Houston has won four straight in the series and have won 22 out of the last 26 games overall. Last season was the first series win for Minnesota since the 2012 season.

First Meeting: The Rockets outscored the Timberwolves by 12 in the final quarter, to win their seventh straight win. James Harden led the Rockets with 49 points on 16-of-41 shooting, six assists and five rebounds, in 39 minutes. Karl-Anthony Towns led the Timberwolves with 27 points on 9-of-15 shooting, 15 rebounds, two steals and two blocks. Jake Layman added 21 points and five rebounds. Robert Covington tallied 17 points, five rebounds and three assists.

Second Meeting: The Rockets used a 80-56 margin over the middle periods to seal a 139-109 victory over the Timberwolves at Toyota Center Saturday afternoon. Houston shot 51.6 percent while limiting the visitors to a 37.9-percent success rate. Josh Okogie's 16 points, which he combined with five rebounds, five assists and four steals, led the Timberwolves. Jarrett Culver furnished 15 points, eight boards and five assists.

Third Meeting: The Rockets took a 10-point lead into the fourth, and while the Timberwolves cut it to a two-point game early in the fourth, but Houston used a 14-6 run in fourth quarter to win 131-124 at Target Center. Russell Westbrook led the Rockets with 45 points on 16-of-27 shooting, 10 assists, six rebounds and a steal. James Harden was quiet, with a season-low 12 points on 3-of-13 shooting, five assists, four rebounds and three blocks. Meanwhile, Karl-Anthony Towns led the Timberwolves with 30 points on 12-of-23 shooting, 12 rebounds, three assists and two blocks.

Became the 15th head coach in Wolves history on Jan. 6, 2019, taking over after Tom Thibodeau was relieved of his coaching duties... It's his first NBA head coaching appointment, having spent the past decade as an assistant (2009-10 through 2013-14 with Washington, 2014-15 through 2018-19 with Minnesota)...At age 33, he's the youngest person to serve as an NBA head coach since a 30-year-old Dave Cowens finished the 1978-79 season in the role of player/coach for Boston... Was the head coach for the Timberwolves' Las Vegas Summer League entries from 2015 through 2017, highlighted by a runner-up finish in 2016... A 2008 graduate of the University of Minnesota, he played four seasons for the Gophers where he was a two-time captain, four-time scholar athlete award winner and 2005-06 Big Ten All-Academic choice... Earned a bachelor's degree in sport management and is currently pursuing a Master's degree in applied kinesiology... Born on Apr. 28, 1986 in Medina, Minn., he is the son of Debbie and the late Flip Saunders, a 17-year NBA coaching veteran and the all-time winningest coach in Timberwolves franchise history (427-392, .521)... They're the fourth father/son head coaching duo in NBA history, joining Bernie & J.B. Bickerstaff, Brendan & Michael Malone, and Bill & Eric Musselman.

**TOP-40 HITS:** Minnesota set a season-high for second quarter points with 44 (prev. 43 vs. Washington, 11/15/19) Tuesday night in New Orleans. It marked the fifth 40+ point second quarter and the 12th 40+ point quarter of the season, extending the team's franchise record for most 40+ point quarters in a season (Prev. six, 3X, MR: 2018-19). The Timberwolves scored 40 points in the first quarter and 41 points in the second quarter Feb. 8 against the Los Angeles Clippers, marking the second time in franchise history (second and third quarters against San Antonio on 11/13/19) scoring 40+ in consecutive quarters. **WOLF TRACKS:** The Timberwolves head on the road for a season-long six-game road trip beginning tonight in Houston. The six-game road trip ties the second-longest in franchise history and marks the eighth time in Minnesota has embarked on a road trip of six games or more. Wednesday's win against the Chicago Bulls wrapped up the team's ninth back-to-back this season against Chicago. Moving to 3-6 on the second of a back-to-backs this year...The Jan. 18 game against Toronto began stretch for the Timberwolves that will see them play five out of the next six game at Target Center. The Jan. 17 contest at Indiana wrapped up the 22nd regular season home-and-home set for Minnesota – and just the fourth time it's occurred vs. an Eastern Conference foe. The Timberwolves wrapped up their the second four-game road trip this season Dec. 26 at Sacramento, a stretch that saw them play eight out of 11 games on the road. The Timberwolves longest overall road trip will be six games from March 10-20.

