MARCH/11-GAME WINNING STREAK RECAP



BEWARE THE IME OF MARCH

Ime Udoka was named Western Conference Coach of the Month for March. He is the seventh different coach to have won the award in franchise history and the first since Mike D’Antoni in February of 2020.

During his stint as head coach of Boston in 2021-22, Udoka was named Eastern Conference Coach of the Month in February and for the combined months of March and April. He has a career coaching record of 24-5 in March.

The Rockets went 13-2 in March despite being without leading scorer and rebounder Alperen Sengun for the final 10 games and playing without their top bench scorer Cam Whitmore for nine games.

Houston won 11 straight games from March 8-29, tying for its longest streak since a 17-game span during 2017-18.

THE STREAK IS DEAD, LONG LIVE THE STREAK

Houston had its 11-game winning streak snapped vs. Dallas on 3/31. That tied for the Rockets longest streak since a 17-game span from 1/28-3/7/18 and is tied for the longest streak by any team this season. The Rockets finished March with a 13-2 record. Here are some notes from the month and the streak:

- The Rockets went 13-2 in March after going 2-9 over the final 11 games in February... Ime Udoka has a career coaching record of 24-5 in March.
- Houston was 36-35 following Game #71 vs. Portland on 3/25, marking its first time above .500 since defeating Detroit in Game #37 on 1/12 (19-18 mark
- The Rockets played the final 10 games of March without leading scorer and rebounder Alperen Sengun and were without top bench scorer Cam Whitmore for nine games.
- The Rockets outscored opponents by an average of 9.3 ppg for the month, including by an average of 12.9 during the 11-game winning streak.
- Houston won six straight games by double-digits from 3/14-3/25, tying for the third-longest streak in franchise history.
- The Rockets scored 125+ points in three straight games from 3/19-3/23, marking their longest streak since a 3-game span from 11/13-11/16/79.
- Jalen Green averaged 27.7 ppg (49.2% FGs, 40.8% 3FGs) in March and had an average plus/minus rating of +11.3... he scored 25+ points in a career-high 8 straight games from 3/12-3/27.
- Rookie Amen Thompson moved into the starting lineup following the injury to Sengun and averaged 15.6 ppg and 9.3 rpg during the 11-game winning streak.

RECORD: Houston has lost a season-high 5 straight after winning an NBA season-high tying 11 in a row prior. The Rockets are 38-40 this season after going 22-60 in 2022-23. Houston was 4-3 at Game #7, marking its first time above .500 since Game #21 in 2020-21.

SCHEDULE: The Rockets were eliminated from Play-In/Playoff contention following their loss at Dallas on 4/7. After tonight, Houston will play its final three games on the road.

POINT DISTRIBUTION: Houston has six players with 40+ games played who are averaging at least 12.0 ppg. The Rockets had 6 players with 40+ GP average at least 12.0 ppg last season after doing so once prior in franchise history (1990-91). Dating back to 2000-01, there were 17 instances of a team having 6 players with 40+ GP average at least 12.0 ppg (3 on pace in 2023-24).

AT HOME: The Rockets have lost a season-high tying 3 straight home games after going 9-2 the 11 games prior (26-14 overall; 14-27 in 2022-23). Over a 7-season span from 2013-14 through 2019-20, the Rockets tied for the 3rd-most home victories by any team.

ON THE ROAD: Houston has lost its past 2 road games after winning 7 straight prior (longest road streak since 10 games from 2/1-3/7/18). Prior to that streak, the Rockets did not win consecutive road games this season and were 5-24 (12-26 total; 8-33 in 2022-23). Houston had the second-most road wins of any team over a four-season span from 2016-17 through 2019-20.

BIG LEADS/WINS: The Rockets are 33-11 in games in which they have led by 10+ points this season (15-10 in 2022-23) and have 21 wins by double-digits (6 in 2022-23), including 9 by 20+ (2 in 2022-23). Houston won three straight games by 18+ points from 11/4-11/8, tying for the 2nd-longest streak in team history.

SCORING MARGIN: Houston is averaging 0.8 more ppg than opponents this season. The Rockets ranked 28th in points differential in 2022-23 at -7.9 ppg.

