### PELICANS ON THE AIR

All 82 regular season games, the entire preseason and the Pelicans' playoff contests will be heard on the team's flagship station WRNO, 99.5 FM, as the Pelicans enter their first of a multi-season agreement with iHeartMedia, Inc. **Todd Graffagnini** is in his fifth season as the radio voice of the Pelicans, **John DeShazier** is in his 12<sup>th</sup> season as color analyst and **Erin Summers** enters her third season as the sideline reporter for the Pelicans Radio team. Graffagnini and DeShazier will also host a weekly insider show featuring interviews with Pelicans players, coaches, front office executives and other quests.



The New Orleans Pelicans and Bally Sports will begin their 12<sup>th</sup> year of bringing a variety of both home and road games into the homes of the Greater New Orleans area and Gulf South region. Bally Sports is scheduled to broadcast 78 regular season games and is available statewide on cable and satellite providers. **Joel Meyers** (Playby-Play), **Antonio Daniels** (Color Analyst) and **Jennifer Hale** (Sideline Reporter) return to the broadcast team to provide viewers with an engaging viewership experience through their dynamic commentary, seamlessly blending insightful analysis with passionate enthusiasm. Included will be a live 30-minute pre and post-game show, as well as additional programming.

BSNO can be found locally on Cox (Channel 1038), AT&T U-Verse (Channel 1757), DirecTV (Channel 676-4) and Spectrum (Channel 810). Additionally, all Pelicans games will be available on Bally Sports+, a new streaming platform that will offer streaming of live Pelicans games on a direct-to-consumer basis within the Pelicans' local territory.

The Pelicans outshot the Hawks, converting 43-of-75 (.573) from the floor and 14-of-27 (.519) from three-point range, while Atlanta only shot 38-of-91 (.418) from the field and 17-of-46 (.370) from behind the arc.

. The Pelicans blocked seven shots and notched eight steals, while the Hawks only swatted four blocks and posted six steals.

The Pelicans turned the ball over 12 times leading to 18 points for the Hawks, while Atlanta only had 11 miscues that led to 21 points for New Orleans.

• New Orleans outscored Atlanta 56-38 in points in the paint and 18-15 in fast break points.

• Trey Murphy III led the way for the Pelicans, scoring a game-high 28 points, shooting 10-of-18 (.556) from the floor, including 6-of-13 (.462) from three-point distance. Murphy added seven boards and two assists in 30 minutes of play.

• In the first half, New Orleans outshot Philadelphia, converting 22-of-40 (.550) from the floor, 8-of-16 (.500) from three-point range and 11-of-12 (.917) from the free throw line, while the 76ers shot 13-of-45 (.289) from the field, 2-of-20 (.100) from behind the arc and 6-of-9 (.667) from the charity stripe. The Pelicans won the first half 63-34. The 76ers 34 first half points is the lowest point total for any half this season by Philadelphia.

The Pelicans finished the game shooting 22-of-23 (.957) from the free throw line, while the 76ers only shot 16-of-20 (.800) from the charity stripe.

New Orleans shot 11-of-31 (.355) from three-point range, while Philadelphia only converted 9-of-37 (.243) from three-point distance.

• Off the bench, Naji Marshall posted 19 points, shooting 7-of-8 (.875) from the floor, including a perfect 4-of-4 from three-point range. Marshall added four rebounds, one assist, a steal and a block in 18 minutes of action.

• The Pelicans have swept the season series 2-0 over the 76ers.

• New Orleans outshot Toronto from all three spots on the floor, shooting 53-of-105 (.505) from the floor, 24-of-49 (.490) from three-point range and 9-of-11 (.818) from the free throw line, while the Raptors only converted 36-of-93 (.387) from the floor, 13-of-44 (.295) from behind the arc and 13-of-22 (.591) from the foul stripe.

The Pelicans outrebounded the Raptors 62-45, including 17-11 on the offensive glass. This led to New Orleans outscoring Toronto 15-12 in second chance points.

• The Pelicans turned the ball over 11 times leading to just eight points for the Raptors, while Toronto had 12 miscues leading 10 18 points for New Orleans.

