SEASON NOTES

RUN AS ONE: This marked the 33rd time in 52 seasons that the Rockets made the playoffs. Houston has made the postseason in a franchise-high tying seven straight seasons after missing the playoffs in three straight seasons from 2009-10 through 2011-12. All-time, the Rockets are 153-157 (.495) in the playoffs, including 98-58 (.628) at home and 55-99 (.357) on the road. The Rockets are 29-31 all-time in playoff series.

A BAKER'S DOZEN: The Rockets were 53-29 in 2018-19, marking their 13th straight season going .500 or better, joining San Antonio as the only teams to have done so over that span. Houston also has the second-highest winning percentage (.617; 648-402) of any team over that span (going back to 2006-07). Dating back to 1984-85, the Rockets have gone .500 or better in 32 of the 35 seasons (no other team has done so more than 30X).

CALL IT A COMEBACK: Here's a look at some notes from the Rockets 2018-19 season:

- The Rockets started the season 11-14 but went 42-15 over the final 57 games and posted the second-highest winning percentage (.737) of any team dating back to 12/11... Houston had the second-worst winning percentage (.440) in the Western Conference through games on 12/10.
- Houston won a season-high nine straight games from 2/23-3/11, which tied for the second-longest in the NBA this season... the Rockets lost three straight games three times this season, including two four-game streaks... Houston only lost more than two in a row once in 2017-18 (5 games).
- The Rockets were 53-29 this season and have won 50+ games in five of the past six seasons after doing so five times the 19 seasons prior.
- Houston lost its first four home games but finished the season 31-10 at Toyota Center... the Rockets have won 30+ home games in five of the past six seasons after doing so five times the 22 seasons prior... Houston won a season-high 10 straight at home from 12/1-1/7.
- The Rockets won 13 of their final 19 road games, including a season-high six straight from 2/23-3/19, after starting the season 9-13 on the road.
- Houston was 33-13 when Clint Capela, James Harden and Chris Paul played together this season after going 42-3 in 2017-18.
- The Rockets outscored opponents by an average of 4.8 points this season, including by 12.8 ppg from the start of March (final 20 games)... Houston was 45-13 in games which it led by double-digits this season and 10-24 in games in which it trailed by 10+ points (lost 13 of first 14).
- Houston won 29 games by double-digits this season, including 12 games by 20+ points... the Rockets lost by double-digits 12 times this season, including four games by 20+ points... the Rockets were 13-12 in games decided by five or fewer points this season after going 12-4 in 2017-18.
- The Rockets were 8-4 in the second game of back-to-backs this season after going 10-3 in 2017-18.
- Houston was 42-6 when leading after three quarters of play this season and 11-23 when tied or trailing.
- The Rockets were 2-4 in overtime this season after going 5-0 the previous two seasons combined.
- Houston used 20 different starting lineups this season, with the most successful being Clint Capela, Eric Gordon, James Harden, Chris Paul and P.J. Tucker (21-5 mark)... Tucker was the only Rocket to have started (and played) all 82 games.

MAMA, THERE GOES THAT MAN: James Harden averaged 36.1 points (1st in NBA), 7.6 assists (7th in NBA), 6.6 rebounds and 2.03 steals (2nd in NBA) this season. He became the first player in NBA history to have averaged at least 35.0 ppg and 7.0 apg in a single season and joined Michael Jordan (1988-89) as the only players to have averaged at least 30.0 ppg, 7.0 apg, 6.0 rpg and 2.00 spg in a season. As usual, Harden posted some impressive performances along the way:

