- The 76ers notched their first win against the New York Knicks this season, as they held the Knicks to an NBA season-low 73 points. This represents the fewest points allowed by Philadelphia since Jan. 28, 2015 (69 points vs. Detroit).
- With Sunday's win, Philadelphia improved to 12-0 this season when holding their opponents to under 100 points. They are one of five teams along with Orlando, New York, Minnesota, and Boston to have 12 such games.
 - o Dating back to Oct. 20, 2022, versus Milwaukee, the 76ers have won 26 straight games when preventing their opponent from reaching the 100-point mark.
- In the first half, the 76ers allowed just 31 points, the lowest allowed by the franchise in a first half since holding Milwaukee to 31 points on March 17, 2021.
- Four 76ers scored in double-figures (**KELLY OUBRE JR**. 18; **BUDDY HIELD** 16; **PAUL REED** 13; **TOBIAS HARRIS** 11), the 21st time this season that at least four players tallied at least 10 points. The 76ers have won 12 of these outings.
- Against the Knicks, Oubre Jr. recorded his second double-double of 2023-24 as he added 10 rebounds, including a season-high-tying five offensive boards. He also tallied three steals by the final buzzer.
- > This outing was his fourth career game with at least 15 points, 10 rebounds and three swipes, his first since Jan. 12, 2020, versus Charlotte.
- Across his last five games, Oubre Jr. has totaled 114 points, 32 rebounds, and five steals, making him one of three NBA players since March 3 with at least 110 points, 30 rebounds and five swipes.
- > Hield went 4-of-6 from three-point range on Sunday and has multiple triples in all 14 games he has appeared in with Philadelphia.
- Among active NBA players, Hield ranks sixth with 234 games with four-plus made three. Only **STEPHEN CURRY** 486, **JAMES HARDEN** 321, **DAMIAN LILLARD** 305, **KLAY THOMPSON** 289, and **PAUL GEORGE** 251, have more such games.



- Reed ended the game with seven rebounds and four blocked shots, marking his third consecutive outing with at least 10 points and five rebounds, the second-longest 10-5 streak of his career.
- ▶ His four rejections against the Knicks extended his career-long streak of games with at least three blocks to three straight contests.

- **TOBIAS HARRIS** registered a team-high 21 points along with 10 rebounds and three steals, marking his fourth career game of at least 20 points, 10 rebounds, and three swipes (2nd with 76ers).
- Harris has five games with at least 20 points and 10 rebounds so far this season, good for the second most on the team (26 JOEL EMBIID).
- Harris is averaging 21.2 points on 51.8-percent shooting and 8.4 rebounds in five games played this month. He is one of seven Eastern Conference players in March averaging at least 20 points and five rebounds while shooting at least 50-percent from the floor.
- **KELLY OUBRE JR.** tallied 20 points and seven rebounds, marking his sixth game this season with at least 20 points and five boards. He has scored at least 20 points in four straight games, marking his longest 20-point streak in 2023-24.
- > During this four-game stretch, Oubre Jr. is averaging 24.0 points and 5.5 rebounds.
- ➤ **PAUL REED** recorded a team-high 11 rebounds (six offensive) and added 17 points in 27 reserve minutes. This marked his first double-double off the bench in 2023-24 and the sixth such performance since joining the league in 2020-21, the second-most by a 76er reserve over this stretch.
- > Friday was also Reed's fourth double figure scoring game in five appearances this month. In 12 games during the month of February, Reed had five games of at least 10 points.
- Reed's sixth offensive boards tonight mark his team-best eighth game this season with at least five offensive rebounds. His 144 offensive rebounds this season also represent a team high.
- So far this season, Reed has hauled in 144 offense rebounds, making him one of two players with at least 140 offensive boards in 1,200-or-fewer minutes played in 2023-24, joining Chicago's **ANDRE DRUMMOND**.
- > CAM PAYNE added 13 points as a reserve, marking his seventh game of 10-plus points in 12 contests with Philadelphia.
- > Since joining Philadelphia, **BUDDY HIELD** has five games of at least two made three-pointers and two steals (T-4th in NBA).
- In these games, Hield is one of six players in the league with at least 40 made threes and 15 steals.