FALLING BEHIND: The Rockets are 9-35 in games in which they trailed by double-digits this season and lost by 10+ points 17 times, including 20+ six times. Houston trailed by double-digits in 61 of the 82 games last season (7-54 mark) and lost by 10+ points 36 times, including by 20+ 15 times.

THRU THREE: Houston is 31-6 when leading after three quarters of play this season (15-12 in 2022-23) and 7-34 when tied or trailing (7-48 in 2022-23).

CLOSE GAMES: The Rockets are 10-10 in games decided by five or fewer points this season (9-8 in 2022-23), including 8-4 by three or fewer (5-4 in 2022-23).

OVERTIME: Houston is 2-5 in overtime this season: Game 1 (L) at SA; Game 24 (L) at CLE; Game 36 (L) at CHI; Game 41 (W) vs. UTA; Game #43 (L) vs. POR; Game 72 (W) at OKC; Game 78 (L) at DAL. The Rockets only played two overtime games last season (1-1 mark) and did not play more than three in any of the past four seasons.

STARTERS: Houston has used 11 different starting lineups this season, including one lineup 45 times. The Rockets used 18 different starting lineups last season, including one lineup 30 times. All five starters scored in double-figures 21 times this season (30 times in 2022-23; 13 times in 2021-22).

DUOS/TRIOS: The Rockets had multiple players score 20+ points 48 times this season, including three players 15 times and 4 once (at IND on 2/6). Houston had two players score 20+ 38 times last season, including 3+ 12 times and 4 players once. The Rockets had two players score 30+ points four times this season.

BACK-TO-BACKS: Houston is 3-10 in the second game of back-to-backs this season (2-11). The Rockets have one set of back-to-back games left (4/11 at Utah and 4/12 at Portland).

ACCOLADES FOR ALPEREN



Alperen Sengun was named Western Conference Player of the Week for games played from 1/1-1/7, becoming the first Rocket to win the award since James Harden in November of 2019 and the youngest in franchise history to have done so at 21 years old.

He suffered a right ankle sprain and a right knee bone bruise late in the fourth quarter at Sacramento on 3/10 and will miss extended time.

Sengun is averaging 21.1 ppg, 9.3 rpg and 5.0 apg while shooting 53.7% from the floor. Entering 2023-24, only 9 different players averaged at least 20.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg and 4.0 apg while shooting 53.0% or better in a season: Kareem Abdul-Jabbar (6x), Giannis Antetokounmpo (5x), Charles Barkley (4x), Wilt Chamberlain (6x), Brad Daugherty (once), Joel Embiid (once), Nikola Jokić (3x), Karl Malone (once) and Domantas Sabonis (once).

Dating back to 1975-76, Sengun is the 12th different player (32nd time over that span) to have reached his totals of points, rebounds and assists through the first 63 games played of a season.

Through games played on 4/7, Sengun was one of six players averaging at least 21.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg and 5.0 apg this season, joining Antetokounmpo, Luka Dončić, Embiid, Jokić and Julius Randle.

He is the first player to have reached his totals of points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks through the first 210 games of a career since Chris Webber in the mid-90's. Sengun joined Dončić and Magic Johnson as the only players under 22 to have reached his totals of points, rebounds and assists through the first 200 games played of a career.

CONGRATS JALEN



Jalen Green was named Western Conference Player of the Week for games played from 3/11-3/17, marking his first time winning the award.

Over the past 37 games, Green is averaging 23.0 ppg (44.8% FGs), 5.8 rpg and 4.1 apg after averaging 17.1 ppg (39.8% FGs), 4.6 rpg and 3.1 apg the first 41 games.

In March (Rockets 13-2 mark), Green ranked fifth in the NBA in scoring with 27.7 ppg on 49.2% shooting and he had an average plus/minus rating of +11.3 for the month.

In 2023-24, Green is the only player within the first three seasons of a career averaging at least 18.0 ppg, 4.0 rpg, 3.0 apg & 2.0 3FGM.

During March, Green became the sixth player to have recorded at least 4,000 points and 500 3FGM within the first 220 games played of a career, joining Luka Dončić, Anthony Edwards, Damian Lillard, Donovan Mitchell and Trae Young.

