TEAM NOTES

- The Toronto Raptors play their last home game of the 2023-24 campaign Tuesday night against the visiting Indiana Pacers. Toronto leads the season series 2-1, with the road team winning all three of the games thus far. The Raptors have won or tied their season series with the Pacers in 10 of their last 12 seasons (2012-13 to 2023-24).
- Toronto defeated Washington 130-122 Sunday night and have now won consecutive games (Apr. 5-7) for the first time since a season-high three-game winning streak Feb. 22-26 (which included a victory against Indiana). Sunday marked the first time in franchise history where four Raptors recorded 20 points, five rebounds & five assists in a single game (Barrett, Olynyk, Quickley and Trent Jr.). Per Stathead, it was just the eighth time in league history where four players on the same team posted 20/5/5 statlines in a game, and first since Feb. 11, 1972.
- Toronto native RJ Barrett played in his 30th game with the Raptors Sunday night against Washington. He has scored 638 points through his first 30 contests with his hometown team, while shooting career highs of .547 (249-455) from the field and .407 (46-113) from three-point range. The only player with more points through their first 30 games as a Raptor was Kawhi Leonard who scored 819 points on .497 (286-576) FG% and .361 (52-144) 3PT %.
- Rookie Gradey Dick has now scored in double figures in six straight games (Mar. 27 Apr. 7), averaging 14.7 points while shooting .466 (34-73) from the field and .414 (12-29) from three-point range over this span. The only Raptors rookies in the last 15 seasons (2009-10 to 2023-24) to record longer 10+ point streaks are Jonas Valanciunas (12 games; Mar. 15 - Apr. 6, 2013) and teammate Scottie Barnes (4X - last: Mar. 24 - Apr. 8, 2022).
- Both Toronto (1st; 19.0) and Indiana (4th; 16.4) rank in the top-five in the NBA in fast break points. Gary Trent Jr. (90) and Pascal Siakam (89) lead their respective teams in fast break points since All-Star, and rank ninth and 10th, respectively, in the NBA over that span. Toronto (4th; 54.1) and Indiana (1st; 57.6) also rank atop the league in points in the paint. The Raptors hold a +43 (66-23) advantage on the fast break and a +58 advantage in the paint (162-104) over the teams' last two match ups (Feb. 14 in Toronto and Feb. 26 in Indiana).
- Tonight marks Toronto's final home game of the season. This year will be just the second time in the last 10 seasons where the Raptors will finish below .500 at home (other: 2020-21 campaign played in Tampa where they finished 16-20). Toronto (.652) ranks sixth in the NBA in home win-loss percentage over the last 10 seasons (2014-15 to 2023-24), trailing only Golden State (.732), Boston (.695), Milwaukee (.681), Denver (.660) and LA Clippers (.660).

- Reached 6000 career points on Apr. 7 vs. WAS, becoming first player from 2019 draft class to hit the milestone.

- · Finished with nine points, three rebounds, one assist, one steal & one block in 28 minutes Apr. 7 vs. WAS
- Has scored 10+ points in seven of 23 games with Toronto; Something he did just eight times in 51 games with Utah.
- Averaging 7.4 points, 4.5 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 27.2 minutes in 15 consecutive starts for Toronto.

- · Posted 21 points, nine rebounds, five assists and three steals in 35 minutes Sunday against the Wizards.
- · Has scored in double figures in season-high eight straight games (Mar. 22 Apr. 7), averaging 14.8 points.
- Leads Raptors in rebounds (133) & steals (35) since acquired Feb. 8; Ranks second in assists (116) & blocks (18)

- Shooting .414 (109-263) from three-point range since Jan. 1; Ranks fifth in the NBA & first in East *min 250 3PA.