Trey Murphy III scored a season-high 34 points, shooting 11-of-17 (.647) from the floor, including 10-of-14 (.714) from three-point distance. His 10 made three-pointers ties a career-high. Murphy becomes the 7<sup>th</sup> player in NBA history to have two-plus games with at least 10 three-pointers made. He joins Steph Curry, Klay Thompson, Damian Lillard, J.R. Smith, James Harden and Zach LaVine. Additionally, Murphy is the 7<sup>th</sup> player in NBA history to have 10 threes in a game off the bench. Lastly, Murphy becomes the first player in franchise history with three games of nine-plus threes made and is also the only player in franchise history with multiple games of 10-plus threes made.

Pelicans Executive Vice President of Basketball Operations David Griffin was a member of Cleveland's front office from 2010-17, initially serving as the Cavaliers' Senior Vice President of Basketball Operations before being promoted to General Manager in 2014...Griffin helped guide Cleveland to three consecutive trips to the NBA Finals from 2015-17, winning the NBA Championship in 2016...Pelicans General Manager Trajan Langdon worked under Griffin in Cleveland, serving as Director of Player Administration and Basketball Operations during the 2015-16 season...Prior to his front office experience, Langdon was selected 11th overall by Cleveland in the 1999 NBA Draft, appearing in 119 games for the Cavaliers between 1999-2002...Cavaliers C Jarrett Allen played for Brooklyn when Pelicans General Manager Trajan Langdon served as the Nets' Assistant General Manager... Cleveland's Assistant Coach Greg Buckner and New Orleans' Player Development Coach Corey Brewer were teammates for one season with the Minnesota Timberwolves during the 2007-08 NBA season ... Cavaliers G Ricky Rubio played for the Phoenix Suns while Pelicans Head Coach Willie Green was the assistant coach on the staff... Cavaliers G Ty Jerome and Pelicans G Trey Murphy III played at Virginia... Pelicans F Larry Nance Jr. played for the Cavaliers from 2018-2021... Cavaliers C Damian Jones is from Baton Rouge, Louisiana... Jones played for Pelicans Head Coach Willie Green at the Warriors during the 2018-19 season, and briefly in Phoenix during the 2020-21 season... Cavaliers G Sam Merrill was originally drafted by the Pelicans in the 2nd round of the 2020 draft (60th overall)... Cavaliers G Max Strus and Pelicans C Cody Zeller were teammates on the Heat during the 2022-23 season... - New Orleans is ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> in steals per game (8.3) and are ranked 7<sup>th</sup> in the NBA in deflections per game (15.2), which has led the Pelicans to be ranked 5<sup>th</sup> in the NBA in points off of turnovers, averaging 17.6 per game.

- Ingram has connected on 152-of-321 (.474) from the mid-range so far this season, which ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> in the NBA in total FGM from this zone.
- Additionally, Ingram is sinking 2.6 field goals per game, which is ranked 5<sup>th</sup> in the NBA from the mid-range.

In His Own Zone: Zion Williamson has been making opponents pay under the basket this season.

CJ from Downtown: Pelicans guard CJ McCollum has been shooting the three ball well this season.

- During this season, McCollum is shooting 137-of-336 (.408) on above the break three-pointers, which is ranked 1st in the NBA (min. 7 3PA per game).
- Additionally, McCollum is shooting 41.7% from three-point range, which is ranked 1st in the NBA for any player attempting seven or more threes a game.

H3RB: Pelicans guard/forward Herb Jones is having his best season yet from behind the arc.

• Among all NBA players that qualify, Herb Jones is **ranked 7<sup>th</sup>** in three-point percentage, shooting 43.5% from deep range on the season. Jones' is shooting 43.5% from three-point distance on 3.5 3PA per game are both career-highs so far this season.

<u>Turbo Jones:</u> On February 22, 2024, the New Orleans Pelicans beat the Houston Rockets 127-105. Pelicans guard/forward Herb Jones posted 17 points, five rebounds, four assists and a **career-high** seven steals.

- This is only the second time this season that a player has notched seven steals in a game.
- Additionally, Jones becomes the just the fourth player in franchise history to notch seven-plus steals in a game.

First Quarter Fire: On 3/1 vs. IND, the Pelicans started off hot, scoring 48 points on 20-of-22 (.909) from the floor in the first guarter.

