 2024 because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Bringing NBA All-Star back to Indiana has been years in the making. Larry Bird originally delivered the team's bid to host the event to NBA Commissioner Adam Silver by driving an Indy Car through New York City to the league offices in April 2017. NBA Commissioner Adam Silver announced that Indianapolis would host NBA All-Star during a press conference at Gainbridge Fieldhouse on December 10, 2017.

In the years since, leaders from Pacers Sports & Entertainment and the All-Star Host Committee - featuring the city and state's brightest leadership stars - have traveled to NBA All-Star Games every season, studying the many components of the event and how each city executes it, with the goal of integrating arts and entertainment elements throughout the downtown streets and executing the greatest and most interactive All-Star event the league has ever seen.

**Tyrese Haliburton** is putting together a historic offensive season and continues to fuel the Pacers and the best offensive attack in the NBA.

A first-time All-Star last season, Haliburton earned his second straight All-Star selection, and became the seventh Pacers starter in an NBA All-Star Game and the first since Paul George in 2015-16. He led all Eastern Conference guards in voting amongst fans, coaches and media.

Haliburton was part of the Pacers' winning team during Saturday Night's Skills Challenge. He competed in the 3-point Shootout for the second straight year after finishing as runner up in 2023.

He capped the weekend by recording 32 points, seven rebounds and six assists in the East's 211-186 victory. He finished second in All-Star Game MVP voting for the evening.

**Myles Turner** competed in the Skills Challenge for the first time in his career as part of All-Star Saturday Night at Lucas Oil Stadium and helped the Pacers' team come away with the win.

Turner is putting together arguably the most complete season on both ends of the court of his NBA career. He was a key figure in the Pacers' run to the NBA In-Season Tournament championship game as he averaged 20.2 points, 8.5 rebounds, 1.0 assist, 1.0 steal and 2.7 blocks per game over the team's six Tournament wins.

Turner continues to rank among the NBA's best shot-blockers, while his continued growth on the offensive end and the glass has paid dividends this season. Turner's productivity has generally led to success for the Pacers, as the team has posted a 17-9 record when he scores 20 or more points and a 10-4 mark when he posts a double-double.



**Bennedict Mathurin** was named Most Valuable Player in the 2024 Panini Rising Stars, which will take place on Friday, Feb. 16 at Gainbridge Fieldhouse

Mathurin, who also competed in the Rising Stars contest as a rookie at NBA All-Star 2023, is averaging 14.3 points and 3.9 rebounds per game during his sophomore season.

He was joined by two-way teammate Oscar Tshiebwe, who represented both the Pacers and Indiana Mad Ants as one of 10 G League players to be selected. Tshiebwe has averaged 12.0 points and a league-best 12.1 rebounds per game during the G League regular season.





# INDIANA'S IN-SEASON TOURNAMENT RUN



The Indiana Pacers enjoyed a magical run during the NBA's inaugural In-Season Tournament as they defeated each of the top four seeds from last season's Eastern Conference standings to earn an appearance in the Tournament's championship game. The Pacers posted a 6-0 record before falling to the Los Angeles Lakers in the title game at T-Mobile Arena in Las Vegas.

The Pacers were placed into East Group A in pool play along with three Eastern Conference playoff teams from a season ago - the Atlanta Hawks, Cleveland Cavaliers and Philadelphia 76ers - and their Central Division rival Detroit Pistons. Indiana posted a 4-0 record to earn the No. 2 seed in the East and a home matchup in the Quarterfinal round against Boston.

In front of a raucous sellout crowd at Gainbridge Fieldhouse Dec. 4, the Pacers overcame a slow start as they outscored the Celtics by 17 in the second half to earn a 122-112 victory and punch their ticket to Las Vegas for the Semifinal round.



The Pacers led by 12 at halftime and were able to weather a 43-point third-quarter storm by Milwaukee before locking down in the final period to earn a 128-119 win over the Bucks in the Semifinals in Las Vegas and earn a chance to compete for the NBA Cup.

Despite struggling from the field for much of the championship game, the Pacers cut the lead to three points with under six minutes to play in the game but were ultimately unable to make enough plays and fell to the Los Angeles Lakers, 123-109.

Tyrese Haliburton averaged 27.8 points, 5.5 rebounds and 13.7 assists per game throughout tournament play and was one of five players to earn All NBA In-Season Tournament Team honors.

Haliburton and the rest of Indiana's young core rose to the occasion and proved they are a threat in the playoff race for the remainder of the 2023-24 season.

Indiana made significant strides in 2022-03, Carlisle's second season after returning to the team. The Pacers jumped from 25 wins in 2021-22 to 35 in 2022-23 and saw the development of young talent begin to rise as Tyrese Haliburton earned his first NBA All-Star appearance and Bennedict Mathurin, the team's highest draft choice since 1988, earned NBA All-Rookie First Team honors.

He earned 242 wins over his first seven combined seasons as Pacers head coach, and is poised to pass Frank Vogel (250 wins) during the 2023-24 season as the franchise's leader in NBA coaching victories.

The Pacers made postseason appearances in each of Carlisle's first three seasons (2003-06) as head coach while winning 18 playoff games over that span. Indiana reached the Eastern Conference Semifinals in 2004-05 before falling in six games to the eventual-Eastern Conference champion Detroit Pistons.

He also served as an assistant coach for the Pacers under head coach Larry Bird from 1997-2000. Carlisle helped lead the team to three straight Eastern Conference Finals appearances, including the franchise's first appearance in the NBA Finals in 2000.

Carlisle ranks second among active NBA head coaches in career coaching victories behind San Antonio's Gregg Popovich. He entered the 2023-24 season ranked 14th in NBA history in career wins as he posted an 896-793 mark (.530) over 22 seasons as a head coach.

Carlisle has led his teams to the playoffs 15 times in his 22 seasons and ranks 17th in NBA history with 63 playoff victories.

Carlisle began his head coaching career with Detroit in 2001-02.