- Led the NBA with 36.1 ppg and scored 2,818 points in 2,867 minutes of play... became the fourth different player to have averaged at least 36.0 ppg in a single season joining Elgin Baylor, Wilt Chamberlain (5 times) and Michael Jordan who was the last player to do so with 37.1 ppg in 1986-87.
 - Harden led the league in scoring by 8.09 ppg... that was the highest differential between the league's top-two qualified scorers since Wilt Chamberlain outscored Elgin Baylor by 10.84 ppg in 1962-63.
 - Harden scored at least 20 points in each of his final 57 games played, which is tied for the fifth-longest streak since the NBA/ABA merger in 1976-77.
 - **Over a span of 40 games played from 12/8-3/8 (Rockets 28-12 mark), Harden averaged 40.1 points, 7.1 assists, 7.0 rebounds and 2.2 steals.**
 - Harden surpassed his career-high for 3-pointers made in his 53rd game played this season and finished with 378 (second-most in NBA history trailing Stephen Curry's 402 in 2015-16)... Harden reached 2,000 career 3FGM vs. Sacramento on 3/30.
 - In the second part of back-to-backs this season (11 games played), Harden averaged 40.9 ppg, 8.8 apg, 6.8 rpg and 2.2 spg in 38.5 mpg.
 - Harden scored 40+ points 28 times this season (Rockets 21-7 mark)... that is the second-highest total by a player since the NBA/ABA merger in 1976-77 (Michael Jordan 37 times in 1986-87).
 - Harden scored 50+ points nine times this season and 18 times in his career (fourth-most in NBA history)... the nine 50-point games are the second-most by a player in a single season going to back 1987-88 (Kobe Bryant 10 times in 2006-07).
 - Harden scored 50+ points in consecutive games twice this season and three times in his career... that is the second-most streaks of recording 50+ points in NBA history (Wilt Chamberlain with... 23)... Elgin Baylor is the only other player with multiple streaks of scoring 50+.
 - Harden scored 57+ points six times this season, which is twice as many as any other player not named Wilt has recorded in a single season.
 - Harden had 36 points and 10 assists in 29 minutes of play at Sacramento on 4/2, marking his second game with 35+ points and 10+ assists in 30 or fewer minutes of play this season (1/11 vs. Cleveland) and the third of his career... according to Elias, no other player has done so once all-time.
 - Harden had 50 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists vs. Sacramento on 3/30, marking his second 50-point triple-double of the season (vs. LAL on 12/13) and the fifth of his career (most in NBA history)... Russell Westbrook (3) is the only player with more than two career 50-point triple-doubles.
 - Harden recorded a 40-point triple-double five times this season, including consecutive games vs. Memphis on 12/31 and at Golden State on 1/3 ... he has 13 40-point triple-doubles for his career, which is the second-highest total in NBA history (Oscar Robertson with 22).
 - Harden scored a total of 118 points over a two-game span from 3/20-3/22, tying for the highest two-game total over the past 50 seasons.
 - Harden had a career-high tying 61 points vs. San Antonio on 3/22, marking his second 60-point game of the season and the third of his career... he is tied for the fourth-most 60-point games in NBA history... the last time a player scored 60+ multiple times in a season was Kobe Bryant in 2006-07.
 - Harden had 57 points, 8 assists, 7 rebounds, 2 steals and 2 blocks at Memphis on 3/20... according to the Elias Sports Bureau, he became the first player to post those numbers in a single game since steals and blocks became official statistics in 1973-74
 - Harden scored 31 points at Atlanta on 3/19, giving him at least one 30-point game against all opposing 29 teams this season... he is the first player to accomplish that feat since the NBA expanded to 30 teams in 2004-05.
 - Harden had 41 points, 11 assists, 9 rebounds, 6 blocks and 3 steals vs. Phoenix on 3/15... according to the Elias Sports Bureau, he became the first player to post those numbers in a single game since steals and blocks became official statistics in 1973-74 (no player even had 30/10/5/3 before).
 - Harden averaged 40.1 points over a 40-game span from 12/8-3/8... according to the Elias Sports Bureau, that was the second-longest stretch of averaging 40+ points in NBA history... only Wilt Chamberlain (**515!!!!!!**) did so over a longer span.
 - Harden led the Rockets in scoring in 43 straight games from 12/1-3/8 which was the longest since a 66-game span by Michael Jordan in 1988.
 - Harden had 58 points and 10 assists vs. Miami on 2/28, marking one of his four 50 times recording 50+ points and 10+ assists this season... he has eight 50-point/10-assists games in his career; no other player has done so more than three times in NBA history.
 - Harden scored 30+ points in 32 straight games from 12/13-2/21, which was the second-longest streak in NBA history (Chamberlain w/65 games).
 - Harden had 43 points, 12 rebounds, 6 steals and 4 blocks at Utah on 2/2... the last player with 40+ points, 12+ boards, 6+ steals and 4+ blocks in a single game was Hakeem Olajuwon (43/13/8/5) at Miami on 4/8/89.
 - Harden scored at least 35 points in 11 straight games from 1/9-1/29, which was the fifth-longest streak in NBA history and the second-longest by a player not named Wilt Chamberlain (Kobe Bryant with 13 games from 1/29-2/23/03).
 - Harden was the high scorer for the Rockets and their opponent in 24 straight games from 12/13-1/29... according to ESPN, that was the second-longest streak in NBA history, trailing a 40-game span by Wilt Chamberlain.
 - Harden's points and assists accounted for an average of 61.9 points in the month of January, which was the highest in NBA history according to Elias... Harden's 43.6 ppg in January was the 7th-highest scoring average in a single month (10+ GP) in NBA history (top six by Wilt Chamberlain).
 - Harden averaged 52.2 points over a five-game span from 1/14-1/23... according to the Elias Sports Bureau, that tied for the second-longest stretch of averaging 50+ in NBA history, trailing a [cough] 116-game span by Wilt Chamberlain.
 - Harden scored a total of 261 points over a five-game span from 1/14-1/23... according to the Elias Sports Bureau, that is the second-highest five-game total over the past 50 seasons, trailing Kobe Bryant's 268 in March of 2007.
 - Harden had a career-high tying 61 points, 15 rebounds and 5 steals at New York on 1/23... he became the first player to record at least 60 points, 15 rebounds and 5 steals in a game since steals became an official statistic in 1973-74.
 - Harden's scoring and assists accounted for 50+ points in an NBA record 19 straight games from 12/13-1/19 according to the Elias Sports Bureau.
 - Harden had 58 points vs. Brooklyn on 1/16 after scoring 57 (in 34 minutes played) vs. Memphis on 1/14... according to ESPN, he joined Wilt Chamberlain as the only players to have scored 55+ points in consecutive games.
 - Harden hit at least five 3-pointers in 12 straight games from 12/19 through 1/11... no other player had a streak longer than seven games in NBA history... Harden hit 10 3-pointers in an overtime win at Golden State on 1/3, tying the franchise single game record.
 - Harden had 43 points, 12 assists and 10 rebounds in 29:34 minutes of play vs. Cleveland on 1/11... according to the Elias Sports Bureau, he became the first player in NBA history to record a 40-point triple-double while playing fewer than 30 minutes in a game.
 - Harden recorded at least 35 points and 5 assists in 10 straight games from 12/17-1/5, marking the longest streak in NBA history according to Elias.

