- > The Philadelphia 76ers fell to the Memphis Grizzlies, 115-109, in the first meeting between the teams in the 2023-24 season.
- **KELLY OUBRE JR.** led Philadelphia with 25 points off the bench, marking his third consecutive 20-plus point outing as a reserve. He is the first 76er with three straight 20-point outings off the bench since **THADDEUS YOUNG** did so in three straight from March 28-April 1, 2011 (Stathead).
- > Through three appearances in March, Oubre Jr. is averaging 25.3 points and 5.0 rebounds. He is one of six Eastern Conference players averaging at least 25 points and five boards in the month, joining Milwaukee's **GIANNIS ANTETOKOUNMPO**, Orlando's **PAOLO BANCHERO**, Boston's **JAYLEN BROWN** and **JAYSON TATUM**, along with Washington's **KYLE KUZMA**.
- In his 23rd start this season, **PAUL REED** tallied 17 points, 11 rebounds and three blocked shots, giving him his fifth double-double of 2023-24, matching his career high, which he set last season. Ten of Reed's 11 career double-doubles have come over the last two seasons (Stathead).
 - Wednesday was the second game for Reed this season with at least 15 points, 10 rebounds and three blocks, entering 2023-24 he had only recorded such a stat line one time (April 9, 2023 against Brooklyn).
- > Reed also has recorded at least 15 points and five rebounds in four of his last six appearances, dating back to Feb. 25.
- > **CAM PAYNE** scored 16 points and collected five rebounds in 28 minutes, giving him five games of at least 15 points in his 11 appearances since being acquired by the 76ers. Payne has started the last three games with Philadelphia and is averaging 17.0 points on 40.9-percent shooting from three in those games.
- > On Wednesday, **BUDDY HIELD** scored 15 points, including a trio of three-pointers, marking his 13th consecutive game with multiple made threes. This represents the fourth-longest active streak in the NBA (Stathead).
- > **JEFF DOWTIN JR.,** who signed a two-way contract with Philadelphia on March 2, tied career highs in points (10), steals (three), three-pointers made (two) and blocks (one) on Wednesday, while setting a career-high mark with six assists in his home debut.

- The 76ers fell to the Brooklyn Nets on Tuesday and hold a 35-26 record through 61 games in 2023-24.
- Against the Nets, Philadelphia had five players (**KELLY OUBRE JR.** 30, **TOBIAS HARRIS** 18, **CAM PAYNE** 15, **KYLE LOWRY** 14, and **BUDDY HIELD** 13) score in double figures for the 34th time this season.
- Tuesday's 30-point showing off the bench represented a season-high in points for Oubre Jr., shooting 11-for-20 from the field and adding six rebounds. This outing was the 11th 30-point and five-rebound game of his career, his first since Dec. 19, 2022.
- Oubre Jr. has scored at least 20 points in his last two games as a reserve, making him the first 76er with back-to-back 20-point games off the bench since **SHAKE MILTON** did so on Jan. 14 (28 points against Memphis) and Jan. 16 (31 points versus Miami) during the 2020-21 season.
- In six games since the All-Star break, Oubre Jr. is Philadelphia's third-leading scorer at 15.0 points per game.
- Philadelphia's starting backcourt of Payne and Lowry combined for 29 points (10-19 FG, 7-14 3FG).
- For Payne, this marked his fifth double-figure scoring game in his 10 appearances since being acquired by the 76ers.
- In these 10 outings, he is averaging 10.2 points (102 total points scored), marking his second-highest point total within his first 10 games with any franchise of his career (106 total points, 10.6 points per game in first 10 games with Phoenix in 2020-21).
- In Lowry's third consecutive start with Philadelphia, he has combined on 29 total points and has shot 44.4-percent from three-point range (8-18). This percentage ranks within the top-20 since March 1 in the NBA (min. 15 3FGA).
- Over this same period, Lowry is one of six players league-wide with at least 20 assists with five or fewer turnovers.

- > The 76ers defeated the Dallas Mavericks on Sunday, splitting their season series 1-1. The win improved Philadelphia's record to 12-8 (.600) against Western Conference teams in 2023-24 (T-3rd among Eastern Conference teams).
- ▶ Defensively, the 76ers tallied 10 steals and five blocked shots against Dallas, marking their NBA-leading 17th game of the season with at least 10 swipes and five rejections.
- > Through 60 games in 2023-24, Philadelphia is one of three NBA teams averaging at least eight steals (8.5; 1st in NBA) and five blocked shots (5.8; 9th in NBA).
- > **TOBIAS HARRIS** led Philadelphia's offense with 28 points on 11-of-19 shooting (3-6 3FG), while also adding five rebounds. Harris has scored at least 20 points in consecutive games for the first time since Jan. 30-Feb. 1.
- In 54 games this season, Harris has nine games with at least 25 points and five rebounds after combining for eight such games over the previous two seasons (7 in 2021-22; 1 in 2022-23).
- > Sunday also marked the ninth game this season for Harris with at least three makes from three-point range (PHI: 6-3).
- > TYRESE MAXEY (24 points), registered his team-best 45th 20-point game this season (T-9th in NBA).
- Maxey scored 17 of his 24 points in the opening quarter on 7-of-10 shooting, tied for the second-highest scoring quarter of his career.
- Maxey is averaging 28.7 points, 5.0 assists, and 1.5 steals over his last six games. He is the only Eastern Conference player with such numbers since Feb. 22.
- **KELLY OUBRE JR.** scored 21 points in 26 reserve minutes, marking his second 20-point performance off the bench this season (27 pts, Oct. 26 vs. Milwaukee).
- Philadelphia shot 29-of-31 (93.5%) from the foul line, marking the fifth-best mark from the stripe in a single game throughout the NBA this season (min. 30 attempts). The 76ers lead the NBA in free throw percentage at 83.2, which currently stands as the fifth-highest mark for a full season in NBA history.