CALL IT A COMEBACK

Houston has 38 wins this season after recording 22 in 2022-23. That is the fifth-best improvement in win totals from one season to the next in franchise history:

+22 wins: 1967-68 to 1968-69
+19 wins: 1983-84 to 1984-85
+19 wins: 1977-78 to 1978-79
+18 wins: 2005-06 to 2006-07
+16 wins: 2022-23 to 2023-24

MOVING ON UP

Over the past three seasons, the Rockets had the fewest wins in the NBA and ranked towards the bottom of the league in several major categories. Here's how Houston's rankings this season compare to those from the past three seasons combined:

Through games played on 4/7, Houston was allowing the 12th-fewest points in the NBA this season (113.3) after allowing the most over the past three seasons (117.9).

Over a 10-game span from 11/4-11/24, the Rockets held opponents to an average of 99.4 points. The last time Houston held opponents below 100.0 ppg over a 10-game span was from 10/30-11/17/18.

NEVER TELL US THE ODDS

Houston is 9-18 in games in which it was outshot and outrebounded this season after going 4-94 over the past three seasons combined.

3-POINT BARRIER

Houston has held opponents below 10 3FGM 19 times this season after doing so seven times in 2022-23.

Through games on 4/7, the Rockets ranked fourth in 3-point defense (.351) and were allowing the 9th-fewest 3FGM (12.4 per). Houston was 27th in 3-point defense in 2022-23 (.374) and last in 3FGM allowed (14.5 per).

NOT IN THE GIVING MOOD

The Rockets have committed 12 or fewer turnovers 40 times this season after doing so 10 times in 2022-23.

Through games played on 4/7, Houston was averaging the ninth-fewest turnovers this season (12.8 tpg) after ranking 30th over the past three seasons combined (15.9 tpg). The Rockets averaged a franchise-low 13.3 tpg in 2018-19.

SHOTS SHOTS SHOTS SHOTS

Houston is averaging 90.8 FGA this season. Dating back to 1986-87, the Rockets only averaged at least 90.0 FGA in a season once (90.4 in 2019-20).

The Rockets have taken at least 100 shots 8 times this season. That is tied for Houston's highest seasons total (8 times in 2019-20) since doing so 12 times in 1990-91.

TIGHT KNIT GROUP

Only 17 different players have appeared in a game for Houston this season and the Rockets haven't had a player appear in a game who wasn't with the team from the start of the season. That would be fewest players used in a season since 17 Rockets saw action in 2008-09 (15 in 2006-07). Houston used an NBA single-season record 30 different players in 2020-21,

PICK 'EM

Of the 18 players on the Rockets roster, four were Top-5 picks (Jalen Green 2nd, Jabari Smith Jr. 3rd, Amen Thompson 4th, Jeff Green 5th).

Six others were picked in the first round (Steven Adams 13th, Tari Eason 17th, Aaron Holiday, Alperen Sengun 16th, Cam Whitmore 20th, Reggie Bullock Jr. 25th)

One was a second round pick (Dillon Brooks 45th).

Seven were undrafted (Nate Hinton, Jock Landale, Boban Marjanović, Jermaine Samuels Jr., Jae'Sean Tate, Fred VanVleet, Nate Williams).

SCHEDULE NOTES

The Rockets played seven of their first nine games at home this season. Houston did not play its seventh home game until Game #18 last season.

From 11/17-12/8, Houston played seven of 10 on the road.

The Rockets played 11 of 15 at Toyota Center from 12/11-1/6, including a seven-game homestand after Christmas to close out that stretch.

Heading into All-Star Weekend, Houston played 13 of 20 on the road from 1/8-2/14.

Post All-Star break, Houston will not play more than three consecutive games at home or on the road.

MEET THE STAFF

Here is a quick look at head coach Ime Udoka's assistant coaches for his first season with the Rockets:

Ben Sullivan: Spent the past two seasons as an assistant coach with Boston, including on Udoka's staff in 2021-22.

Royal Ivey: Spent the past three seasons as an assistant coach with Brooklyn, including alongside Udoka in 2020-21.

Garrett Jackson: Spent the past two seasons as a player enhancement coach for Boston, including on Udoka's staff in 2021-22.

Tiago Splitter: Spent the past four seasons as an assistant coach with Brooklyn, including alongside Udoka in 2020-21.

Cam Hodges: Spent the past three seasons as a coaching associate with the Clippers and worked alongside Udoka with Philly in 2019-20.

Mike Moser: Player enhancement coach for Boston last season after serving as an assistant coach for the Oregon Ducks women's team in 2021-22.