HEAD COACH MIKE D'ANTONI

Mike D'Antoni [dan-TONE-ee] is in his third season as head coach of the Houston Rockets. He has over a quarter of a century of coaching experience, including 15 seasons as a head coach in the NBA with a career mark of 628-499 (.557) in the regular season (173-73 with Houston; .703) and 49-49 in the playoffs (23-16 with Houston). Last season, D'Antoni led the Rockets to a franchise record 65 wins after picking up NBA Coach of the Year honors in his first season with Houston in 2016-17. He became the eighth coach in league history to win multiple Coach of the Year awards and joins Gregg Popovich as the only ones who are active. D'Antoni's first Coach of the Year award came after leading Phoenix to a franchise-high tying 62 wins in 2004-05. Over a four-season span from 2004-05 through 2007-08, the Suns compiled a 232-96 (.707) mark, including back-to-back trips to the Western Conference Finals in 2005 and 2006. In addition, D'Antoni served a pair of three-year assignments for USA Basketball as an assistant coach on Mike Krzyzewski's staff, highlighted with gold medal performances in the 2008 and 2012 Olympics. USA Basketball National Teams posted a 49-1 mark with D'Antoni on staff. A dual citizen of the U.S. and Italy, D'Antoni enjoyed tremendous success as both a player and a coach in the Italian League, capturing numerous titles in both endeavors. Prior to embarking on his international career, D'Antoni spent parts of four seasons playing in the NBA and ABA during the mid-70's.