TORONTO - Immanuel Quickley had a season-high 31 points and 13 assists. RJ Barrett scored 22 points, and the Toronto Raptors beat Washington 130-122 ... Kelly Olynyk scored 21 points and Gary Trent Jr. had 20 as the Raptors won consecutive games for the first time since a season-best three-game streak Feb. 22-26 ... Quickley shot 9 for 15 and went 10 for 10 at the free-throw line as Toronto won a fourth straight home meeting with Washington ... Deni Avdija had 32 points and 10 rebounds, and Jordan Poole added 20 points and 12 assists for Washington ... Corey Kispert scored 21 points and Patrick Baldwin had a season-best 16 points and a career-high 11 rebounds, but the Wizards lost for the sixth time in seven ... Washington (15-64) lost 63 games in 2000-01 and again in 2008-09. The Wizards have three games remaining ... Toronto rookie Gradey Dick scored 13 points before leaving because of a sore right groin ... Washington had more turnovers (eight) than made baskets (five) in the first guarter ... The Raptors scored 15 points off Wizards miscues to lead 42-17 after one period ... Washington outscored Toronto 21-2 over the first seven minutes of the second as the Raptors missed 14 of 15 field goal attempts ... Toronto recovered to make its next eight straight shots and led 63-50 at the half ... Poole scored 17 in the third but Barret answered with 11 for the Raptors ... Toronto took a 99-87 lead to the fourth.

INDIANA — All-Star Scottie Barnes logged his fourth triple-double of the season and RJ Barrett had 24 points on Monday night to lead the Toronto Raptors to their second win this season over the Indiana Pacers, 130-122 ... Barnes had 21 points, 12 rebounds and 12 assists on a night seven Raptors scored in double figures, including rookie Gradey Dick who had 18 points and matched his season high with four 3s as Toronto won its third straight ... Bennedict Mathurin matched his career high with 34 points for the Pacers ... Two-time All-Star Pascal Siakam had 27 points, nine rebounds and six assists against his former team ... Haliburton had nine points and seven assists while going 2 of 11 from the field as the Pacers shot just 46% as a team ... Toronto built a 61-56 lead after a back-and-forth first half, and then watched Indiana score six straight in the third quarter to make it 67-66 ... The Raptors answered with an 11-0 run, only to see the Pacers charge back within 90-87 at the end of three, tie it on Mathurin's 3 to open the fourth and eventually take a 96-95 lead on Jalen Smith's putback with 10:04 to go ... Instead of pulling away, the Pacers let Toronto hang around and Dick's tie-breaking 3 with 8:01 left spurred a 10-2 run that gave the Raptors a 112-104 lead.

MILWAUKEE - Gary Trent Jr. scored 31 points and Immanuel Quickley narrowly missed a triple-double as the Toronto Raptors snapped a 15-game losing streak with a 117-111 victory over the slumping Milwaukee Bucks ... Milwaukee, playing without the injured Giannis Antetokounmpo, lost for the fifth time in its last six games, with the last three coming against Washington, Memphis and Toronto, who are all well below .500 ... Antetokounmpo sat out with a left hamstring injury ... Trent was 7 of 15 from 3-point range and helped the Raptors build a 14-point lead in the third quarter before the Bucks mounted a rally ... But Lillard fouled out with 1:48 left and Toronto held on to take the season series from Milwaukee, 2-1 ... RJ Barrett added 26 points and Quickley scored 25 while adding 11 rebounds and nine assists ... Quickley was 14 of 15 at the free throw line ... Lillard, who had missed the previous three games, led the Bucks with 36 points and six assists, while Khris Middleton had 21 points ... Bobby Portis had 19 points and 10 rebounds for Milwaukee ... The Bucks fell to 15-16 since Doc Rivers took over as coach for Adrian Griffin on Jan. 26 ... The trio of Antetokounmpo, Lillard and Middleton has been together in just six of those games ... Trent returned for the Raptors after missing two games with back spasms and Ochai Agbaji joined him in the starting lineup after sitting out the previous three with a right hip contusion ... Barrett had missed 10 of the previous 11 games.