AGE GAP

Heading into last season, nine Rockets were 21 or younger (Josh Christopher, Tari Eason, Usman Garuba, Jalen Green, KJ Martin, Daishen Nix, Alperen Sengun, Jabari Smith Jr., TyTy Washington Jr.).

Houston only had four players who were 25 or older at the start of 2022-23 (Jae'Sean Tate 26, Eric Gordon 33, Garrison Mathews 25, Boban Marjanović 34). Gordon and Mathews were traded in February.

Half of the 18 players on the Rockets opening night roster this season were 27 or older.

THE YUTES

Jabari Smith Jr. and Tari Eason were both selected to the NBA All-Rookie Second Team in 2022-23 after Jalen Green earned First Team honors in 2021-22 and Jae'Sean Tate was named First Team in 2020-21.

Houston joined Detroit as the only teams to have at least four All-Rookie selections over the past three seasons.

The previous four franchises to have at least four All-Rookie selections over a three-year span were Memphis (2019-21), the Los Angeles Lakers (2016-18), Philadelphia (2016-18) and Denver (2015-17).

MINUTE DETAILS

Last season, 75% of the minutes played by the Rockets roster came from players who were with the team in 2021-22. That marked Houston's highest percentage of minutes played in a season from returning players since having 85% in 2015-16 from 2014-15.

Heading into this season, returning players accounted for 49.8% of the Rockets minutes played in 2022-23.

DID I HEAR A NINER IN THERE?

Houston acquired a total of nine players from the first round of the draft over the past three years: Amen Thompson and Cam Whitmore in 2023; Jabari Smith Jr., Tari Eason and TyTy Washington Jr. in 2022; Jalen Green, Alperen Sengun, Usman Garuba and Josh Christopher in 2021.

From 2016-2020, the Rockets did not acquire any players from the first round of the draft.



TEEN TIME

Cam Whitmore, who was the 20th overall pick by Houston in the 2023 NBA Draft, will be 19 years old for the duration of his rookie season.

Dating back to 2021-22, seven different teenagers have appeared in a game for Houston (Josh Christopher, Usman Garuba, Jalen Green, Daishen Nix, and Alperen Sengun in 2021-22, Jabari Smith Jr. in 2022-23, Whitmore in 2023-24).

Prior to that, the late Eddie Griffin (2001-02) was the only teenager to have appeared in a game for Houston.



BET ON YOURSELF

The Rockets signed free agent Fred VanVleet on 7/7/23. He spent his first seven seasons with Toronto.

VanVleet went undrafted in 2016 and played 37 games as a rookie in 2016-17 while averaging 2.9 ppg.

He was a finalist for the Sixth Man of the Year award in his second season, helped Toronto win its first championship in his third season, became a starter in his fourth season and made his first All-Star appearance in his sixth season in 2021-22.

RIGHT SAID FRED

Fred VanVleet averaged at least 6.0 apg, 1.50 spg and 3.0 3FGM in each of the past three seasons.

Stephen Curry (6 times), **James Harden** (4 times) **Kyle Lowry** (once) are the only other players to have averaged those numbers.

Over the past five seasons, VanVleet was one of seven players with at least 1,500 assists to have an assist-to-turnover ratio of 3.00 or better.

Over the past four seasons, VanVleet joined **LaMelo Ball** as the only players to have averaged at least 19.0 ppg, 6.0 apg, 4.0 rpg and 1.50 spg.

VanVleet joins **James Harden** and **Deron Williams** as only players in NBA history to have recorded a 50-point game, a 20-assist game and to have hit at least 10 3FGM in a game.



BROOKS WAS HERE

Houston acquired Dillon Brooks via a sign-and-trade with Memphis on 7/8/23 as part of a five-team deal.

Brooks was originally the 45th overall pick by the Rockets in the 2017 NBA Draft before his rights were acquired by the Grizzlies. He spent his first six seasons with Memphis.

Over the past four seasons, Brooks was one of five players with 150+ GP to have averaged at least 16.0 ppg in fewer than 30.0 mpg.

WHO ARE THE FIVE BEST DEFENDERS OF ALL-TIME? DILLON, DILLON, DILLON, DILLON & DILLON

Dillon Brooks was named NBA All-Defensive Second Team last season. The last time the Rockets had a player named to an All-Defensive Team was Patrick Beverley in 2013-14.

Of players who averaged at least 30.0 minutes played with 30+ GP last season, Brooks ranked tied for fourth in defensive rating (108.5).

Brooks also ranked sixth in defensive field goal percentage (.446) among players with 30+ GP who defended an average of at least 12.0 shots per game.

After helping Canada defeat Team USA in the bronze medal game of the FIBA World Cup, Brooks was named Best Defensive Player of the event by the organization.



IT'S NOT EASY BEING GREEN

Jalen Green became the fifth player who had at least 1000 points and 200 FTA as a rookie to have increased their totals by at least 500 points and 200 FTA in their second season, joining **Jerry West**, **Nate Archibald**, **Dave Bing** and **Bob McAdoo**.

Back to 2000-01, Green was the 7th player to have at least 1,600 points, 280 rebounds and 280 assists in their second season, joining **Luka Dončić**, **Donovan Mitchell**, **Damian Lillard**, **Derrick Rose**, **LeBron James** and **Dwyane Wade**.

JALEN'S JUMP

Jalen Green averaged 22.1 points in 2022-23, up from 17.3 ppg his rookie season. Going back to 1980-81, here is the list of guards who averaged at least 22.0 ppg in their second season:

SEN-GOOD

Last season, **Alperen Sengun** became the fourth player 20 or younger for the majority of a season to have averaged at least 14.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg and 3.0 apg joining **Luka Dončić** (2019-20), **Antoine Walker** (1996-97) and **Chris Webber** (1993-94).

Back to 1983-84, Sengun was the fourth center to have averaged at least 14.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg and 3.0 apg in their first or second season joining **Joel Embiid** (2nd season in 2017-18), **Nikola Jokić** (2nd season in 2016-17) and **Webber** (1st season in 1993-94).

Sengun also became the fourth different player to have recorded at least 1,100 points, 650 rebounds and 250 assists while playing fewer than 2,200 minutes in a season, joining **Giannis Antetokounmpo** (3x), **Jokić** & **Domantas Sabonis** (2x).



JUNIOR MINT

Jabari Smith Jr. was 19 years old for the duration of his rookie season and earned NBA All-Rookie Second Team honors.

He is the first player in NBA history to have his totals of points, rebounds, blocks and 3FGM through the first 151 games played of a career.

Smith tied for the fourth-most double-doubles (16) by a player 19 or younger and became the youngest player in NBA history to have recorded at least 20 points and 10 rebounds in three straight games (3/9-3/13/23).

He joined **Luka Dončić** as the only rookies to have recorded at least 550 rebounds and 100 3FGM and Smith had the second-most 3FGM (118) by a rookie listed 6'10" or taller in NBA history.



PLAY 'EM LIKE TARI

Tari Eason was the 17th pick in the 2022 NBA Draft and joined Jabari Smith Jr. as an NBA All-Rookie Second Team selection.

He is the second player to have reached his totals of points, rebounds, assists, steals, blocks and 3FGM through the first 104 games of a career (Antoine Walker).

He became the fourth player to have averaged at least 9.0 ppg, 6.0 rpg and 1.00 spg in fewer than 22.0 mpg in a single season and just the second going back to 1981-82 (Nikola Jokić in 2015-16).

Eason was the fifth rookie to have recorded at least 450 rebounds, 90 steals, 40 blocks and 50 3-pointers joining Carmelo Anthony, Larry Bird, Lamar Odom and Walker.



BIG MAN TATE

Jae'Sean Tate missed 51 games last season after appearing 148 of a possible 154 games over his first two seasons.

He is one of 19 players to have reached his totals of points, rebounds, assists, steals, blocks and 3FGM through the first 244 games of a career.

Tate is in his fourth season and is the longest tenured Rocket.



UNCLE JEFF

The Rockets signed free agent Jeff Green on 7/7/23, marking his second stint as a Rocket. He was with the team during the 2019-20 season, including the "bubble" in Orlando.

Green appeared in all 20 games for Denver during its championship run last season while averaging 17.2 mpg.

He is in his 16th season and got his start as a 21-year-old rookie with Seattle in 2007-08.



BOBAN'S BACK

The Rockets re-signed Boban Marjanović prior to training camp. He was originally acquired via trade with Dallas in June of 2022.