- The Pelicans' 48 first quarter points, ties a franchise record for points scored in any quarter.
- Additionally, the Pelicans' 20 made field goals, marks as franchise-high for most field goals in any quarter.
- In the play-by-play era (since the 1997-98 season), 20-for-22 shooting from the floor is tied for the second-highest field goal percentage by a team in a quarter with a minimum of 20 field goals attempted.
- In the first quarter, Brandon Ingram led the way for the Pelicans, scoring 19 points, shooting 9-of-11 (.818) from the floor, including a perfect 1-of-1 from three-point range. His 19 points scored in the quarter marks his **third-highest point total for any quarter in his career**.

1-of-1: On 2/5 vs. TOR, Brandon Ingram posted a season-high 41 points, nine assists, six rebounds and a block while committing zero turnovers in under 30 minutes of play.

- This performance marks the first time in NBA history that a player has posted 40-plus points, nine-plus assists, zero turnovers in 30 minutes or less.
- Ingram finished the first half with 21 points, five rebounds and four assists, while shooting 9-of-11 (.818) from the floor, including 2-of-3 (.667) from three-point range. Ingram's 81.8% field goal percentage is the **highest field goal percentage** in **any half of Ingram's career** (min. 10 field goal attempts).
- In the third quarter, Ingram scored 20 points, which is the second-most points he's scored in any quarter in his career.
- Additionally, Ingram converted 6-of-8 (.750) from three-point range in the third frame. Ingram's six made three-pointers in the third quarter marks the most threes by any Pelicans player in franchise history in a single quarter.

• With the win, New Orleans has won a road game at each of the other four Southwest division's place this season. This is the first time in franchise history that New Orleans has defeated each of the other four Southwest divisional opponents on the road in the same season.

Happy New Year: On January 2, 2024, the Pelicans started the new year off on the right foot. The Pelicans beat the Brooklyn Nets 112-85 in regulation.

- Through the first three quarters of action, New Orleans held Brooklyn to just 58 points, which marks a low in the NBA for a team through three quarters
  this season. The last team to score 58 or fewer points through the first three quarters in a regular season game was Portland (58) on March 27, 2023 vs.
  New Orleans.
- Additionally, the Pelicans finished the game with McCollum leading the way with 16 points.
  - The Last time in New Orleans franchise history to win a game by 25 or more points with no player scoring 20-plus points was 1/27/2012, when New Orleans beat the Orlando Magic 93-67. The leading scorer for the Pelicans in that game was Carl Landry with 17 points off the bench.

<u>STAT LINE:</u> On December 26, 2023, Pelicans forward Brandon Ingram posted 24 points, seven assists, six rebounds, three steals and **tied a career-high** with four blocks. This is the **third time in franchise history** that a player has posted 20-plus points, five-plus assists, five-plus rebounds, three-plus steals and four-plus blocks in a single game. The other two players two accomplish this feat were Anthony Davis (10/26/2016) and DeMarcus Cousins (2/23/2017). Additionally, this is only the 14<sup>th</sup> time in the last five years that a player has posted these numbers in a game.

2nd Quarter Eruption: On 12/13 at WAS, the Pelicans scored 47 second quarter points which marks the team's highest-scoring second frame in franchise history. Additionally, this marks the second-highest scoring quarter in franchise history. New Orleans outshot Washington during the quarter, converting 17-of-24 (.708) from the field, including 9-of-11 (.818) from behind the arc. The Pelicans also sunk a perfect 4-of-4 from the charity stripe. They held the Wizards to 11-of-21 (.524) from the field and 5-of-10 (.500) from deep. New Orleans notched four fast break points and 10 points off Washington turnovers. The Pelicans also out-rebounded the Wizards 10-3. Starters CJ McCollum and Brandon Ingram both put up 13 points in the quarter.