76ers **KELLY OUBRE JR.** played for Pelicans assistant coach **JAMES BORREGO** when he was the head coach of the Charlotte Hornets during the 2021-2022 season... 76ers **NICOLAS BATUM** and New Orleans' **CJ MCCOLLUM** were teammates on the Portland Trail Blazers from 2013-2015... The Pelicans **JEREMIAH ROBINSON-EARL** played collegiately at Villanova... Philadelphia's **DE'ANTHONY MELTON** and New Orleans' **JONAS VALANCIUNAS** were teammates on the Memphis Grizzlies from 2019-2021... Valanciunas also played under 76ers head coach **NICK NURSE** when he was an assistant coach and head coach for the Toronto Raptors from 2015-2019... Pelicans' coaching advisor **MIKE D'ANTONI** was an associate head with the 76ers during the 2015-2016 season... Pelicans assistant coach for player development **COREY BREWER** played for the 76ers during the 2018-2019 season... 76ers assistant coach **BRYAN GATES** was an assistant coach with the Pelicans from 2013-2015... Philadelphia's **KYLE LOWRY** and Pelicans' **CODY ZELLER** were teammates on the Miami Heat during the 2022-2023 season... 76ers **BUDDY HIELD** was drafted by the Pelicans in the first round of the 2016 NBA Draft... New Orleans' **LARRY NANCE JR.** and 76ers' **CAM PAYNE** were teammates on the Cleveland Cavaliers for part of the 2018-2019 season.



THE JO SHOW

- > Joel Embiid was named a started for the 2024 NBA All-Star Game on Jan. 25, marking the seventh career All-Star nod for Embiid. The only 76ers ever with more All-Star selections are Hall of Famers **DOLPH SCHAYES** (12), **JULIUS ERVING** (11), **HAL GREER** (10) and **ALLEN IVERSON** (eight).
- > Embiid, Milwaukee's **GIANNIS ANTETOKOUNMPO**, and the Lakers' **LEBRON JAMES** are the only NBA players to be named All-Stars in each of the last seven seasons.
- On Jan. 22 the reigning NBA MVP set a 76ers franchise record, and a 2023-24 NBA high, with 70 points against the San Antonio Spurs. In the process, Embiid recorded the NBA's first-ever stat line of at least 70 points, 15 rebounds, and five assists.
- > His record-setting performance made the Cameroon-native one of 10 NBA players in league history to record a 70-point game.
- > Embiid did all of this in just 37 minutes played, the fewest ever in a 70-point game. He and Damian Lillard (39 minutes) are the only players in NBA history to score at least 70 points in a game while playing fewer than 40 minutes.
- > Through 34 appearances this season, Embiid is averaging career highs in points (35.3), field goals made (11.8), free throws made (10.5), free throw percentage (88.3%), assists per game (5.7) and steals (1.1)
- > Embiid's is averaging 35.3 points in 2023-24. Embiid, who captured the scoring title in each of the last two seasons (2021-23), is averaging the highest points per game by a player since **JAMES HARDEN** averaged 36.1 points during the 2018-19 season.
- > By also shooting 53.3-percent from the floor, Embiid is on track to be the third NBA player to average at least 35 points on 50-percent shooting for a full season. He would join Hall of Famers Wilt Chamberlain (1960-64) and Michael Jordan (1987-88).
- While adding 11.3 rebounds and 5.7 assists, Embiid is also on pace to join Wilt Chamberlain in 1963-64 as the only NBA players to average 35 points, 10 rebounds and five assists for a full season.
- > Embiid set a franchise-record with 22 straight games of 30-plus points from Nov. 17 to Jan. 22, representing the fifth-longest 30-point streak in league history.
- Embiid has tallied 11,919 career points, good for seventh on the franchise's all-time ledger.

A deep dive into Joel Embiid's Most Valuable Moments from 2022-23:

- Posted a then-career-high 59 points to go along with 11 rebounds, eight assists and a career-high-tying seven blocked shots against Utah on Nov. 13.
- On Feb. 15, became the fastest 76er ever to reach 10,000 career points.
- Set a franchise record with 10 straight 30-point games between March 2-20.
- Recorded an Eastern Conference-best 44 games with at least 30 points, the most by a 76er since Hall of Famer Allen Iverson did so during the 2005-06 season.

- Embiid averaged 10.2 first quarter points on 56.9% shooting making him the lone player in the league with such numbers.
- > Tallied 50-plus points on three occasions, joining Chamberlain and Iverson as the only 76ers ever with at least three such games in a season.
- > Over the course of the season, Embiid earned three Eastern Conference Player of the Month awards (December, January and March/April), as well as four Eastern Conference Player of the Week nods.
 - He is the first NBA player since 2019-20 and the first 76er ever to capture a trio of monthly honors within a single season.
 - His seven career Player of the Month honors are a 76ers record.