Last season, Marjanović appeared in 31 games for the Rockets while shooting a career-best 68.3% from the floor and leading the team in plus/minus rating. He became the ninth player to have played for all three Texas teams.

Marjanović finished runner-up to Mike Conley in voting for the NBA Sportsmanship award last season and was second in voting for the 2021-22 Twyman-Stokes Teammate of the Year Award.

#TWINNING

The Rockets selected Amen Thompson with the fourth overall pick in the 2023 NBA Draft.

His twin brother, Ausar, was taken fifth by Detroit. They became the first brothers to be picked top-10 in the same draft.

The other times that the Rockets had an NBA twin on their team was Stephen Graham in 2005-06 (Joey) and Marcus Morris from 2011-2013 (Markieff).



YO, ADRIAN!



The Rockets have two players on their roster who attended Villanova University outside of Philly: Jermaine Samuels Jr. and Cam Whitmore.

Both made their NBA debuts in the season opener at Orlando on 10/25. Prior to that, Kyle Lowry (2009-12) was the only Rocket from Villanova to have appeared in a game.

OI! OI! OI!!!



Houston signed free agent Jock Landale on 7/6/23.

After going undrafted in 201, the Australian played overseas and eventually made his NBA debut for San Antonio in 2021-22. He spent last season with Phoenix.

Landale is the second Australian to have played for the Rockets, joining David Anderson (2009-10). Dante Exum was briefly with the Rockets but was waived prior to the start of the 2021-22 season. Jae'Sean Tate played in Australia before joining the Rockets.

HOLIDAY CHECKLIST



Houston signed free agent Aaron Holiday on 7/10/23. His older brothers, Justin and Jrue, have both been in the NBA for over a decade. Justin was briefly with the Rockets in February of 2023. Their sister, Lauren, played basketball at UCLA. Jrue's wife, Lauren, was a two-time Olympic gold medalist with the U.S. Women's National Soccer team.

Aaron was originally the 23rd overall pick in the 2018 NBA Draft by Indiana. He spent last season with Atlanta. Over the past four seasons, Holiday shot 38.6% from 3-point range.

The Rockets were tied to another well-known set of NBA brothers, the Jones'. During the 80's and 90's, the Rockets had Caldwell, Charles and Major on their roster at some point, but the oldest of the NBA Jones brothers, Wil, never played for Houston.

CAM I AM



Houston acquired Villanova's Cam Whitmore with the 20th overall pick in the 2023 NBA Draft. In his lone season, Whitmore averaged 12.5 points, 5.3 rebounds, 1.4 spg and 1.4 3FGM.

He was named MVP of the 2023 NBA Summer League in Vegas after averaging 19.3 ppg, 5.2 rpg, 1.8 spg and 2.5 spg.

At the 2022 FIBA Under-18 Americas Championship, Whitmore averaged 18.7 points and was named MVP after leading USA Basketball to the gold medal.

YES BULL

The Rockets signed free agent Reggie Bullock Jr. on 10/4/23 after he cleared waivers from San Antonio.

Bullock spent the past two seasons with Dallas and was traded to San Antonio as part of a three-team trade with Boston in July.

He started every game for the Mavs during their run to the Western Conference Finals in 2021-22, while averaging 10.6 ppg, 4.6 rpg and 2.9 3FGM on 39.7% shooting.

Over the past six seasons, Bullock averaged 2.1 3-pointers made on 38.8% shooting. He was one of 12 players with 350-plus games played over that span to have averaged at least 2.0 3FGM while shooting 38.0% or better.

- Was a member of Popovich's staff for USA Basketball during the 2020 Tokyo Olympics and the 2019 FIBA World Cup.
- As a player, spent parts of seven seasons in the NBA from 2003-04 through 2010-11 while appearing in 316 games with 80 starts.
- After going undrafted in 2000, had brief stints with the Lakers and Knicks, but spent most of his time in the NBA Development League and playing overseas... first full NBA season came as a 29-year-old for Portland in 2006-07.
- During his career, played for Popovich, Phil Jackson, Larry Brown, Nate McMillan and Paul Westphal.
- Since father was of Nigerian decent, represented the Nigerian national team and was the team's leading scorer at the 2006 FIBA World Championships.
- Sister, Mfon, played in the WNBA, including for the Houston Comets in 2003.