Inaugural In-Season Tournament: On 12/4, the Pelicans faced the Kings for the third time this season in an In-Season Tournament quarter-final. Brandon Ingram led the team with 30 points, eight boards, six assists and one steal. After falling behind early in the first quarter, New Orleans outshot Sacramento in the second frame, shooting 12-of-21 (.571) from the field, 6-of-10 (.600) from three, and 4-of-5 (.800) from the charity stripe. Leading 69-61 at the half, New Orleans maintained their lead over Sacramento for the remainder of the game. The Pelicans outscored the Kings 52-38 in the paint, and 17-13 in second chance points. The Pelicans bench proved integral in the win, totaling 29 points, three blocks, five steals and ten boards. The win marked the Pelicans' third against the Kings this season, and secured New Orleans' spot in the first-ever In-Season Tournament semifinals. The team travelled to Las Vegas, where they faced the Lakers on 12/7. The Pelicans fell 133-89 to Los Angeles, who went on to win the NBA Cup. The Pelicans return to their regularly scheduled season with a home game vs. Minnesota on Monday, 12/11.

### **David Griffin -** Executive Vice President of Basketball Operations

- In 2022-23, the Pelicans went 42-40, the team's best record since the 2017-18 season.
- In 2021-22, the Pelicans earned their first playoff berth of Griffin's tenure. The ninth-seed in the Western Conference, New Orleans won both Play-In Tournament games to clinch a First Round matchup against the Phoenix Suns, in which they pushed the one-seed to six games.

On April 17, 2019, David Griffin was named the Executive Vice President of Basketball Operations, becoming the eighth individual in franchise history to lead the organization's player and personnel decisions.

- Griffin was named the Vice President of Basketball Operations for the Cleveland Cavaliers in September 2010 and was elevated to General Manager on February 6, 2014.
- During Griffin's tenure in Cleveland, the Cavaliers reached the NBA Finals for three consecutive seasons from 2015-17, winning the NBA Championship in 2016, becoming the first team in NBA Finals history to overcome a 3-1 deficit.
- Prior to joining Cleveland, Griffin spent 17 seasons with the Phoenix Suns, moving to the basketball operations department in 1997 after beginning in media
  relations. Along the way, Griffin held titles of senior vice president of basketball operations, assistant general manager, director of player personnel, assistant director of player personnel and
  basketball operations assistant.

### **Coaching Notes**

- Appointed head coach on July 22, 2021, his first head coaching position in the NBA. Green enters his third season with New Orleans.
- On 1/7/24 at SAC, notched his 100th career win in the NBA.
- In his second season as the Pelicans Head Coach, Green led the team to a 42-40 overall record, the team's best record since 2017-18. The Pelicans finished the regular season ranked sixth in defensive rating (112.0) and ranked 10th in net rating (1.9). Green led the Pelicans to a ninth-place finish in the Western Conference, where New Orleans fell to Oklahoma City in the Play-In Tournament.
- In his first season with the Pelicans, Green led the team to its first playoff appearance since 2018. Praised around the league for his steady and calm demeanor, Green helped the Pelicans overcome a 1-12 start to the season to earn the ninth seed and reach the postseason Play-In Tournament. The Pelicans defeated San Antonio and the LA Clippers to clinch a First Round matchup against the Phoenix Suns, in which they pushed the one-seed to six games.
- Spent the previous two seasons (2019-21) as an assistant coach for the Phoenix Suns. Helped guide the 2021 Western Conference Champions to their first NBA Finals appearance since 1993. As the Suns' defensive coordinator, Phoenix finished the regular season with the NBA's sixth-best defensive rating. He also served as the Phoenix's head coach for NBA Summer League in 2019, leading the Suns to a 3-1 record in Las Vegas.
- Helped the Warriors win back-to-back NBA Championships in 2017 and 2018 before returning to the NBA Finals in 2019. He also served as the Warriors' head coach for NBA Summer League in 2018, leading Golden State to the California Classic's only 3-0 record.
- A 12-year NBA veteran as a player, Green averaged 8.3 points, 1.8 rebounds and 1.4 assists in 731 regular season games (297 starts) with Philadelphia, New Orleans, Atlanta, the LA Clippers and Orlando from 2003-2015.
- Was selected 41st overall by Seattle in the 2003 NBA Draft.
- Was a four-year standout at the University of Detroit Mercy. A native of Detroit, he won Horizon League Player of the Year as a senior in 2003 and helped the Titans to two NIT appearances in 2001 and 2002, including a trip to the semifinals at Madison Square Garden in 2001. Green remains fourth in program history in career points scored.