TORONTO — Dennis Schroder scored 19 points against his former team, Trendon Watford had 11 of his season-high 19 points in the second quarter and the Brooklyn Nets snapped a six-game losing streak by beating the short-handed Toronto Raptors 96-88 ... Mikal Bridges scored 13 points and Jalen Wilson added 12 as the Nets outscored Toronto 28-19 in the fourth guarter to help Brooklyn win for the first time since March 10 ... Gary Trent Jr. scored 18 points and Javon Freeman-Liberty had 15 for Toronto ... The Raptors have lost 11 straight ... Nic Claxton had 16 rebounds for Brooklyn, one shy of his career high ... The Nets outrebounded Toronto 50-30, including a 16-8 edge on offensive rebounds ... For the second straight game, Toronto played without four regular starters, with only Trent available ... All-Star Scottie Barnes (left hand) and center Jakob Poeltl (left pinkie) remain injured ... RJ Barrett and Immanuel Quickley rejoined the team Monday after being away for personal reasons ... Earlier Monday, Toronto signed guard Kobi Simmons to a 10-day contract ... Simmons scored seven points in 17 minutes ... The Raptors had 23 assists Monday, giving them a single-season franchise record of 2,086.

ADDITIONAL TEAM NOTES ...

- The Raptors set a single-season franchise record in assists this year, surpassing the previous team best of 2085 assists set during the 2018-19 campaign.
- **RJ Barrett** was acquired via trade from New York on Dec. 30 and played in his 25th game as a Raptor Mar. 5 vs. New Orleans. Barrett totalled 513 points through his first 25 contests with Toronto, the second most in franchise history trailing only Kawhi Leonard (659).
- The Raptors signed forward-centre Kelly Olynyk to a multi-year contract extension on Mar. 4. The Raptors acquired Olynyk from the Jazz on Feb. 8. A native of Toronto, Olynyk was picked 13th overall by Dallas in the 2013 NBA Draft following three seasons at Gonzaga (2009-13).
- Toronto recorded 46 fast break points Feb. 22 vs. Brooklyn which marked the second most points in franchise history since 2000-01 (53 - Mar. 8, 2019 at NOP)
- The Raptors dished out 25+ assists in a franchise record 30 straight games (Nov. 28 - Jan. 30), averaging 30.4 over this span. Toronto's streak tied the 1984-85 LA Lakers for most consecutive games of 25+ assists in a single season.
- Scottie Barnes scored 20+ points in a career-high seven straight games (Dec. 23 Jan. 5), averaging 23.4 points and shooting .465 (60-129) from the field, including .426 (23-54) from three-point range over this stretch. Barnes joined Chris Bosh (5X last: Jan. 10 Feb. 9, 2007) and Vince Carter (2X last: Dec. 17-30, 1999) as one of just three Raptors to post seven straight 20-point performances at age 22 or younger.
- Toronto dished out 43 assists Dec. 27 at Washington. It marked a singlegame franchise record for most assists in a road game.
- The Toronto Raptors recorded a single-game franchise record 44 assists Nov.
 19 vs. Detroit. Per Elias Sports Bureau, Toronto became the first team since
 1991-92 with 44-or-more assists and eight or fewer turnovers in a single game.
- The Raptors scored a season-high 142 points Nov. 19 vs. Detroit shooting .539 (55-for-102) from the field. It marked the fifth time in franchise history Toronto has scored 140+ points in a game and set a franchise-high for points at home.
- Gradey Dick made his NBA debut Oct. 25 becoming the fourth youngest Raptor to play in a regular season game (19 years 339 days). Only Tracy McGrady (18 years 160 days), Bruno Caboclo (19 years 61 days) and Chris Bosh (19 years 219 days) were younger when making their Raptors debut.

DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ

HEAD COACH

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a life-long journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007).

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid.

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate, and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their six-year-old son, Luka.