- > The Philadelphia 76ers fell to the Memphis Grizzlies, 115-109, in the first meeting between the teams in the 2023-24 season.
- **KELLY OUBRE JR.** led Philadelphia with 25 points off the bench, marking his third consecutive 20-plus point outing as a reserve. He is the first 76er with three straight 20-point outings off the bench since **THADDEUS YOUNG** did so in three straight from March 28-April 1, 2011 (Stathead).
- Through three appearances in March, Oubre Jr. is averaging 25.3 points and 5.0 rebounds. He is one of six Eastern Conference players averaging at least 25 points and five boards in the month, joining Milwaukee's GIANNIS ANTETOKOUNMPO, Orlando's PAOLO BANCHERO, Boston's JAYLEN BROWN and JAYSON TATUM, along with Washington's KYLE KUZMA.
- In his 23rd start this season, **PAUL REED** tallied 17 points, 11 rebounds and three blocked shots, giving him his fifth double-double of 2023-24, matching his career high, which he set last season. Ten of Reed's 11 career double-doubles have come over the last two seasons (Stathead).
 - o Wednesday was the second game for Reed this season with at least 15 points, 10 rebounds and three blocks, entering 2023-24 he had only recorded such a stat line one time (April 9, 2023 against Brooklyn).
- > Reed also has recorded at least 15 points and five rebounds in four of his last six appearances, dating back to Feb. 25.
- > **CAM PAYNE** scored 16 points and collected five rebounds in 28 minutes, giving him five games of at least 15 points in his 11 appearances since being acquired by the 76ers. Payne has started the last three games with Philadelphia and is averaging 17.0 points on 40.9-percent shooting from three in those games.
- > On Wednesday, **BUDDY HIELD** scored 15 points, including a trio of three-pointers, marking his 13th consecutive game with multiple made threes. This represents the fourth-longest active streak in the NBA (Stathead).
- **JEFF DOWTIN JR.,** who signed a two-way contract with Philadelphia on March 2, tied career highs in points (10), steals (three), three-pointers made (two) and blocks (one) on Wednesday, while setting a career-high mark with six assists in his home debut.

THE JO SHOW

- > Joel Embiid was named a started for the 2024 NBA All-Star Game on Jan. 25, marking the seventh career All-Star nod for Embiid. The only 76ers ever with more All-Star selections are Hall of Famers **DOLPH SCHAYES** (12), **JULIUS ERVING** (11), **HAL GREER** (10) and **ALLEN IVERSON** (eight).
- > Embiid, Milwaukee's **GIANNIS ANTETOKOUNMPO**, and the Lakers' **LEBRON JAMES** are the only NBA players to be named All-Stars in each of the last seven seasons.
- > On Jan. 22 the reigning NBA MVP set a 76ers franchise record, and a 2023-24 NBA high, with 70 points against the San Antonio Spurs. In the process, Embiid recorded the NBA's first-ever stat line of at least 70 points, 15 rebounds, and five assists.
- ▶ His record-setting performance made the Cameroon-native one of 10 NBA players in league history to record a 70-point game.
- Embiid did all of this in just 37 minutes played, the fewest ever in a 70-point game. He and Damian Lillard (39 minutes) are the only players in NBA history to score at least 70 points in a game while playing fewer than 40 minutes.
- > Through 34 appearances this season, Embiid is averaging career highs in points (35.3), field goals made (11.8), free throws made (10.5), free throw percentage (88.3%), assists per game (5.7) and steals (1.1)
- Embiid's is averaging 35.3 points in 2023-24. Embiid, who captured the scoring title in each of the last two seasons (2021-23), is averaging the highest points per game by a player since **JAMES HARDEN** averaged 36.1 points during the 2018-19 season.
- > By also shooting 53.3-percent from the floor, Embiid is on track to be the third NBA player to average at least 35 points on 50-percent shooting for a full season. He would join Hall of Famers Wilt Chamberlain (1960-64) and Michael Jordan (1987-88).
- While adding 11.3 rebounds and 5.7 assists, Embiid is also on pace to join Wilt Chamberlain in 1963-64 as the only NBA players to average 35 points, 10 rebounds and five assists for a full season.
- > Embiid set a franchise-record with 22 straight games of 30-plus points from Nov. 17 to Jan. 22, representing the fifth-longest 30-point streak in league history.
- Embiid has tallied 11,919 career points, good for seventh on the franchise's all-time ledger.

A deep dive into Joel Embiid's Most Valuable Moments from 2022-23:

- Posted a then-career-high 59 points to go along with 11 rebounds, eight assists and a career-high-tying seven blocked shots against Utah on Nov. 13.
- On Feb. 15, became the fastest 76er ever to reach 10,000 career points.
- Set a franchise record with 10 straight 30-point games between March 2-20.
- Recorded an Eastern Conference-best 44 games with at least 30 points, the most by a 76er since Hall of Famer Allen Iverson did so during the 2005-06 season.

- Embiid averaged 10.2 first quarter points on 56.9% shooting making him the lone player in the league with such numbers.
- Tallied 50-plus points on three occasions, joining Chamberlain and Iverson as the only 76ers ever with at least three such games in a season.
- > Over the course of the season, Embiid earned three Eastern Conference Player of the Month awards (December, January and March/April), as well as four Eastern Conference Player of the Week nods.
 - He is the first NBA player since 2019-20 and the first 76er ever to capture a trio of monthly honors within a single season.
 - His seven career Player of the Month honors are a 76ers record.
