Nov. 12: The Wolves completed a five-player trade with Philadelphia, acquiring forwards Robert Covington and Dario Šarić, guard Jerryd Bayless and a 2nd-round pick in the 2022 NBA Draft for forward Jimmy Butler and center Justin Patton... Of the 16 players who ended 2017-18 with Minnesota, seven were back this season; 11 new faces dotted the Wolves' roster, including free-agent signees Anthony Tolliver, Luol Deng and C.J. Williams... Five rookies were on the list: Josh Okogie (1st round, 20th overall), Keita Bates-Diop (2nd round, 48th overall), Creek (undrafted), Reynolds (undrafted) and Jared Terrell (undrafted); Terrell and Williams are signed to two-way contracts... The final 18-player roster averaged 4.7 years of NBA experience, with an average age of 27.5 years; the 2017-18 group was at 5.0 and 27.1 years, respectively (3.6 and 26.1 in 2016-17).