**NAIL BITER:** The Feb. 26 12-point comeback with 3:59 left in the fourth quarter against the Heat represented just the sixth game in the StatsCube era (since 1996-97) that Minnesota has won when trailing by double figures at any point in the final 5:00 of regulation – and the first in over a decade (ending a run of 366 consecutive losses in that category) – out of a total of 682 contests meeting those criteria. **OFFENSIVE POWERS:** *In the four weeks since the Feb. 5-6 roster makeover, Minnesota ranks second in the NBA in scoring (119.7 ppg) behind New Orleans (121.1), first in Pace (107.14), 14th in TS% (57.4%) and third in three-pointers made (14.9 per game), only behind the Dallas Mavericks (16.1) and Houston Rockets (16.0).* Over the last 12 games (Feb. 8-Mar. 6, 2020), the Timberwolves have scored 1556 points, the most over a 13-game stretch in team history. With the 139-134 victory over the New Orleans Pelicans Mar. 3, the Timberwolves set a franchise record for points scored on the road in regulation with 139 (prev. 136 at Dallas, 10/20/18).

**JUMP START:** In his debut with the Timberwolves on Feb. 10 at Toronto, D'Angelo Russell finished with 22 points, shooting 7-for-12 from the field and 4-for-5 from three-point range, the 12th player in team history to tally 20+ points in his debut. On Saturday night against the Clippers, Malik Beasley erupted for 23 points on 8-of-19 shooting, including a career-high 7-of-13 from deep and a career-high 10 rebounds. He became the 11th player to score 20+ points in his Timberwolves debut – and the first of the 12 players to also collect 10+ rebounds. A look at Minnesota's all-time top "first impressions":

**LET IT FLY:** *Minnesota connected on 26-of-44 (.591) from three-point range Feb. 8 against the Clippers, surpassing the franchise record of 23 set against Sacramento on 1/27/20 in OT. The 26 threes represent the second-most in NBA history, one shy of the league record of 27 set by Houston vs. Phoenix on 4/17/19.* The Timberwolves had 10 different players hit from deep against the Clippers Feb. 8, the most for any single game in franchise history (previously: 9, 2x; MR: Nov. 27, 2019 at San Antonio). The 59.1% from deep in that same game represented a season-high and the 26 threes were the most in NBA history while shooting 50% or better from long range. Minnesota has connected on 10+ threes in 56 games this season, (the fourth-most in the NBA), while the Wolves have hit 15+ treys 22 times this season.

**BOARD REPORT:** Minnesota outrebounded Houston on Jan. 24 52-34, the fourth time this season (3-1) outrebounding its opponent by double-digits and the 34 rebounds by the Rockets represented the lowest by a Wolves opponent this season. The Timberwolves grabbed a season-high 65 rebounds Dec. 26 against the Kings, tied for the second-most rebounds in franchise history and the most since pulling down 65 boards in a 120-114 triple overtime loss against the Houston Rockets on Jan. 13, 2010. Coming into tonight's matchup against the Magic, Minnesota ranks 15th in rebounding (44.9 rpg), including ranked tied for 10th in offensive boards (10.6 rpg). The Wolves have turned the offensive rebounding advantage into 13.6 second chance points per game, ninth in the NBA.

**DON'T CALL IT A COMEBACK:** For the second straight game Wednesday, the Timberwolves stormed back from double-digit deficits. Against Chicago, Minnesota turned around a 13-point deficit, the second largest comeback this season and marked the sixth double-digit comeback of the season. On Nov. 25 at State Farm Arena, Atlanta held its largest lead of the game at 71-59 with 9:28 left in the third quarter. Minnesota would flip the script in the fourth quarter and wound up taking its largest lead of the night of 14 (123-109) with 1:44 left in the game. *Minnesota had eight double-digit comebacks in the 2018-19 season.* A look at Minnesota's "volatility factor" in 2019-20:
